## **MISCELLANEOUS NOTES**

- Baylor and West Virginia have met seven times since the Mountaineers joined the Big 12 for the 2012 season. West Virginia now leads the all-time series 5-2, including a 3-0 mark in Morgantown.
- The home team has won six-of-the-seven matchups.
- Baylor is in its 117th football season and second under Matt Rhule -- the Bears are 593-572-44 all-time and Rhule is 33-38 in his career (5-15 at BU).
- Baylor has scored in a school-record 145-straight games -- the previous school record was 89 games from Dec. 31, 1979 Oct. 23, 1987.
- West Virginia won the toss and chose to receive.
- OL Blake Blackmar, WR Jalen Hurd, DT Braavion Roy, LB Blake Lynch served as captains for today's game.

## **TEAM NOTES**

- The Bears now have 20 touchdowns on 30 redzone trips this season. They have scored field goals on seven more trips this season.
- Overall the Bears have scored on 27-of-30 redzone trips this season.
- The Bears had one more scoring drives of 10 or more plays today, giving them 13 total on the year.
- With OL Connor Galvin's start, the Bears have had 15 players make their first-career starts, five of those true freshmen.

## INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- QB Jalan McClendon with his first rushing TD of the season, third of his career.
- QB Jalan McClendon finished 16-of-21 for 183 yards with 1 rushing TD.
- QB Jalan McClendon's 16 pass completions are a new career high, 21 attempts also a career high.
- S Verkedric Vaughns tied for the team lead with six total tackles, all solo.
- LB Clay Johnston tied for the team lead with six tackles (five of those solo).
- LB Clay Johnston had one of five tackles-for-loss on the day for the Bears, giving him 2.5 on the year.
- CB Raleigh Texada with his first-career TFL.
- DT Greg Roberts finished with 5 tackles (all solo), third-most on team and had 1 TFL.
- CB Raleigh Texada was credited with Baylor's only pass breakup on the day.
- NT Ira Lewis was credited with Baylor's QB hurry.
- S Christian Morgan forced Baylor's only fumble on the day, the first forced fumble of his career.
- S Christian Morgan had his first full TFL of his career (previously credited with a half TFL).
- WR Denzel Mims has had two or more catches in 18-straight games.
- WR **Denzel Mims** now has 102 career receptions, the 17th-most in school history.
- WR Denzel Mims now has 1,669 career receiving yards, remains 15th-most in program history.
- K Connor Martin remains ranked 8th in school history in total points with 158 among kickers.
- WR Tyquan Thornton ties his career-high with three receptions for 36 yards.
- RB JaMycal Hasty added to his lead as the running back in the Big 12 with the most receptions, with three more tonight taking him to 22 on the season.
- WR Josh Fleeks with his second-career touchdown, a 2-yd rush, his first rushing TD of the season and career.
- QB Charlie Brewer with his first three-interception game of his career.
- DE James Lynch had a blocked field goal, the first of his career and third blocked kick of the year for Bears, fifth under Rhule.
- OL Patrick Lawrence and OL Blake Blackmar made their 33rd and 32nd consecutive starts, respectively. They also have both appeared in a team-best 45 career games.
- CB Raleigh Texada made his fourth-career start at corner, third straight.
