STORY LINES

SATURDAY BRINGS TOP 25 CLASH, HONORING OF NINA DAVIS

Baylor will take on No. 17/18 West Virginia before a nationally-televised audience Saturday at 7 p.m. on FS1. The Lady Bears lead the series 15-3 and are 15-2 under Mulkey vs. the Mountaineers. The last matchup was the Big 12 regular-season finale in March where Baylor cemented its perfect 18-0 record in league play, but not without a fight, squeaking out a 63-57 win in Morgantown, W. Va., March 4.

Baylor is 75-47 all-time when playing a Top 25 opponent at the Ferrell Center and 70-17 (.804) under Kim Mulkey. Since the 2010-11 season, Baylor is 40-3 vs. Top 25 opponents at the Ferrell Center.

Former Lady Bear Nina Davis will have her No. 13 jersey retired in a pregame ceremony Saturday. Davis was one of six Baylor players to have 2,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds. She ranks fifth all-time in both scoring and rebounding and earned All-America status in all four seasons with the team by various entities.

LADY BEARS PICK UP SIGNATURE WIN AT NO. 1 UCONN

Prior to last year's meeting with UConn at home, Baylor was 0-11 in the NCAA era vs. No. 1-ranked opponents. However, after a 67-58 win over the top-ranked Huskies in Waco Jan. 3, 2019 and a 74-58 win at No. 1 UConn Thursday, Baylor now has two-straight wins over No. 1s. Both Baylor head coach Kim Mulkey and UConn head coach Geno Auriemma downplayed the impact of game and the result pregame and postgame, respectively. However, for Baylor it gives their non-conference resume some punch after falling to No. 5/6 South Carolina (74-59) in St. Thomas, USVI Nov. 30.

The Lady Bears moved to 3-1 vs. ranked opponents in 2019-20 and improved to 60-15 vs. Top 25 programs away from Waco since the 2010-11 school year.

Baylor is now 4-4 all-time vs. UConn, and the Lady Bears have stopped two impressive streaks in the last two victories over the Huskies. Baylor snapped UConn's 126 regular-season game win streak in 2019 before ending the Huskies' 98-game home win streak Thursday. It also marked UConn's worst home loss since Dec. 5, 2005 when North Carolina beat the Huskies by 23.

For the second-straight season, Baylor held UConn to below 30 percent shooting from the floor. The Huskies managed just a .294 shooting mark in Waco before holding UConn to a .290 effort Thursday on 20-69 shooting.

STREAKS CONTINUE TO BE ON THE LINE FOR BAYLOR

Baylor has tied the Big 12 and BU record with 44-straight Big 12 wins in the regular season after Wednesday's win at Kansas. Forty-four-straight conference wins in the regular season is tied for the 12th best conference win streak in NCAA history. Baylor can take sole possession of the Big 12 and Baylor record with a win over West Virginia Saturday and sole possession of 12th place all-time.

Baylor's home win streak of 48 games is the longest active streak in the NCAA after the Lady Bears ended UConn's 98-game home win streak Jan. 9. Forty-eight straight wins at the Ferrell Center is tied for the 18th-best home win streak in NCAA history, and the Lady Bears are 393-97 (.802) all-time in Waco.

WRAPPING UP A NINE-YEAR RUN OF DOMINANCE FOR BAYLOR'S LADY BEARS

Baylor closed 2019 with a 335-23 record between Jan. 2, 2010 and Dec. 30, 2019 for a .936 winning percentage. Last decade produced two national championships (2012, 2019), **CONTINUED ON PAGE 2...**

NUMBERS THAT MATTER

103 The Lady Bears have been ranked in the Associated Press Top 10 since Dec. 8, 2014.

48 Baylor has 48-straight wins on its home floor, the Ferrell Center, with its last loss coming Feb. 6, 2017 to Texas (85-79). That's tied for the 19th-best home-court win streak in NCAA history.

44 Baylor has won 44-straight Big 12 contests in the regular season, that's tied for the 12th best streak in NCAA history and tied for the Baylor & Big 12 record.

three Final Fours (2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Sweet 16s, 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, nine Big 12 regular season championships, and eight Big 12 Tournament titles. It also saw 11 players receive WBCA First-Team All-America honors, seven earned Associated Press All-Americans, eight were named USBWA First-Team All-Americans, Kim Mulkey earned seven different National Coach of the Year honors and six Big 12 Coach of the Year awards. Six players were named Big 12 Player of the Year and 22 players earned First-Team All-Big 12.

