TEAM NOTES

• Baylor won its 10th Big 12 Championship Tournament title Monday, it marks the 20th Big 12 title combined between regular season and tournament championships in **Kim Mulkey's** 19 seasons at the helm.

- Baylor's 10 conference tournament titles are tied for sixth among D1 women's basketball programs since the 1999-2000 season.
- The Lady Bears have played in 13 title games in the Big 12 Championship in Mulkey's 19 seasons as head coach and in 10 of the last 11.
- Baylor improved to 31-1 on the season.

• Baylor improved to 29-7 all-time vs. ISU, 28-4 in the Kim Mulkey era, 4-1 all-time vs. the Cyclones in the Big 12 Championship, and it was Baylor's 10th-straight win over ISU.

- Baylor moved to 570-99 under 19th-year head coach Kim Mulkey, 43-13 all-time in the Big 12 Championship, and 42-9 under Mulkey in the Big 12 Tournament
- Baylor has the nation's longest active winning streak at 23 games.
- Starting lineup for the Lady Bears was Chloe Jackson, Juicy Landrum, DiDi Richards, Lauren Cox, and Kalani Brown, they improved to 29-1 as a unit.
- Baylor out-rebounded ISU 37-27, marking the 31st time this season out of 32 games that the Lady Bears have out-rebounded their opponents.

• The Lady Bears held ISU to 37.7% shooting from the field (20.53). In 654 of 669 games under Mulkey, the Lady Bears have held their opponent at or below 50 percent field goal shooting, with only seven of those efforts coming in the last 14 years.

• Baylor has assisted on 723 of 1,023 field goals this season marking 70.6 percent of field goals with an assist; Baylor had 17 on 29 field goals this evening vs. Iowa State.

• Baylor is outscoring teams this season 343-77 on the fast break.

- Kalani Brown was the Big 12 Championship Most Outstanding Player for the second-straight year
- Brown finished with 17 points, the 27th time this season to reach double figures for her and the 109th time in her career.
- Lauren Cox finished with 14 points, her 23rd time this season to reach double-digits, 64th time in her career and fourth-straight game.
- Cox led the team with three blocks, tied for fifth most among Baylor players in the Big 12 Tournament championship game.
- Cox led Baylor with eight rebounds
- Chloe Jackson finished with 16 points her 21st time this season to have double-digit points and 68th time in career.
- Juicy Landrum led Baylor with six assists, tied for seventh most among Baylor players in a Big 12 Tournament title game.

• DiDi Richards led the team with four steals, which was tied for third most among Baylor players in teh Big12 Tournament title game and tied for 10th most among Baylor players in the Big12 Tournament overall.
