TEAM NOTES

- Baylor is 6-6, 4-5 in the Big 12 Conference and Texas is 8-4, 6-3 in the Big 12.
- Texas leads the all-time series, 79-29-4, including a 49-10-2 mark in games played in Austin.
 - Texas has won four straight games in Austin.
- Baylor captains: Bryson Jackson, Khalil Keith, Cole Maxwell, Craig Williams.
- Baylor is 20-15 under third-year head coach Dave Aranda.
- Baylor is 5-3 in 2022 when scoring first and 14-6 under Aranda.
- Baylor has 64 takeaways and 40 giveaways in 35 games under Aranda.
- Baylor recorded its first safety since 2017, when Bravion Roy secured a sack vs. TCU.
- Baylor was 4-for-5 on fourth down and pull into a tie for the nation's lead in fourth-down conversions (27).
- The Bears recorded five sacks, its most since going for a season-best six sacks at Texas Tech.
- The Bears returned a fumble for a TD in the fourth quarter, a 16-yard score for Gabe Hall, marking the first fumble returned for a score since JT Woods had a 97-yard return vs. Texas Southern in 2021.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Baylor senior OL Connor Galvin made his team-leading 49th-career start and made his team-high 38th-straight start.
- Galvin passed Spencer Drango (2012-15) for first place in Baylor history with 48 career starts.
- Senior S AI Walcott had a team-leading 10 tackles with two forced fumbles and a sack.
- Walcott has two sacks on the year and three in his career.
- Walcott has 12 career tackles for a loss and 10 in 2022.
- Walcott forced his second and third fumbles of the year.
- Freshman S Devin Lemear had seven tackles and recovered his second fumble of the year.
- Senior DL TJ Franklin finished with three tackles and a sack.
- Franklin has 1.5 sacks on the year and eight in his career.
- Franklin has 13.5 tackles for a loss in his career and three in 2022.
- Senior LB Bryson Jackson had a sack.
- Jackson has three sacks on the year and 6.5 in his career.
- Jackson has 10.5 tackles for a loss in his career and 5.5 in 2022.
- Junior DL Gabe Hall had four tackles, a sack and a 16-yard fumble returned for a touchdown.
- Hall has 4.5 sacks on the year and 10.5 in his career.
- Hall has 5.5 tackles for a loss on the year and 13 in his career.
- Hall returned a fumble in the fourth quarter for a touchdown.
- Senior TE Ben Sims caught a 14-yard TD in the second quarter.
- Sims caught his third TD of the year and the 12th of his career.
 - Sims has the most TD receptions of any tight end in program history.
- Senior John Mayers made a 30-yard field goal in the second quarter and was 2 of 2 in PATs.
 - Mayers has 221 career points, moving into third in program history.
 - Mayers has made 34 of 44 field goals in his career.
 - Mayers is 119 of 121 in his career in PATs, ranking third in PATs made and attempted.
 - Mayers ranks eighth in program history in field-goal attempts.
 - Mayers has made 98.3 percent of his PATs, ranking sixth in program history.
- Mayers has made 77.3 percent of his field goal attempts, ranking tops in program history.
- Sophomore QB Blake Shapen was 18 for 36 for 179 yards and two TDs, adding 18 yards rushing.
- Shapen threw his 15th and 16th TD passes of the year and has 21 in his career.
- Freshman WR Josh Cameron finished with four catches for 48 yards.
- Sophomore WR Monaray Baldwin had three grabs for 35 yards.
- Senior Issac Power punted five times for a 36.4 yard average, with two downed inside the 20.
- Freshman RB Richard Reese added to his rushing yardage, program record for a freshman, with 15 carries for 54 yards.

- Junior RB Qualan Jones carried it 14 times for 45 yards, and had a team-leading six catches for 18 yards.
- Sophomore CB Lorando Johnson has five pass break-ups in 2022.
- Senior S Christian Morgan finished with nine tackles and a sack.
- Morgan recorded a sack which led to a safety in the first quarter, marking his second career sack and his first since 2020.
- Junior WR Jaylen Ellis hauled in a 47-yard TD strike int he first quarter.
- Ellis hauled in a 47-yard TD grab in the first quarter, his second catch of the year. His first catch came in a 50-yard grab in the season-lidlifter vs. UAlbany.
- Freshman LB Jackie Marshall had three tackles and a PBU.
 - Marshall broke up his third pass of the year.
- Senior CB Mark Milton finished with five tackles.
- Sophomore LB Brooks Miller made his first career start.
- Senior DL Chidi Ogbonnaya played in his 58th career game, ranking third in program history.
- Jacob Gall played in his 58th career game over two institutions, Buffalo and Baylor.
