STORY LINES

- No. 10 Baylor heads to Houston to face UT Martin in the Battleground 2k19 at Toyota Center.
- Baylor is coming off a pair of wins against top-20 opponents, knocking off No. 12 Arizona and No. 18 Butler despite shooting a combined 33 percent across those two games (38-of-116).
- BU has defeated 3 ranked teams prior to January for the 2nd time in program history (4-0 in 2016-17).
- Baylor is playing in Houston for the first time since the 2010 Elite Eight at Reliant Stadium, and the Bears are playing in Toyota Center for the first time in the arena's 17-year history.
- Baylor's defense has forced 15+ turnovers in 7 of 9 games after doing so in 7 of 34 games last year.
- BU is No. 10 in the most recent AP Top 25 and has been ranked in all 7 AP polls this season.
- Baylor's streak of 7 consecutive AP polls ranked ties the 7th-longest in program history (all since 2009).
- Baylor's No. 10 ranking is its highest since the Bears were No. 9 entering the 2017 Big 12 tournament.
- The Bears have now been ranked in every AP Top 25 spot except No. 8 during the 17-year Drew era.
- BU has won 7 straight games, its longest non-conference winning streak since starting 15-0 in 2017.
- BU won its third tournament title in 4 years by beating Villanova to win the Myrtle Beach Invitational.
- Baylor is 1 of 6 Power-5 programs to win 18 + games in each of the last 12 seasons since 2008, joining Duke, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan State and North Carolina.
- Baylor is 44-11 in games against non-Big 12 teams over the last 4 seasons since 2016-17.
- Baylor is the only school with FB, MBB, WBB & VB all ranked. Those teams are a combined 56-5 this year. All of those teams are currently top-10 ranked (No. 1 VB, No. 7 WBB, No. 8 FB, No. 10 MBB).
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 17th season in Waco and is BU's all-time wins leader (324-210).
- Drew is coaching his 535th game at Baylor (324-210). His .607 winning percentage is best in BU history among coaches with 40+ games, and his teams have a .673 winning percentage since 2007-08 (290-141).
- Baylor is playing its 221st game as a ranked team under Drew BU was ranked in 2 of 2197 games over the program's 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since 2008-09, BU has been ranked in 218 of 400 games.
- Baylor is coming off its 10th 20-win season in the last 12 years. The Bears were a No. 9 seed in the 2019 NCAA Tournament, where they knocked off Syracuse before falling to No. 1 seed Gonzaga.
- BU was picked 2nd in the Big 12 Preseason Coaches Poll, tying the highest in program history (2012-13). The Bears were picked 9th in last year's poll, but overcame a multitude of injuries to finish in 4th place.
- Baylor has been in the Preseason AP Top 25 in 7 of 10 seasons since its first preseason ranking in 2010-11.
- BU has advanced to the postseason in 8 straight seasons, tied as the nation's 10th-longest active streak.
- Baylor's streak of 11 consecutive seasons ranked was snapped last season, but the Bears have now been ranked in 12 of 13 seasons since 2007-08. BU was ranked only twice prior to the Drew era.
- BU has ranked top-10 nationally in offensive rebounding pct. in 6 straight seasons (No. 2 last year).
- BU has been top-25 nationally in adj. offensive efficiency in 7 of the last 8 seasons (No. 20 last year).
- Baylor is 60-31 against non-confenence teams in neutral-road games during the Drew era, including a 32-16 record in away games against non-Big 12 teams since 2011-12.