LADY BEARS ON THE RUN

Through 15 games the Lady Bears have 28 double-digit runs this season, including a season-high 37-0 run to begin the game vs. New Hampshire Nov. 5 and a Big-12 best 29-0 run at Oklahoma Jan. 4. In addition to the transition game on offense, Baylor's defense has allowed just 61 fast-break points on the season. Baylor is outscoring teams on the break by an average of 18.6-4.1.

LADY BEARS PIQUING ON BOTH SIDES OF THE BALL THROUGH FIRST 15 GAMES

The 13-1 Lady Bears rank in the top 10 nationally in 14 categories through games played through Jan 12. Baylor ranks tops in the nation in assists per game (23.2), field goal percentage (.515), scoring margin (38.6), scoring offense (87.4) and field goal percentage defense (.296). Baylor also ranks in the top five in the nation in assists-to-turnover ratio (2nd, 1.72:1), blocked shots per game (5th, 6.5) assists (3rd, 325), rebound margin (14.6), three-point field goal percentage (4th, .399) and scoring defense (2nd, 48.8).

DiDi Richards ranks fourth nationally in assists-to-turnover ratio (3.35:1) while Juicy Landrum ranks 17th (2.60:1) and Jordyn Oliver checks in at 24th (2.41:1); the trio ranks first through third, respectively in that category in the Big 12 rankings. Nalyssa Smith ranks 14th in the nation and second in the Big 12 at 60.5 shooting from the floor while Queen Egbo is 20th and third, respectively with a .592 mark. Juicy Landrum is shooting .468 from beyond the 3-point arc, which ranks her eighth in the nation and second in the Big 12.

THE FUTURE IS BRIGHT: LADY BEARS INK TWO TOP-10 RECRUITS FOR 2020

Baylor head coach Kim Mulkey announced the signing of two of the top 10 players in the country Wednesday, with Irving MacArthur standouts Sarah Andrews and Hannah Gusters signing national letters of intent to join the Lady Bears in 2020.

Gusters was the first to verbally commit to Baylor in May. The 6-4 post player is the No. 9 overall ranked player in the 2020 class and the No. 2 center by espnW's HoopGurlz. The Dan Olson Collegiate Basketball Report ranks her ninth and second, respectively as well. After helping Duncanville High School win a state championship as a freshman, Gusters averaged 14.5 points per game as a sophomore in leading the Pantherettes to a 39-2 record and the Class 6A region finals. Gusters played AAU ball for Nike ProSkills, and her maternal grandfather, Dewey Turner, played football for the University of Texas.

Andrews verbally committed to Baylor on social media Nov. 2 during an official visit. The 5-7 point guard is ranked No. 7 overall and the No. 2 point guard by espnW's HoopGurlz recruiting rankings and carries the same ranking from the Dan Olson Collegiate Basketball Report. Among Andrews' honors as a point guard for Irving MacArthur High School, she was a two-time TGCA 6A All-State selection in 2018 and 2019. USA Today named Andrews to the second-team All-Texas team in 2019 as well. The Dallas Morning-News named Andrews the top recruit in Texas. As a junior, she was the District 6-6A MVP after averaging 15.1 points, 7.0 assists, 5.6 rebounds and 2.9 steals for a MacArthur team that went 29-9. Andrews played AAU ball for Nike ProSkills.

SCORING IS TOUGH VS. THE LADY BEARS

Baylor ranked tops in the nation in 2018-19 in the following categories: Assists (850), Assists Per Game (22.4), Blocked Shots (274), Blocked Shots Per Game (7.2), Defensive Rebounds Per Game (32.0), Rebound Margin (+17.0), Rebounds (1,790), and won-lost percentage (97.4). But perhaps the most consistent category the Lady Bears led the nation in, was field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to a .318 clip. That marked the third-straight year to lead the nation in that category while also ranking in the top five in eight of the last nine years.

THE BAYLOR LADY BEARS REGIME

2019 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2018-19 Lady Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame 82-81 April 7 in Tampa, Fla. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Lady Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox** each earning multiple all-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament championship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the *Associated Press* and the WBCA.

2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2011-12 Lady Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. **Brittney Griner** and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Lady Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE & 9+-YEAR DOMINANCE

- The Lady Bears have made 16 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 18 overall. Those appearances have resulted in two national championships (2005, 2012), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), nine Elite Eights and 14 Sweet Sixteens.
- The Lady Bears are 20-time Big 12 Champions – most in Big 12 history – capturing 10 consecutive regular season titles and 10 tournament titles.
- Baylor is 326-24 (.931) over the past eight seasons while posting a 156-7 (.957) mark in Big 12 play and a 24-1 (.958) in Big 12 Tournament play.
- 282 of Baylor's 326 wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 16 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points (most recently one, 82-81, vs. No. 3/3 Notre Dame, April 7, 2019).
- In Baylor's last 482 games, only five times (Texas, .516 and .515; Stanford, .509; West Virginia, .500; South Carolina, .528) has a team shot 50 percent or above.

