- No. 2 Baylor opens Big 12 play at Kansas State on Saturday, ending a 9-day stretch without a game.
- This is the earliest conference game in program history (previously Dec. 29 in 1937 and 2017).
- BU enters Big 12 play ranked for the 7th time in 8 seasons 4th time in top-10 (2014, 2017, 2020, 2021).
- Baylor is opening Big 12 play vs. K-State for the first time BU's 11th different opponent in a Big 12 opener. BU swept the season series vs. K-State last season, snapping a 6-game series losing streak. The Bears never trailed in either game and built a 16-point lead in Manhattan and a 34-point lead in Waco.
- Baylor is the Big 12's final undefeated team. The Bears lead the league in scoring (90.8), scoring margin
- (+27.0), field goal pct. (.508), 3-point pct. (.468), 3-pointers made (11.0), assists (20.0) and steals (9.0).
- Baylor is 41-40 in Big 12 road games over the last 10 seasons, second best behind Kansas (51-27). Baylor returned four All-Big 12 players from a 2019-20 team which went 26-4 and spent five weeks
- ranked No. 1 nationally. The Bears finished last season ranked No. 4 in the coaches poll (No. 5 in AP).
- Baylor has scored 80 + points in 4 straight games for the first time since December 2017.
- BU has won all 4 games by 13+ points and averages a +27.0 margin of victory (3 wins of 30+).
- Baylor's bench has 34 + points in every game and is out-scoring opposing benches 40-17 on average.
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 15 straight weeks top-5 ranked (previously 6 straight in 2017).
- BU's streak of 24 consecutive AP polls ranked is the 2nd-longest in program history (25 in 2016-17).
- Baylor's defense forced 15+ turnovers in 20 of 34 games since the start of the 2019-20 season.
- BU forced a Ferrell Center-record 35 turnovers with 40 points off turnovers in its last game, a win over SFA.
- Baylor has led by at least 5 points in 34 straight games and built a double-digit lead in 28 of 34 games. Among BU returners is Jared Butler, who is the first preseason AP All-American in program history.
- BU also welcomes back MaCio Teague, an all-conference pick in all 3 of his collegiate seasons.
- BU returns two players who were semifinalists for the 2020 Naismith Defensive Player of the Year.
- Mark Vital was 1 of 4 finalists, while Davion Mitchell joined Vital among the 10 semifinalists.
- Baylor is playing its 246th game as a ranked team under Drew BU was ranked in 2 of 2197 games over the program's 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since 2008-09, BU has been ranked in 243 of 425 games.
- BU has been top-10 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage a nation's-best 7 straight years.
- Baylor is 1 of 5 Power-5 programs to win at least 18 games in each of the last 12 seasons since 2007-08, joining Duke, Kansas, Kentucky and Michigan State.
- Baylor has won 20 + games in 11 of the last 13 years. The Bears reached the 20-win mark only 3 times in 101 seasons prior to 2008. BU is averaging 24 wins per season since 2008.
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 18th season in Waco and is BU's all-time wins leader (346-213).
- Baylor joins Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas as the only programs ranked No. 1 in 3 of the last 5 seasons.
- Baylor signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history (No. 4) earlier this month. BU
- inked 5-star Kendall Brown, 4-star Langston Love and 4-star Jeremy Sochan for the 2021-22 season.
- BU has advanced to 8 consecutive postseasons, tied as the nation's 10th-longest active streak. .

#### GAME-BY-GAME

- Baylor opened with a 112-82 win over ULL on Nov. 28. BU's 112 points were its most since 2017.
- BU then beat Washington 86-52 on Nov. 29 in Las Vegas, out-rebounding the Huskies 50-19.
- Baylor won 82-69 over No. 5 Illinois in Indianapolis on Dec. 2, recording the 9th top-5 win in program history.
- BU defeated SFA 83-52 on Dec. 9, turning a Ferrell Center-record 35 turnovers into 40 points off turnovers.