QUICK HITS

- BU returned 8 letterwinners from last season, including 5 players who made at least 7 starts Mark Vital (34),
 Jared Butler (21), Tristan Clark (14), Freddie Gillespie (11) and Devonte Bandoo (7).
- Baylor returned 9 players with at least 26 games of Division I experience, including a pair of transfers who are
 now starters after sitting out last season Davion Mitchell and MaCio Teague.
- Eight of Baylor's 14 players either have used or are currently using a redshirt year. Five after transferring to BU Flagler, Gillespie, Mitchell, Tchamwa Tchatchoua and Teague, and three as freshmen — Moffatt, Turner and Vital.
- Eight of Baylor's nine starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (14 of last 15 seasons).
- BU is 44-72 against AP-ranked teams since 2007-08 after going 0-27 in Drew's first 4 rebuilding seasons.
- Baylor is 12-23 against AP Top 10 teams since March 2012. BU started the Drew era 1-26 vs. top-10.
- Baylor has defeated 7 top-10 teams in the last 3 seasons, including a 6-3 mark vs. top-10 teams in Waco.
- Baylor is 35-4 when leading at halftime over the last 3 seasons since 2017-18.
- Baylor has won 88% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (153-20).
- Baylor has won 20+ games in 10 of the last 12 seasons after recording only three 20-win seasons in the previous 100 years of Baylor Basketball (1946, 1948, 1988).
- The Bears are one of 11 programs nationally (1 of 6 in Power-5) to win 18+ games in every year since 2008.
- Baylor is 1 of 14 teams nationally to appear in every postseason since 2012 (6 NCAAs, 2 NITs).
- BU is 96-21 since 2015-16 when leading at any point in the 2nd half of a game (8-1 this season).
- Baylor is 199-94 over the last 9 seasons, averaging 24 wins per season since 2012.
- Baylor's 199 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (245).
- Baylor is 290-141 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- BU is 5-1 all-time in Big 12/SEC Challenges, the best record of any team in either league. Combined with a 3-1
 mark in the Big 12/Pac-10 Series and 1-0 in the Big 12/Big East Battle, Baylor is 9-2 in conference challenges.
- Baylor has the nation's 11th-longest active streak with at least one 3-point FG made in 912 straight games the
 last time Baylor failed to make a 3-pointer was more than 29 years ago, on Feb. 21, 1990 vs. Texas Tech (0-8).
- BU has recorded double-digit non-conference wins in 11 of the last 12 seasons (all except 2012-13).
- Baylor has won 6 tournament titles under Drew (2007 Paradise Jam, 2011 Las Vegas Classic, 2013 NIT, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic and 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational).

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew is now in his 17th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (324).
- Drew is coaching his 535th game at Baylor (324-210). His .607 winning percentage is best in BU history among coaches with 40+ games, and he's the program's all-time wins leader.
- Baylor has a .673 winning percentage (290-141) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .679 winning percentage (199-94) over the last 9 seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (49) is the youngest of 12 coaches nationally to take his current program to four Sweet 16s since 2010.
- Baylor is playing its 221st game as a ranked team in Drew's 17 seasons. BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's first 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since 2008-09, BU has been ranked in 218 of 400 games.
- In Drew's first 16 seasons at Baylor, 42 players have gone on to professional careers.

GAME 10 - vs. UT MARTIN

SERIES HISTORY

- Wednesday is the first series meeting between Baylor and UT Martin. The Bears are 3-3 all-time against current OVC members 2-2 vs. Murray State, 1-0 vs. Morehead State, 0-1 vs. Eastern Kentucky.
- Wednesday is Baylor's first game against an Ohio Valley Conference opponent since a 71-66 win vs. Morehead State in Las Vegas on Dec. 21, 1982.

KENPOM STATS OF THE GAME

- BU's No. 27 ranked offense (109.1 efficiency) is matching up against UTM's No. 353-ranked defense (116.7).
- The Bears are No. 13 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (37.0), while UTM ranks 348th in preventing offensive rebounds (36.3).
- UTM's offense ranks No. 13 nationally in lowest turnover percentage (15.7), and Baylor's defense is No. 32 nationally in defensive turnover percentage (23.6).
- Opponents score 41.9% of points on 3-pointers against UT Martin's defense, which is 8th-highest nationally.

