### STORY LINES

- Baylor opens November with a road trip to Ames, Iowa, and a date with No. 17 Iowa State. ISU is Baylor's first ranked opponent this season. The Bears are 54-185-6 all-time against ranked teams.
- Running back **Craig 'Sqwirl' Williams** totaled 82 rushing yards on nine carries against TCU with one touchdown. Williams now has three career rushing scores on 19 carries in five career games.
- Preseason All-American linebacker **Terrel Bernard** leads the Big 12 in tackles per game (11.8), ranks second in sacks per game (0.9) and ranks fourth in TFL per game (1.4).
- Sophomore tight end **Ben Sims** is the first Baylor TE to score two TD in a game since Justin Akers in 2008 at UConn. Sims has three TD in 2020, a first for a BU tight end since Akers totaled four in 2007.
- Baylor used its fourth different starting offensive line combination of the year in the game with TCU.
- Senior QB **Charlie Brewer** has passed for 59 touchdowns in his career. He needs one more TD pass to tie Seth Russell (60, 2013-16) and three to tie Bryce Petty (62, 2011-14).
- Brewer is trying to become only the second player in Baylor history to lead the team in passing yards four straight years joining JJ Joe (1990-93).
- With 256 yards at Texas, Brewer (8,572) passed Bryce Petty (2011-14; 8,195) for the second most passing yards in Baylor Football history. He trails only Heisman winner Robert Griffin III (2008-11; 10,366).
- Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week **Terrel Bernard's** 19 tackles at UT are the most by a Big 12 player this year, and second most by any player in FBS. He has two 19-tackle games in his career, the most for a Baylor player since 2011.
- The Bears' 77 victories since 2011 are second most among all Power 5 programs in the State of Texas, trailing only Texas A&M (79).
- After recovering from two ACL tears, **Gavin Holmes** recorded his first TD since 11/12/2011 in the game at Texas. Holmes is tied for the BU team lead with 17 receptions in 2020.
- BU is playing its 119th season of football. BU holds a 608-580-44 (.513) record all-time. Baylor has scored in a school-record 168 straight games — the previous record was 89 games from Dec. 31, 1979 - Oct. 23, 1987.
- Baylor has 13 graduates on its 2020 roster, including 10 student-athletes enrolled in graduate school.
- Baylor senior quarterback **Charlie Brewer** leads the team with 34 starts, including 22 straight. Senior cornerback **Raleigh Texada** leads the defense with 24 career games started (18 straight).
- **Trestan Ebner**, voted Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week for his effort vs. Kansas, was the first player in Big 12 history to score 3 different types of TDs in a game and only the 6th Power 5 player to accomplish the feat since 1996.

## IOWA STATE SERIES HISTORY

- Baylor travels to Ames, Iowa to face No. 17 Iowa State on Saturday, Nov. 7 at Jack Trice Stadium.
- BU leads the all-time series 10-8 including a victories in five of the last seven meetings. Baylor is 4-5 in trips to Ames dating back to 1988.
- The Bears lost the last trip to Ames 28-14 in 2018 in a chippy matchup that included Charlie Brewer totaling more than 350 total yards and two touchdowns before being ejected on his second personal foul.
- Last season, Baylor held a 20-0 lead entering the fourth quarter but needed a 38-yd field goal by John Mayers with 21 seconds remaining to lift it to a 23-21 win at McLane Stadium.

## UP NEXT

- Baylor makes the trek to Lubbock to face Texas Tech in a true road game for the first time since 2008.
- BU leads the all-time series 39-38-1 in a rivalry that dates back to 1929. In Lubbock, the Bears are 14-23-1.
- Baylor hasn't won a game in Lubbock since 1990 when Eldwin Raphel, Robert Strait and Carmichael Moore each rushed for touchdowns and the Bears held on for a 21-15 win.
- Last season, the Bears earned a hard-fought double OT 33-30 win when JaMykal Hasty scored a 5-yard touchdown after BU held Tech to a field goal. Charlie Brewer passed for 352 yards and added three rushing TD.

## SIMS A WEAPON THROUGH THE AIR

- Baylor sophomore tight end has turned himself into a weapon in the passing game in 2020. The San Antonio native has eight receptions for 101 yards with three touchdowns in the first four games.
- He has receptions in four straight games to start 2020, the first time a BU tight end has accomplished that feat since Jordan Najvar (6) and Jerod Monk (4) in 2011.
- Sims had two scores against TCU, the first two TD game for a Baylor tight end since Justin Akers at UConn in 2008. He is the first TE with three TD in a season since Akers had four in 2007.

