STORY LINES

- Baylor returns home and opens Big 12 play with a visit from Iowa State. The Bears have won five straight
 games for the first time since opening the 2016 season with a 6-0 mark. BU is 9-14 all-time in Big 12 openers.
- Baylor ranks second in the Big 12 in both yards per carry (6.85) and defensive yards allowed per carry (3.37).
 BU has out-scored its first three opponents a combined 91-10 in the first half. Thirteen different Baylor players
- have scored a touchdown, the top total among all FBS programs.
- Charlie Brewer has completed greater than 60% of his passes in 14 of 19 career starts, including five straight.
- Baylor is averaging 237.0 rushing ypg at home since the start of 2018 and holds a 6-2 record in those contests.
 The Bears have blocked six kicks in the last eight games, and have 11 blocked kicks in 28 games under Rhule.
- Third bears have blocked six blocked six blocked six blocked six and have in blocked kicks in 20 games dider white.
 Thirty-nine players have made their Baylor debuts in 2019. Baylor has played 81 different true or redshirt freshmen over the last two-plus seasons.
- The Baylor offense leads the nation in third down success rate converting at a 61.8 percent clip.
- BU's 63 points vs. UTSA are its highest total since putting up 66 vs. Kansas on Oct. 10, 2015. Baylor is second among Big 12 programs in scoring offense through three games (46.7 ppg).
- Baylor running backs have 131 receptions over the last 28 games after totaling only 40 catches from 2013-16.
- Baylor offensive lineman **Sam Tecklenburg** leads the team with 28 consecutive starts. Sixth-year senior wide receiver **Chris Platt** leads the roster with 46 career games played.
- Denzel Mims ranks ninth in BU history with 2,154 receiving yards, & has a catch in 27 straight games played.
- Matt Rhule coached teams have won 35 straight games when leading entering the fourth quarter.
- Baylor is 77-15 since 2008 when scoring 30 points or more.
- Through three games, the Bears have held opponents to only 10 first-half points and an average of 261.7 yards per game (10th, NCAA) 146.0 passing (3rd, Big 12 / 9th, NCAA) and 115.7 rushing (2nd, Big 12).
- BU is playing its 118th season of football. BU holds a 599-574-44 (.510) record all-time. Baylor has scored in a school-record 153 straight games the previous record was 89 games from Dec. 31, 1979 Oct. 23, 1987.

• In Waco, BU has won 5-of-8 meetings including four straight before losing a tight 23-13 game in 2017.

In last season's meeting, Baylor came up short 28-14 in Ames despite out-gaining ISU 505-355. Kickoff

NEXT UP

• Following the matchup with Iowa State, Baylor heads on the road to face Kansas State in Manhattan. • Baylor trails the all-time series with K-State, 9-7, but picked up a thrilling 37-34 victory last season at

- McLane Stadium on the back of a 29-yard Connor Martin field goal with :08 remaining in the fourth guarter.
- In Manhattan, Kansas State holds a 5-2 advantage including a 33-20 victory in Rhule's first visit in 2017.
- Baylor won four straight in the series from 2012-15, including a 52-24 victory over the No. 2 ranked Wildcats at Floyd Casey Stadium in 2012.

 The 2014 matchup featured the fifth-ranked Bears and No. 9 K-State in the only ranked vs. ranked matchup in the series, a 38-27 win for Baylor. BU has faced a ranked Kansas State team only five times.

THIRD DOWN AND REDZONE TRENDING UP

· Baylor struggled in 2017 converting only 32.8% of its third down chances, but made a big step in 2018 leaping form No. 115 to No. 29 (43.4%). The Bears are trending upward once again in 2019. NCAA rank in parentheses.

 The Bears have also showed improvement in red zone scoring percentage after regressing in 2018. <u>Baylor</u> has also scored a touchdown on 12 of its 13 red zone trips (92.3%, 1st NCAA).

RUN GAME SUCCESS

 The Bears have done damage on the ground over its first three victories averaging 253.33 ypg, good for fifth in the Big 12 and 18th nationally. Baylor is third in the conference with 11 rushing touchdowns.

