### **STORY LINES**

- The Bears return home to Baylor Ballpark to start a five-game homestand, beginning with a midweek tilt vs. Dallas Baptist on Wednesday, March 11 at 6:30 p.m. CT.
- The Bears have won six of their last eight games, including taking the weekend series at Cal Poly. The Bears enter the week having won the last two games.
- Baylor has finished its home schedule with a .500 record or better in all 20 seasons at Baylor Ballpark (since 1999) and is 459-206 all-time at the park after starting off the 2020 season 5-5 at home.
- The Bears are 37-13 all-time in midweek contests under fifth-year head coach Steve Rodriguez and 2-1 so far in 2020.
- The Bears are 217-321-1 all-time against opponents ranked in Baseball America's weekly rankings and 83-126-1 in nonconference games and 185-270-1 in regular season contests. The Bears are 2-0 this year vs. opponents ranked in Baseball America's top 25, with wins over No. 14 LSU and No. 9 Arkansas.
- FR OF Jared McKenzie has had a hit in 13-of-15 games on the year and has had multi-hit performances in nine of those 15 games. He twice has a season-high four hits, including this past Saturday at Cal Poly. His 26 total hits on the year rank 12th-most in the nation and the highest hit total of any freshman in the country. Likewise, his batting average of .400 is the highest of any freshman in the Big 12 and ranks tied for third. Over the weekend he collected 8 hits in the series win at Cal Poly, with three multi-hit outings.

### **TEAM QUICK NOTES**

### LAST WEEK

• The Bears batted .285 last week as they went 2-2, including a series win at Cal Poly, 2-1. Davion Downey led the way, batting. 471 on the weekend with 8 hits, 2 doubles, 1 HR (the only BU home run on the weekend in game two's 8-6 victory) and 2 RBI. Chase Wehsener also broke out of his slump, batting .412 on the week, with 7 hits, 3 ddoubles and 1 walk. His 3 hits in game three tied his career high and his 2 doubles were a season best. Friday night starter Paul Dickens was outstanding in the no-decision, throwing 7.0 scoreless, scattering 4 hits with 1 walk and a season-best 9 Ks. In the rubber match on Sunday, starter Hayden Kettler tossed 6.1 innings of scoreless baseball, facing just three over the minimum through the first 6.0 innings. He also struck out a season-high seven batters as the Bears went on to win, 6-4 to take the series.

### **HOW THE BEARS STACK UP IN THE BIG 12**

• The Bears rank fourth in the Big 12 in team batting average (.279). Individually, true freshman Jared McKenzie is tied for third in the Big 12 with a batting average of .400 (highest of any freshman in the conference) and he ranks tied for third with 26 total hits. Nick Loftin and Kyle Nevin rank tied for fourth with 2 triples on the year. Nick Loftin's slugging percentage of .585 ranks tied for ninth. Luke Boyd's six saves lead the Big 12 and he ranks first in the conference in appearances (7) along with Logan Freeman.

### IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

• The Bears have turned 14 total double plays on the year, good for 20th most nationally and their 0.93 double plays per game ranks 23rd best. The Bears have 2.0 shutouts on the year, good for 31st in the country.

### INDIVIDUALS IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

• Jared McKenzie ranks 12th nationally with 26 total hits on the year, the highest total of any freshman in the country. He also ranks 21st nationally with an average of 1.73 hits per game. Luke Boyd is tied for the national lead with 6.0 saves on the year and his nine appearances on the year rank 19th most nationally. Logan Freeman also ranks 17th with nine appearances on the year. Hayden Kettler ranks 22nd nationally with 3 wins on the year.

