TEAM NOTES

- Baylor improved to 604-100 (.858) under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor moved to 43-58 all-time vs. Texas [34-4 in the Mulkey era], and has 8-straight wins over the Longhorns.
- Baylor is now 170-7 (.960) vs. Big 12 opponents since the start of the 2010-11 season and 282-55 (.837) all-time under Mulkey.
- Baylor extended its Big 12 regular-season win streak to a Big 12 and school-record 58 games, and it also ranks as the 6th-best conference win streak in NCAA history (excludes postseason).
- Baylor has the nation's longest active home win streak with its 56th at the Ferrell Center; the streak is also the 11th-best home-win streak in NCAA history.
- Baylor never trailed in the contest, leading for 38:52 over the Longhorns.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Te'a Cooper (20 points) scored in double figures for the 24th time this season and 56th time in her career.
- Cooper has scored 20+ points in 12 career games.
- Lauren Cox (17 points, 12 rebounds) posted her second-straight double-double, eighth of the season and 36th of her career.
- Cox (17 points) scored in double figures for the 17th time this season and 85th time in her career.
- Cox (12 rebounds) posted double-digit boards for the ninth time this season and 39th time in her career.
- NaLyssa Smith (13 points, 10 rebounds) posted her 11th double-double of the season and 14th of her career.
- Smith (13 points) surpassed 700 career points.
- Smith (13 points) scored in double figures for the 22nd time this season and 39th time in her career.
- Smith (10 rebounds) posted double-digit boards for the 12th time this season and 16th time in her career.
- DiDi Richards (8 assists) has posted 18 assists in the last two Big 12 games.
