TEAM NOTES

- Baylor is 3-3, 1-2 in the Big 12 Conference and West Virginia is 3-3, 1-2 in the Big 12.
- West Virginia leads the series 7-4 and has won all six meetings in Morgantown.
- Baylor captains: Grant Miller, Mark Milton, Griffin Speaks and Craig Williams.
- Baylor is now 3-5 on Thursdays, dating back to 1970. It was Baylor's first Thursday-night game since 2019, a 17-14 win at home vs. WVU.
- The Bears are 1-2 on the road in 2022.
- Baylor is 17-12 under third-year head coach Dave Aranda.
- The Bears totaled a season-high 590 yards of total offense, including a season-best 421 yards through the air.
- The 421 passing yards marked the most since throwing for 463 vs. Oklahoma in 2017.
- This marked the third game of six outings in 2022 that Baylor has gone over 500 yards of total offense.
- The Bears intercepted a pass in the third quarter and own a +21 turnover margin under Aranda.
- Baylor has 49 takeaways (34 interceptions, 15 fumble recoveries) and only 28 giveaways (17 interceptions, 11 fumbles lost).
- For the first time in an 18-game span, an opponent scored more than 30 points against Baylor, dating back to the season finale in 2020.
 - It was the longest stretch holding an opponent to 30 or fewer points since a 19-game stretch from 1984-86.
- Baylor had a blocked PAT returned for a score, marking the first time since 2009 vs. Nebraska an opponent has blocked a kick, field goal or PAT and returned it for points.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Sophomore QB Blake Shapen was 14 for 22 with 326 yards and two TDs.
- It was the second-most passing yards of his career and his second career and consecutive game with 300+ yards passing.
 - Shapen has 11 TD passes in 2022 and 16 in his career.
- Senior WR Gavin Holmes had a career game, setting new career highs with catches (seven), yards (210), while hauling in a TD.
 - Holmes is the first BU player to have 200 + yards receiving since KD Cannon in the 2016 Cactus Bowl.
 - Holmes eclipsed the 100-yard receiving plateau for the first time in his career.
 - Holmes has three TD grabs in 2022, a career-high and six in his career.
 - Holmes tied his career long with a 56-yard grab in the second quarter.
- Freshman QB Kyron Drones was 7 for 14 through the air for 95 yards and a TD, adding 24 yards rushing.
 - Drones threw his first career TD pass.
- Sophomore WR Hal Presley caught his second career TD pass, both in 2022.
- Junior RB Qualan Jones finished with 10 carries for 45 yards and a TD.
- Jones rushed for his sixth career TD and his fourth of 2022.
- Junior TE Drake Dabney had a career-high five catches for a career-best 66 yards.
- Freshman RB Richard Reese rushed 13 times for 57 yards.
- Senior LB Dillon Doyle had his second straight 10-tackle game, leading the team with 10 stops and hauling in his second career interception.
- Sophomore LB **Tony Anyanwu** finished with three tackles.
 - Anyanwu has 1.5 tackles for a loss in 2022.
- Senior DL TJ Franklin had four tackles, half a stop for a loss and one pass break-up.
 - Franklin broke up his first pass of the year.
 - Franklin has two tackles for a loss in 2022 and 12.2 in his career.
- Senior S Christian Morgan finished with five tackles and a pass break-up.
- Morgan broke up his second pass of the year and the 13th of his career.
- Senior LB Bryson Jackson had four tackles and half a stop for a loss.
 - Jackson has 8.5 tackles for a loss in his career and 3.5 in 2022.
- Freshman LB Tyrone Brown recorded his first career half tackle for a loss.
- Senior John Mayers connected on field goals from 40 and 44 yards.
 - Mayers has made 30 of 38 career field-goal attempts, good for a .789 percentage, which ranks first in program history.
 - Mayers had made 29 career field goals, tying Jarvis Van Dyke for eighth all time.
 - Mayers has 184 career points, ranking seventh in program history and passing Connor Martin and Marty Jimmerson.
 - Mayers has made 97 career PATs, ranking sixth in school history.

- Junior RB Craig Williams rushed three times for 25 yards and caught a 39-yard TD in the second quarter.
 - Williams had his first career receiving TD.
- A 39-yard TD grab in the second quarter was the longest reception of his career.
- Sophomore LB Brooks Miller broke up his first career pass.
- Senior TE Ben Sims grabbed two passes for 18 yards and rushed for a one-yard TD.
 Sims rushed for his second career TD and his first since 2021 vs. Texas.
- Sophomore CB Lorando Johnson broke up his third pass of the year.
- Junior LB Matt Jones had three tackles and two pass break-ups.
 - Jones broke up his third and fourth passes of the year.
- Junior DL Siaki Ika had his first tackle for a loss of 2022 and his second QB hurry of the year and the sixth of his career.
- Junior DL Gabe Hall had a career high five tackles, including half a stop for a loss.
 - Hall has nine career tackles for a loss and 1.5 in 2022.
- Senior CB Mark Milton had a career-high eight tackles, including half a stop for a loss.
- Milton has two career tackles for a loss.
- Junior S Devin Lemear had a career-high seven tackles.
- Baylor senior OL Connor Galvin made his team-leading 43rd-career start and made his team-high 32nd-straight start.
- Jacob Gall played in his team-best 53rd career game.
