TEAM NOTES

- Baylor moved to 559-99 under 19th-year head coach Kim Mulkey, improving to 40-58 all-time vs. Texas and 295-172 (.632) vs. Big 12 teams.
- Baylor is 31-11 vs. Texas under Mulkey and winners in 19 of the last 20 matchups.
- Mulkey is 257-55 all-time vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season (.824).
- Baylor extended its overall win streak vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season to 33.
- Baylor extended its win its road win streak vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season to 32.
- Starting lineup for the Lady Bears was Chloe Jackson, Juicy Landrum, DiDi Richards, Lauren Cox, and Kalani Brown, they improved to 18-1 as a unit.
- Baylor out-rebounded UT 41-28, making it 91 of the last 94 games in which the Lady Bears have out-rebounded their opponents.
- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in all 21 games this season.
- The Lady Bears held UT to 46.4% shooting from the field (26-56). In 643 of 658 games under Mulkey, the Lady Bears have held their opponent at or below 50 percent field goal shooting, with only seven of those efforts coming in the last 14 years.
- Baylor has assisted on 488 of 686 field goals this season marking 71.1 percent of field goals with an assist; Baylor had 28 on 67 field goals this evening vs. Texas.
- Baylor outscored UT 11-2 on the fastbreak and has outscored its opponents this season 256-61.
- Current 11-0 run is the 21st run this season of at least 10 unanswered points.
- Baylor has at least one run of 10+ points in seven of the first 10 Big 12 contests and 14 of the 21 games this season.
- Baylor is 84-53 in the Kim Mulkey era in the games vs. ranked opponents away from Waco.
- Since 2010-11 Season, Baylor is 52-14 vs. Top 25 opponents away from the Ferrell Center.
- Second time this season that all players that have recorded minutes have scored in the ball game.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Junior Lauren Cox is in double figures for the 15th time this season, 54th time in her career and for the 8th time in the last seven games.
- Junior Lauren Cox led the team in rebounds with 14 rebounds.
- Junior Lauren Cox has her second double-double (Points & Rebounds) performance in the last three games, her fourth on the year and 22nd in her career.
- Sophomore Moon Ursin finished with career-high 20 points; it was the second-straight game, fourth time this season and fifth time in her career to score in double figures.
- Sophomore DiDi Richards finished with 12 points and was in double figures for the fifth time this season, eighth time in her career and fourth time in the last seven games.
- Richards tied a career high in steals with 4 steals.
- Senior Kalani Brown scored 15 points and was in double figures for the 12th-straight game, for the 18th time this season and 99th time in her career.
- Chloe Jackson led the team in assist with 6 assists.