BACK-TO-BACK TOP-20 WINS KEYED BY DEFENSE

- Baylor has knocked off No. 12 Arizona and No. 18 Butler in its last two games, despite shooting 35 percent against Butler (21-60) and 30 percent against Arizona (17-56). The Bears shot .327 (38-116) over those two games.
- The Bears led for 75:30 of 80:00 minutes in those two games, holding a lead for 94 percent of game time.
- BU limited Arizona to .269 (14-52) from the field, the Wildcats' lowest in a game since at least 2000.
- The Bears held Butler to .392 (20-51) from the field and each team had 11 turnovers, but Baylor turned those 11 Butler turnovers into 17 points, while limiting the Bulldogs to 5 points off turnovers.

THREE WINS VS. TOP-20 TEAMS

- Baylor is 3-0 this season against ranked opponents, defeating No. 12 Arizona, No. 17 Villanova and No. 18 Butler.
- Those three teams all remain top-20 ranked and have a combined 28-2 record in all other games.
- BU's only loss this season was by 3 points on a neutral court against current No. 22 Washington.
- The Bears have 3 wins against teams currently ranked in the KenPom Top 20 (No. 10 Butler, No. 15 Arizona, No. 19 Villanova). Duke and Gonzaga are the only other teams with multiple top-20 wins, and they have two apiece.

BU DEFEATS NO. 18 BUTLER IN INAUGURAL BIG 12/BIG EAST BATTLE

- Baylor defeated No. 18 Butler 53-52 in the inaugural Big 12/Big East Battle on Dec. 10 in Waco.
- The Bears won despite scoring only 53 points and shooting 35 percent from the field.
- Baylor's 53 points were its fewest in a win since a 51-40 victory over TCU on Jan. 12, 2012.
- BU built a 16-point first-half lead and never trailed in the game. Butler cut the BU lead to 53-52 with 1:14 remaining, but Mark Vital blocked the potential go-ahead layup off of Butler's Kamar Baldwin to secure the win.

BEARS KNOCK OFF NO. 12 ARIZONA TO COMPLETE HOME-AND-HOME SWEEP

- Baylor improved to 2-0 vs. ranked teams by recording a 63-58 win over No. 12 Arizona on Dec. 7.
- The Bears held Arizona to a .269 field goal percentage (14-52), the Wildcats lowest in a game since at least 2000.
- BU won despite shooting only .304 from the field (17-56). The Bears out-rebounded Arizona 40-33, had 12 assists to Arizona's 7 assists and made 6-of-24 from 3-point range against Arizona's 2-of-11 from downtown.
- MaCio Teague led the Bears with 19 points, while Freddie Gillespie posted career-highs of 17 points, 13 rebounds, 5 blocks and 36 minutes. Mark Vital recorded a +17 plus-minus in just 14 minutes off the bench.
- Gillespie earned his career-first Big 12 Player of the Week honor two days after the win.
- The win completed Baylor's home-and-home sweep against Arizona following a 58-49 win in Tucson last season.

WIN OVER VILLANOVA GIVES BEARS MYRTLE BEACH INVITATIONAL TITLE

- . Baylor claimed the Myrtle Beach Invitational title with wins vs. Ohio, at Coastal Carolina and vs. No. 17 Villanova.
- **Jared Butler** earned MVP honors after scoring 10 points in the final 6 minutes of the championship game, and he was joined on the All-Tournament Team by **MaCio Teague**, who led the Bears with 18.7 ppg in the tournament.
- Davion Mitchell averaged 12.3 points in the tournament after entering with a career single-game high of 10 points.
- BU overcame an early 7-point deficit on its way to a 76-53 win over Ohio in the quarterfinals, led by Butler's 19 points.
- The Bears trailed by 8 points with 15 minutes left at Coastal Carolina, but rallied to win 77-65 in the semifinals.
- The championship game vs. No. 17 Villanova featured 18 lead changes, but Baylor closed the game on a 23-12 run over the final 6 minutes to claim an 87-78 win. The Bears made 6-of-9 3-pointers in the 2nd half.