BIG 12 DYNASTY

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 20 Big 12 Conference titles, 10 regular season and 10 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game nine seasons in a row and 13 times in program history.
- The Lady Bears have won eight of the last nine Big 12 Championship titles, besting No. 13/19 Iowa State, 67-49, in the 2019 final.

HEAD COACH KIM MULKEY • 20TH SEASON



Success = Kim Mulkey. No matter what she's attempted in basketball, whether it be on the court or along the sideline, Mulkey has found success. In 19 seasons as a head coach, she has attained 590 career victories and ranks No. 2 among the winningest active Division I head coaches in winning percentage (.855). She is No. 3 all-time by percentage between two mentors, second-ranked Leon Barmore (.869) and Pat Summitt (.841).

When the Women's Basketball Hall of Famer accepted the position as Baylor University's head women's basketball coach on April 4, 2000, few could have predicted the dramatic and prestigious transformation the program was about to undergo. Inheriting a program that was 7-20 in the year prior to her arrival and had registered 13 losing seasons in the 17 previous years, Mulkey has transformed the Lady Bears into a national power. The former Olympic Gold medalist has three times guided the Lady Bears basketball program to the pinnacle of women's basketball with 2005, 2012 and 2019 NCAA Championships. The Mulkey-led Lady Bears have made 18 NCAA Tournament appearances, 19 20-win seasons, 17 25-win efforts, 10 30-win campaigns and an NCAA record 40 victories and a perfect season in 2011-12. In addition, Mulkey has led the Lady Bears to four Final Four appearances (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019) and a record 20 Big 12 Conference titles.

The 2005 NCAA title was Baylor's first for a women's team sport, and just the second in school history overall. In winning the 2005 championship, Mulkey became the first person, man or woman, to win a basketball national championship as a student-athlete, assistant coach and head coach.

En route to the 2005 NCAA Championship, the Lady Bears won their first Big 12 Conference championship and followed with the conference tournament championship for the first of nine title sweeps. In 2019, Baylor won its unprecedented ninth consecutive regular season Big 12 championship beginning with the 2011 season and its 10th overall (2005). In addition, the Lady Bears have taken 10 Big 12 Tournament Championships, including eight of the last nine (2011-2016; 2018-19) along with 2005 and 2009.

To accompany 10 regular season conference titles, Baylor has run the table in conference play four times with 16-0 marks in 2012 and 2013 along with with 18-0 records in 2018 and 2019. The Big 12 has had six undefeated records in the history of the league in the regular season with Baylor taking four of the six (Oklahoma, 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska, 16-0 in 2010).

Under Mulkey's tutelage, Sophia Young became the program's first two-time Kodak All-American and also the school's first AP All-American, Brittney Griner garnered the program's first national Freshman of the Year honor (2010) and National Player of the Year kudos (2012 and 2013), and Sims followed in 2011. Griner also earned the program's first Honda Cup award. Griner and Sims were both winners of the prestigious Wade Trophy.

Baylor has had a total of 15 players drafted to the WNBA, all under the direction of Mulkey.

The 2004-05 season proved to be Mulkey's breakthrough year. The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Lady Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. Blackmon and Young were both named All-Americans with Young becoming Baylor's third WBCA All-American. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, Mulkey received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

Mulkey's ninth season (2008-09) along the sideline was highlighted by another trip to the NCAA's Sweet 16 and a Big 12 Conference Tournament title. The Lady Bears posted a 29-6 record, a final AP ranking of No. 5 and a 12-4 Big 12 record to finish in second place.

In 2009-10, the Lady Bears advanced through the NCAA Tournament to the Final Four in San Antonio before losing to the eventual NCAA Champion and undefeated Connecticut Huskies. The Lady Bears ended the season with a 27-10 record overall and were ranked No. 14 in AP and No. 4 in coaches poll final releases.

The 2011-12 Lady Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. Brittney Griner and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and Odyssey Sims were named consensus All-Americans, while Destiny Williams was a WBCA All-American honorable mention honoree.

