LAST WEEKEND RECAP

Time/Result

The Bears went 1-2 last week at the Shriners College Classic. On Friday vs. Texas A&M, the Bears ran into the Aggies' ace Jon Doxakis, who shut down the Bears' offense through much of the day. However, the Bears still managed to bring the game-tying run to the plate in the ninth inning. Then on Saturday against Rice, the Bears also ran into a tough starting pitcher and only mustered six hits, tying a season-low hits total set the night before vs. A&M. On Sunday, the Bears proved they could fight back from a deficit and rallied to score two runs with two outs in the ninth inning to take the lead. Nick Loftin brought home the game-tying run and a double by Davis Wednzel brought home the go-ahead run. Closer Kyle Hill, who entered in the bottom of the eighth earned the win and put up the most important zero in the bottom of the ninth to close things out. Loftin led the way with a .417 batting average, while Davis Wendzel led the team with 3 RBI. Richard Cunningham was named to the Shriners College Classic All-Tournament team after batting .333 on the weekend with 1 home run, 1 triple, 2 doubles and 1 RBI. On the mound, Jimmy Winston was outstanding, throwing 4.2 innings over two appearances, allowing no runs on two hits with just 1 walk and 3 strikeouts. Fellow reliever Daniel Caruso also looked strong out of the pen, throwing 2.2 scoreless innings over two different appearances, allowing just 1 hit and 1 walk while striking out 4.

NEBRASKA

Former Big 12 foe Nebraska faces the Bears for the first time since it was a member of the Conference in 2011. That year the Bears visited Lincoln and took two out of three from the Huskers. The Bears the Friday game, 6-2, lost the Saturday contest 6-2 and took the rubber game, 2-0 to win the series. The last time the Huskers were in Waco was in 2010 and the Bears took 2-of-3 in that series, winning on Friday and Sunday. The 2019 Huskers come to Waco with a 4-6 record and are fresh off a split at the Frisco Classic, where they defeated then-No. 3 Texas Tech, 2-1 on Friday night before falling to Sam Houston State on Saturday, 11-10.

TEAM QUICK NOTES IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

• The Bears boast the fourth-highest batting average in the nation (.334), the 19th-best scoring offense in the country with 8.5 runs per game and rank 25th with 130 total hits so far on the year. The Bears rank 12th with 2.55 doubles per game and 17th with 28 total doubles on the year. The team also ranks 24th nationally with 0.45 triples per game and the team's 5 triples are 14th-best. The Bears' on-base percentage of .419 is 17th-best in the nation, while the can do a lot of different things with the bat as the team's slugging percentage (.524) ranks eighth.

HOW THE BEARS STACK UP

• The Bears currently lead the Big 12 with a team batting average of .334 and are second in the conference in pitching with a team ERA of 2.22. Wendzel's batting average of .516 is tops in the conference (26th nationally) and Hayden Kettler's 17 strikeouts are 2nd-best in the conference, 32nd nationally.

GETTING BEANED

• The Bears have been hit 23 times this season, ranking 19th nationally in the category. Davion Downey has been hit eight times on the year, good for fourth nationally.

OFEENSE CLICKING EARLY

•The Bears mashed 83 runs in their first seven games of the season, the most in the first eight games in program history. The Bears have outscored their opponents, 83-22 overall. Impressively, three of the top five in the Big 12 in the hits-per-game category come from the Bears' roster, with Davis Wendzel tying for the conference lead with 1.82 hits per game, followed by Richard Cunningham and Nick Loftin tying for third with 1.64 hits per game.

WENDZEL WITH QUITE THE START

• The junior third-baseman is on fire to start the season, leading the Big 12 and ranking 18th nationally with a .465 batting average. His 20 total hits are tied for first in the conference and rank 35th nationally. The San Clemente, Calif., native, bosts 7 total doubles on the year, good for tops in the conference and third-most nationally. His 0.64 doubles per game rank 16th. Wendzel leads the conference with a 0.554 on-base percentage and his six stolen bases are tied for third-most in the conference. The junior has hit safely in 10 of 11 games and had multi-hit performances in eight of 11 games.