INDIVIDUAL PLAYER RANKINGS

- Jared Butler has led BU in scoring in 6 of 9 games this season. He leads the Big 12 in 3FG% (.444) and 3FGs/gm (3.1), ranks 2nd in scoring (17.4), 3rd in FT% (.900), 7th in FG% (.459), 11th in steals (1.6) and 14th in assists (3.0).
- Freddie Gillespie ranks 21st nationally and 2nd in the Big 12 in offensive rebounding (3.8), tied for 2nd in the Big 12 in double-doubles (4), 3rd in rebounding (9.1), 3rd in blocks (2.4), 11th in steals (1.6) and 13th in FT% (.724).
- MaCio Teague is 7th in the Big 12 in scoring (14.8), 4th in 3FGs (2.3/gm), 4th in FT% (.857) and 14th in minutes (30.9). Teague joined Butler (MVP) on the Myrtle Beach Invitational All-Tournament Team.
- Davion Mitchell ranks 15th in the Big 12 in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.6) and 13th in assists (3.1).
- Mark Vital ranks 8th in the Big 12 in steals (1.7), 10th in blocks (1.1) and 17th in rebounding (5.6).

SUCCESS ACROSS BAYLOR ATHLETICS DEPARTMENT

- Baylor is the nation's only school with top-25 ranked teams in football, men's and women's basketball and volleyball.
- Those four sports have a combined 56-5 record this season FB 11-2, MBB 8-1, WBB 8-1, VB 29-1.
- The BU Volleyball team is ranked No. 1 and earned the NCAA Tournament No. 1 overall seed. They are now 29-1 and play in the Final Four in Pittsburgh on Thursday. Baylor Volleyball has lost only 13 sets all season (87 sets won, 13 lost).
- Baylor Football is No. 8 nationally at 11-2. The Bears face No. 5 Georgia in the Sugar Bowl on Jan. 1.
- Baylor Men's Basketball is ranked No. 10 nationally at 8-1 with its lone loss by 3 points to Washington.
- Baylor Women's Basketball is ranked No. 7 nationally at 8-1 with its lone loss against No. 5 South Carolina.

RANKED 10TH IN LATEST AP TOP 25

- Baylor climbed to No. 10 in the latest AP Top 25 released on Monday. It's the Bears' 7th straight week ranked and Baylor's highest ranking since the Bears were No. 9 entering the 2017 Big 12 Championship.
- This is the first time Baylor has been ranked No. 10 in the AP Top 25. The Bears have now occupied 24 of 25 spots in the AP Top 25 over the last 12 seasons (all spots except No. 8).
- Baylor's streak of 7 consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 ties the 7th-longest streak in program history 25 polls in 2017-18, 22 in 2012-13, 17 in 2010-11, 15 in 2015-16, 12 in 2014, 10 in 2016, 7 in 2009.
- Wednesday is Baylor's 220th game as a ranked team, with 218 of those coming in the last 13 seasons.
- Baylor was ranked No. 16 in the preseason AP Top 25 poll, which tied the 2nd-highest preseason ranking in BU history.
- BU has been in the preseason AP Top 25 in 7 of 10 seasons since the program's first preseason ranking in 2010-11.
- Baylor's highest preseason ranking was No. 12 in 2011-12. The Bears were No. 16 in 2010-11 and 2019-20, No. 19 in 2012-13, No. 22 in 2015-16, No. 24 in 2017-18 and No. 25 in 2013-14.

