MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- Tonight's matchup was just the third time Baylor and Duke met on the gridiron. The series record is now 0.2.
- Baylor is in its 117th football season and second under Matt Rhule -- the Bears are 591-569-44 all-time and Rhule is 31-35 in his career (3-12 at BU).
- Baylor has scored in a school-record 140-straight games -- the previous school record was 89 games from Dec. 31, 1979 Oct. 23, 1987.
- Duke won the toss and deferred. Baylor received the kickoff to start the game.
- DT Ira Lewis, DT Bravvion Roy, DT James Lynch and DE Chris Roberts served as captains for the Bears.

TEAM NOTES

- WR Tyquan Thornton's TD in the 4th quarter broke Duke's streak of eight games not allowing any points in the 4th quarter.
- WR Pooh Stricklin's 9-yard reception was his first catch of the season and makes him the 11th different Baylor receiver to record a catch this season.
- Baylor outgained the Blue Devils in total offense (400-399) and passing yards (270-174), topping its opponents in total offense for the third-straight game.
- After falling behind 23-0 at half, the Bears rallied back to outscore the Blue Devils, 27-17, in the second half.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- WR Josh Fleeks with a career long 49-yard kickoff return to open the game.
- QB Charlie Brewer with his first career rushing TD, a three-yard run in the third quarter.
- OB Brewer with a 2-yard TD rush in the fourth quarter, the second of the day and second of his career.
- QB **Brewer** was 14-for-26 for 175 yards and rushed for 2 TDs.
- OB Jalan McClendon was 10 for 16 for 95 yards, 1 TD and 1 INT.
- WR Tyquan Thornton with his first-career TD reception, a 25-yard reception in the fourth quarter.
- WR Tyquan Thornton with a career long pass reception of 39 yards set up the Bears first scoring drive in the third quarter.
- C Christian Morgan blocked a punt and RB JaMycal Hasty with the 33 yard TD return off the block.
- The blocked punt is the first blocked punt by a Baylor player since Terence Williams did so on Nov. 27, 2015 at TCU.
- First blocked punt returned for a TD since Braelon Davis blocked and returned the punt against North Texas in 2004.
- WR Chris Platt caught 2 passes on the day, has at least one catch in his last 13 straight games.
- WR Platt with 2 catches for 25 yards, moves him up the career leaders in yards receiving list. He now sits at No. 23 with 1,241 career receiving yards on 71 receptions.
- With two extra points made in the game, K/P Connor Martin passed Bubba Hicks for 10th all-time in career points (122, 25 FG, 47 PATs) for kickers.
- RB Hasty had with two pass receptions, extending his active catch streak to nine games with at least one catch.
- LB Clay Johnston led the Bears with a season-high 9 tackles (7 solo).
- WR Jalen Hurd with his first rush as a Bear with a carry for 12 yards in the fourth quarter. The carry is his 400th career rush attempt.
- RUSH Greg Roberts with a season high 6 tackles (3 solo) and 2 pass breakups.
- S Verkedric Vaughns with a season high 7 tackles (3 solo) and 1 pass breakup.
- OL Patrick Lawrence and OL Blake Blackmar made their 28th and 27th consecutive starts, respectively.
- OB Charlie Brewer made his seventh-career start.
- WR Jared Atkinson with his third career start and first of the season vs. Duke.
- OL Johncarlo Valentin made his Baylor debut vs. Duke.
