#### STORY LINES

- After two weeks off, Baylor travels south on I-35 to Austin to face Texas in the 110th all-time meeting between the two programs. The series is Baylor's second most played behind only TCU (115).
- The meeting is the first between former college roommates and now head coaches Dave Aranda and Tom Herman, both alumni of Division III California Lutheran University in Thousand Oaks, Calif.
- The Bears' 77 victories since 2011 are second most among all Power 5 programs in the State of Texas trailing only Texas A&M (78).
- With a strong season, senior QB Charlie Brewer can become only the second player in Baylor history to lead the team in passing yards four straight years joining JJ Joe (1990-93).
- Trestan Ebner, voted Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week for his effort, is the first player in Big 12 history to score three different types of TDs in a game and only the sixth Power 5 player to accomplish the feat since 1996.
- In 2019, BU became the first Power 5 program to win 11 games within two seasons of losing 11 games.
- Charlie Brewer has completed greater than 60% of his passes in 23 of 32 starts, including 14 of the last 18.
- Preseason All-American linebacker Terrel Bernard leads the Big 12 in tackles per game (10.5) and sacks per game (1.25). Jalen Pitre leads the league in tackles for loss per game (2.0), while Bernard is second (1.75).
- Senior running back John Lovett could become the third player to lead Baylor in rushing for three straight seasons joining Darrell Bush (1997-00) and Walter Abercrombie (1978-81).
- · Charlie Brewer is one of two returning FBS guarterbacks (Justin Fields, Ohio St.) to pass for 20+ TD and rush for 10+ TD in 2019.
- BU is playing its 119th season of football. BU holds a 608-578-44 (.513) record all-time. Baylor has scored in a school-record 166 straight games — the previous record was 89 games from Dec. 31, 1979 - Oct. 23, 1987.
- Baylor has 13 graduates on its 2020 roster, including 10 student-athletes enrolled in graduate school.
- BU guarterback Charlie Brewer leads the team with 32 starts, including 20 straight. Corner Raleigh **Texada** leads the defense with 22 career games starts (16 straight).
- The Bears led the Big 12 with four seniors (William Bradley-King, Charlie Brewer, Trestan Ebner and John Lovett) named to the Senior Bowl Top 250 list.

#### **TEXAS SERIES HISTORY**

- The Bears head south to Austin and DKR to face the Texas Longhorns on October 24. BU trails the all-time series with Texas 28-77-4.
- With 109 all-time meetings, Texas is Baylor's second most-played opponent trailing only TCU (115 games).
- Over the last 10 seasons, the series is an even 5-5. The Bears are 10-47-2 in Austin with the most recent victory a 28-7 win in 2014.
- · Last season, Baylor recorded five sacks along with one interception and the Longhorns took a timeout with five seconds remaining in the fourth quarter to setup its only touchdown of the game as BU rolled 24-10.

#### UP NEXT

- Back at home for Halloween, the Bears host TCU at McLane Stadium on October 31. It will be the Bears' first game at home on the Brazos since 47-14 victory over Kansas on Sept. 26.
- The game will be the 116th all-time meeting for Baylor and TCU, the most played for both schools.
- TCU leads the all-time series 55-53-7, and had won four straight before Baylor's thrilling 29-23 3OT win in 2019.
- The Bears have not defeated TCU in Waco since 2014's historic 61-58 comeback that ultimately forced a tie in the final league standings between the Horned Frogs and BU.
- · Last season, Baylor's John Mayers nailed a career-long 51 yard field goal with 36 seconds remaining to force overtime. Current New York Jet Denzel Mims caught a pair of extra-time scores and Grayland Arnold iced the win with an interception in the third overtime for the 29-23 win.

#### TRESTAN EBNER'S BIG NIGHT

- Senior running back Trestan Ebner had the best game of his career in the 2020 opening win over Kansas. The Henderson, Texas native totaled 272 all-purpose yards and four touchdowns (two kickoff returns, one receiving, one rushing). For his effort, he earned his first career Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week honor.
- His 272 all-purpose yards are the third most in BU program history (Terrance Williams, 314 vs. WVU/2012; & Johnny Jefferson, 299 vs. UNC/2015).
- · Ebner is the first player in the 25 year history of the Big 12 Conference to score three different types of touchdowns in a game. He is the lone FBS player over the last 25 seasons with 1 rush TD, 1 rec TD and 2 KR TD in a game.
- · He scored four touchdowns against KU after totaling only five in all of 2019. He has scored 17 touchdowns in his BU career.