#### **QUICK HITS**

- BU was picked to win the Big 12 in the league's preseason coaches' poll for the first time.
- Baylor is 55-5 when leading at halftime over the last 4 seasons since 2017-18 (21-2 in 2019-20, 4-0 this season).
- Baylor has won 89% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (173-21).
- BU is 118-23 since 2015-16 when leading at any point in the 2nd half of a game (30-3 since 2019-20).
- Baylor's 23-game winning streak last season was the longest ever by a Big 12 team (previously 22 by 1996-97 KU).
- BU's 13-game conference winning streak was the longest in school history (previously 11 in 1946 SWC).
- Baylor has won 20+ games in 11 of the last 13 seasons after recording only three 20-win seasons in the previous 100 years of Baylor Basketball (1946, 1948, 1988).
- Baylor is 221.97 over 9+ seasons, averaging 24 wins per season since 2011.12.
- Baylor's 221 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (270).
- Baylor is 312-144 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- BU returned 8 players with at least 30 games of DI experience, including a pair of sophomore transfers who joinec the rotation after sitting out last season Adam Flagler and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua.
- Eight of Baylor's players either have used or are currently using a redshirt year. Four after transferring to BU Flagler, Mitchell, Tchamwa Tchatchoua and Teague, and four as freshmen Moffatt, Turner, Vital and Dainja.
- Nine of Baylor's 10 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (15 of last 16 seasons).
- Baylor is 1 of 14 teams nationally to appear in every postseason since 2012 (6 NCAAs, 2 NITs).
- Baylor has the nation's 10th-longest active streak with at least one 3-point FG made in 936 straight games the
  last time Baylor failed to make a 3-pointer was more than 30 years ago, on Feb. 21, 1990 vs. Texas Tech (0-8).

#### **ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY**

- Scott Drew became Baylor head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 18th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (346).
- Drew is coaching his 560th game at Baylor (346-213). His .619 winning pct. is best in BU history among coaches
- with 40+ games, and he's the program's all-time wins leader with 145 more victories than any other coach.
   Baylor has a .684 winning percentage (312-144) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08

and a .695 winning percentage (221-97) over the last 9 + seasons since 2011-12.

- Drew (50) is the youngest of 12 coaches nationally to take his current program to four Sweet 16s since 2010.
- Baylor is playing its 246th game as a ranked team in Drew's 18 seasons. BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games
- over the program's first 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since 2008-09, BU has been ranked in 243 of 425 games.
- In Drew's first 17 seasons at Baylor, 44 players have gone on to professional careers.

#### UP NEXT

• Baylor returns home to host Arkansas-Pine Bluff at 7 p.m. Monday on ESPN+. The Bears then have an eight-day Christmas break before returning to action at 3 p.m. on Dec. 29 vs. Central Arkansas.

• Baylor's next Big 12 game is a road trip to Iowa State on Saturday, Jan. 2. Tipoff time is TBD on ESPN+.

#### ONE OF FOUR PROGRAMS RANKED NO. 1 THREE TIMES SINCE 2017

• Baylor joins Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas as the only programs ranked No. 1 in three seasons since 2017.

BU was No. 1 for the first time on Jan. 9, 2017, spent five weeks ranked No. 1 in 2020 and was No. 1 in the preseason and week 1 coaches' polls this year. All told, BU has been No. 1 for eight weeks since 2017.
The Bears have been ranked in 24 of 25 AP Top 25 spots during the Drew era (all since 2008). The only spot Baylor hasn't been ranked in the AP poll is No. 8.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

• Saturday is the 44th all-time series meeting. K-State leads the series 23-20, but BU leads 19-18 in the Big 12 era.

- Baylor swept the season series last season, ending a 6-game losing streak in the series.
- The Bears are 8-7 vs. Kansas State since 2014, including a 4-3 mark in Manhattan.
- Since Big 12 double round-robin play began in 2012, BU has swept the season series three times (2014, 2016,
- 2020) and K-State has swept three times (2013, 2018, 2019). The teams split in 2012, 2015 and 2017.

• The Bears won 73-67 in Manhattan and 85-66 in Waco last season.

#### LAST SEASON VS. K-STATE

- Baylor swept the season series vs. K-State last season for the first time since 2016.
- The Bears never trailed in either game and built a 16-point lead in Manhattan and a 34-point lead in Waco.

• Baylor's three starting guards combined for 48 of the Bears' 73 points in Manhattan. Jared Butler posted 20 points, while Davion Mitchell added 13 points and 7 assists and MaCio Teague contributed 15 points.

• Five Bears scored in double-figures in Waco, led by **Matthew Mayer's** career-high 19 points in 20 minutes off the bench. **Mitchell** posted his career-first double-double with 14 points and 10 assists.

#### **HISTORY IN BIG 12 OPENERS**

• Baylor is 8-5 in Big 12 Conference openers since 2008 and 11-13 all-time in Big 12 openers.

• Baylor won 6 straight openers from 2008-13 before losing 5 of the last 7 Big 12 openers (wins in 2017 and 2020). All five of those losses were on the road, with four of them against top-25 ranked opponents.

• This is the 6th time in the last 7 years Baylor will open Big 12 play on the road. The Bears are 1-5 in Big 12 openers on the road since 2014, but four of the five losses were against ranked opponents.