NON-CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS

- BU went 10-5 in non-conference last season, with marquee wins at Arizona, vs. Oregon, vs. Alabama and vs. Syracuse.
- BU held Oregon to 47 points on Dec. 15, the Ducks' fewest in a game since scoring 46 vs. Cal on Feb. 21, 2013.
- BU won 58-49 at Arizona on Dec. 1, becoming the first team to hold UA below 50 points since Feb. 26, 2011.
- The win at Arizona snapped the Wildcats 52-game non-conference home winning streak.
- Baylor is 12-5 vs. the Pac-12 during the Drew era, 11-1 against the Big East during the Drew era and 15-10
 against the SEC during the Drew era, including 10-5 since 2012-13 and 5-1 in the Big 12/SEC Challenge.
- Baylor is 42-11 in games against non-Big 12 teams over the last 4 seasons, including home wins against No. 4 Oregon, No. 7 Xavier, No. 12 Arizona, No. 18 Butler, Oregon and Alabama, neutral site wins vs. No. 10 Louisville, vs. No. 17 Villanova, vs. No. 24 Michigan State, vs. VCU, vs. USC, vs. Wisconsin, vs. Creighton and vs. Syracuse and road wins at Arizona and Ole Miss.

TWENTY-SIX WINS VS. RANKED TEAMS IN LAST FIVE SEASONS

- Baylor has gone 26-32 against ranked teams since the start of the 2014-15 season (3-0 this season).
- BU is 44-72 against AP-ranked teams since 2007-08 after going 0-27 in Drew's first four rebuilding seasons.
- Baylor has won multiple games vs. AP Top 25 teams in each of the last 13 seasons. The Bears have defeated at least five ranked teams in four of the last six seasons dating back to 2013-14.

A WIN WOULD ...

- Extend Baylor's winning streak to 8 games, its longest in non-conference play since starting 15-0 in 2016-17.
- Make Baylor 1-0 all-time vs. UT Martin and 4-3 against current OVC teams.
- Move Baylor to 45-11 in games against non-Big 12 teams since 2016-17.
- Be Drew's 325th win at Baylor and improve Baylor's record to 291-141 since 2007-08.
- Make Baylor 154-34 in November/December games under Drew, including 77-19 in December games.

BIG 12'S BEST RECORD IN CONFERENCE CHALLENGES

- Baylor is 9-2 in conference challenges, the best record of any Big 12 team in those games 5-1 in the Big 12/SEC Challenge, 3-1 in the Big 12/Pac-10 Series and 1-0 in the Big 12/Big East Battle.
- BU's 5-1 record in the Big 12/SEC Challenge includes wins over Kentucky, Vanderbilt, Georgia, Ole Miss and Alabama.
- Baylor's 5-1 record is best by any team in the Big 12/SEC Challenge. Kansas, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, TCU and Texas Tech are all 4-2, Iowa State, K-State and Texas are all 3-3 and West Virginia is 1-5.
- Baylor's 9-2 record in conference challenges is best in the Big 12, followed by Kansas (7-3), Oklahoma State (7-4), Oklahoma (6-4), Texas (6-4), Iowa State (6-5), K-State (5-6), Texas Tech (5-6), TCU (4-2) and West Virginia (1-6).

PICKED 2ND IN BIG 12 PRESEASON COACHES POLL

- Baylor was picked second in the 2020 Big 12 Preseason Coaches Poll, tying 2013 for the best in program history.
- Baylor (71 points) was projected behind only Kansas (80). Texas Tech (62) was third, followed by Texas (57), West Virginia (45), Oklahoma State (42), Iowa State (30), Oklahoma (29), Kansas State (23) and TCU (11).
- BU was projected to finish 9th last season, but the Bears overcame injuries to four projected starters to finish 4th.

GILLESPIE GROWING INTO STARTING ROLE

- Freddie Gillespie has started 18 of the last 21 games since entering the starting lineup on Feb. 9, 2019 vs. K-State.
- Gillespie did not play in 8 of 9 games immediately preceding Tristan Clark's injury last year, but he joined the rotation for the first game without Clark on Jan. 12, and he became a starter 8 games later (started 9 of final 12 games).
- Gillespie was named Big 12 Player of the Week on Dec. 9 after recording career-highs of 17 points, 13 rebounds, 5 blocks and 36 minutes played in the Bears' win over No. 12 Arizona two days prior.
- Gillespie has posted 4 double-doubles this season after doing so in 1 of 26 games played last year.
- Gillespie is 2nd in the Big 12 and 38th nationally with 4 double-doubles. He ranks 2nd in the Big 12 in offensive rebounding (3.9), 3rd in blocks (2.4), 3rd in rebounding (9.1), 11th in steals (1.8) and 13th in FT% (.724).

