RECORDS...

Saturday's game marked the 16th all-time meeting between Kansas State and Baylor, with the Wildcats holding a 9-7 advantage, including an 8-7 mark since the Big 12's inception in 1996... Baylor broke a two-game winning streak by the Wildcats.

TOUGH BIG 12 START

The Wildcats are 0-3 to start Big 12 play for the fifth time since the league's inception in 1996... In three of the previous four instances, the Wildcats recovered and were able to earn a bowl berth... Those bowl seasons came in 2001, 2013 and 2015, while the only time K-State started 0-3 in Big 12 play and did not go to a bowl was 2004.

RUNNING WILD

Kansas State rushed for 319 yards and four touchdowns on Saturday... It was a new season high in rushing yards and the most since the Wildcats had 344 yards against UCLA in the 2017 Cactus Bowl... The four rushing scores were also a season high and the most since carding four in last year's Cactus Bowl.

BARNES PUTS ON A SHOW

Junior running back **Alex Barnes** rushed for a careerhigh 250 yards with three touchdowns on Saturday... His rushing total was the fifth-best mark in school history and most by a Wildcat since **Daniel Thomas** went for 269 yards at North Texas in 2010... It was the 15th 200-yard game in school history... Barnes' 55-yard touchdown run in the first quarter was the second longest of his career, only behind his 75-yard score last year against Oklahoma, while he added a 35-yarder in the second quarter and a 48-yarder in the fourth quarter... Barnes moved into 13th place in school history with 1,868 career rushing yards.

BARNES RUNS WELL VS. BEARS

Alex Barnes has run well against Baylor in his career as he now has 459 rushing yards in three games against the Bears, the most against any team in his career... The Pittsburg, Kansas, product rushed for 129 yards in Waco in 2016 and 80 yards last season.

PICK PARTY IN WACO

With K-State's two interceptions on Saturday, the Wildcats have recorded an interception in each of their eight trips to Waco as Big 12 members... Over the span, the Wildcats have totaled 13 interceptions, including five in the last two trips alone.

SIX PICKS

Senior defensive backs **Duke Shelley** and **Kendall Adams** each recorded their sixth-career interceptions in the second quarter on Saturday... Shelley's turned into a K-State touchdown, while Adams' was in the end zone on a halfback pass.

RISNER IMPROVES STARTS NUMBER

Senior right tackle **Dalton Risner** collected his 44th career start on Saturday, remaining in fourth place since 1989 in starts by offensive lineman... In his next start, Risner will tie **Quentin Neujahr** for third, who started 45 games from 1990-93... **B.J. Finney** (2011-14) is first on the list with 52, one ahead of **Cody Whitehair** (2012-15).
