- The Bears remain at home as part of an eight-game homestand as they welcome Arkansas-Pine Bluff for a midweek contest on Tuesday, Feb. 18 at 6:30 p.m. CT.
- The Bears are coming off a 2-1 opening weekend series with Nebraska. The Bears bounced back after an opening day loss to the Huskers, 19-9 to take game two 7-2 in walk-off fashion and game three, 7-2 on Sunday.
- FR CF Jared McKenzie was outstanding in the season-opening weekend, leading the team with a .571 average with a team-high eight hits, including two doubles and three RBIs. He reached base in 9-of-17 plate appearances.
- Baylor has finished its home schedule with a .500 record or better (24-6 in 2019) in all 20 seasons at Baylor Ballpark (since 1999) and is 458-205 all-time at the park after starting off the 2020 season 2-1 at home.
- The Bears return all members of its pitching staff from 2019 with the exception of All-American closer Kyle
 Hill. That includes Friday and Saturday starters Jimmy Winston and Paul Dickens. The Bears also add six talented
 newcomers to the pitching staff (five freshmen, one junior college transfer), highlighted by RHP Will Rigney, drafted
 in the 38th round by the San Francisco Giants in 2019 and LHP Evan Godwin.
- Baylor has won 30 or more (34) games in a season for the fourth-straight year (35 in 2019), giving the program back-to-back-to-back-back 30-win seasons for the first time since 2009-12.

TEAM QUICK NOTES

HOW THE BEARS STACKED UP IN THE BIG 12

• The Bears rank second in the Big 12 in team batting average (.318) after weekend one. Individually, true freshman Jared McKenzie ranks third with an average of .571, is tied for first with eight hits and is sixth with an on-base percentage of .6000. Nick Loftin is tied for third with seven RBIs over the first weekend, fourth with 13 total bases and fifth with a slugging percentage of .867.

IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

• The Bears rank 16th nationally with two triples so far on the year. The Bears also rank 19th with 3 sacrifice flies year. The Bears have turned five double plays so far on the year, good for 11th-best nationally and an average of 1.67 double plays turned per game ranks 10th.

INDIVIDUALS IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

• Individually, freshman phenom Jared McKenzie ranks 10th nationally with eight hits. Nick Loftin freshman Tre Richardson both rank eighth nationally with one triple apiece on the year, good for 15th nationally with 0.33 triples wer game. Loftin ranks 18th with 2.33 RBIs per game and 22nd with seven total RBIs. Loftin also ranks 30th with 13.0 total bases on the year.

GETTING THE BALL

• True freshman Hambleton Oliver will get the nod for his first collegiate start vs. UAPB. He made his collegiate debut in the season opener on Feb. 14, tossing 1.0 inning of work (7th inning), allowing two earned runs on three hits with one strikeout. Out of Corpus Christi, Texas, Oliver was a four-year letterwinner at Calallen HS and was named district 29-5A MVP and two time South Texas Pitcher of the Year, also was a three-time district champion. He was named an Elite All-State RHP and held a .9 ERA with 104 strikeouts in 84 innings of work his senior year (2019).

BULLPEN SUCCESS

• Baylor's bullpen boasted a 3.04 ERA through 266.2 innings pitched, striking out 268 to just 124 walks. The bullpen was 19-7 on the year and tallied seven saves. The Bears return 232.1 innings of work from 2019 in 2020, losing just three arms in Kyle Hill (29.1 IP), Ryan Segner (2.2 IP) and William Gilbert (2.1 IP).

WELCOMING THE GOLDEN LIONS

• The Golden Lions visit Baylor Ballpark for the third time in program history under head coach Steve Rodriguez. In the previous two matchups, the Bears outscored UAPB 31-7. In 2017, the Bears won 17-3 on Feb. 28 and then followed that up with a 14-4 victory on April 18, 2018. The Golden Lions come to Waco with a record of 1-3. They defeated Prairie View A&M 7-6 in New Orleans on Feb. 15, but fell to Grambling State 10-0 in the season opener, Alabama State 6-5 on Saturday and Alcorn State 13-7 on Sunday.

ALL-BIG 12 HONOREES RETURNING

• The Bears return eight of 12 All-Big 12 selections from a year ago, led by first team selections Nick Loftin and Andy Thomas. Other honorees include Jimmy Winston, Paul Dickens, Ryan Leckich, Daniel Caruso, Luke Boyd and Chase Wehsener.

RETURNING ARMS

• The Bears return 439.1 innings of work of their 480 innings from a year ago, with the biggest loss being All-American closer Kyle Hill who threw 29.1 innings, had 7 saves and a 6-0 record. The Bears return four of their five guys with the most appearances in 2019, led by Ryan Leckich with 29, Daniel Caruso with 25, Luke Boyd with 24 and Jimmy Winston with 19. The Bears also return 51 of 54 starts from a year ago, just losing Cody Bradford's three starts. Finally, the Bears return 83 percent of their wins on the mound from a year ago (29-of-35).

STRONG DEFENSE

 The Bears finished the 28th-best fielding percentage in the country (.978). Redshirt freshman first baseman Chase Wehsener did not make an error in 404 chances on the year.

STRONG OFFENSE

• The Bears return 153 of 348 RBI from 2019 and just 172 of 385 runs scored from 2019. Big shoes to fill on the offense as the Bears lose four of their six top hitters from a year ago. The Bears were 24-6 overall when scoring first in 2019. They tallied double-digit hits 30 times in the season and outhit their opponents in 31 of 35 victories.

