TEAM NOTES

- Baylor improved to 599-100 (.857) under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor has 20+ wins in all 20 seasons under Mulkey.
- Baylor improved to 44-11 all-time vs. Oklahoma State [38-6 in Mulkey era]; Baylor now has eigh-straight wins over the Cowgirls and have taken 23 of the last 24.
- Baylor is now 165-7 (.959) vs. Big 12 opponents since the start of the 2010-11 season and 277-55 (.834) all-time under Mulkey.
- Baylor extended its Big 12 regular-season win streak to a Big 12 and school-record 53 games, and it also ranks as the 7th-best conference win streak in NCAA history.
- Baylor extended its conference road-win streak in the regular season to 42 games, which is the third-longest such streak in NCAA history.
- Baylor went on a 12-0 run in the second quarter, the team's 33rd double-digit run of the season.
- Baylor held Oklahoma State to nine points in each of the first through third quarters, the 28th, 29th & 30th times this season that the Lady Bears defense has held an opponent to single digits in a quarter.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Juicy Landrum finished with 12 points, the 49th time in her career and 13th time this season to score in double figures.
- Te'a Cooper finished with 15 points, the 52nd time in her career and 20th time this season to reach double figures in scoring.
- Cooper's 12th point was the 1,000th of her career.
- Cooper had a career-high 8 rebounds.
- Cooper and DiDi Richards tied for the team lead with four steals apiece.
- Richards and Landrum tied for the team lead with five assists apiece.
- NaLyssa Smith finished with 11 rebounds; her 10th time to grab double-digit boards this season, 14th time in her career.
- Queen Egbo finished with 10 points, her 26th time to reach double figures in her career and 18th time this season.