## RYAN MILLER THE MAN IN THE MIDDLE

- After opening his Baylor career as a true freshman with consecutive starts at center to open the 2017, junior defensive lineman Ryan Miller contributed on special teams and battled injury through last season.
- The Southlake, Texas native has earned starts against both Texas and TCU at nose tackle, a span of more than 1,141 days between starts in his career.
- Miller has seven tackles in the last three games including his first career sack and PBU against TCU.

## TERREL BERNARD LEADING DEFENSE

- Preseason All-American Terrel Bernard is back as the anchor of Baylor's defense following a breakout season in 2019. Bernard was a All-Big 12 pick in 2019 despite only starting 11 of 14 games.
- The junior linebacker opened his 2020 account with eight tackles, career-bests of 3.5 TFL and 2.5 sacks along with Baylor's first safety since 2017 in the win over KU. He has 47 tackles, 5.5 TFL, 3.5 sacks, 1 INT in four games.
- The LaPorte, Texas native has 206 stops in his career. Bernard has totaled 18.0 TFL and 9.0 sacks in 31 career games (17 starts). **In his last 12 games as starter, he is averaging 10.75 tackles per game.**
- Bernard leads the Big 12 in tackles per game (11.8), ranks second in sacks per game (0.9) and ranks fourth in TFL per game (1.4). He ranks fifth nationally in tackles. His 19 tackles at Texas are the second most by a player in FBS this year. He was named Big 12 Player of the Week for his efforts against the Longhorns.

## TRESTAN EBNER'S BIG NIGHT

- Senior Trestan Ebner had the best game of his career in the 2020 opening win over Kansas. The Henderson native totaled 272 all-purpose yards and four TD (2 KO returns, 1 receiving, one rushing). For his effort, he earned his first career Big 12 Special Teams Player of the Week honor.
- His 272 APY are the 3rd most in BU history (T. Williams, 314 vs. WVU/2012; & J. Jefferson, 299 vs. UNC/2015).
- Ebner is the first player in the 25 year history of the Big 12 Conference to score three different types of touchdowns in a game. He is the lone FBS player over the last 25 seasons with 1 rush TD, 1 rec TD and 2 KR TD in a game.
- He scored four touchdowns against KU after totaling only five in all of 2019. He has scored 17 touchdowns in his BU career.

## TOUGHNESS REWARDED

Baylor began a new tradition in 2017 of rewarding the toughest players on the BU roster with single-digit jerseys. The jersey numbers are awarded to the student-athletes deemed by their teammates to be the toughest members of the team. First-year Baylor head coach Dave Aranda has continued this tradition for 2020.



### THREE-HEADED RUNNING ATTACK

- BU's 2020 ground game has been led by a talented trio of Trestan Ebner, John Lovett and Craig 'Sqwirl' Williams.
- Lovett is the only four-year single-digit honoree in program history. He has led the Bears in rushing each of the last three seasons and has recorded 1,798 career rushing yards in his career (16th, BU history).
- The New Jersey native has 17 career rushing touchdowns (18 total) and six career 100-yard games.
- The versatile Ebner has high-level skills as a runner, receiver and returner. He has tallied 2,418 all-purpose yards in his career along with 17 total touchdowns.
- Ebner's 1,080 career receiving yards are the most by a primary running back in school history. His seven receiving touchdowns trail only Ronnie Bull (8, 1959-61). He is one of 38 BU players all-time to reach 1k receiving yards.
- Williams has 160 yards on 17 carries with two touchdowns in 2020. He has scored three TD in 19 career touches. He earned the 'Sqwirl' nickname from his grandfather as a child.

### CHARLIE BREWER AMONG BAYLOR'S BEST

- Senior quarterback Charlie Brewer has played in 39 games in his career with 34 starts. The Austin native has passed for 8,572 yards in his career which ranks second in Baylor history (Griffin 10,366).
- Brewer has passed for 219.8 yards per game in his career with 59 touchdowns and 23 interceptions. He needs one more TD pass to tie Seth Russell (60, 2013-16) and three to tie Bryce Petty (62, 2011-14).
- **Brewer has a 63.6 (573-of-901) completion percentage in 29 career games against Big 12 opponents.**
- The Austin native has eclipsed 300 yards passing in 11 games, third-most in program history. He trails only Bryce Petty (16) and Robert Griffin III (13).
- Brewer earned a single digit for the first time in his Baylor career entering his senior season. He has completed greater than 60% of his passes in 24 of 34 career starts, including 16 of last 20.

