STORY LINES

- · Baylor plays its second non-conference game of the season on Saturday when it hosts UTSA in the final game of a three-game series. Both road teams have won the first two games in the series.
- Trestan Ebner scored three TDs for the first time in his career, he has five scores in his last two games.
- Seven different Baylor players were responsible for touchdowns vs. SFA, including the first career scores for Gerry Bohanon (TD pass) and Abram Smith (TD run). Charlie Brewer tied his career high (5x) with three touchdown passes.
- Baylor has 14 graduates on its 2019 roster, including nine student-athletes enrolled in graduate school.
 BU was the lone team in the country with 2 blocks in week 1. The Bears have 11 blocks in the last 26 games.
- Thirty-six players made their Baylor debuts in the win over Stephen F. Austin. Baylor has played 79 different true or redshirt freshmen over the last two-plus seasons.
- Baylor has scored 40+ in two straight for first time under Rhule (45 vs. Vanderbilt, 56 vs. Stephen F. Austin).
- BU's 56 points vs. SFA are its highest total since putting up 62 vs. West Virginia on Oct. 17, 2015. It was the most points scored by any Big 12 team during the opening weekend of play.
 Baylor running backs have 126 receptions over the last 26 games after totaling only 40 catches from 2013-16.
 John Lovett posted his fourth career 100-yard rushing game in the opener and his third of 100+ in his last 6 games.

- Baylor offensive lineman Sam Tecklenburg leads the team with 26 consecutive starts. Sixth-year senior Chris Platt leads the roster with 44 career games played.

 Baylor returns 100 percent of its record-setting 663 offensive yards from the 2018 Texas Bowl.

 Denzel Mims ranks 12th in Baylor history with 1,951 receiving yards, and has a catch in 25 straight games played.

 Matt Rhule coached teams have won 33 straight games when leading entering the fourth quarter.

- BU had a record 22 players named to the 2018 Academic All-Big 12 team & 41 over last 2 years under Rhule.
- Baylor is 76-15 since 2008 when scoring 30 points or more.
- The Bears had 25 student-athletes earn their degree during the 2018-19 academic year.
- Freshman kicker Noah Rauschenberg had eight touchbacks in his first nine kickoffs against SFA.
 BU is playing its 118th season of football. BU holds a 596-574-44 (.511) record all-time. Baylor has scored in a school-record 151 straight games — the previous record was 89 games from Dec. 31, 1979 - Oct. 23, 1987.
- BU's +6 win improvement from 2017-18 is tied with Florida and Syracuse for largest among Power 5 teams.
- The Bears finished with 518 total yards vs SFA, the 2nd-straight game they have had over 500 yards of offense.

UTSA SERIES HISTORY

- Baylor hosts UTSA for its final non-conference home game of 2019. The all-time series is tied 1-1.
- The Bears defeated UTSA 37-20 in 2018 at the Alamodome behind Charlie Brewer's 328 yards and three touchdowns. Brewer also caught a 36-yard pass from Jared Atkinson and rusehd for 22 yards on eight carries.
- The first-ever meeting between the two programs went in favor of the Roadrunners in 2017 at McLane Stadium. Only the second game of the Matt Rhule era, the Bears totaled just 274 total yards as UTSA picked up the program's first win over a Power 5 program.
- BU is 65-35-2 against members of Conference USA. Additionally, the Bears face Rice in Houston on Sept. 21.
- The Bears hold a 374-231-31 all-time record against current Division I schools in the state of Texas.

NEXT UP

- · Following the matchup with UTSA, Baylor has a bye weekend (Sept. 14) before traveling to face Rice in Houston to close out non-conference play.
- Former Southwest Conference rivals, Baylor holds a 49-30-2 advantage in the all-time series with the Owls. In Houston, BU has won 27 of 49 meetings. The all-time series dates back to 1914.
- Baylor has won the last eight meetings including a 38-10 win in Houston on Sept. 24, 2016. Seth Russell passed for 337 yards and three scores and JaMycal Hasty posted his first career 100-yard rushing game to lead BU to a win.