#### **TERREL BERNARD ANCHORS DEFENSE IN 2020**

- Preseason All-American Terrel Bernard is back as the anchor of Baylor's defense following a breakout season in 2019. Bernard was a All-Big 12 pick in 2019 despite only starting 11 of 14 games.
- The junior linebacker opened his 2020 account with eight tackles, career-bests of 3.5 TFL and 2.5 sacks along with Baylor's first safety since 2017 in the win over KU. He has 21 tackles, 3.5 TFL, 2.5 sacks, 1 INT in two games.
- Bernard took the reins at middle linebacker midway through the 2019 season and finished with a team-best 112 tackles to go along with 9.5 TFL and 4.5 sacks. He added one interception and three PBU.
- The LaPorte, Texas native has 180 stops in his career. Bernard has totaled 16.0 TFL and 8.0 sacks in 29 career games (15 starts). Bernard ranks among 2020 Big 12 leaders in tackles, TFL and sacks.

#### SENIORS KEY IN THE RUN GAME

- BU's running game in 2020 will be led by a pair of senior single-digits in Trestan Ebner and John Lovett.
- · Lovett is the only four-year single-digit honoree in program history. He has led the Bears in rushing each of the last three seasons and has recorded 1,774 career rushing yards (16th, BU history).
- The New Jersey native has 17 career rushing touchdowns and six career 100-yard games.
- The versatile Ebner has high-level skills as a runner, receiver and returner. He has tallied 2,112 all-purpose yards in his career along with 17 total touchdowns.
- · Ebner's 1,002 career receiving yards are the most by a primary running back in school history. His seven receiving touchdowns trail only Ronnie Bull (8, 1959-61). He is one of 38 men in program history to reach 1k receiving yards.

#### TOUGHNESS REWARDED

Baylor began a new tradition in 2017 of rewarding the toughest players on the BU roster with single-digit jerseys. The jersey numbers are awarded to the student-athletes deemed by their teammates to be the toughest members of the team. First-year Baylor head coach Dave Aranda has continued this tradition for 2020.

#### CHARLIE BREWER AMONG BAYLOR'S BEST

- Senior guarterback Charlie Brewer has played in 37 games in his career with 32 starts. The Austin native has passed for 8.113 yards in his career which ranks third in Baylor history (Griffin 10.366; Petty 8.195).
- Brewer has passed for 219.3 yards per game in his career with 55 touchdowns and 22 interceptions. He has completed 64.0 percent of his passes (668-of-1044). He also has 18 rushing touchdowns.
- · Brewer has completed 63.9 percent of his passes (525-of-821) in 27 career games against Big 12 opponents.
- The Austin native has eclipsed 300 yards passing in 11 games, third-most in program history. He trails only Bryce Petty (16) and Robert Griffin III (13).
- Brewer earned a single digit for the first time in his Baylor career entering his senior season. He has completed greater than 60% of his passes in 23 of 32 career starts, including 15 of last 18.

#### **BREWER THE CARDIAC KID**

• In his time as Baylor's starting quarterback, Charlie Brewer has led the Bears on five game-winning drives in the fourth quarter, including 2019 victories over lowa State and OSU. In 2019, he also led drives to tie the game before ultimately winning in overtime vs. Texas Tech and TCU. At WVU in 2020, he led a game-tying drive but the Bears fell in OT. Below is a breakdown of those wins.

#### MORE BREWER NOTABLES

- · Charlie Brewer is only the third quarterback in BU history to throw for 8,000+ yards in his career. He owns the Baylor single-game marks for completions (43) and attempts (63).
- He is the only returning FBS QB to pass for 20+ touchdowns and rushing for 11+ touchdowns in
- Only four returning FBS QBs rushed for 11+ TD in 2019 (Hammond, AFA; Plumlee, UM; Thompson, KSU).
- · Eleven times in his career Brewer has thrown for a touchdown and rushed for a touchdown in the same game. Baylor is 8-3 in those games.
- Brewer is third in Baylor history with 20 career 200-yard passing games. He trails only Robert Griffin III (29) and Bryce Petty (21).
- Brewer ranks 2nd among BU passers since 2000 with a completion percentage greater than 60 in 25
- · With three rushing touchdowns against Texas Tech in 2019, the Austin native tied a Baylor QB record set by Bryce Petty in 2014. Brewer has 18 rushing touchdowns in his career, fourth most in BU history.