The 2018-19 team placed Mulkey and Baylor in elite company as just the third program in NCAA history to win three NCAA Women's

Basketball National Championships. The 37-1 Lady Bears cruised through the season with its lone loss coming at No. 11/11 Stanford Dec. 15. From there, Baylor won its final 29 games to end the season on the nation's longest active winning streak, and the Lady Bears defeated Notre Dame in a thrilling 82-81 contest April 7 to join UConn (11) and Tennessee (8) as the only programs with three or more national crowns. Kalani Brown was a WBCA All-American and a second-team selection to the Associated Press and United States Basketball Writers' Association all-America teams while Lauren Cox was honorable mention, third team and third team all-America, respectively. Mulkey won three of the four major National Coach of the Year awards, taking home the AP, USBWA and WBCA honors while earning her seventh Big 12 Coach of the Year award.

Mulkey, a 2000 inductee into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, came to Baylor from Louisiana Tech where she spent 19 years as either a student-athlete or coach in the legendary Lady Techster program. During her tenure in Ruston, Mulkey was associated with 11 Final Four squads and three national championship teams. She has either played or coached in the national championship game on eight occasions.

As a player, Mulkey led the Lady Techsters to a 130-6 (.956) record, two national titles and four Final Fours from 1980-84. During that time, the 5-foot-4 playmaker, known for her spectacular passes and French braids, also led Louisiana Tech to its first two national championships (1981 and 1982) and was a part of the USA's Gold medal-winning team at both the 1984 Olympics and the 1983 Pan American Games.

Mulkey averaged 6.38 assists and 1.56 steals per game and currently ranks second on Tech's all-time list in assists and 12th in steals.

In addition, the summa cum laude scholar was a two-time Academic All-American as a business major. In recognition of her success in the classroom and on the basketball court, Mulkey was inducted into the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America Hall of Fame in June 2003.

Her athletic career began at an early age. Mulkey, a native of Hammond, La., played Dixie Youth baseball as a 12 year old as well as two years of Pony League baseball and made the all-star team two of the three years. At Hammond High School, she led the basketball team to four-straight state championships, posted a 136-5 record and finished her career with a then-national record 4,075 points. She earned all-district, all-state and All-America honors each of her four years at Hammond High. She also graduated as her class' valedictorian with a perfect 4.0 grade point average. Mulkey has a street named after her in her hometown of Tickfaw, La.

Mulkey is a member of the National High School Hall of Fame, the Louisiana High School Hall of Fame, Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame and Louisiana Tech Athletics Hall of Fame. In 1999, she was the lone female named among the Louisiana Sports Writers top 25 athletes of the 20th century and was listed by Sports Illustrated as one of the top 50 sports figures of Louisiana for the 20th century. In June of 2000, she was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame located in Knoxville, Tenn. Additionally, Mulkey was inducted into the Baylor Athletics Hall of Fame in 2007 and entered the Texas Sports Hall of Fame in 2010. Born May 17, 1962, in Santa Ana, Calif., Mulkey has two children, daughter Makenzie (27) and son Kramer (24).

Makenzie (Robertson) Fuller serves as associate director of basketball operations for the Lady Bears. She married former Baylor football and professional baseball player Clay Fuller in 2015. The couple had Mulkey's first grandchild, Kannon Reid Fuller, in 2018.

Kramer attended LSU, where he played for the highly touted Tiger baseball team. He was selected in the fourth round of the MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. In 2019, he played for the Cardinals' Double-A & Triple-A affiliates in Springfield, Mo. and Memphis, Tenn.

Mulkey's autobiography, "Won't Back Down" with Peter May, a retired Boston Globe senior sportswriter, appeared in bookstores Nov. 5, 2007, and the paperback edition became available Sept. 8, 2008.

- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in 118 of the last 125 games.
- Baylor is 228-1 all-time when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 37-0 when shooting 60 percent or higher.
- In 674 of 690 games under Mulkey, the Lady Bears have held their opponent at or below 50 percent field goal shooting with only eight of those efforts coming in the last 15 seasons.

- Baylor is 156-3 all-time vs. non-conference opponents at the Ferrell Center under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- In games away from Waco that include true-road contests, Big 12 tournament and NCAA Tournament contests, Baylor is 92-54 in the Kim Mulkey era against ranked opponents while collecting a 60-15 record vs. the Top 25 away from the Ferrell Center since the 2010-11 season.
- Baylor is 70-17 under Mulkey at the Ferrell Center when playing a Top 25 team, BU is 75-47 all-time vs. ranked opponents at home.
- Since the 2010-11 season, Baylor is 40-3 vs. Top 25 opponents at the Ferrell Center.
- Baylor is 306-172 (.639) vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season all-time and 268-55 (.829) in the Mulkey era.
- Baylor has been ranked in the Associated Press Top 25 for 310 straight weeks.
