TEAM NOTES

- Baylor improved to 590-100 (.855) under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor moved to 32-8 all-time vs. Kansas [30-2 in Mulkey era], won its 11th straight over the Jayhawks and 20th of the last 21 games.
- Baylor is now 156-7 (.957) vs. Big 12 opponents since the start of the 2010-11 season and 268-55 (.830) all-time under Mulkey.
- Baylor extended its Big 12 regular-season win streak to a school-record 44 games, and it also ranks as tied for the 12th-best conference win streak in NCAA history.
- Baylor extended its road win streak vs. Big 12 opponents to 37 games, the third best such streak in NCAA history.
- All 11 Baylor players scored in the contest.
- Baylor's 35-point half time lead was a school record for largest halftime lead in a Big 12 contest (30, by K-State, 1/25/17, BU 44 K-State 14).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Te'a Cooper finished with 11 points, her 13th time this season to score in double figures and the 45th time in her career.
- Lauren Cox finished with 13 points, the 75th career time to have 10+ and the seventh game this season (seven games played).
- NaLyssa Smith finished with 13 points, the 31st time in her career with double digits and the 13th time this season.
- Juicy Landrum finished with 11 points, the 43rd time in her career with at least 10 and the 7th time this season.
- Trinity Oliver finished with a career-high 10 points, her first ever game in double figures; her 7th point gave her 100 for her career.
- Oliver led the team in rebounds for the first time in her career with seven.
- Cooper led all players with five assists with just one turrnover.
- Cox had four steals and two blocks to lead all players in both categories.