 Nine different players have scored a rushing touchdown, and junior running back John Lovett leads the team with 186 total rushing yards to lead three rushers with more than 100 rushing yards.

• BU's 368 rushing yards on only 39 carries against UTSA set a new program record for yards on less than 40 carries. The Bears had only rushed for 350+ yards on fewer than 50 carries once before. 426 on 42 carries vs. Washington State in 2008.

 Baylor opened the 2019 season with another strong effort on the ground, posting 268 rushing yards against SFA - the third-best opening week total in the Big 12. Three different players recorded a rushing touchdown and John Lovett (108 yards) recorded his fourth career 100-yard performance.

• BU is averaging 237.0 rushing ypg at home since the start of 2018 and holds a 6-2 record in those contests. In the six victories the average is 271.0 ypg and in the two losses it was 135.0 ypg.

RHULE'S NEW SCORING RECORD

· Baylor's 63 points against UTSA established a new scoring record for a Matt Rhule-coached team. In his six seasons as a head coach, Rhule had never had a team tally more than 60 points in a game.

Rhule's previous high-water mark was the 60 points tallied by Temple in a 60-40 victory at SMU in 2015.

· BU established new high-scoring totals under Rhule in consecutive games following the 56 scored against SFA in the opener.

 The last time the Bears scored 60+ points was when they scored 66 on Oct. 10, 2015 when they scored 66 in a 66-7 victory at Kansas.

TOUGHNESS REWARDED

In 2017, head coach Matt Rhule began a new tradition at Baylor of rewarding the nine toughest players on the BU roster with single-digit jerseys. The jersey numbers are awarded to the student-athletes deemed by their teammates to be the toughest members of the team. Rhule began the tradition of honoring toughness with single digits during his tenure at Temple

· Junior quarterback Charlie Brewer has played in 24 games in his career with 19 starts. The Austin native has passed for 5,246 yards in his career which ranks ninth in Baylor history.

• Brewer has passed for 218.6 yards per game in his career with 37 touchdowns and 13 interceptions. He has completed 64.7 percent of his passes (432-of-668). He also has nine rushing touchdowns.

• Brewer has completed 64.54 percent of his passes (313-of-485) in 16 career Big 12 games.

 The Austin native has eclipsed 300 yards passing in eight games, fourth-most in program history. He is joined by Bryce Petty, Robert Griffin III and Nick Florence. He has passed for 400+ yards twice, fifth most in BU history (Griffin, Petty, Szymanski, Florence).

• Brewer opened 2019 with a 71.6 percent completion rate, 665 yards and seven touchdowns with no interceptions in three wins. He has completed greater than 60% of his passes in 14 of 19 career starts, including five straight.

ARNOLD'S RETURN FOR THE RECORD BOOK

• Junior safety Grayland Arnold busted loose for a 73-yard punt return touchdown against UTSA. It was the first punt return touchdown of Arnold's career and the first for Baylor since Levi Norwood in 2013. • At 73 yards, Arnold's return was the longest for Baylor since Shaun Rochon had an 85-yarder against Samford in 2005 and it tied with Don Huggins (1970 vs. TCU) for the ninth longest in program history. • Arnold's score was the first allowed by UTSA in program history (nine seasons) and he is one of just 15 players in FBS to return a punt for a score over the season's first four weeks.

SHARING THE WEALTH ON OFFENSE

• Baylor has a multitude of talented players with which to distribute the football on offense and has made use of many of those options in its 3-0 start.

• That emerging offense ranks second the Big 12 and 10th in the country at 46.7 ppg.

. The Bears have had 13 different players score a touchdown, a total that is tied for tops nationally with Oregon and Maryland.

NEW-LOOK DEFENSE TRENDING UP

• Transitioning to an odd front with three down linemen, three linebackers and five defensive backs, Baylor believed adding more speed to the back end would translate to results. So far they have been right.