BUTLER TAKING OVER

- Jared Butler has led Baylor in scoring in 6 of 9 games this season after doing so in 6 of 34 games last year.
- Butler had 30 points in the season-opener vs. UCA, the 2nd-most of his career (31 at Kansas on March 9, 2019), and he posted back-to-back 20-point games – 22 vs. Villanova, 20 vs. UMES.
- Butler leads the Big 12 in 3-point percentage (.444) and 3-pointers made (3.1/gm), ranks 2nd in scoring (17.4), 7th in field goal percentage (.459), 3rd in free throw percentage (.900), 11th in steals (1.6) and 14th in assists (3.0).
- Butler has scored at least 12 points in 8 of 9 games this season.
- Butler was named Myrtle Beach Invitational MVP and picked up Big 12 Player of the Week honors on Nov. 25.

TEAGUE CONTINUING STREAKS

- MaCio Teague has played in 76 consecutive games and made 72 consecutive starts during 3 collegiate seasons (2016-17 & 2017-18 at UNC Asheville, 2019-20 at Baylor). He has started all but one game (Nov. 20, 2016).
- Teague has made at least one 3-pointer in 34 consecutive games, including 27 of 34 games with multiple 3FGs.
- Teague ranks 7th in the Big 12 in scoring (14.8), 4th in 3-pointers made (2.3/gm), 4th in free throw percentage (.857) and 14th in minutes played (30.9/gm).
- Teague led the Bears with 18.7 points per game at the Myrtle Beach Invitational, earning All-Tournament honors.

SUCCESS IN TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor is 36-12 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including tournament titles in 3 of the last 4 years.
- BU is 23-4 in its seven regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1 and 3-0.
- BU advanced to championship games in the 2007 Paradise Jam (won), 2008 76 Classic (lost), 2011 Las Vegas Classic (won), 2013 Maui Invitational (lost), 2014 Las Vegas Invitational (lost), 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis (won), 2017 Hall of Fame Classic (won) and 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational (won).
- Baylor has won five regular-season tournament titles under Drew the 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, the 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, the 2011 Las Vegas Classic and the 2007 Paradise Jam.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Drew is in his 17th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (324).
- Baylor has had a nation-leading four players selected in the NBA Draft since 2010 who weren't ranked in the ESPN100 out of high school Quincy Acy, Ekpe Udoh, Pierre Jackson and Taurean Prince.
- Drew has graduated 49 players during his Baylor tenure, averaging more than 3 graduates per season.
- The Bears have advanced to postseason play in a school-record eight straight seasons (6 NCAA, 2 NIT).
- Baylor is 23-4 in regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, including 4 regular-season tournament titles.
- Drew has won 20+ games in 10 of the last 12 years the Bears had 3 seasons of 20+ wins prior to his arrival.

FIVE NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES IN LAST SIX SEASONS

- Baylor appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the fifth time in the last six seasons in 2019.
- BU is 1 of 22 teams (1 of 15 in Power-5) to appear in five NCAA Tournaments since 2014, joining Arizona,
 Cincinnati, Duke, Gonzaga, Iowa State, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Michigan State, New Mexico State, North
 Carolina, Oklahoma, Oregon, Providence, Purdue, VCU, Villanova, Virginia, Wichita State, Wisconsin and Xavier.

EIGHT CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of eight consecutive postseason berths, surpassing the total number of postseason berths in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
- Baylor is 1 of 14 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Cincinnati, Duke, Gonzaga, Iona, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan State, New Mexico State, North Carolina, Oregon, Saint Mary's, Virginia and Wichita State.
- BU earned NCAA Tournament bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2019 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has made postseason appearances in 11 of 12 seasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).
- Baylor is 21-10 in postseason national tournaments during the Drew era after going 3-9 prior to Drew's arrival.