• BU enters Big 12 play ranked for the 7th time in 8 seasons since 2014 - 4th time in top 10 (2014, 2017, 2020, 2021).

#### **BEARS ARE 7-1 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST TWO SEASONS**

Baylor is 7-1 against top-25 ranked teams since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Bears last loss against a ranked team before that stretch was to No. 4-ranked Gonzaga in the 2019 NCAA Tournament second round.
BU is 3-0 away from home against ranked teams over the last two seasons. BU defeated No. 17 Villanova in the 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, then recorded road wins at No. 22 Texas Tech and No. 4 Kansas in January 2020.

#### FOUR ALL-BIG 12 PLAYERS RETURN

- All five Baylor starters were named to 2020 All-Big 12 teams, making BU the first team in the league's 24-year history with five players on All-Big 12 teams, and four of those players are back for the 2020-21 season.
- Jared Butler became Baylor's first underclassman named first-team All-Conference since Terry Teagle in 1980, and he was named a consensus third-team All-American. He's the Bears' first AP Preseason All-American.
- MaCio Teague has been all-conference in all three of his previous seasons. He was a first-team All-Big South
  honoree while at UNC Asheville in 2017 and 2018 and earned second-team All-Big 12 honors in 2020.
- Mark Vital and Davion Mitchell were both third-team All-Big 12 and Big 12 All-Defensive Team choices.

#### **FIFTEEN STRAIGHT WEEKS AP TOP-5 RANKED**

- BU is No. 2 in this week's AP Top 25, extending its school-record streak to 15 straight weeks top-5 ranked.
- Baylor's 5-week streak at No. 1 last season was the longest since Kentucky in 2015.

• Baylor's streak of 24 consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 is the 2nd-longest streak in program history, trailing only the 25 consecutive polls ranked in 2016-17.

#### A WIN WOULD ...

- Be Drew's 347th win at Baylor and improve Baylor's record to 313-144 since 2007-08.
- Make Baylor 5-0 for the 3rd time in the last 5 seasons (2016-17, 2017-18, 2020-21).
- Improve Baylor to 33-10 all-time when playing as an AP Top 5 team.

## **BU FORCES 35 TURNOVERS IN DOMINANT WIN OVER SFA**

- Baylor forced a Ferrell Center-record 35 turnovers and rolled to an 83-52 win over SFA in its Dec. 9 home opener.
- The Bears snapped SFA's 18-game winning streak (which was the nation's 2nd-longest active streak) and handed SFA its largest margin-of-defeat in more than two years a 38-point loss at Miami on Nov. 13, 2018.

#### BEARS NOTCH TOP-5 WIN OVER ILLINOIS IN JIMMY V CLASSIC

- Baylor recorded its first ranked win of the season by beating No. 5 Illinois 82-69 in the Jimmy V Classic on Dec. 2.
- Four BU guards all scored in double-figures and combined for 56 points, led by Adam Flagler's 18 off the bench.
- There were 10 lead changes in the game, and score was tied 43-43 with 13:16 left. BU used a 6-0 run to take the
- lead for good, and put the game away with a 9-0 run over 75 seconds to take a 65-61 lead with 7 minutes left.
- After being out-rebounded 25-18 in the first half, Baylor out-rebounded the Illini 20-10 after the break.

- **TWO 30-POINT WINS IN VEGAS TO OPEN SEASON**
- Baylor's season started three days later than expected, but the Bears came out strong scoring 112 points in a 30-point win over Louisiana-Lafayette and then taking down Washington 86-52 the following day.
- The Bears drained 15 treys and had 25 assists on their way to 112 points in the opener vs. Louisiana-Lafayette.
- BU out-rebounded Washington 50-19, with Mark Vital (15) recording as many rebounds as all Washington players

## combined (15 + 4 team rebounds). It was the second time Vital accomplished that feat (2018-19 at Arizona).

## **BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12**

- BU is 114-80 in Big 12 play in 11 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 128-97 in Big 12 play in 13 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 41-40 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (54-27).
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 9 straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has recorded double-digit Big 12 wins in 5 of the last 6 years and 7 of the last 11 seasons.

#### BUTLER BACK AFTER ALL-AMERICA SOPHOMORE SEASON

- Jared Butler was named to the Sporting News All-America Third Team and All-Big 12 First Team, becoming Baylor's first underclassman to earn All-America or All-Conference first team honors since Terry Teagle in 1980.
- Butler led Baylor in scoring in 17 of 30 games last season after doing so in 6 of 34 games as a freshman.
- Butler had 8 games with 20+ points last season, including his 2nd career 30-point game 30 vs. UCA, 22 vs. Villanova, 20 vs. UMES, 22 at Kansas, 20 at K-State, 21 vs. WVU, 22 at Oklahoma and 21 at WVU.
- Butler ranked top-10 in the Big 12 in scoring (3rd, 16,0), 3-pointers (2nd, 2.6/gm), 3-point percentage (6th, .381), field goal percentage (7th, .421), steals (7th, 1.6) and assists (10th, 3.1).