RUN GAME ROAD TO VICTORY

- Baylor opened the 2019 season with another strong effort on the ground, posting 268 rushing yards against SFA - the third-best opening week total in the Big 12. Three different players recorded a rushing touchdown and John Lovett (108 yards) recorded his fourth career 100-yard performance.
- In Baylor's seven victories in 2018 the Bears averaged 219.3 rushing yards per game and 5.29 yards per carry. In losses, that total drops to just 110.5 yards per game including three games with less than 90 yards.
- The Bears rushed for 231.6 yards per game in their three Big 12 home wins and are rushing for 210.0 yards per game overall at McLane Stadium in 2018.
- In 2018, BU ranked fourth in the Big 12 in rushing offense with an average of 169.08 ypg. Four different Baylor players had at least three rushing touchdowns (Brewer, Lovett, Hurd, Hasty).

BEVY OF BAYLOR DEBUTS UNDER RHULE

- After ranking among the top teams in the country to feature freshmen in 2017 and 2018, Baylor continued to introduce new players into its lineups in the opening week of 2019.
- Against SFA, Baylor had 36 players make their first appearances in a Bears' uniform, including 20 true freshmen (Brandon Bass, Davis Baucum, Will Baxter, Blake Bedier, Jacoby Clarke, Colby Delashaw, TJ Franklin, Blake George, Jackson Gleeson, Gabe Hall, Bryson Jackson, Colby Johnston, Matt Jones, Qualan Jones, Josh Landry, Alex Lanham, Collin Losack, Paul Matavao-Poialii, Michael McNair, Tripp Mitchell, Kyle Peterson, Casey Phillips, Prince Pines, Garmon Randolph, Noah Rauschenberg, Trystan Slinker, Shevin Smith, Yusuf Terry, Solo Turner, Brayden Utley, Skyler Wetzel, Brandon White, Harrison White, Kolby White, Will Williams, Niadre Zouzoua).
- Offensive linemen Blake Bedier and Prince Pines made their first career starts against SFA.
- Over the last two-plus seasons, Baylor has played 79 true or redshirt freshmen.

NEW KICKERS CONVERT

- Baylor rolled out a trio of freshman kickers against Stephen F. Austin with all three enjoying success.
- · Redshirt freshmen place kicker John Mayers was a perfect 6-for-6 on extra points and punter Issac Power had four punts with a long of 50 yards.
- True freshman kicker Noah Rauschenberg had nine kickoffs, including eight touchbacks, and added two XP.

BLOCK PARTY

- Over the last 26 games, Baylor has showed the ability to make plays on special teams including blocking kicks and punts. Below is a list of Baylor's 11 blocks since the beginning of 2017.
- BU led the country in 2018 with seven blocks. As a head coach, Rhule's teams have blocked 30 kicks since 2013 (2013-16 at Temple; 2017-current at Baylor).
- Baylor's seven blocked kicks were the most since the team recorded nine in 1989.
- The Bears have blocked six kicks in its last six games dating back to Oklahoma State 2018.

BREWER AS A RUNNER

- Charlie Brewer turned his legs into a weapon in 2018. The now junior QB displayed his athleticism and recorded a team-best 133 rushing attempts, third most for a Big 12 QB.
- Brewer led the Bears with six rushing touchdowns, fourth-most among passers in the Big 12 Conference.
- The Austin native ran for 50 or more yards four times in 2018, including a career-best 109 rushing yards on 16 attempts in the bowl win over Vanderbilt.
- Brewer's six rushing touchdowns in 2018 were the eighth-most by a Baylor quarterback since 1980.
- His 542 career rushing yards through 21 games rank fourth by BU quarterbacks since 2007 behind Robert Griffin III (2,254; 2008-11), Seth Russell (1,240; 2012-16) and Nick Florence (651; 2009-12)

ABUNDANCE OF RECEIVING OPTIONS

- BU quarterbacks completed passes to 10 different receivers against Stephen F. Austin with 3 players scoring touchdowns (Trestan Ebner, RJ Sneed, Tyguan Thornton). Sneed, Denzel Mims & Ebner had 5 catches each.
- Denzel Mims (120/1,905 yards) and Chris Platt (98/1,634) are two of the top 16 receivers in program history. Fellow senior Marques Jones had 21 receptions for 242 yards and scored twice in 2018.
- Sophomores Tyquan Thornton (354 yards, 3 TD), Josh Fleeks (126 yards, TD) and RJ Sneed (57 career yards) add key depth. Junior Jared Atkinson has nine career receptions for 117 yards.
- The Bears also feature freshman receivers in Jackson Gleeson, Peyton Powell and Yusuf Terry.

