TEAM NOTES

- · Baylor faced off against Houston for the 30th time in program history.
 - The series is now tied 15-15-1 and 8-8-1 in Waco.
- Baylor head coach Dave Aranda is 36-37 in his sixth year with Baylor.
 - Baylor is 24-30 in conference games in the Aranda era.
 - Baylor is 3-4 this year at home and 21-16 under Aranda.
- Baylor is 643-634-44 all-time.
- The Bears are 5-4 in day games in 2025 and 25-21 under Aranda.
- BU is 4-6 on artificial turf in 2025 and 32-28 under Aranda.
- Baylor is 1-3 in November and 10-12 under Aranda.
- BU erased a 15-point deficit during the game, the first time since 9/30/23 at UCF.
- Baylor captains: Sawyer Robertson, Josh Cameron, Cooper Lanz, Devyn Bobby
- First career start for Matthew Klopenstein

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Baylor put up 421 offensive yards, 309 through the air and 112 on the ground.
- Senior QB Sawyer Robertson threw 23-46-1 for 309 yards and a passing touchdown.
 - Robertson has 7,932 yards of total offense in his career, ranking fourth-best in program history.
 - Robertson has been responsible for 68 career TDs, fifth-best in career history.
 - Robertson has 40 TDs responsible for in 2025, moving him to fourth in program history behind Nick Florence (2012) at 43.
 - Robertson has thrown for 7,616 yards in his career, ranking fourth-best in BU history.
 - Robertson has thrown for 599 completions in his career, ranking third-best in program history.
 - Robertson has 61 career TD passes, ranking fourth-best in BU history.
 - Robertson has thrown 31 TD passes in 2025, and is now in sole possesion of fourth in program history.
- Senior WR Kole Wilson led the team with 96 receiving yards on four receptions.
- Senior WR Josh Cameron finished with 55 yards on three receptions and a touchdown.
 - Sawyer Robertson and Josh Cameron are tied for the fourth-most TD's in Baylor history between a QB & WR with 18 TDs.
 - Cameron has 29 straight games with a catch, tied for the 11th-longest active streak in the country.
 - Cameron 19th career receiving TD moves him to sole possesion tied for 8th in program history.
 - His 167 career catches moves him in to 8th in BU history.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- BU allowed Houston to 417 offensive yards, 210 passing and 216 rushing.
- Junior LB Keaton Thomas led the team in tackles with 11 total, nine being solo, a sack and an interception.
 - Marked the fifth double-digit tackle game of the season and 10th of his career.
 - Thomas earned his 100th tackle of the season.
 - Thomas is the first Bear since Eddie Lackey (2012-13) to have back-to-back 100 + tackle seasons.
- Junior S Micah Gifford ended with 10 tackles, eight solo.
 - Marked a career-best amount of tackles, and his first double-digit tackle game.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Freshman K Connor Hawkins went three-for-three in field goals with a long made field goal of 54 yards.
 - 54-yard completion is the longest by a Bear at McLane, tied for stadium record.
 - Hawkins has made 18 FGs in 2025, sole possesion of 4th in single-season history.
- Sophomore P Palmer Williams punted twice for 96 yards with a long of 53 yards.
 - Marked Williams 11th 50+ long punt of the season and 39th of his career.