QUICKEST TO 25 WINS

 The Bears tallied 25 wins through 35 games in 2012, the quickest Baylor has reached the 25-win mark since 2012, when the Bears won 25 of their first 32 games.

RUNS WITH TWO OUTS

• Six of the Bears' seven runs on Sunday in the rubber match came with two outs. Overall on the weekend, just 8 of the Bears' 24 runs came with two outs.

WALK-OFF WINS

•The Bears were 5-0 in walk-off wins last year and 4-1 in extra inning contests. Bissonette delivered the walk-off single in the bottom of the 12th inning to defeat Oklahoma, 3-2. Wendzel had the walk-off hit in the bottom of the ninth in game one of the series vs. West Virginia, while Davion Downey delivered the walk-off single in the bottom

of the ninth against Texas in game one of the series. The other two walk-off victories have come off the bat of Ryan Bertelsman, as he hit a walk-off three-run homer in the 11th inning of game one of the double header vs. Holy Cross on Feb. 16 and then he came through with an RBI single in the bottom of the 11th vs. Texas Southern on Wednesday, March 27.

DIGGIN' LONG BALL

- Baylor has hit 195 home runs in 221 games under Rodriguez. BU hit 57 home runs in 2019, its most in a season under Rodriguez. The Bears are coming off back-to-back seasons with at least 50 home runs (51 in 2017, 54 in 2018, 57 in 2019) for the first time since 2008 (52), 2009 (73) and 2010 (57) and first time in the BBCOR era.
- The Bears connected on three home runs over opening weekend. Redshirt sophomore Chase Whesener hit his first collegiate homer in the season opener on Friday and then Nick Loftin and Andy Thomas went back-to-back in the third inning on Saturday.

LITTLE LEAGUE TO D1

• Senior Mack Mueller played in the 2009 and 2010 Little League World Series as a member of Team Europe from Ramstein Air Base in Germany where his father, Mark, was stationed.

KEEPING IT IN THE FAMILY

• Redshirt junior Daniel Caruso is not the first in his family to be coached by Rodriguez. His older brother, Brandon, played baseball at Pepperdine from 2014-17, where he was coached by Rodriguez for two seasons (2014, 2015) before Coach Rodriguez took the Baylor job.

PICKED TO FINISH SIXTH IN THE BIG 12

The Bears were picked to finish sixth in the Big 12 in 2020 in vote of the conference's coaches. The Bears sit behind Texas Tech who was picked to win the conference, Oklahoma State, TCU, Oklahoma and Texas. The Bears earned 35 points, just 3 behind Texas in fourth place and a comfortable nine points ahead of seventh place selection West Virginia.

DRAFT SUCCESS

• In the 2019 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, the Bears had their first two first rounders in one season as catcher Shea Langeliers went 9th overall to the Atlanta Braves while Davis Wendzel went 41st overall to the Texas Rangers. Overall, the Bears had six selections in the 2019 draft, the most since the 2012 draft. Cody Bradford went in the sixth round to the Texas Rangers, Kyle Hill went in the 10th round to the Seattle Mariners, Josh Bissonette in the 31st round to the Pittsburgh Pirates and Luke Boyd in the 38th round to the Los Angeles Angels. Overall, the Bears have 143 draft picks in program history and head coach Steve Rodriguez has seen 54 of his student-athletes drafted. The six selections are the second-most in one year for head coach Steve Rodriguez.

POSITION REVIEWS

- The Bears return four position starters from 2019.
- Catcher: The Bears lose first round draft pick Shea Langeliers, but it is time for senior catcher Andy Thomas to shine at the position he entered the program at. One of the best receivers, his leadership skills also help him handle the staff. He is backed up by redshirt sophomore Kyle Harper and true freshmen Nicolas Balsano and Cade Currington.
- First Base: Chase Wehsener excelled for the Bears last year as he worked his way into an everyday role at first base. He earned 2019 Big 12 All-Freshman Team honors (unanimous selection) and was an honorable mention selection for All-Big 12. True freshman Kyle Nevin could back up Wehsener at first, while Andy Thomas could also play the position when getting a rest from behind the plate.
- Second Base: The Bears have a big hole to fill here after losing four-year starter Josh Bissonette to graduation. Sophomore Ricky Martinez is an option here or at the hot corner. Freshman Tre Richardson, who graduated early from high school in Dec. 2019 to join the Bears may jump right into a starting role. Junior college transfer Esteban Cardoza-Oqueno is also an option.
- Shortstop: The Big 12's Preseason Player of the Year, Nick Loftin, occupies this spot as he looks to solidify his stock as a first round draft pick in 2020. Ricky Martinez will back him up.
- Third Base: There are a couple options for the Bears at the hot corner. Those options include Martinez, Richardson, Cardoza-Oquendo and true freshman Kyle Nevin.
- Outfield: True freshman Jared McKenzie is pegged to be the opening day center fielder as a true freshman.
 Options at the corner spots include everyday right fielder from 2018 and 2019 Davion Downey and in left Mack Mueller, Hunter Seay and Kyle Harper will vie for time.
- **Designated Hitter:** Those left out of the outfield are all options to take over the DH role, including Seay and Mueller. Ryan Bertelsman is also an option for the Bears.