• Through three games, the Bears have held opponents to only 10 first-half points and an average of 261.7 yards per game - 146.0 passing (3rd, Big 12 / 9th, NCAA) and 115.7 (2nd, Big 12) rushing.

• LB Clay Johnston has been an early key with 24 tackles, 4.0 TFL and 1.5 sacks. Safety Chris Miller has 15 tackles. Thirteen different players have a TFL and eight have contributed to a sack.

 Baylor has been able to get valuable experience for young players and 30 different defensive players have recorded at least one tackle.

MORE BREWER NOTABLES

With 303 yards against Rice, Charlie Brewer became only the ninth quarterback in Baylor history to throw for more than 9,000 yards. He owns the Baylor single-game records for completions (43) and attempts (63).
Brewer ranks second among active Big 12 QBs in career passing efficiency (145.02) behind Texas' Sam Ehlinger (145.07). Texas Tech's Alan Bowman is third at 143.69.

• The junior from Austin is ranks second in the Big 12 in adjusted completion percentage (81.4) behind Oklahoma's Jalen Hurts (81.7).

- Brewer's 50-yard touchdown throw to Chris Platt at Rice was the fifth-longest TD toss of his career.
- Dating to the Texas Bowl, he has thrown 76 consecutive pass attempts without an INT, 14th-best nationally.

HIGH SCHOOL CONNECTIONS

• Baylor head coach Matt Rhule and co-offensive coordinator Jeff Nixon join elite company among college football coaches that played as high school teammates. Rhule and Nixon are both 1994 graduates of State College (Pa.) High School.

• Over the last 28 games, Baylor has showed the ability to make plays on special teams including blocking kicks and punts. Below is a list of Baylor's 11 blocks since the beginning of 2017.

• BU led the country in 2018 with seven blocks. As a head coach, Rhule's teams have blocked 30 kicks since 2013 (2013-16 at Temple; 2017-current at Baylor).

- · Baylor's seven blocked kicks in 2018 were the most since the team recorded nine in 1989.
- The Bears have blocked six kicks in its last eight games dating back to Oklahoma State 2018.

BEVY OF BAYLOR DEBUTS UNDER RHULE

• After ranking among the top teams in the country to feature freshmen in 2017 and 2018, Baylor continued to introduce new players into its lineups in the opening weeks of 2019.

 Against SFA and UTSA, Baylor had 39 players make their first appearances in a Bears' uniform, including 21 true freshmen (Brandon Bass, Davis Baucum, Will Baxter, Blake Bedier, Jacoby Clarke, Colby Delashaw, TJ Franklin, Blake George, Jackson Gleeson, Gabe Hall, Bryson Jackson, Colby Johnston, Matt Jones, Qualan Jones, Josh Landry, Alex Lanham, Collin Losack, Paul Matavao-Poialii, Cole Maxwell, Michael McNair, Tripp Mitchell, Kyle Peterson, Casey Phillips, Prince Pines, Garmon Randolph, Noah Rauschenberg, Trystan Slinker, Shevin Smith, Sam Snyder, Yusuf Terry, Solo Turner, Brayden Utley, Skyler Wetzel, Brandon White, Harrison White, Jonah White, Kolby White, Will Williams, Niadre Zouzoua).

• Over the last two-plus seasons, Baylor has played 81 true or redshirt freshmen.

MULTIPLE TURNOVERS EQUALS WINS

- Matt Rhule defenses have forced two or more turnovers in 28 of 78 (36.4%) career games coached.
- His teams own a 20-8 record with 2+ turnovers forced, and have won 15 of the last 19 when doing so.
- Rhule's teams are 7-0 when forcing 4+ turnovers and 10-3 when creating 3+.
- His teams are 23-4 in games where they have a positive turnover margin, including this season's win over UTSA.

RHULE TEAMS' FOURTH QUARTER SUCCESS

• In Matt Rhule's six seasons as head coach, he has sealed the deal when leading or tied entering the fourth quarter. In his career, his teams are 20-10 when posting a fourth quarter shutout.

