TEAM NOTES

• Texas is now 6-5 on the season and 4-4 in Big 12 play.

- The Longhorns are 2-1 against Baylor under head coach Tom Herman.
- Texas is now 7-9 against top-25 opponents during Tom Herman's tenure as head coach.
- \bullet The Longhorns are now 11-3 following a loss since 2017. That includes a 3-1 mark in 2019.
- Texas' defense has forced at least one turnover in 14 of its last 15 games, and in 31 of the 38 games Tom Herman has been head coach for.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

QB Sam Ehlinger

• Finished 22-of-37 for 200 yards passing.

- Thrown for 3,114 yards and 27 touchdowns this season. Has also rushed for 507 yards and 5 touchdowns.
- Responsible for 73 touchdowns since the start of the 2018 season. He is one of only two Power Five QBs to total more than 70 touchdowns in that stretch.
- The eighth Longhorn QB to throw for at least 3,000 yards in a season.
- Joins Colt McCoy (2007-09) as the only Texas QBs to throw for 3,000 yards in multiple seasons. He threw for 3,292 yards (14 games) in 2018.
- His 11th 200-yard game this season, tied for the second-most in school history.
- Marked his 11th-straight game with at least 200 passing yards, tying Major Applewhite (1999) for the longest single-season streak in school history.

WR Devin Duvernay

- Caught 10 passes for 78 yards.
- Has caught 97 passes for 1,095 and 7 touchdowns this season.
- Marked his 25th-straight game with at least one catch, the eighth-longest streak in school history and second-longest among active Longhorns (Collin Johnson, 33)
- His 11th-straight game with at least six catches, one shy of Kwame Cavil's school record of 12-straight games (1999).
- Has made at least six catches in every game this season.
- · Has made at least eight catches in nine games this season, the most in school history.
- His sixth game this year with at least nine catches, tying Jordan Shipley (2009) for the highest single-season total in school history.
- Tallied his third game with double-digit catches this year, making him only fourth player in team history with three-or-more double-digit catch games in a single season, and the first since Jordan Shipley (2009).

RB Keaontay Ingram

- . Carried the ball seven times for 86 yards. He has rushed for at least 70 yards in four of his last five outings.
- Broke a 68-yard run, the longest of his career, that set up Cameron Dicker's 48-yard field goal as time expired at the end of the first half.

DB D'Shawn Jamison

• Forced a fumble on Baylor's opening drive, the first forced fumble of his career.

DB DeMarvion Overshown

• Logged five tackles, including one for a loss, broke up a pass and forced a fumble while making his second start of the season.

DB Chris Brown

• Tied his career with six tackles.

K Cameron Dicker

· Booted a 48-yard field goal as time expired at the end of the first half.

TE Jared Wiley

• Made his first career start.