CONTROLLING THE CLOCK

- One staple of Matt Rhule coached teams is controlling time of possession. After holding the ball for an average of 29:48 in 2017 (6th, Big 12), the Bears put an even greater emphasis on possession in 2018.
- BU was first in the Big 12 and 17th nationally with an average time of possession of 32:40 last season.
- Baylor won the time of possession battle in nine of 13 games in 2018. Baylor has controlled the ball 35+ minutes eight times in last 25 games.

RHULE TEAMS IN THE FOURTH QUARTER

- In Matt Rhule's six seasons as head coach, he has sealed the deal when leading or tied entering the fourth quarter. In his career, his teams are 20-10 when posting a fourth quarter shutout.
- Rhule-coached teams have won 33 straight games when leading or tied entering the fourth, and are 34-4 overall. All four losses came in his first season as head coach at Temple in 2013.
- When leading entering the 4Q, he has won 31 straight and is 32-3 overall with all three losses in 2013.
- Over the last four-plus seasons, Matt Rhule coached teams are 15-4 when recording a fourth-quarter shutout. Baylor held ACU, Kansas, Texas, Iowa State and TCU scoreless in the final quarter in 2018.
- BU's second-half shutout of UT was the first under Rhule & the program's first in a B12 game since 2015 (at TCU).

RHULE TEAMS IN YEAR THREE

- Baylor head coach Matt Rhule has experienced rebuilding projects in his career before and his time at Temple is very similar to year one in Waco.
- After a 2-10 mark in 2013 with the Owls, Rhule guided the program to a 6-6 mark & bowl eligibility in 2014.
- Baylor finished 2017 with a 1-11 mark, made a big jump in year two finishing 7-6 with a bowl win.
- In his third season at Temple, Rhule led the Owls to a 10-4 record including a berth in the 2015 AAC Championship game.

2019 ROSTER FEATURES 14 GRADUATES

- Preparing Champions for Life is not just a slogan at Baylor and coach Matt Rhule's team is proving it. The 2019 Baylor roster features 14 college graduates including three graduate transfers.
- The list of graduates is as follows: Henry Black, Koby Bullard, JaMycal Hasty, Jameson Houston, Clay Johnston, Marques Jones, James Lockhart, Blake Lynch, Ross Matiscik, Chris Platt, JD PicKell, Owen Rogers, Sam Tecklenburg and Skyler Wetzel. That total ranks seventh nationally.
- Additionally, former letterman and graduate Lenoy Jones serves as a student coach on defense.
- Two other members of the Baylor roster are scheduled to graduate in December. The Bears boast 19 seniors.

JOHNSTON, LYNCH TO LEAD NEW-LOOK DEFENSE

- Preseason All-Big 12 picks LB Clay Johnston and DL James Lynch are being counted on to anchor a new-look Baylor defense in 2019.
- Johnston (184 career tackles) will man the middle linebacker spot and James Lynch (15.5 TFL, 9.5 sacks) will play a key role as one of three down linemen in a new 3-3 stack defensive system.
- Junior Grayland Arnold (25 games, 12 PBU) moves from corner to safety following a redshirt season and will join seniors Chris Miller and Henry Black as starters at safety.
- By dropping from four to three defensive linemen, Baylor is able to add an extra playmaker to the back end and take advantage of its team speed, one of the roster's strengths.

MARQUES JONES EXCELS ON FIELD AND IN CLASSROOM

- Baylor senior Marques Jones is one of the top student-athletes in the country and a nominee for the Campbell Trophy, the Academic Heisman.
- Jones earned a 3.95 GPA in Electrical and Computer Engineering before completing his degree in May 2019. He was honored as a 2018 Gerald Lage Academic Achievement Award from Big 12.
- Jones was awarded with a scholarship at the conclusion of fall camp in 2018. He has played in 26 games in his career with nine starts. The junior had 21 receptions for 242 yards and two scores in 2018.

