TEAM NOTES

- Baylor moved to 554-99 under 19th-year head coach Kim Mulkey, improving to 14-3 all-time vs. WVU and 290-172 (.628) vs. Big 12 teams.
- Mulkey is 252-55 all-time vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season (.821).
- Baylor has four-straight wins over WVU.
- Baylor extended its winning streak at the Ferrell Center to 30 games.
- Baylor extended its win streak over Big 12 opponents at home in the regular season to 13, and improved its overall winning streak in the Big 12 to 27.
- Starting lineup for the Lady Bears was Chloe Jackson, Juicy Landrum, DiDi Richards, Lauren Cox, and Kalani Brown, moving to 14-1 as a starting unit.
- Baylor out-rebounded WVU 51-28, making it 86 of the last 89 games in which the Lady Bears have out-rebounded their opponents.
- Baylor has out-rebounded all 16 opponents this season.

• The Lady Bears held WVU to 30.9% shooting from the field (17-55). In 638 of 653 games under Mulkey, the Lady Bears have held their opponent at or below 50 percent field goal shooting, with only seven of those efforts coming in the last 14 years.

• Baylor has assisted on 371 of 533 field goals this season marking 69.6 percent of field goals with an assist; Baylor had 28 on 33 field goals this evening vs. WVU, including assists on the first 12 buckets of the game.

- Baylor outscored WVU 10-6 on the fastbreak and has outscored its opponents this season 188-54.
- The Lady Bears recorded their16th run this season of at least 10 unanswered (first half, 13-0).
- Baylor has had at least one 10-0 run in four of its first five Big 12 games.
- The Lady Bears shot 50% from the field vs. WVU, improving Baylor's record under Mulkey when shooting 50 percent or better to 209-1.

• Kalani Brown (17 points) scored in double figures for 32nd time in last 34 games, for the 95th time in her career, for the seventh-straight game and for the 14th time this season.

- Lauren Cox (13 points) posted her four-straight games in double figures and 10th of the season.
- Cox's four blocks put her in sole possession of fourth place in school history at 185, trailing Kalani Brown (197) by 12 for third place.
- Chloe Jackson dished out a career-high 10 assists, and the first Baylor player with double-digit assists since Kristy Wallace (12 vs. Oklahoma, 2/5/18)
- Juicy Landrum (13 points) scored in double figures for eighth time this season, all of them coming in the last 12 games.
- Landrum added a season high with 8 assists.
- NaLyssa Smith scored 11 points, her second consecutive game in double figures and 12th of the season.double figures.
- Queen Egbo (10 points) recorded her seventh game with double figure scoring and second of the Big 12 season (19 at Texas Tech).
- Egbo added 8 rebounds, her third time this season with eight or more.
- DiDi Richards had 6 assists to just 1 turnover, her fourth time this season with 6 or more assists.
- Richards collected five rebounds, moving her past the 200 mark for her career with 202.
- Moon Ursin registered her 100th career rebound after bringing down five for the game.