- BU is 113-94 in Big 12 play in 12 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- BU is 99-77 in Big 12 play in 10 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- Baylor is 34-38 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (44-24).
- BU has recorded double-digit Big 12 wins in 4 of the last 5 and 6 of the last 10 seasons.
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 8 straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.

SECOND-MOST WINS AMONG BIG 12 TEAMS SINCE 2011-12

- Baylor's 199-94 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (245-61) among Big 12 teams (thru 12/15/19).
- lowa State (189-97) is 3rd, Kansas State (178-104) is 4th, West Virginia (178-110) is 5th, Oklahoma (168-107) is 6th, Texas (160-124) is 7th, Oklahoma State (151-124) is 8th, Texas Tech (147-127) is 9th and TCU (144-137) is 10th.
- Baylor has averaged 24 wins per season over the last seven seasons since 2011-12.

PROTECTING HALFTIME LEADS

- Baylor is 38-4 in its last 42 games when leading at the half, including 15-3 last season and 15-0 in 2017-18.
- Baylor has won 88% of its games (153-20) when leading at the half since 2011-12 (5-1 in 2019-20, 15-3 in 2018-19, 15-0 in 2017-18, 18-3 in 2016-17, 18-2 in 2015-16, 21-7 in 2014-15, 18-2 in 2013-14, 17-1 in 2012-13 and 26-1 in 2011-12).
- BU has won 38% of games in which its been tied or trailing at the half since 2011-12, going 46-74 in those.

NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER SUCCESS

- Baylor has posted a combined 153-34 record in November and December games during the Drew era, including a 71-12 mark in November and December games since 2013.
- The Bears are 77-15 in November games and 76-19 in December contests.
- BU is 37-7 in November games since 2013, with the only losses to No. 8 Syracuse (2013), vs. Illinois (2014) in Las Vegas, at No. 25 Oregon (2015), at No. 21 Xavier (2017), vs. Texas Southern (2018), vs. Ole Miss (2018) in Florida and vs. Washington (2019) in Alaska.
- BU is 34-5 in December games since 2013, with the only losses at No. 24 Texas A&M (2015), vs. No. 8 Wichita State (2017), at No. 22 Texas Tech (2017), at Wichita State (2018) and vs. SFA (2018).

POINT GUARDS THRIVE IN DREW'S SYSTEM

- Eight of Baylor's nine starting point guards during the **Scott Drew** era have earned All-Big 12 recognition.
- Baylor's starting point guard has earned All-Big 12 recognition in 14 of 15 seasons since 2004-05.
- Makai Mason (2019), Manu Lecomte (2017, 2018), Lester Medford (2016), Kenny Chery (2014, 2015), Pierre Jackson (2012, 2013), Tweety Carter (2010), Curtis Jerrells (2007, 2008, 2009) and Aaron Bruce (2005, 2006, 2007) have earned All-Big 12 recognition.

DOUBLE-DIGIT NON-CONFERENCE WINS IN 11 OF LAST 13 YEARS

- Baylor has begun Big 12 play with double-digit wins in 5 of the last 6 seasons and 11 times in the last 13 years.
- All told, Baylor has gone 148-26 prior to Big 12 play over the last 14 seasons dating back to 2006-07, including an 11-9 record against AP Top 25 teams.
- BU entered Big 12 play 8-4 in 2018-19, 10-2 in 2017-18, 12-0 in 2016-17, 10-2 in 2015-16, 11-1 in 2014-15, 12-1 in 2013-14, 8-4 in 2012-13, 13-0 in 2011-12, 10-3 in 2010-11, 12-1 in 2009-10, 12-2 in 2008-09, 12-2 in 2007-08 and 10-3 in 2006-07. The Bears are 8-1 in non-conference this season.

