TEAM NOTES

- Baylor moved to 562-99 under 19th-year head coach Kim Mulkey, improving to 29-25 all-time vs. Oklahoma and 298-172 (.634) vs. Big 12 teams.
- Baylor is 25-18 vs. Oklahoma under Mulkey and winners of 18 of the last 19 matchups.
- Mulkey is 260-55 all-time vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season (.825).
- Baylor extended its overall win streak vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season to 36.
- Baylor extended its win streak at the Ferrell Center to 34.
- Starting lineup for the Lady Bears was Chloe Jackson, Juicy Landrum, DiDi Richards, Lauren Cox, and Kalani Brown, they improved to 21-1 as a unit.
- Baylor out-rebounded OU 59-28, making it 94 of the last 97 games in which the Lady Bears have out-rebounded their opponents.
- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in all 24 games this season.
- The 59 rebounds was the most for the Lady Bears vs. a Big 12 opponent this season, and their third-best outing overall in 2018-19.
- The Lady Bears held OU to 25.8% shooting from the field (16-62). In 646 of 661 games under Mulkey, the Lady Bears have held their opponent at or below 50 percent field goal shooting, with only seven of those efforts coming in the last 14 years.
- The 25.8% field goal percentage by OU was the second-lowest in a Big 12 game against Baylor this season (fourth-lowest overall).
- Baylor has assisted on 565 of 787 field goals this season marking 71.8 percent of field goals with an assist; Baylor had 26 on 37 field goals this evening vs. Oklahoma.
- Baylor outscored OU 18-2 on the fastbreak and has outscored its opponents this season 288-69.
- Baylor had two runs of 10-0 or better, giving them 23 such runs on the season.
- The Lady Bears now have at least one of those runs in 8 of 13 Big 12 games this season.
- Baylor recorded 12 team blocks, a season high
- The Lady Bears improved to 214-1 when shooting 50 percent or better under Mulkey; BU shot 37-of-74 from the floor.
- All 12 Lady Bears played and 10 had double-digit minutes.
- Baylor had six players with three assists or more.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Chloe Jackson scored a season-high 24 points, her 61st time in double figures for her career and 14th time this season.
- It was Jackson's 22nd career game with at least 20 points.
- Jackson tied a season high with 10 field goals made on 13 attempts, converting at a 77 percent clip.
- Lauren Cox (14 points) scored in double figures for the sixth-straight game and the 11th time in the last 12 games.
- Cox now has 56 career games with double-digit scoring, including 17 this season.
- Cox recorded a season-high 7 blocks and added 9 rebounds.
- Queen Egbo pulled down 10 rebounds, her third game of the season with double digit rebounds.
- Moon Ursin led Baylor with four assists while five additional players had three each.
- Kalani Brown finished with eight points and eight rebounds, she is 11 points shy of 2,000 career points and two rebounds shy of 1,000.