### BREWER THE CARDIAC KID

- In his time as Baylor's starting quarterback, Charlie Brewer has led the Bears on five game-winning drives in the fourth quarter, including 2019 victories over Iowa State and OSU. In 2019, he also led drives to tie the game before ultimately winning in overtime vs. Texas Tech and TCU. At WVU in 2020, he led a game-tying drive but the Bears fell in OT. Below is a breakdown of those contests.

### MORE BREWER NOTABLES

- Charlie Brewer is only the third quarterback in BU history to throw for 8,000+ yards in his career. He owns the Baylor single-game marks for completions (43) and attempts (63).
- **He is the only returning FBS QB to pass for 20+ touchdowns and rushing for 11+ touchdowns in 2019.**
- Only four returning FBS QBs rushed for 11+ TD in 2019 (Hammond, AFA; Plumlee, UM; Thompson, KSU).
- Eleven times in his career Brewer has thrown for a touchdown and rushed for a touchdown in the same game. Baylor is 8-3 in those games.
- Brewer is second in Baylor history with 22 career 200-yard passing games. He trails only Robert Griffin III (2008-11; 29).
- Brewer ranks 2nd among BU passers since 2000 with a completion percentage greater than 60 in 26 games.
- With three rushing touchdowns against Texas Tech in 2019, the Austin native tied a Baylor QB record set by Bryce Petty in 2014. Brewer has 18 rushing touchdowns in his career, fourth most in BU history.

## 2020 BAYLOR FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

### TONS OF EXPERIENCE AT WIDE OUT

- Baylor's passing game has been led in 2020 by a trio of veteran receivers in juniors RJ Sneed and Tyquan Thornton and Josh Fleeks. Additionally, Gavin Holmes has returned after missing 2017-19 due to ACL tears.
- Sneed, who owns 65 receptions and 692 yards in his career, leads the Bears with 17 catches and 198 yards with one touchdown in 2020.
- Thornton has eight grabs for 67 yards. In his career, he has 1,203 receiving yards (25th, BU history) and eight touchdowns.
- Fleeks has 108 yards on 13 catches with one TD in 2020. He has 3 career receiving TD and 2 rushing scores.
- Holmes set a career high with 9 catches at Texas. He is tied for the team lead with 17 receptions in 2020. He missed all but once game in 2018-19 after tearing his ACL twice. He has four career touchdowns.
- Baylor wide receivers have posted nine 1,000-yard seasons since 2011 including Denzel Mims in 2019.

### ARANDA IS ONE OF TOP DEFENSIVE MINDS IN COUNTRY

- First-year head coach Dave Aranda has earned a national reputation as one of the top defensive minds in the country over his 20-plus year career that included stops as defensive coordinator at LSU, Wisconsin, Utah State and Hawaii.
- Aranda led the LSU defense in 2019 as the Tigers posted a perfect 15-0 record and won the National Title with a 42-25 victory over Clemson in CFP National Championship Game.
- Since taking over as the defensive coordinator at Utah State, Aranda's defenses gave up a touchdown or less in 48 of 108 games from 2014-19.
- In six seasons as defensive coordinator at a Power 5 school from 2014-19, Aranda's defenses were ranked in the Top 12 nationally in total yards five times. The units also ranked among the top 10 in scoring four times in seven years from 2013-19.
- Aranda trying to become the first Baylor coach to take his first team to a bowl since Sam Boyd in 1956.
- He is the first full-time BU coach to win his debut since Chuck Reedy in 1993.

### MORE ON BREWER'S CAREER

- Senior quarterback Charlie Brewer is in his fourth season at the helm of the Baylor offense, and has a chance to etch himself in the record book as one of the best at the position in program history.
- Brewer holds a 19-15 record as a starter in 34 starts (39 games played). The Baylor record for games played by a quarterback is 42 from current Baylor radio analyst JJ Joe (1990-93). Joe and Robert Griffin III are tied for the record with 23 all-time wins.

## 2020 ROSTER FEATURES 14 GRADUATES

- Preparing Champions for Life is not just a slogan at Baylor and coach Dave Aranda's team is proving it. The 2020 Baylor roster features 13 college graduates including three graduate transfers.
- The list of graduates is as follows: Terrel Bernard, William Bradley-King, Jake Burton, Zeke Brown, Tyler Henderson, Bryson Jackson, Michael McNair, Jalen Pitre, Thor Rodoni, Gunnar Royer, RJ Sneed, Raleigh Texada and Skyler Wetzel.
- Ten of those graduates are enrolled in graduate school in six different master's programs.
- Twelve other members of the BU roster are scheduled to graduate in December. The Bears boast 17 seniors.