WINSTON STARTING STRONG

• Out of the bullpen, redshirt sophomore reliever Jimmy Winston leads the team with six appearances. He has given up just one run in 11.2 innings, and he has currently thrown 7.2 scoreless innings over five games. He boasts a 0.77 ERA and has walked two and struck out nine.

FRIDAY GUY

• In the early-goings of the season, junior righthanded pitcher Hayden Kettler has stepped into the role of the "Friday guy" and he has looked the part early on this season. He tied his career-high with seven-complete innings pitched against Holy Cross, while striking out a then-career-high 8 batters. That career-high mark was broken this past weekend as he struck out a career-high 9 batters in six innings of work vs. Cornell. Kettler took his first loss of the season vs. Texas A&M and currently boasts a 2.65 ERA, 2-1 record has given up 5 runs over a team-high 17.0 innings pitched. He has struck out 18 and walked just five.

LOFTIN CRUISING

• Like Wendzel, Loftin has had multi-hit performances in eight of 11 games this season, including going 3-for-5 in Sunday's victory over Texas State. Over the weekend at the Shriners College Classic, Loftin led the team with a .417 batting average (5-for-12) with 2 doubles, 2 RBI and 2 runs scored.

GOING FOR EXTRA BASES

• The Bears have had at least one extra base hit in each game this season.

WINNING EARLY

 The Bears started the season 8-0 for the first time since 2017 and just the third time in program history (1984, 2017).

TOUGH TO K

• Redshirt freshman Kyle Harper is the second-toughest in the Big 12 to strike out, striking out once every 14.5 at bats. Sophomore Nick Loftin is the fourth-toughest in the conference, striking out once every 12.5 at bats.

INJURY BUG

• The Bears have been bit by the injury bug, with the Big 12 Preseason Pitcher of the Year selection Cody Bradford out for the season with Thoracic Outlet Syndrome. Preseason All-American catcher Shea Langelier is on the mend from a broken hamate bone.

OFFENSE AND PITCHING THRIVING

• The Bears have scored double-digit runs in five of 11 games this season, including four in a row for the first time since 2012 (April 14-18). *Baylor has at least nine hits in 9 of 11 games this season. The Bears pitching staff has punched out at least 10 batters in 10 of 11 games.

IN THE PRESEASON POLLS

The Bears were the preseason No. 2 pick in the Big 12 and earned two first place votes, collected 58 total points, behind No. 1 Texas Tech's 61 points. The second place selection in the preseason poll ties the highest in program history, first time since 2004 the Bears were picked second and fifth time in program history.

FAMILIAR FACES

• Baylor returns 20 letterwinners after losing eight from the 2018 squad, including Preseason All-Big 12 selections Cody Bradford, Shea Langeliers, Davis Wendzel and Nick Loftin. Baylor returns all nine position starters, plus the entire pitching rotation from 2018. On the mound the Bears return 95 percent of their starts (55 of 58) from 2018 and 73 percent of their wins.

STREAKS

 Senior infielder Josh Bissonette extended his on-base streak to 18 games going back to last season, while Shea Langeliers has a 16-game on-base streak in play.

CUNNINGHAM AT THE PLATE

 The senior was named to the Shriners College Classic All-Tournament team after batting .333 (4-for-12) with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run and 1 RBI over three games. He currently ranks second on the team with a .375 average, 8 RBI, 6 doubles and a team-leading 2 triples. The Austin, Texas, native was outstanding over the first weekend, leading the team with 8 hits. Cunningham first started out the weekend going 3-for-5 on opening day with two runs scored, over four seasons he is now 7-for-13 during home openers. Then in game two of the double header he was 5-for-5, a home run shy of hitting for the cycle. He finished the weekend 8-for-20 with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, 1 triple and 4 RBIs.