- Rhule-coached teams have won 35 straight games when leading or tied entering the fourth, and are 36-4 overall. All four losses came in his first season as head coach at Temple in 2013.
- When leading entering the 4Q, he has won 33 straight and is 34-3 overall with all three losses in 2013.
- Over the last four-plus seasons, Matt Rhule coached teams are 15-4 when recording a fourth-quarter
- shutout. Baylor held ACU, Kansas, Texas, Iowa State and TCU scoreless in the final guarter in 2018.
- BU's second-half shutout of UT was the first under Rhule & the program's first in a B12 game since 2015 (at TCU).

PLATT IN RARE COMPANY FOR LONGEVITY

Sixth-year senior wide receiver Chris Platt scored his first career rushing touchdown in Baylor's win over UTSA. That score placed him in elite company of players with touchdowns in five different seasons.
His 50-yard touchdown catch from Charlie Brewer was his longest reception since 2017.

Platt is just the fourth active player nationally to score in each season from 2015-19 joining Wake Forest

WR Kendall Hinton, K-State RB James Gilbert and SMU RB Xavier Jones.

• Platt led the nation in receptions of 70+ yards in 2017 despite only playing in four games due to injury. For his career, he has five receptions of 70+ yards which is second most in Baylor history behind Melvin Bonner's six from 1989-92. Below is a list of Platt's 70-yard receptions at Baylor.

RHULE TEAMS IN YEAR THREE

• Baylor head coach Matt Rhule has experienced rebuilding projects in his career before and his time at Temple is very similar to the beginning of his tenure in Waco.

• After a 2-10 mark in 2013 with the Owls, Rhule guided the program to a 6-6 mark & bowl eligibility in 2014.

• Baylor finished 2017 with a 1-11 mark, made a big jump in year two finishing 7-6 with a bowl win.

• In his third season at Temple, Rhule led the Owls to a 10-4 record including a berth in the 2015 AAC Championship game. The Bears have opened 2019 with three consecutive wins.

SHUTTING DOWN THE RUNNING GAME

The Baylor defense has taken pride in the shutting down its opponents on the ground in the early part of 2019. BU held Rice to only 64 rushing yards (1.8 ypc) and is allowing only 115.7 ypg in 2019 (2nd, Big 12).
The Rice game was the third time under Rhule that Baylor had allowed less than 100 yards rushing (2018 vs. UTSA; 2017 vs. Texas Tech).

• Rice's 64 rushing yards were the fewest allowed by Baylor against a FBS opponent and any opponent on the road since Nov. 21, 2015 at Oklahoma State (23 att., 8 yards, 0.3 ypc).

• Baylor allowed only 242 yards of total offense to Rice, the fewest given up since Oct. 15, 2016 against KU (217 yds). BU has only allowed 242 yards or less on the road twice since 2000 (Oct. 10, 2015 at KU, 227 yds).

MIMS IS ONE OF THE COUNTRY'S BEST

• A Preseason All-Big 12 selection, senior Denzel Mims is one of the top wide receivers in the country. Mims leads the Bears with 18 receptions, 249 yards and three touchdowns in 2019.

• The Daingerfield, Texas native ranks among Baylor's all-time greats with 2,154 yards (9th), 138 receptions (13th), 19 touchdowns (7th) and nine 100-yard games (9th).

• Mims is third among Big 12 receivers in career yards per game (56.7) behind only OU's CeeDee Lamb (70.8) and OSU's Tylan Wallace (70.8).

• His 2,154 receiving yards in his career ranks 10th among active FBS wideouts.

• Mims (2x) is one of only eight men in Baylor program history to catch three or more touchdowns in a game. He is joined by Melvin Bonner (2x), KD Cannon, Corey Coleman (4x), Lawrence Elkins, Jay Lee, Reggie Newhouse and Kendall Wright.

• Biletnikoff winner Coleman set the Baylor program record with four touchdown catches vs. Lamar in 2015.

