MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- Baylor Captains: Terrel Bernard, Charlie Brewer, Jalen Pitre, RJ Sneed.
- Iowa State won the coin toss and deferred to the second half.

TEAM NOTES

- The Bears have scored in a school record 168 straight games.
- With Dabney's first half TD the Baylor tight ends have scored four touchdowns in the last four games.
- The three interceptions by the Baylor defense are the most since the team had four picks against KU on Nov. 30, 2019.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Running back Craig 'Sqwirl" Williams and tight end Drake Dabney each earned their first career starts.
- Kalon Barnes picked up his second career interception in the first quarter. His last INT came back on Oct. 19, 2019 against Oklahoma State.
- Jared Atkinson had the longest reception of his career with a 62-yard catch and run in the opening quarter. It was the Bears' longest play of the season.
- RJ Sneed's nine-yard touchdown reception in the first quarter was the fifth of his career and second of the season.
- Sneed tied a career high with receptions and had a career best 93 yards receiving.
- With his three touchdown passes in the game, Charlie Brewer passed Seth Russell (60 2013-16) and tied Bryce Petty (62 2011-14) for second place all time at Baylor.
- Brewer has completed 60 percent or greater of his passes 27 times in his career, three shy of Robert Griffin III's Baylor record of 30 (2008-11).
- Brewer (295) passed for over 200 yards for the 23rd time in his career. He is six shy of Griffin III's BU record of 29.
- Raleigh Texada had his third INT of his career in the first quarter and returned it a career best 56 yards.
- Dabney had a career day with his first career reception and first touchdown in the first quarter. He finished the day with three catches for 32 yards.
- Jalen Pitre's interception return for a touchdown in the second quarter was the first INT of his career and the first pick-six since Ryan Reid at Kansas 2016. The score marked the first defensive
- TD since Bernard's fumble return at OSU on Oct. 19 last year.
- Gunnar Royer recovered the first fumble of his career on a muffed punt in the third quarter.
- Qualan Jones had his first career carries with four for 13 yards.
- Christian Morgan had a career-high 8 tackles.
- Brayden Utley set a new career high in tackles for the second consecutive week, with six in the game.
