### MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- Today's attendance of 49,109 is the third-largest crowd in McLane Stadium history.
- Baylor is 27-78-4 all-time against Texas.
- Baylor is 17-31-2 all-time against Texas in Waco.
- With the victory the Bears clinched a berth to the Big 12 Championship game for the first time in program history.
- This is the Bears' fifth 10 win season this decade in sixth in program history.
- Baylor snapped a 4-game losing streak to the Longhorns with tonight's victory.
- Baylor is in its 118th football season and third under Matt Rhule -- the Bears are 606-575-44 all-time and Rhule is 46-41 in his career (18-18 at BU).
- The Bears are 116-56-2 as a ranked team in program history.
- Baylor has scored in a school-record 160-straight games -- the previous school record was 90 games from Dec. 31, 1979 - Oct. 23, 1987.
- Largest consecutively attended games in McLane Stadium (10/16 vs. OU, 50,223 and 10/23 vs. UT 49,109 for a total of 99,332) after having back-to-back crowds of 49,875 vs. OU and 48,093 vs. UT for 97,968 fans in 2015.
- The Bears 6 wins at home this year (6-1 overall) are the most in a single season in McLane Stadium history and first since the Bears had 6 home wins in 2013.
- Texas won the toss and defered to the second half.
- **Xavier Newman, John Lovett, Grayland Arnold and James Lynch** served as captains for today's game vs. Texas.

### TEAM NOTES

- BU defense has now allowed only 6 points on 11 opening drives this season - two FGs, 9 punts forced.
- For the 10th time in 11 games the BU defense did not allow a TD in the first quarter.
- Through 11 games the Bears have held opponents to just 54 total first half points and only 29 second quarter points.
- Through 10 games the Bears have held opponents to just 103 points through the first three quarters.
- BU finished with 6.0 TFL, giving them 81 on the season, moving them up to 8th most in a single season in program history.
- With WR **Denzel Mims'** 100+yd receiving performance, Baylor has had a 100-yard performer in 58 percent of its (21-of-36) games under head coach Matt Rhule, including eight of the last 12. The Bears have had two 100-yard performers in 11 games under Rhule. There have been 31 total 100-yard performances under Rhule.
- Since the start of 2018, Baylor is 12-1 when an individual records a 100-yard performance.
- Rhule coached teams at Baylor are now 16-1 when leading or tied entering the fourth quarter.
- Rhule coached teams are now 40-5 when leading or tied entering the third quarter.
- The Bears added to their Big-12 leading sack total with 5 vs. Texas, giving them 38.0 on the season, good for second-most in a single season in program history behind 40 in 1992.
- With 1 takeaway in the game, the Bears have now had 25 in 13 games after only six in the previous 14 games.
- The Bears have now had at least one takeaway in 13 straight games.
- After totaling 10 interceptions in the first 25 games of the Rhule era, Baylor now has 12 interceptions in 2019, including 11 in the last 8 games.
- The Bears' 12 interceptions are the most since having 12 in 2016.
- The Bears have 38.0 sacks through 11 games in 2019 after totalling just 25 in 2018.
- The Bears finished with 5 sacks of the day, 9th game this season they have collected 3 or more sacks.
- Baylor's defense has allowed only 32 plays of 30 or more yards in a season, fewest in the Big 12.

### INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- QB **Charlie Brewer** finished with 1 rushing TDs on the day, giving him now 10 rushing TDs on the season and 17 for his career, good for fourth in Baylor history.
- QB **Charlie Brewer** had 221 yards passing, giving him 18 in his career, third in Baylor history, behind Bryce Petty with 21 and RGIII with 29.
- QB **Charlie Brewer** 23rd career game with a completion percentage of 60.0 or more, good for third most in Baylor history.
- QB **Charlie Brewer's** 10th rushing TD of the season ties him with RGIII, Florence and Trull for rushing TDs in a season by a QB.
- WR **Denzel Mims** hauled in his 11th TD reception of the season, tying him for 6th on the single season TD list. For his career, Mims now has 27 career TDs, moving him into a tie for 3rd in BU history.
- DL **James Lynch** collected 2.0 sacks, giving him 19.0 career sacks, setting a new program record (breaking Shawn Oakman's previous career record of 17.5).
- DL **James Lynch** now has 10.5 sacks this season, tying him for second most in a single season in program history, just half a sack away from tying for first.
- RB **John Lovett's** 28-yd rushing TD in the second quarter to open up scoring for the Bears was his 5th TD of the season, 16th of his career. The TD is his first since at Oklahoma State (10/19).
- LB **Ross Matiscik** collected his first career sack.
- S **Grayland Arnold** collected his 5th interception of the year, the most since Orion Stewart had 6 in 2016.
- WR **Denzel Mims** finished with 125 yards on 7 receptions, his 4th 100+yd receiving game of the season, 11th of his career.
- WR **Denzel Mims'** 11 career 100 yard games is 6th most in Baylor history, tied with KD Cannon.
- QB **Charlie Brewer** remains ranked third all-time at Baylor with 7,334 passing yards in his career.
- QB **Charlie Brewer's** 1 TD pass on the day gives him 49 career TD passes and he remains in sole possession of 4th all-time.
- QB **Charlie Brewer** had 16 completions on the day and remains ranked second in program history with 590 career completions.
- QB **Charlie Brewer** led the Bears with 18 rushing attempts, giving him 328 rushing attempts in his career, moving him past Mark Jackson (323) to fourth-most in program history by a QB.
- QB **Charlie Brewer** moved into fourth in program history in career rushing yards as his 75 today vs. Texas gives him 892 for his career, moving him past J.J. Joe (820).
- QB **Charlie Brewer** 66 TD responsible for ranks fourth in Baylor history (17 rush, 49 pass)
- QB **Charlie Brewer** 29 TD responsible for this season is a new career high for Brewer, moving him up to 6th most in BU single season history.
- WR **Denzel Mims** has had at least one catch in 35 consecutive games and now has 2,797 career receiving yards, keeping him at 6th-most in program history.
- WR **Denzel Mims** now has 177 career receptions, moving up to 6th-most in program history, passing Corey Coleman (173).
- WR **Chris Platt** hauled in 4 receptions, giving him 121 receptions for his career, moving him past Brandon Whitaker (120) for 16th most receptions in a career.
- RB **JaMykal Hasty** now has 1,881 rushing yards in his career, keeping him at 13th-most rushing yards in program history.

- RB **John Lovett** now has 1,606 career rushing yards, keeping him at 20th-most in program history.
- TE **Rob Saulin** made his second career start, first since 2017.
- WR **Chris Platt** appeared in his team-leading 54th career game, starting 35 of those. He has now played in more games than anyone in Baylor history.
- OL **Sam Tecklenburg** made his 36th-consecutive start, 39th start overall, tops on the team.