## BU WELCOMES FOUR TRANSFERS TO FOLD FOR 2020

- Baylor added four transfer players to the 2020 roster and all four are playing key roles this season.
- OLB/DE William Bradley-King (Arkansas State), who tallied 8.5 sacks and 13.5 TFL in 2019 with the Red-wolves, has 17 tackles, 4.5 TFL, 2.5 sacks and one forced fumble in his first four games with the Bears. He has also added two pass break ups and a fumble recovery.
- Gunnar Royer is a graduate transfer from Division II IUP and is serving as the Bears' long snapper in 2020.
- After transferring from Iowa, Dillon Doyle received an immediate eligibility waiver from the NCAA. He started the first four contests at middle linebacker and tallied 28 tackles with one sack and one forced fumble. He had his first career double-digit tackle performance with 11 at Texas.
- Jake Burton joined the Baylor roster from UCLA in late August as a graduate transfer and moved into the starting lineup at WVU. He has played in 32 career games overall, including starting 26 of his last 27.

### SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED FOR FALL

- Baylor coach Dave Aranda took the opportunity in late August to award scholarships to three deserving walk-on players in QB Garret McGuire, LS Thor Rodoni and S Zeke Brown.
- McGuire, the son of associate head coach Joey McGuire, is in his fourth year with the program and plays a valuable role as one of Baylor's primary signalers on game day.
- Brown and Rodoni are both fifth-year players that have each already completed their undergraduate degrees. Brown is pursuing a master's degree in electrical/computer engineering.

### BREWER AS A RUNNER

- Charlie Brewer has turned his legs into a weapon over his career. The senior QB displayed his athleticism and recorded a team-best 147 rushing attempts in 2019, third most for a Big 12 QB.
- As a junior, Brewer led BU with 11 rushing touchdowns, second-most among passers in the Big 12.
- The Austin native ran for 50 or more yards four times in 2019. He set a career-best with 109 rushing yards on 16 attempts in the 2018 Texas Bowl win over Vanderbilt.
- Brewer's 11 rushing touchdowns in 2019 were the third-best total by a Baylor quarterback since 1980.
- His 902 career rushing yards ranks fourth by BU modern era quarterbacks behind Robert Griffin III (2,254; 2008-11), Seth Russell (1,240; 2012-16) and Mark Jackson (940; 1974-76).

**Trestan Ebner** piled up 272 all-purpose yards and scored four touchdowns, including two on kick returns, to help Baylor (1-0, 1-0) open the Dave Aranda era with an impressive 47-14 win over Kansas in Saturday's season opener at McLane Stadium.

In one of the best all-around individual performances in program history, Ebner scored on kickoff returns of 100 and 83 yards, added a one-yard TD run and also caught an 18-yard TD pass from **Charlie Brewer**. The senior running back is the first Big 12 player in the league's 25-year history to score touchdowns on rushes, receptions and returns in the same game.

After Kansas (0-2, 0-1) opened the game with a 79-yard scoring drive and the first of Pooka Williams' two touchdowns, the Baylor defense stiffened the rest of the first half and didn't give up another score until the fourth quarter long after the Bears sent in their backups.

Linebacker **Terrel Bernard**, who had 2.5 sacks, 3.5 stops for losses and a game-high eight tackles, sacked KU freshman quarterback Jalon Daniels for the first safety at McLane Stadium and first for the Bears since Bravwon Roy versus TCU in 2017.

The Bears piled up 352 yards total offense, including 203 on the ground, and averaged better than five yards per play. Brewer, making his 31st career start, was 15-of-23 for 142 yards and one touchdown and added 23 yards rushing on eight carries.

### POSTGAME NOTES

- New Baylor head coach Dave Aranda won his first game at the helm, moving Baylor head coaches to 14-11-3 all-time in BU career openers all-time.
- Baylor is now 79-36-4 all-time in season openers. The Bears have won 11 of their last 12 season openers.
- **Trestan Ebner** finished with 272 total yards and four total touchdowns (two kickoff return, one rushing, one receiving).
- Ebner's 272 all-purpose yards are the third-most in program history (Terrance Williams, 314 vs. West Virginia - all receiving; and Johnny Jefferson, 299 vs. North Carolina - all rushing).
- Prior to today, there had never been a Big 12 player to score three different types of touchdowns in a game. Ebner is the first.
- Ebner is also the only FBS player in the last 25 seasons (since 1996) to score a rushing TD, a receiving TD and multiple return touchdowns in a game.
- **Terrel Bernard** recorded a sack for a safety, the first safety by a Baylor player since Bravwon Roy in 2017 vs. TCU.

With a chance for its road win ever at West Virginia, Baylor came up inches short on a fourth-and-goal play in regulation and then turned it over in the second overtime, falling 27-21 to the West Virginia Mountaineers Saturday afternoon.

