TEAM NOTES

- Baylor moved to 561-99 under 19th-year head coach Kim Mulkey, improving to 35-8 all-time vs. K-State and 297-172 (.633) vs. Big 12 teams.
- Baylor is 33-4 vs. K-State under Mulkey and winners of the last 31 matchups.
- Mulkey is 259-55 all-time vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season (.825).
- Baylor extended its overall win streak vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season to 35.
- Baylor extended its win streak on the road vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season to 33.
- Starting lineup for the Lady Bears was Chloe Jackson, Juicy Landrum, DiDi Richards, Lauren Cox, and Kalani Brown, they improved to 20-1 as a unit.
- Baylor out-rebounded K-State 40-29, making it 93 of the last 96 games in which the Lady Bears have out-rebounded their opponents.
- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in all 23 games this season.
- The Lady Bears held K-State to 26.7% shooting from the field (16-60). In 645 of 660 games under Mulkey, the Lady Bears have held their opponent at or below 50 percent field goal shooting, with only seven of those efforts coming in the last 14 years.

- Baylor has assisted on 539 of 750 field goals this season marking 71.8 percent of field goals with an assist; Baylor had 21 on 29 field goals this evening vs. K-State.
- Baylor outscored K-State 6-2 on the fastbreak and has outscored its opponents this season 270-67.
- Baylor is 213-1 all-time when shooting 50 percent or better under Mulkey (58.0 tonight)

• Kalani Brown missed her second free-throw attempt in the second quarter ending her streak at 27 consecutive made free throws (last seven at OSU, 3-3 at Texas, 5-5 vs. Texas Tech, 10-10 vs. TCU, first FT at K-State).

- Brown finished with 12 rebounds, her fourth game this season with at least 10 and the 35th game of her career to have 10+.
- Brown scored 10 points to finish in double figures for the 14h-straight game.
- Brown's double-double was the 34th of her career and fourth this season.

• Juicy Landrum finished the game with 15 points on 6-of-9 shooting, it marked the 13th time that she has scored in double figures this year with eight coming in Big 12 play. It was the 25th time in Landrum's career to reach double figures.

• Lauren Cox finished with 14 points, marking the fifth-straight game, the 10th in the last 11 games, and the 56th time in her career to reach double-digit points or more.

• Cox's fourth rebound Wednesday was the 650th of her career; she finished with nine.

• Chloe Jackson scored 16 points reaching double figures for the first time since Jan. 27 (at OU), it was her 14th time this season and 60th time in her career to reach double figures in scoring.

• Jackson led the team with seven assits and tied her season-high with a team-leading five assists
