MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- BU is now 18-20 all-time against the Cowboys, including a 7-13 mark in Stillwater.
- Baylor has won six of its last eight meetings with OSU, including breaking a 76-year drought in Stillwater with a 45-35 victory in 2015. Prior to the 2015 victory, the last win in Stillwater came in 1939. Overall, the Bears have won 2 of the last 3 in Stillwater.
- The Bears have won nine straight games (dating back to 2018 season), tying for the third-longest winning streak in program history (longest since 11/5/2011-9/21/2012)
- The Bears have started the season 7-0 for the first time since starting the 2015 season 8-0.
- Baylor is in its 118th football season and third under Matt Rhule -- the Bears are 603-574-44 all-time and Rhule is 43-40 in his career (15-17 at BU).
- The win gives the Bears their first four-straight Big 12 wins under Rhule and the first time the Bears have won four-straight in conference since 2015 when they won five straight (Oct. 3-Nov. 5).
- The Bears are 113-55-2 as a ranked team in program history.
- Baylor has scored in a school-record 157-straight games -- the previous school record was 89 games from Dec. 31, 1979 Oct. 23, 1987.
- Baylor won the toss and deferred to the second half.
- Sam Tecklenburg, Jordan Williams, Bravvion Roy, Denzel Mims and Clay Johnston served as team captains at Oklahoma State.

TEAM NOTES

- Bears have forced a punt on all 7 opponent first possessions this year.
- For the first time since SFA the Bears scored at TD on their opening drive of the game.
- The Bears now have 6 wins when trailing at any point in the 4th quarter, the most wins in FBS since 2018.
- The Bears finished with 536 total yards, the most in a Big 12 game this season and second most on the year behind 546 yards vs. UTSA.
- James Lynch's blocked extra point is the 4th blocked kick of the season, 8th block in the last 12 games and 13th in 32 games under Rhule.
- The Baylor defense allowed a TD to the Cowboys in the first quarter, the first time they have allowed a TD in the first quarter since the SFA game.

• With Fleeks' 100 + yard performance and Hasty's 100 yard rushing performance, the Bears have had at least one 100-yd performer in 20-of-32 games under Rhule, including seven of the last nine. Overall, there have been 30 total 100-yd performances under Rhule. Since the start of 2018, the Bears are 11-1 when an individual records a 100-yard performance. The Bears have had two 100-yard performances under Rhule.

- The Bears had their first fumble return TD since Xavien Howard went 30 yards at Kansas in 2015.
- The Bears overcame their biggest deficit of the season, 10 points in the victory.
- The Bears are 12-3 when creating three or more turnovers in a game and 26-4 in games where they have a positive turnover margin, including four 2019 victories.
- Matt Rhule coached teams are 24-8 when recording 2+ turnovers forced and have won 19 of the last 23 when doing so.
- The Bears added to their Big-12 leading sack total with 2 at Oklahoma State, giving them 25.0 on the season.
- Matt Rhule coached teams have won 39-straight games when leading or tied entering the fourth quarter. They are now 40-4 all-time when leading or tied entering the fourth quarter. All four losses came in his first season at Temple in 2013.
- With 3 takeaways in the game, the Bears have now had 16 in nine games after only six in the previous 14 games.
- After totaling 10 interceptions in the first 25 games of the Rhule era, Baylor now has six interceptions in 2019, including five in the last four games.
- The Bears have 25 sacks through seven games in 2019 after totalling just 25 in 2018.
- Through seven games the Bears have held opponents to just 32 total first half points and only 13 second quarter points.
- Through seven games the Bears have held opponents to just 63 points through the first three quarters.
- For the third time under Matt Rhule Baylor has totaled three takeaways, with the first coming vs. K-State in 2018. The Bears have had three takeaways in back-to-back games.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- DL James Lynch's blocked extra point is the his second blocked kick of the season (other field goal vs. lowa State) and third blocked kick of his career (first at WVU in 2018).
- QB Charlie Brewer connected with RB JaMycal Hasty on a 63-yd pass completion and then opened one up for 78 yards to WR Tyquan Thornton, a career-long pass for the junior.
- The 63-yd pass completion to RB **JaMycal Hasty** is a career long reception.

• The 78-yard reception by WR Tyquan Thornton is the longest of his career and the third-longest reception to not end in a touchdown in program history. It is tied for the 28th-longest pass in program history.

- OB Charlier Brewer connected with WR Josh Fleeks for a 64-yd TD reception, the third longest of Brewer's career and the longest of Fleeks' career.
- The three 50+ pass completions are the 10th, 11th and 12th career completion for Brewer of 50+ yards.
- For the first time in QB Charlie Brewer's career he has had 3 or more completions of 50+ yards in a game.
- WR Josh Fleeks with his 2nd receiving TD of his career (first of the season) and second TD of the season after a rushing TD at Rice.
- CB Kalon Barnes picks up his first career interception.
- WR Josh Fleeks finished with 126 receiving yards on just three receptions, his first career 100 + yard performance.

• QB Charlie Brewer is the fourth player in BU history to throw for 6,000 or more yards in his career and passed Nick Florence with 312 yards on 13-for-17 passing today to move into third in BU program history (6,447 passing yards in his career).

- \bullet With 42 career TD passes QB $Charlie\ Brewer$ is now in sole possession of 4th all time.
- QB Charlie Brewer's 13th career rushing TD moves him into sole possession of 6th in BU history for QB rushing touchdowns passing JJ Joe (12).

• OB Charlie Brewer finished with 312 yards passing (13-17), his 11th game in 23 starts with 300 + yards passing, puts him in sole posession of third place on the Baylor career list of 300-yard passing performances.

- RB JaMycal Hasty's career-long rush of 74 yards for a TD was his second of the day, tying his career-high with 2 TDs in a game.
- RB JaMycal Hasty finished with 139 yards, his 3rd career 100 + yards rushing performance and first of 2019.
- RB JaMycal Hasty also had 66 receiving yards, 1 yard shy of tying his career best, most in a game dureing 2019.
- DL Chidi Obgonnaya forced the first fumble of his career.
- LB Terrel Bernard scored his first career TD as he recovered the fumble forced by Obgonnaya. The fumble recovery is the first of his career.
- LB Terrel Bernard tallied a career-best 9 total tackles.
- \bullet S JT Woods had a career-best 6 tackles on the day.

- OB Charlie Brewer now has 790 career attempts, fifth-most in program history.
- WR Denzel Mims has had at least one catch in 31 consecutive games and now has 2,424 career receiving yards, good for eighth-best in program history.
- WR Denzel Mims now has 153 career receptions, moving him up to 11th-most in program history.
- RB JaMycal Hasty now has 1,726 yards in his career, moving him up to 15th most in program history.
- RB John Lovett now has 1,464 career rushing yards, moving him up to 25th most in program history.
- WR Chris Platt appeared in his team-leading 50th career game, starting 32 of those.
- OL Sam Tecklenburg made his 32nd consecutive start, 35th start overall, tops on the team.