BREWER THE UNQUESTIONED STARTER

- Junior quarterback Charlie Brewer has played in 22 games in his career with 17 starts. The Austin native has passed for 4,780 yards in his career which ranks 10th in Baylor history.
- Brewer has passed for 217.3 yards per game in his career with 33 touchdowns and 13 interceptions. He has completed 64.0 percent of his passes (400-of-625). He also has six rushing touchdowns.
- Brewer has completed 64.54 percent of his passes (313-of-485) in 16 career Big 12 games.
- The Austin native have eclipsed 300 yards passing in seven games, fourth-most in program history. He is joined by Bryce Petty, Robert Griffin III and Nick Florence. He has passed for 400+ yards twice, fifth most in BU history (Griffin, Petty, Szymanski, Florence).

MULTIPLE TURNOVERS EQUALS WINS

- Matt Rhule defenses have forced two or more turnovers in 28 of 76 (36.8%) career games coached.
- His teams own a 20-8 record with 2+ turnovers forced, and have won 15 of the last 19 when doing so.
- Rhule's teams are 7-0 when forcing 4+ turnovers and 10-3 when creating 3+.
- His teams are 22-4 in games where they have a positive turnover margin, including 2018 wins over K-State and Texas Tech.

PLATT GOING DEEP

• Sixth-year senior wide receiver Chris Platt led the nation in receptions of 70+ yards in 2017 despite only playing in four games due to injury. For his career, he has five receptions of 70+ yards which is second most in Baylor history behind Melvin Bonner's six from 1989-92. Below is a list of Platt's 70-yard receptions at Baylor.

- Including head coach Matt Rhule's 2012 stint with the New York Giants, there are five on-field coaches on the Baylor staff with 23 years combined experience in the National Football League, sixth-best in the country.
- Three of the five coaches on offense spent time in the NFL including co-offensive coordinators Jeff Nixon (10 years) and Glenn Thomas (seven years). Frisman Jackson has one year of coaching experience.
- Defensive coordinator Phil Snow was a Detroit assistant for four seasons.
- Additionally, senior offensive consultant George DeLeone has spent six seasons in professional football over three stints. Injury prevention specialist Kent Johnston has 25 years experience in the NFL. With those two staff members added to the total it reaches 54 years.

Running back Trestan Ebner's winding 21-yard run was the first of his three touchdowns, Charlie Brewer threw for 215 yards and three scores in barely more than a half and Baylor handed the Lumberjacks their seventh straight season-opening loss with a 56-17 victory Saturday night.

After scoring a TD on a 3-yard run for those first SFA points in a series that dates back to 1928,SFA's Trae Self's pass was intercepted by Blake Lynch, who partially blocked a punt on the

opening series. Ebner's highlight-reel TD came six plays after Lynch's interception.

Ebner's other touchdowns were also in the first half on a 16-yard pass from Brewer and an 11-yard

R.J. Sneed had a pair of TD catches with a team-leading 57 yards receiving. Sneed, Ebner and

Denzel Mims had five catches apiece.

John Lovett ran for 108 yards on eight carries, including a 19-yard touchdown to give Baylor a 35-7 halftime lead.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Baylor is now 78-36-4 all-time in season openers, a 13-10 mark in the Big 12 era (since 1996)
- The Bears are 18-1 all-time against four members (Abilene Christian, Lamar, Northwestern State, Stephen F. Austin, Sam Houston State) of the Southland Conference.
- The 56 points are the third-most points ever scored by a Matt Rhule coached team. The record is 60 points scored in a 60-40 win for Temple at SMU on Nov. 6, 2015.
- The 56 points scored are the most points for Baylor since putting up 62 vs. West Virginia on Oct. 17,
- LB Blake Lynch blocked the first kick of his career, a punt in the first quarter. DT Gabe Hall blocked a field goal attempt in the third quarter, the first of his young career. Lynch and Hall are the fifth and sixth different players to do so in the Rhule era.
- RB Trestan Ebner's three-TD performance is a career best, his previous high was two vs. Vanderbilt in the Texas Bowl and two rushing TDs vs. West Virginia in 2017. He is the first Baylor player to score three TDs in a game since RB John Lovett collected three in last year's season opener vs. Abilene
- RB John Lovett finished with 108 yards, his fourth-career 100+ rushing performance.