LOTS OF FIRSTS

- Opening weekend saw a lot of firsts for the Bears, Newcomers Mack Mueller, Paul Dickens Ricky Martinez. William Gilbert, Chase Wehsener and Anderson Needham made their Baylor debuts, For Martinez, Wehsener, Gilbert and and Needham made their collegiate debuts. Mueller and Dickens are junior college transfers. Websener collected his first-career hit on Saturday vs. Holy Cross, while Needham had a no-hitter going through 4.0 innings and struck out 6 batters.
- In the 17-0 victory over Cornell on Feb. 22, three more Bears made their collegiate debuts, as catcher Jake Walsh made an appearance, along with RHP Blake Helton and RHP Ryan Segner, who both pitched shutout innings.
- · Redshirt sophomore Daniel Caruso was outstanding, earning the win in game three of the victory over Holy Cross on Saturday. He threw 2.0 scoreless innings in relief, holiding the Crusaders to just 1 hit and 1 walk along with a career-high 3 strikeouts.

• The Bears ended 2018 at the Stanford Regional, falling to No. 51Stanford, 4-2. The Bears lost game one of the regional 6-2, running into a hot Cal State Fullerton and pitcher Colton Eastman. The Bears then bounced back and won the elimination game vs. Wright State, 11-5.

GOLDEN SPIKES

. Bradford and Langeliers were two of 55 and one of three from Big 12 named to USA Baseball's 2018 Golden Spikes Award Watch List (top amateur baseball player in country). For the first time in program history the Bears have had two players named to the watch list in the same season. Langeliers is one of 10 returners to the watch list from 2018.

STOPPER OF THE YEAR MOVING UP THE RANKS

• Hill was one of 75 and one of three from Big 12 named to NCBWA 2019 Stopper of the Year Preseason Watch List (top relief pitcher in NCAA DI baseball). For the third-straight year the Bears have a pitcher on the watch list after Troy Montemayor in 2017 and 2018. Hill currently ranks eighth in the record book with 111 career strikeouts in relief and he is three away from taking over the No. 7 spot.

BOBBY BRAGAN COLLEGIATE SLUGGER AWARD

 Cunningham and Andy Thomas were 2 of 30 players (2 of 6 from the Big 12) named to 2019 Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award Watch List (top DI slugger on field, in dugget and in the classroom from Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana and New Mexico). Cunningham is the first student-athlete to be on the watch list for threestraight seasons.

CLOSING OUT HOT

 The Bears won 24 of the last 29 games of the 2018 season, en route to winning the program's first Big 12 Tournament title. The Bears then made their second-straight NCAA Regional berth. During that streak they won 13-straight games, including six-straight Big 12 games. During that stretch the Bears garnered its first sweep of TCU on April 20-22 since Feb. 18-20, 2000.

STEADY IMPROVEMENT

 The Bear are looking to take another jump in 2019 as they have steadily improved under fourth-year head coach Steve Rodriguez. In his first year in 2016, the Bears finished 24-29, 10-14 in the Big 12. In year two (2017), the Bears were 34-23, 12-12 in the Big 12 and advanced to the Houston Regional. In 2018, the Bears won the Big 12

Tournament for the first time in program history and advanced to the NCAA postseason in the Stanford Regional for the second-straight season. The Bears were 37-21 and finished fifth in the Big 12 at 13-11.

BIG 12 TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS

- •The Bears won the Big 12 Tournament title in 2018 for the first time in program history, its first conference tournament title since 1993 (Southwest Conference) and its fourth overall (1977, 1978 (both SWC)). Baylor played in the Big 12 Championship title game for the first time since 2010 (No. 6 Baylor lost to No. 4 Texas A&M 5-3 in 10 innings). BU is now 1-6 all-time in Big 12 Championship title games and made it to the title game as a No. 5 seed in 2003 (lost to No. 3 Texas 10-8 in 10 innings). BU was the first No. 5 seed to play in the title game since Texas in 2015 (won). For head coach Steve Rodriguez, he won his sixth conference tournament title (five with Pepperdine in the West Coast Conference). The Bears defeated TCU 6-5 in 11 innings to earn the victory.
- •Cody Bradford, Richard Cunningham, Shea Langeliers, Nick Loftin and Davis Wendzel were named to the 2018 Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship All-Tournament Team. BU's five selections were its most since having a program-record six in 2003. Cody Bradford and Shea Langeliers were named Co-Most Outstanding Players of the 2018 Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship, marking Baylor's first MOP winners in program history.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