The Bears (1-1), falling to 7-8 all-time in overtime games, tied it up with 1:19 left in regulation on **Charlie Brewer's** 34-yard TD pass to **Josh Fleeks** and then matched a West Virginia score in the first OT period with Brewer's 25-yard toss to tight end **Ben Sims** on the first play.

But, on the first play of the second overtime, Brewer overthrew running back Trestan Ebner on a seam route and was picked off by cornerback Tykee Smith in the back of the end zone.

West Virginia (2-1, 1-1) won it with **Leddie Brown's** second touchdown run of the day, this one from three yards out, as the Mountaineers bounced back from a 27-13 loss to Oklahoma State on the opening weekend of Big 12 play.

Baylor's defense kept them in it, though, coming up with three first-half turnovers with a fumble strip and recovery by **William Bradley-King** and interceptions by **JT Woods** and **Terrel Bernard**.

### POSTGAME NOTES

- **Terrel Bernard** (14 tackles, 10 solo) recorded his fifth-career game with double-digit tackles.
- Bernard corralled his third-career interception, one of three takeaways Saturday by the Baylor defense.
- **Jalen Pitre** registered a career-high 11 tackles (all of them solo) along with 2 tackles for loss
- **JT Woods** intercepted the first pass of his career while recording a career-high 9 tackles (5 solo).
- **Charlie Brewer** (23-of-38) has now completed 60% or better on passes in 23 of 32 starts, including 14 of his last 18.
- Brewer moved into second place alone in Baylor history (passing Shawn Bell) with his 25th career 60+% passing game.
- Brewer threw 3 touchdown passes and now has 55 career TD passes (73 career total TDs)

Playing their first game in three weeks, the Baylor Bears made things interesting with two fourth-quarter touchdowns but came up short against the Texas Longhorns, 27-16, Saturday afternoon at DKR-Texas Memorial Stadium.

**Charlie Brewer**, who moved up to No. 2 all-time in career yards passing, completed 30-of-43 passes for 256 yards and had touchdown tosses to **John Lovett** and **Gavin Holmes** to give the Bears (1-2) a chance late in the game.

The defense helped the cause with a 32-yard interception return by safety **JT Woods** that set up the second touchdown and also came up with another stop that gave Baylor the ball back with four minutes left.

Trailing 27-3 going into the fourth quarter, Brewer got clicking on a nine-play, 75-yard drive, hitting 6-of-7 passes for 70 yards and capping it with a short three-yard TD pass to a wide-open Lovett in the left flat.

Baylor's defense came up with the only turnover when Sam Ehlinger took a deep shot down the left sideline. The receiver appeared to be open, but cornerback **Mark Milton** got there in time to deflect the ball to Woods, who returned it 32 yards to UT's 25.

Five plays later, Brewer connected with Holmes on a seven-yard TD pass, his third career score and first in three years. Holmes, who had missed most of the previous two seasons with knee injuries, had a career-high nine catches for 57 yards.

Trailing 27-0 less than 17 minutes into the game, Baylor football could have thrown in the towel. Instead, the Bears clawed back within 10 of the TCU Horned Frogs and missed on a fourth-down try that could have made things even tighter.

Sparked by big plays, including a 67-yard punt return by Derius Davis, TCU (2-3) held on for a 33-23 victory Saturday afternoon in the Bears' first home game at McLane Stadium in 35 days.

The Bears' comeback started with a big fourth-down stop by Terrel Bernard and Brayden Utley. Sims, who had a career-high four receptions for 40 yards, grabbed a three-yard TD pass from Brewer that made it a 33-14 game.

Feeling a significant momentum switch, Baylor appeared to score another touchdown when Brewer found Trestan Ebner down the right sideline. But, Ebner stepped out at the 8-yard line, and the Bears had to settle for a 27-yard field goal by John Mayer.

When the defense forced another three-and-out, Baylor came up with a quick answer, with Craig "Squirl" Williams finishing off a five-play, 71-yard drive with a 32-yard touchdown, his third career TD. Brewer missed on the two-point conversion that would have made it a one-score game.

Driving from its own 9-yard line, Baylor marched into TCU territory, but safety Trevon Moehrig broke up a 4th-and-3 pass to Sims. The Horned Frogs were able to run out the last 6 ½ minutes and escape with the win.

- RS freshman **Yusuf Terry** had career highs in catches (2), yards (43) and longest reception (27).

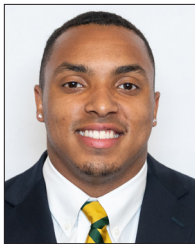
