

TEAM NOTES

- Baylor's 15 3-pointers set a single-game record for threes in a game, surpassing the previous mark of 13 that was accomplished three times (Landrum 14, T. Oliver 1).
- Baylor's home win streak improved to 46 games, which is tied for the 20th best home-win streak in NCAA history and the second best in BU history (69, 2011-14)
- Baylor's non-conference home win streak improved to 56 games.
- Baylor head coach **Kim Mulkey** moved to to 585-100 all-time with the win (.854).
- Baylor is now 4-0 all-time vs. Arkansas State.
- Baylor is ranked No. 7 by the *Associated Press*, which marks the 306th consecutive week the Lady Bears have been ranked in the AP Top 25 and the 99th-straight week in the Top 10.
- Baylor improved to 321-24 since the start of the 2010-11 season, which marks the second-best win pct. (.930) among all NCAA programs in that span.
- Baylor outscored the Red Wolves on the fastbreak 20-3 today; the Lady Bears have outscored opponents on the break this season 181-32.
- The Lady Bears started the game on a 12-0 run, recorded an additional 11-0 run and closed the first half on a 17-0 run (extended to 19-0 in second half). A second-half run of 13-0 made it 20 double-digit runs in 10 games this season.
- Baylor's 30 points in the first quarter marked the sixth 30-point quarter of the season for the Lady Bears.
- The Lady Bears held Arkansas State to four points in the second quarter and eight points in the fourth quarter, the 15th and 16 times this season to hold an opponent to single-digit points in a quarter.
- Today's attendance of a sold-out 10,284 marks the first sellout since UConn (1/3/19) and tied for the 13th-best attendance mark in school history.
- The Lady Bears set a season high and tied for the third-best game in school history with 37 assists as a team (37, vs. McNeese State, 12/13/15)
- Baylor is now 87-1 all-time in 100-point games.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- **Juicy Landrum** set NCAA, Big 12 and Baylor single-game records with 14 three-pointers made on 23 attempts.
- Landrum's 14 threes is five better than the previous school mark of 9 (Odyssey Sims, vs. Oklahoma 2/27/11; Mandy Hayworth, vs. Texas State, 12/7/99)
- Landrum cruised past the Big 12 record of 11 three-pointers that was held by TCU's Amber Ramirez (vs. SELA 2/10/07)
- Landrum took down the NCAA record set by Moe Kinard from Lamar, who hit 13 on Nov. 23, 2018 vs. Denver.
- The sounds associated with jet planes measure between 120 and 140 decibels. On Landrum's record-breaking three, the Ferrell Center reached a game-high 131.7 dB
- Landrum's 42 points smashed her previous career high of 23 as she cruised past the 800-point mark for her career (841).
- Landrum entered the game at 11th all-time on the Baylor career list for 3-pointers and jumped to eighth with 14; she carries 137 into the Dec. 30 game vs. Morehead State and passed Alexis Prince (136, 2012-17), Alexis Jones (132, 2015-17) and Jessika Stratton (131, 2000-04).
- It was the fourth game this season with multiple 3-pointers for Landrum.
- Landrum scored in double figures for the 41st time in her career and fifth time this season.
- Landrum tied her season high with seven assists and also pulled down eight rebounds
- **NaLyssa Smith** scored 15 points, her ninth time in double figures this season and 27th time in her career.
- Smith did not miss a shot on six field-goal attempts
- **Te'a Cooper** tied career high with 10 assists (10 vs. Houston Baptist, 11/14)
- **Queen Egbo** scored 13 points and grabbed 10 rebounds, her eighth career double-double and fifth of the season.
- Egbo has 17 career double-figure scoring games and nine games in double figure rebounds for her career.
- Egbo tied a career high with four blocks, a mark she has reached three times.
- **Erin DeGrate** recorded 11 points, her 30th career double-figure scoring game and fifth this season.
- DeGrate tied a career high with three steals and **DiDi Richards** tied for the team lead with three steals as well.
