

BAYLOR at K-STATE BY THE NUMBERS

52,293 – Attendance Saturday afternoon at Bill Snyder Family Stadium, K-State's 36th-straight sellout and the ninth-straight sellout for a home opener.

2,461 – Career passing yards by **Jesse Ertz**, who moved from 16th to 15th in K-State history on Saturday.

1,395 – Career rushing yards by **Jesse Ertz**, who moved into 19th place in K-State history in career rushing yards but third among quarterbacks.

234 – Career points by **Matthew McCrane**, and needs one point to move into seventh place in school history in career points by kickers.

225 – Rushing yards for K-State on Saturday; third straight game the Wildcats have rushed for 200 or more yards

205 – Career victories by head coach **Bill Snyder**, who is two wins away from a tie for 20th place all-time in FBS history.

79 – Career high receiving yards by **Isaiah Zuber**.

58 – Distance on a **Nick Walsh** punt in the third quarter, his longest punt since last year's Texas Tech game (Oct. 8, 2016).

53 – Wins in September home games under **Bill Snyder** since 1992.

49 – Distance on a **Matthew McCrane** field goal in the fourth quarter, his second connection from 40 or more yards this year.

44 – Distance of a second-quarter Baylor field goal that was blocked by **Reggie Walker**... It was the first blocked kick of his career.

36 – Consecutive sellouts at Bill Snyder Family Stadium dating back to the 2012 season.

20 – Career rushing touchdowns by **Winston Dimel**, one of 15 players in school history to reach 20 rushing touchdowns in a career.

1:43 – Time off the clock it took for K-State to get on the scoreboard... It was the second time this season the Wildcats scored within the first two minutes of the game (Central Arkansas).

RECORDS...

Today's game was the 15th all-time meeting between Kansas State and Baylor as the Wildcats lead the all-time series, 9-6... Kansas State has won each of the last two games, its first time winning consecutive games over the Bears since 2002-03... It was the first time K-State defeated Baylor at home since 2011, a 36-35 victory... K-State is now 21-9 (.700) when coming off a bye week under head coach **Bill Snyder**, including a 10-5 (.667) mark since his return to the sidelines in 2009... The Wildcats are now 53-3 (.946) in September home games under Snyder since 1992.

STARTING OFF 1-0

K-State earned a victory to begin Big 12 play for the first time since a 32-28 victory at Iowa State in 2014... In the 22-year history of the Big 12, the Wildcats hold a 11-11 (.500) record in Big 12 openers... Kansas State is now 14-8 (.636) in Big 12 home openers.

SNYDER NOTCHES ANOTHER W

With today's victory, head coach **Bill Snyder** improved his career record to 205-106-1 (.659)... He is now two victories away from a tie for 20th place all-time in FBS history... Snyder also recorded his 120th career league win as he moved within one of tying **Bob Stoops** (Oklahoma) for second place in Big 8/12 history.

ERTZ UP THE CHARTS

Quarterback **Jesse Ertz** once again moved up both the career rushing and passing charts... With his 95 rushing yards, Ertz now has 1,395 career rushing yards to rank 19th in school history, including third among quarterbacks, the latter passing **Michael Bishop** (1,314; 1997-98)... He also threw for 119 yards to give him 2,461 in his career, moving from 16th to 15th in school history in career passing yards.

REACHING 20

Junior fullback **Winston Dimel** scored one touchdown on Saturday... He now has 20 career rushing touchdowns, the 15th player in school history to record 20 rushing scores in a career... He is now four away from entering K-State's career top-10 list.

GETTING A PAW ON IT

Sophomore **Reggie Walker** blocked a 44-yard Baylor field goal attempt in the second quarter... It was Walker's first-career blocked kick and the Wildcats' first blocked field goal since **Marquel Bryant** did so in the 2016 Liberty Bowl (after 2015 season) against Arkansas... Immediately preceding the blocked kick, senior defensive end **Davis Clark** recorded his first-career full sack.

BRINGING THE WOOD

Senior **Tanner Wood** registered a personal season-high six tackles, one for loss, and two pass breakups... The two pass breakups were a new career-high... His six tackles were his best effort since registering six at Baylor on Nov. 19, 2016.

ADAMS PICKS

Junior **Kendall Adams** snatched his second interception of the season, late in the fourth quarter... Adams tied his personal season-high from the 2016 season and has four interceptions in his career.

THROUGH THE UPRIGHTS

Matthew McCrane was true on all four field-goal attempts on Saturday, tying his career-high for field goals in a game (4, at West Virginia; 11/20/2014)... This was the sixth time in his career he made at least three field goals in a game... Adding in his three extra points, McCrane now has 234 career points as he moved into fourth place in school history in career points among kickers.

FILL THE BILL

Kansas State recorded its 36th-consecutive sellout on Saturday with a capacity crowd of 52,293... The sellout streak began on Sept. 15, 2012, in a 35-21 victory over North Texas.