#### TONS OF EXPERIENCE AT WIDE OUT

- · Baylor's passing game will be led in 2020 by a trio of veteran receivers in juniors RJ Sneed and Tyquan Thornton and Josh Fleeks. Additionally, senior Jared Atkinson and fourth-year sophomore Gavin Holmes are going to be counted on as playmakers.
- · Sneed, Thornton and Fleeks have combined for 17 touchdowns over their careers and will fill the void left by the departed Denzel Mims and Chris Platt. Atkinson has 17 receptions since 2016.
- · Holmes, a fall camp standout, is one of the more intriguing options after missing most of the last two seasons after playing in only nine games as a freshman in 2017. Prior to his freshman year injury, he had 13 receptions for 166 vards and three total touchdowns.
- Baylor wide receivers have posted nine 1.000-yard seasons since 2011 including Denzel Mims in 2019.

#### 2020 BAYLOR FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

### ARANDA IS ONE OF TOP DEFENSIVE MINDS IN COUNTRY • First-year head coach Daye Aranda has earned a national reputation as one of the top defensive

- First-year head coach Dave Aranda has earned a national reputation as one of the top defensive minds in the country over his 20-plus year career that included stops as defensive coordinator at LSU, Wisconsin, Utah State and Hawaii.
- Aranda led the LSU defense in 2019 as the Tigers posted a perfect 15-0 record and won the National Title with a 42-25 victory over Clemson in CFP National Championship Game.
- Since taking over as the defensive coordinator at Utah State, Aranda's defenses gave up a touchdown or less in 48 of 108 games from 2014-19.
- In six seasons as defensive coordinator at a Power 5 school from 2014-19, Aranda's defenses were ranked in the Top 12 nationally in total yards five times. The units also ranked among the top 10 in scoring four times in seven years from 2013-19.
- Aranda trying to become the first Baylor coach to take his first team to a bowl since Sam Boyd in 1956.
- He is the first full-time BU coach to win his debut since Chuck Reedy in 1993.

#### MORE ON BREWER'S CAREER

- Senior quarterback Charlie Brewer is in his fourth season at the helm of the Baylor offense, and has a chance to etch himself in the record book as one of the best at the position in program history.
- Brewer holds a 19-13 record as a starter in 32 starts (37 games played). The Baylor modern record for games played by a quarterback is 42 from current Baylor radio analyst JJ Joe (1990-93).

- Preparing Champions for Life is not just a slogan at Baylor and coach Dave Aranda's team is proving it. The 2020 Baylor roster features 13 college graduates including three graduate transfers.
- The list of graduates is as follows: Terrel Bernard, William Bradley-King, Jake Burton, Zeke Brown, Tyler Henderson, Bryson Jackson, Michael McNair, Jalen Pitre, Thor Rodoni, Gunnar Royer, RJ Sneed, Raleigh Texada and Skyler Wetzel.
- Ten of those graduates are enrolled in graduate school in six different master's programs.
- Twelve other members of the BU roster are scheduled to graduate in December. The Bears boast 17 seniors.

#### **BREWER AS A RUNNER**

- Charlie Brewer has turned his legs into a weapon over his career. The now senior QB displayed his athleticism and recorded a team-best 147 rushing attempts in 2019, third most for a Big 12 QB.
- As a junior, Brewer led BU with 11 rushing touchdowns, second-most among passers in the Big 12.
- The Austin native ran for 50 or more yards four times in 2019. He set a career-best with 109 rushing yards on 16 attempts in the 2018 Texas Bowl win over Vanderbilt.
- Brewer's 11 rushing touchdowns in 2019 were the third-best total by a Baylor quarterback since 1980.
- His 900 career rushing yards ranks fourth by BU modern era quarterbacks behind Robert Griffin III (2,254; 2008-11), Seth Russell (1,240; 2012-16) and Mark Jackson (940; 1974-76).

