TEAM NOTES

- Baylor is 1-3, 0-1 in the Big 12 Conference and Texas is 3-0, 0-0 in the Big 12.
- Texas leads the all-time series with Baylor, 81-28-4, including a 32-18-2 mark in games played in Waco.
 - Baylor has won six of the last 14 meetings with Texas.
- Baylor head coach Dave Aranda is 21-19 in his fourth year in Waco.
 - Baylor is 9-4 in September under Aranda.
 - Baylor is 13-8 at McLane Stadium under Aranda and are 11-6 over the last three years.
- The Bears are 38-21 all-time at McLane Stadium.
- The Bears are 59-196-6 all-time against ranked foes.
 - Baylor is 5-11 under Aranda vs. ranked foes and 0-2 in 2023.
 - The Bears were seeking their fourth all-time top-three win and their first since 2012 vs. Kansas State. BU also beat No. 3 USC in 1985 and No. 2 Tennessee in 1956.
- Baylor had a conference opener streak of six straight wins snapped.
- Baylor is 628-596-44 all-time.
- A crowd of 49,165 was the fifth-largest attendance in McLane Stadium history and the 11th in Baylor history.
- Baylor captains: Clark Barrington, Devin Lemear, Mike Smith, Dominic Richardson.
- Baylor returns to action on Saturday, hitting the road for the first time on the year, traveling to face UCF for their Big 12 home debut. Kickoff is slated for 2:30 p.m. CT and will be broadcast live on FS1 and the Baylor Sports Network.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior TE Drake Dabney caught two balls and now has 42 catches in his career, ranking sixth among tight ends in program history.
- Sophomore QB Sawyer Robertson threw for a career-high 203 yards on 20 of 35 passes.
- Senior LB Matt Jones finished with eight tackles, 3.5 for a loss and two sacks.
- Jones has seven career QB sacks.
- Jones has 16.5 career tackles for a loss.
- Sophomore PK Isaiah Hankins was 2-of-2 in field-goal attempts.
- Hankins has scored 135 points in his career, ranking tied with Ryan Havens (2003-06) for 10th in program history.
- Hankins is 21 for 30 in his career in field-goal attempts, connecting on 70% of his attempts which ranks seventh in school annals.
- Sophomore LS Garrison Grimes recovered his first two career fumbles.
- Freshman CB Caden Jenkins had his first career tackle for a loss in the first quarter.
- Sophomore DL Cooper Lanz had half a tackle for a loss, the first of his career.
- Freshman Palmer Williams punted six times for a 44.7 yard average, with one downed inside the 20-yard line and a long of 52.
- Senior S Bryson Jackson played in his team-high 52nd career game.
- Senior C Clark Barrington made his Baylor debut and played in his 50th career game and made his 44th career start. After making 37 straight starts to end his BYU career, Barrington has now started 41 consecutive games.