### FRESHMEN PHENOMS ON THE MOUND

• Three true freshmen Bears have made six starts on the season, with RHP Hambleton Oliver starting and earning the win vs. UAPB on Feb. 18 and following that up with a start on March 3 vs. Texas State. LHP Evan Godwin earned the start vs. Oral Roberts on Feb. 22, earned the win and in his second start of the year vs. LSU, Godwin tossed 5.2 innings, striking out a career-high eight batters while walking two and allowing three runs on five hits. Finally, RHP Will Rigney made his Baylor and collegiate debut on Wednesday vs. UTRGV and earned the win in 3.0 innings of work. So far on the year, freshmen pitching starters are 3-0 and have tossed 22.2 innings, allowing 13 runs on 20 hits with 6 walks and 21 Ks.

### **BULLPEN SUCCESS**

• The Bears return 232.1 innings of work from 2019 in 2020, losing just three arms in Kyle Hill (29.1 IP), Ryan Segner (2.2 IP) and William Gilbert (2.1 IP).

### CLOSING TIME

• Since the arrival of head coach Steve Rodriguez and pitching coach Jon Strauss in 2016, the Bears have had elite arms at the back of the bullpen. First it was Troy Montemayor, who is tied for the program record with 37 career saves and earned All-America honors in 2018 and then in 2019, Kyle Hill took over the role, earning first team All-America honors, not giving up a run in 29.1 innings, earning seven saves and a 6-0 record. So far in 2020 it is senior righty Luke Boyd taking over the role, converting all six of seven save attempts in 2020. Under the direction of Strauss in four plus seasons, the Bears have converted 53-of-56 save opportunities.

### **BACKSTOP SUCCESS**

• Senior catcher Andy Thomas was named to the official watch list for the 2020 Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award, presented by the Kamerion Wimbley Foundation and given by the Greater Witchita Sports Association. Thomas is one of 60 catchers named to the watch list and one of three from the Big 12 Conference. It is the first time in his career he has been named to the watch list. Thomas has thrown out 6-of-8 (75 percent) would be base stealers on the year and has not been charged with a passed ball so far on the year. He also has not committed an error. For the third-straight season the Bears have had a watch lister for the Buster Posey Award. Prior to Thomas, Langeliers was named to the list in 2018 and 2019 and was a semifinalist in 2019.

### **ALL-BIG 12 HONOREES RETURNING**

• The Bears return eight of 12 All-Big 12 selections from a year ago, led by first team selections Nick Loftin and Andy Thomas. Other honorees include Jimmy Winston, Paul Dickens, Ryan Leckich, Daniel Caruso, Luke Boyd and Chase Wehsener.

### RETURNING ARMS

• The Bears return 439.1 innings of work of their 480 innings from a year ago, with the biggest loss being All-American closer Kyle Hill who threw 29.1 innings, had 7 saves and a 6-0 record. The Bears return four of their five guys with the most appearances in 2019, led by Ryan Leckich with 29, Daniel Caruso with 25, Luke Boyd with 24 and Jimmy Winston with 19. The Bears also return 51 of 54 starts from a year ago, just losing Cody Bradford's three starts. Finally, the Bears return 83 percent of their wins on the mound from a year ago (29-of-35).

### STRONG OFFENSE

• The Bears return 153 of 348 RBI from 2019 and just 172 of 385 runs scored from 2019. Big shoes to fill on the offense as the Bears lose four of their six top hitters from a year ago. The Bears were 24-6 overall when scoring first

in 2019. They tallied double-digit hits 30 times in the season and outhit their opponents in 31 of 35 victories.

### DIGGIN' LONG BALL

- Baylor has hit 206 home runs in 237 games under Rodriguez. BU hit 57 home runs in 2019, its most in a season under Rodriguez. The Bears are coming off back-to-back-back seasons with at least 50 home runs (51 in 2017, 54 in 2018, 57 in 2019) for the first time since 2008 (52), 2009 (73) and 2010 (57) and first time in the BBCOR era.
- . Senior outfielder Mack Mueller and redshirt sophomore Chase Wehsener lead the team with three home runs
- The Bears smashed six home runs over three games at the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic.