- Brown and Rodoni are both fifth-year players that have each already completed their undergraduate degrees. Brown is pursuing a master's degree in electrical/computer engineering.

#### BREWER AMONG EXPERIENCED NATIONAL LEADERS

- Charlie Brewer has put up impressive numbers throughout his entire career and in his senior season he is among the nation's leaders in multiple categories.
- Brewer ranks sixth among active passers in career passing yards with 8,113. He also stands seventh among P5 passers with 55 career touchdown passes and fifth in overall career total offense (9,013)

#### **BU WELCOMES FOUR TRANSFERS TO FOLD FOR 2020**

- Baylor added four transfer players to the 2020 roster and all four are playing key roles this season.
- Outside linebacker William Bradley-King (Arkansas State), who tallied 8.5 sacks and 13.5 TFL in 2019 with the Redwolves, has 10 tackles, 2.5 TFL, 1.5 sacks and one forced fumble in his first two games with the Bears.
- Gunnar Royer is a graduate transfer from Division II IUP and is serving as the Bears' long snapper in 2020.
- After transferring from lowa, Dillon Doyle received an immediate eligibility waiver from the NCAA. He started the first two contests at middle linebacker and tallied 11 tackles with one forced fumble.
- Jake Burton joined the Baylor roster from UCLA in late August as a graduate transfer and moved into the starting lineup at WVU. He has played in 30 career games overall, including starting 24 of his last 25.

Trestan Ebner piled up 272 all-purpose yards and scored four touchdowns, including two on kick returns, to help Baylor (1-0, 1-0) open the Dave Aranda era with an impressive 47-14 win over Kansas in Saturday's season opener at McLane Stadium.

In one of the best all-around individual performances in program history, Ebner scored on kickoff returns of 100 and 83 yards, added a one-yard TD run and also caught an 18-yard TD pass from Charlie Brewer. The senior running back is the first Big 12 player in the league's 25-year history to score touchdowns on rushes, receptions and returns in the same game.

After Kansas (0-2, 0-1) opened the game with a 79-yard scoring drive and the first of Pooka Williams' two touchdowns, the Baylor defense stiffened the rest of the first half and didn't give up another score until the fourth quarter long after the Bears sent in their backups.

Linebacker Terrel Bernard, who had 2.5 sacks, 3.5 stops for losses and a game-high eight tackles, sacked KU freshman quarterback Jalon Daniels for the first safety at McLane Stadium and first for the Bears since Bravvion Roy versus TCU in 2017.

The Bears piled up 352 yards total offense, including 203 on the ground, and averaged better than five yards per play. Brewer, making his 31st career start, was 15-of-23 for 142 yards and one touchdown and added 23 yards rushing on eight carries.

#### **POSTGAME NOTES**

- Baylor is now 79-36-4 all-time in season openers. The Bears have won 11 of their last 12 season openers

   Ebner's 272 all-purpose yards are the third-most in program history (Terrance Williams, 314 vs. West
- Virginia all receiving; and Johnny Jefferson, 299 vs. North Carolina all rushing).

   Prior to today, there had never been a Big 12 player to score three different types of touchdowns in a game. Ebner is the first.

goal play in regulation and then turned it over in the second overtime, falling 27-21 to the West Virginia Mountaineers Saturday afternoon.

The Bears (1-1), falling to 7-8 all-time in overtime games, tied it up with 1:19 left in regulation on Charlie Brewer's 34-yard TD pass to Josh Fleeks and then matched a West Virginia score in the first OT period with Brewer's 25-yard toss to tight end Ben Sims on the first play.

But, on the first play of the second overtime, Brewer overthrew running back Trestan Ebner on a seam route and was picked off by cornerback Tykee Smith in the back of the end zone.

West Virginia (2-1, 1-1) won it with Leddie Brown's second touchdown run of the day, this one from three yards out, as the Mountaineers bounced back from a 27-13 loss to Oklahoma State on the opening weekend of Big 12 play.

Baylor's defense kept them in it, though, coming up with three first-half turnovers with a fumble strip and recovery by William Bradley-King and interceptions by JT Woods and Terrel Bernard

- · Bernard corralled his third-career interception, one of three takeaways Saturday by the Baylor