#### VITAL TO BEARS' SUCCESS

- Mark Vital is back after being named one of 4 Naismith Defensive Player of the Year Award finalists in 2020.
- He was named to the All-Big 12 Third Team and was a unanimous All-Defensive Team selection.
- In Baylor's Nov. 29, 2020 game vs. Washington, Vital's 15 rebounds matched all Washington players combined (15). That was the second time Vital accompished the feat, after doing so for the first time at Arizona in 2018.
- Vital did not attempt a field goal in the Feb. 1, 2020 win over TCU, but he had a +13 plus-minus in 22 minutes.
- Vital filled the stat sheet in the Jan. 29 win at Iowa State, posting 8 points, 9 rebounds and 7 assists in 31 minutes.

#### **TEAGUE LOOKING FOR FOURTH ALL-CONFERENCE SEASON**

 MaCio Teaque has earned all-conference honors in all 3 collegiate seasons – All-Big South First Team in 2017 and 2018 at UNC Asheville and All-Big 12 Second Team in 2020 at Baylor.

- Teague played in 90 consecutive games and made 86 consecutive starts before sitting out two games with a broken wrist. He has started all but 3 games (Nov. 20, 2016, Feb. 18, 2020, Feb. 22, 2020) in his career.
- Teague led Baylor in scoring in 6 straight games (15+ points in each) before injuring his wrist at Texas on Feb. 10.
- Last season, Teague ranked 10th in the Big 12 in scoring (13.9), 3rd in free throw percentage (.848), 7th in
- 3-pointers (2.1/gm), 8th in 3-point percentage (.355) and 8th in minutes (32.7).

Baylor is 24-1 when Teague scores 10+ points. He's averaging 9.5 ppg in BU's 4 losses with him (8, 8, 13, 9).

#### MITCHELL RETURNS AS STARTING POINT GUARD

 Davion Mitchell was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, selected to the All-Big 12 Third Team and Big 12 All-Defensive Team and was a unanimous choice on the Big 12 All-Newcomer Team.

Mitchell has started all 34 games at BU after coming off the bench in all 34 games as an Auburn freshman (2017-18).

 Mitchell has made a 3-pointer in 25 of the last 30 games and is shooting 38% on 3FGs in that stretch (40-of-106). Prior to that stretch, he shot .264 (19-of-72) from downtown over his first 38 collegiate games.

- Last season, he ranked 8th in the Big 12 in steals (1.5), 4th in A:T ratio (1.70) and 7th in assists (3.8).
- Mitchell joined Mark Vital to make BU the only school with two Naismith Defensive Player of the Year semifinalists.
- When Mitchell has played 20+ minutes, his collegiate teams are 41-4 (12-0 at Auburn, 29-4 at Baylor).
- When Mitchell scores 10+ points, his collegiate teams are 19-1 (2-0 at Auburn, 17-1 at Baylor).

#### **PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS**

- Drew is in his 18th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (346).
- Baylor has had a nation-leading four players selected in the NBA Draft since 2010 who weren't ranked in the ESPN100 out of high school - Quincy Acy, Ekpe Udoh, Pierre Jackson and Taurean Prince.
- Drew has graduated 51 players during his Baylor tenure, averaging 3 graduates per season.
- The Bears have advanced to postseason play in a school-record eight straight seasons (6 NCAA, 2 NIT).

- Mark Vital, Freddie Gillespie, MaCio Teague and Davion Mitchell have earned All-Big 12 honors after redshirting.
- Adam Flagler and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua redshirted last season while sitting out to satisfy NCAA

transfer rules, while freshman **Jordan Turner** elected to redshirt last year. **Dain Dainja** is redshirting in 2020-21.

#### **OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING BECOMING A BAYLOR STAPLE**

• Baylor has ranked top-10 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in every season since 2013-14, including five times ranked in the nation's top-4. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.

- Baylor's 7-year streak is the nation's best, and West Virginia (6 years) is the only other team with a 3+ year streak.
- The Bears ranked 8th nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (35.7) in 2019-20.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 2 nationally in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1
- in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that top-10 streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

- Morris is in his 37th year doing BU broadcasts (26th full-time), and Nunley is in his 40th season as analyst.

- Three current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.