### **BIG LEAGUE TIES**

• Freshman infielder/outfielder Kyle Nevin is the son of Phil Nevin, a 12-year MLB veteran who played for the Astros, Tigers, Angels, Padres, Rangers, Cubs and Twins during his career. He is currently the third base coach for the Yankees. Kyle's older brother Tyler was drafted by the Colorado Rockies as the 38th overall pick on the 2015 MLB Draft.

### **LITTLE LEAGUE TO D1**

 Senior Mack Mueller played in the 2009 and 2010 Little League World Series as a member of Team Europe from Ramstein Air Base in Germany where his father, Mark, was stationed.

### **KEEPING IT IN THE FAMILY**

 Redshirt junior Daniel Caruso is not the first in his family to be coached by Rodriguez. His older brother, Brandon, played baseball at Pepperdine from 2014-17, where he was coached by Rodriguez for two seasons (2014, 2015) before Coach Rodriguez took the Baylor job.

### PICKED TO FINISH SIXTH IN THE BIG 12

The Bears were picked to finish sixth in the Big 12 in 2020 in vote of the conference's coaches. The Bears sit behind Texas Tech who was picked to win the conference, Oklahoma State, TCU, Oklahoma and Texas. The Bears earned 35 points, just 3 behind Texas in fourth place and a comfortable nine points ahead of seventh place selection West Virginia.

### 30+ WIN SEASONS

 Baylor has won 30 or more (34) games in a season for the fourth-straight year (35 in 2019), giving the program back-to-back-to-back-back 30-win seasons for the first time since 2009-12.

### **DRAFT SUCCESS**

• In the 2019 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, the Bears had their first two first rounders in one season as catcher Shea Langeliers went 9th overall to the Atlanta Braves while Davis Wendzel went 41st overall to the Texas Rangers. Overall, the Bears had six selections in the 2019 draft, the most since the 2012 draft. Cody Bradford went in the sixth round to the Texas Rangers, Kyle Hill went in the 10th round to the Seattle Mariners, Josh Bissonette in the 31st round to the Pittsburgh Pirates and Luke Boyd in the 38th round to the Los Angeles Angels. Overall, the Bears have 143 draft picks in program history and head coach Steve Rodriguez has seen 54 of his student-athletes drafted. The six selections are the second-most in one year for head coach Steve Rodriguez.

### **POSITION REVIEWS**

- The Bears return four position starters from 2019.
- Catcher: The Bears lose first round draft pick Shea Langeliers, but it is time for senior catcher Andy Thomas to shine at the position he entered the program at. One of the best receivers, his leadership skills also help him handle the staff. He is backed up by redshirt sophomore Kyle Harper and true freshmen Nicolas Balsano and Cade Currington.
- First Base: Chase Wehsener excelled for the Bears last year as he worked his way into an everyday role at first base. He earned 2019 Big 12 All-Freshman Team honors (unanimous selection) and was an honorable mention selection for All-Big 12. True freshman Kyle Nevin could back up Wehsener at first, while Andy Thomas could also play the position when getting a rest from behind the plate.
- Second Base: The Bears have a big hole to fill here after losing four-year starter Josh Bissonette to graduation. Sophomore Ricky Martinez is an option here or at the hot corner. Freshman Tre Richardson, who graduated early from high school in Dec. 2019 to join the Bears may jump right into a starting role. Junior college transfer Esteban Cardoza-Oqueno is also an option.
- Shortstop: The Big 12's Preseason Player of the Year, Nick Loftin, occupies this spot as he looks to solidify his stock as a first round draft pick in 2020. Ricky Martinez will back him up.
- Third Base: There are a couple options for the Bears at the hot corner. Those options include Martinez, Richardson, Cardoza-Oquendo and true freshman Kyle Nevin.
- Outfield: True freshman Jared McKenzie is pegged to be the opening day center fielder as a true freshman. Options at the corner spots include everyday right fielder from 2018 and 2019 Davion Downey and in left Mack Mueller, Hunter Seay and Kyle Harper will vie for time.
- Designated Hitter: Those left out of the outfield are all options to take over the DH role, including Seay and Mueller. Ryan Bertelsman is also an option for the Bears.
