TEAM NOTES

- Baylor improved to 588-100 (.855) under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor evened the series at 4-4 vs. UConn.
- Baylor is now 2-11 in the NCAA era vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (AP/WBCA).
- After snapping UConn's 126-game regular season win streak last season in Waco (Jan. 3, 2019), Baylor snapped UConn's 98-game home win streak Thursday.
- Baylor improved to 92-54 in the **Mulkey** era and to 60-15 since 2010-11 in games vs. Top 25 opponents away from Waco that include true road contests, Big 12 Tournament games and NCAA Tournament competition.
- Baylor improved to 161-71 under **Mulkey** vs. the Top 25 and 51-37 vs. Top 10 opponents.
- Baylor hit 7 3-point field goals tonight (2nd most this season) after hitting just three in BU and UConn's last meeting Jan. 3, 2019 in Waco.
- Baylor held UConn to just .290 shooting (20-69); in 672 of 687 games under Mulkey, Baylor has held opponents below 50-percent shooting.
- Baylor put together a 15-0 run in the fourth quarter; Baylor's 25th double-digit run of the season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Te'a Cooper finished with 27 points, her 43rd time to score in double-digits for her career and 11th this season. It was Cooper's 11th time to go over 20 points for her career
- Lauren Cox finished with a season-high 16 points, it was the 73rd time in her career to score in double figures and her fifth in five games this season.
- NaLyssa Smith finished with 20 points, it was her 11th game this season with 10+ and 29 in her career. It was Smith's fifth time to go over 20 points in her career.
- Smith notched a double-double, the eighth of her career and fifth of the season by adding a team-leading 12 rebounds.
- Cooper finished with five assists; her fourth was the 200th of her career.