- •So. LHP Cody Bradford and Jr. DH Richard Cunningham were named to the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-District Seven Team on May 10. The duo's recognition marked the first for Baylor since Logan Brown in 2015. Overall, Bradford and Cunningham are the program's 40th and 41st selections and gave BU multiple choices for the first time since 2013.
- Cunningham earned Third Team CoSIDA Google Cloud Academic All-America honors for the first time in his career in 2018 and gave Baylor an Academic All-America selection for the eighth time in the last 10 seasons. He was the first to garner the honor since Logan Brown in 2015. Overall, he was the program's 16th all-time selection and 12th different player to earn the award. The Austin, Texas, native graduated with a 3.83 GPA in finance and had a 3.89 GPA in his first year of graduate school in the business administration program. Cunningham was one of only two players in the Big 12 Conference represented on the three-team, 33-person list.

LANGELIERS AND HIS GOLDEN GLOVE

• Catcher Shea Langeliers is the second Gold Glove winner in program history, joining Logan Brown, who was recognized as an outfielder in 2014. The Keller, Texas, native was recognized as Division I's best defensive catcher in 2018 after allowing an average of only one stolen base every five games during the 2018 season. He caught 23 of 33 attempted base stealers in 50 games started behind the dish, including only one stolen base allowed in his last 21 games of 2018. Langeliers also was charged with only three passed balls, and his glovework limited Baylor pitchers to only 0.46 wild pitches per game while Langeliers was catching. He posted a .995 fielding percentage as a catcher, recording 387 putouts and 50 assists while committing only two errors. Langeliers started all 58 games for the Bears during his sophomore season, with eight of those starts coming at first base. He hit .252 with a team-best 11 home runs, while adding 18 doubles, two triples, 44 RBIs and 49 runs scored.

DRAFT SUCCESS

• In the 2018 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, senior right-handed pitcher Troy Montemayor and then-sophomore third baseman Davis Wendzel were selected. Montemayor went to the St. Louis Cardinals in the 25th round with the 753rd overall pick, and Wendzel was drafted by the Boston Red Sox in the 37th round with the 1,120th overall selection. Wendzel chose to forgo his opportunity with the Red Sox to return for his junior season in Waco. With the picks, Baylor has had at least one player selected in 41 of 43 drafts since 1976. The Bears have had 140 total draft picks in program history, including two selections in each of the last two years.

BIG SHOES TO FILL IN THE BULLPEN

• The Bears may return 20 student-athletes in 2019, including all 9 position players plus the entire pitching rotation, but there are big shoes to fill in the back of the pen. The Bears lost All-American closer Troy Montemayor, who had 11 saves and a 2.39 ERA in 23 appearances in 2018, along with Drew Robertson who had a 1.88 ERA in 28 appearances all out of the pen (28.2 IP) and the do-it-all reliever Alex Phillips, who made 16 appearances in 2018, including three starts, eating up 45.0 innings and boasting a 2.40 ERA.

The Bears will look to senior righty Kyle Hill to step up to the challenge in 2019, potentially taking over the closer role after boasting a 2.62 ERA and a 4-1 record with 1 save in 25 appearances (3 starts) over 55.0 innings in 2018.

TEAM USA

• Catcher Shea Langeliers was the first choice for the 2018 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team on April 11, marking BU's first USA player since 2008, eighth overall and ninth selection. Pitcher Cody Bradford also played with the team during the summer, but did not make the final roster.

HOME SWEET HOME

• The Bears have finished their home slate with a .500 record or better (19-7 in 2018) in all 20 seasons at Baylor Ballpark (since 1999) and look to do the same in 2019. The Bears are 437-199 all-time at the park.

CLEAN FIELDING

• Rodriguez has helped conduct Baylor top 10 fielding percentage seasons in each of his three seasons with the Bears. In 2016, the team tied for eighth all-time at BU with a .968 fielding percentage and topped it in 2017 with a third-best .972 mark. In 2018, the Bears had a fielding percentage of .971 which tied for fourth-best in program history.