GRADUATING 91 PERCENT OF SENIORS

- Since **Scott Drew** took over the Baylor Basketball program in 2003, 32 of 35 scholarship players who have played their fourth years of collegiate eligibility under Drew have graduated from Baylor.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT — FROM UNRANKED TO NBA DRAFT PICKS

- Baylor has had a nation-leading four players selected in the NBA Draft since 2010 who weren't ranked in the ESPN100 out of high school.
- The only other schools with three such players were Colorado, Marquette, Missouri, New Mexico and Connecticut.
- Baylor developed Quincy Acy, Ekpe Udoh, Pierre Jackson and Taurean Prince into NBA Draft picks after joining the program as unranked recruits.

HISTORY OF DEVELOPMENT WITH REDSHIRTS

- Baylor has a track record of success when players redshirt under Scott Drew. Ekpe Udoh, Johnathan Motley,
 Cory Jefferson, Brady Heslip, Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. and Manu Lecomte have all gone on to professional careers after redshirting.
- Mark Vital, Freddie Gillespie, MaCio Teague and Davion Mitchell have all redshirted while at Baylor.
- Adam Flagler and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua are both redshirting this season while sitting out to satisfy NCAA transfer rules, while freshman Jordan Turner has elected to redshirt.

42 PRO PLAYERS IN DREW ERA

- In Scott Drew's 16 years at Baylor, 42 of his players have gone on to professional careers.
- Five of Drew's players were in the NBA last season, and they all graduated from Baylor Quincy Acy (Suns), Johnathan Motley (Clippers), Royce O'Neale (Jazz), Taurean Prince (Hawks) and Ekpe Udoh (Jazz).

CONSISTENTLY AMONG NATION'S BEST OFFENSES

- . Baylor's offense has consistently ranked among the nation's best over the last 12 seasons under Scott Drew.
- The Bears have finished 10 of the past 12 seasons among the top 25 nationally in KenPom's adjusted offensive efficiency, joining Duke as the only programs to make that claim. Baylor is currently No. 27 nationally in 2019-20.
- BU finished No. 20 in 2018-19, No. 62 in 2017-18, No. 23 in 2016-17, No. 13 in 2015-16, No. 18 in 2014-15, No. 9 in 2013-14, No. 14 in 2012-13, No. 8 in 2011-12, No. 102 in 2010-11, No. 3 in 2009-10, No. 11 in 2008-09 and No. 11 in 2007-08.

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING BECOMING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- Baylor has ranked top-10 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in every season since 2013-14, including five times ranked in the nation's top-4. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor's 6-year streak is the nation's best, and West Virginia (5 years) is the only other team with a 3+ year streak.
- The Bears currently rank 13th nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (37.0) in 2019-20.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 2 nationally in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that 6-year top-10 streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

BAYLOR BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO

- Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Network from Learfield IMG College on ESPN Central Texas and flagship station 1660AM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.
- Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris and former Baylor basketball standout Pat Nunley.
- Morris is in his 36th year doing Baylor broadcasts, while Nunley is in his 39th season as color analyst.
- Dave Rosselli enters his 3rd season filling in when Morris slides over to the TV broadcast.
- All of Baylor's games can be heard live on the Internet at www.BaylorBears.com and via the Tuneln App.

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Three current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 11th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Grant McCasland is in his third season as head coach at North Texas. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Paul Mills is in his third season as head coach at Oral Roberts. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.

ENTIRE STAFF RETURNS

- Scott Drew's entire coaching staff returns for the 2019-20 season.
- Jerome Tang is in his third season as associate head coach and has been on Drew's staff all 17 seasons at Baylor.
- Assistant coaches Alvin Brooks III (fourth season) and John Jakus (third season) also return to the bench.
- Special assistant & director of player development Jared Nuness is back for his 10th season, while director of basketball operations Aditya Malhotra returns for his 7th season. Special assistant to the head coach Bill Peterson and director of video operations Ty Beard are both back for their third seasons.


- Baylor returns home to Waco to cap non-conference play against Jackson State on Dec. 30.