2019 ROSTER FEATURES 14 GRADUATES

• Preparing Champions for Life is not just a slogan at Baylor and coach Matt Rhule's team is proving it. The 2019 Baylor roster features 14 college graduates including three graduate transfers.

• The list of graduates is as follows: Henry Black, Koby Bullard, JaMycal Hasty, Jameson Houston, Clay Johnston, Marques Jones, James Lockhart, Blake Lynch, Ross Matiscik, Chris Platt, Owen Rogers, Sam Tecklenburg and Skyler Wetzel. <u>That total ranks seventh nationally.</u>

• Additionally, former letterman and graduate Lenoy Jones serves as a student coach on defense.

• Two other members of the Baylor roster are scheduled to graduate in December. The Bears boast 19 seniors.

MARQUES JONES EXCELS ON FIELD AND IN CLASSROOM

• Baylor senior Marques Jones is one of the top student-athletes in the country and a nominee for the Campbell Trophy, the Academic Heisman.

• Jones earned a 3.95 GPA in Electrical and Computer Engineering before completing his degree in May 2019. He was honored as a 2018 Gerald Lage Academic Achievement Award from Big 12.

• Jones was awarded with a scholarship at the conclusion of fall camp in 2018. He has played in 27 games in his career with 10 starts. The senior had 21 receptions for 242 yards and two scores in 2018.

opening series. Ebner's highlight-reel TD came six plays after Lynch's interception. Ebner's other touchdowns were also in the first half on a 16-yard pass from Brewer and an 11-yard run

R.J. Sneed had a pair of TD catches with a team-leading 57 yards receiving. Sneed, Ebner and

Denzel Mims had five catches apiece. John Lovett ran for 108 yards on eight carries, including a 19-yard touchdown to give Baylor a 35-7 halftime lead.

Denzel Mims was a little slow getting up after a play when he saw Baylor's call for the next snap. The enior receiver quickly waved off another player heading on to the field to take his place.

Mims then caught the second of his three touchdowns before Grayland Arnold's 73-yard punt return for a score in Baylor's 63-14 win over UTSA on Saturday.

Charle Brewer completed 12 of 16 passes for 165 yards and the three TDs to Mims while playing only the first half, when the Bears (2-0) built a 35-0 lead. Brewer also had a 5-yard touchdown run on a blistering hot day.

Mims had all seven of his catches for 101 yards in the first half of his second career three-TD game He was wide open in the end zone for a 9-yard TD to start the scoring when cornerback Cassius Grady fell down. Mims got behind the same defender along the sideline for a 30-yard TD and then kicked over

the pylon to make it 21-0 on the play he stayed on the field. The Roadrunners (1-1) trailed 49-0 before a 16-play drive capped by true freshman Sincere McCor-mick's 2-yard TD run at the end of the third quarter. He added a 54-yard score after that.

Arnold had Baylor's first punt return for a touchdown since 2005 midway through the second quarter. After fielding the ball and sliding to his right, Arnold sprinted down the sideline and got some nice downfield blocks

Charlie Brewer threw for 303 yards and a touchdown, Denzel Mims caught six passes for 102 yards and Baylor held on to beat Rice 21-13.

Brewer threw a 50-yard touchdown pass to Chris Platt with five minutes left in the second quarter, and ran for a 25-yard touchdown with 15 seconds left in the first half as the Bears (3-0) built a 21-3 halftime lead. Brewer finished 20 of 27 and rushed 12 times for 58 yards.

Platt finished with 80 parts and rushed r2 lines for 36 yards. Platt finished with 80 parts with the touchdown on five catches. Josh Fleeks put Baylor on the board with three minutes left in the first quarter. Baylor outgained Rice 427-242. Wiley Green finished 13-of-23 passing for 128 yards in his return after missing last week with a neck injury. Tom Stewart was 5 of 8 for 50 yards and rushed for a 21-yard touchdown with 8:42 left in the fourth quarter to pull Rice within eight. Brad Rozner caught seven passes for 100 yards for the Owls (0-4).
