TEAM NOTES

• Baylor's 53-point win broke the school record for the largest margin of victory in a Big 12 game. The previous high was a 50-point victory against Kansas on Jan. 28, 2006 (90-40).

- Baylor improved to 596-100 (.856) under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor has 20+ wins in all 20 seasons under Mulkey.
- Baylor improved to 33-8 all-time vs. Kansas [31-2 in Mulkey era]; Baylor now has 12-straight wins over the Jayhawks and 21 in the last 22.
- Baylor is now 162-7 (.959) vs. Big 12 opponents since the start of the 2010-11 season and 273-55 (.832) all-time under Mulkey.

• Baylor extended its Big 12 regular-season win streak to a Big 12 and school-record 50 games, and it also ranks as the 8th-best conference win streak in NCAA history.

- Baylor now has 52-straight wins at the Ferrell Center, which is tied for the 14th-longest home win streak in NCAA history.
- Baylor has 31 double-digit runs this season after posting two against Kansas.
- Baylor held Kansas to seven points in the first quarter, its 24th time holding an opponent to single-digit scoring in a quarter this season.
- Baylor's .737 shooting effort (14-19) in the third quarter was the 10th-best field goal percentage in a quarter vs. a Big 12 opponent.
- Baylor's 32 points in the third quarter matched a season high against a Big 12 opponent (32 against West Virginia on Jan. 18).
- Baylor improved to 232-1 all-time under Mulkey when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor (55.6 percent on 40-72 shooting).
- Baylor held an opponent under 30 percent shooting for the 13th time this season tonight (26.9 percent on 14-52 shooting for KU).

- Juicy Landrum (160 career three pointers) moved past Kristy Wallace for fifth all-time on BU's career three-point field goals made with two on three attempts.
- Queen Egbo (10 points, 11 rebounds) posted her 7th double-double of the season and 10th in her career.
- Egbo (11 rebounds) surpassed 300 career rebounds with her third against the Jayhawks; it was her 12th career game with double-digit boards.
- Egbo (10 points) scored in double figures for the 16th time this season and 24th time in her career.
- Te'a Cooper (15 points) scored in double figures for the 19th time this season and 51st time in her career.
- Erin DeGrate (4 rebounds) surpassed 400 career rebounds with her second against the Jayhawks.
- NaLyssa Smith (23 points, 10 rebounds) posted her eighth double-double of the season and 11th of her career.
- Smith (23 points) scored in double figures for the 15th time this season and 33rd time in her career.
- Smith (10 rebounds) posted double-digit boards for the eighth time this season and 12th time in her career.
- Lauren Cox posted a season-high seven assists with zero turnovers, whil DiDi Richards matched the team lead with seven.
- **Cox** led Baylor with three assists and three blocked shots
- Jordyn Oliver matched a season-high with nine points.
- Moon Ursin (11 points) scored in double figures for the fourth time this season and 11th time in her career.
