STORY LINES

- No. 2 Baylor returns to action after a 7-day break by hosting Central Arkansas at 3 pm CT Tuesday.
- BU is facing UCA for the third time in the last four seasons. Baylor opened the 2017-18 season with a 107-66 win vs. UCA and opened the 2019-20 season with a 105-61 victory vs. UCA.
- Baylor is the Big 12's final undefeated team. The Bears lead the league in scoring (93.7), scoring margin (+32.7), field goal pct. (.521), 3-point pct. (.470), 3-pointers made (11.7/gm), assists (21.5/gm), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.84), rebounding margin (+10.7) and steals (9.0/gm).
- Baylor has scored 80+ points in 6 straight games for the first time since 1994.
- Baylor has won 6 consecutive games by double-digits for the first time since December 2016.
- Baylor is the nation's only team to win every game by 13+ points this season (min. 3 games played).
- BU is looking to start a season 7-0 for the first time since starting 15-0 on its way to No. 1 in 2016-17.
- Baylor leads the nation in 3-point percentage (.470) and ranks 6th in 3-pointer made (11.7/game).
- BU ranks 2nd nationally in scoring margin (+32.7) and has won 5 of 6 games by 30+ points.
- BU is 6th nationally in scoring (93.7), assists (21.5) and AST-TO ratio (1.84) and 7th in TO margin (+7.8)
- Baylor's bench has 33+ points in every game and is out-scoring opposing benches 41-17 on average.
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 17 straight weeks top-5 ranked (previously 6 straight in 2017).
- BU's streak of 26-straight AP polls ranked is the nation's 5th-longest active streak and longest in BU history.
- Baylor has been ranked top-5 for 17-straight weeks. BU was top-5 for 12 weeks all-time prior to this streak.
- Baylor's defense forced 15 + turnovers in 21 of 36 games since the start of the 2019-20 season.
- BU's bench out-scored UAPB's bench 55-0 in the Dec. 21 win. LJ Cryer led all Bears with 15 points.
- BU became the first team since 1992 to score 100 points in Manhattan in the Dec. 19 win at K-State.
- BU forced a Ferrell Center-record 35 turnovers with 40 points off turnovers in the Dec. 9 win over SFA.
- Baylor has led by at least 5 points in 36 straight games and built a double-digit lead in 30 of 36 games.
- Baylor returned four All-Big 12 players from a 2019-20 team which went 26-4 and spent five weeks ranked No. 1 nationally. The Bears finished last season ranked No. 4 in the coaches poll (No. 5 in AP).
- Among BU returners is Jared Butler, who is the first preseason AP All-American in program history.
- BU also welcomes back MaCio Teague, an all-conference pick in all 3 of his collegiate seasons.
- BU returns two players who were semifinalists for the 2020 Naismith Defensive Player of the Year. Mark Vital was 1 of 4 finalists, while Davion Mitchell joined Vital among the 10 semifinalists.
- Baylor is playing its 248th game as a ranked team under Drew BU was ranked in 2 of 2197 games over the program's 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since 2008-09, BU has been ranked in 245 of 427 games.
- Baylor is 52-11 in games against non-Big 12 teams over the last 5 seasons since 2016-17.
- Baylor is 106-8 in non-conference home games since 2007-08, including 67-4 since December 2012.
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 18th season in Waco and is BU's all-time wins leader (348-213).
- Baylor signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history (No. 4) earlier this month. BU inked 5-star Kendall Brown, 4-star Langston Love and 4-star Jeremy Sochan for the 2021-22 season.

GAME-BY-GAME

- Baylor opened with a 112-82 win over ULL on Nov. 28. BU's 112 points were its most since 2017.
- BU then beat Washington 86-52 on Nov. 29 in Las Vegas, out-rebounding the Huskies 50-19.
- Baylor won 82-69 over No. 5 Illinois in Indianapolis on Dec. 2, recording the 9th top-5 win in program history.
- BU defeated SFA 83-52 on Dec. 9, turning a Ferrell Center-record 35 turnovers into 40 points off turnovers.
- Baylor won at K-State 100-69 on Dec. 19, becoming the first team to score 100 in Manhattan since 1992.
- The Bears rolled to a 99-42 win over UAPB on Dec. 21, with Baylor's bench out-scoring UAPB's 55-0.

QUICK HITS

- BU was picked to win the Big 12 in the league's preseason coaches' poll for the first time.
- Baylor is 57-5 when leading at halftime over the last 4 seasons since 2017-18 (21-2 in 2019-20, 6-0 this season).
- Baylor has won 89% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (175-21).
- BU is 120-23 since 2015-16 when leading at any point in the 2nd half of a game (32-3 since 2019-20).
- Baylor's 23-game winning streak last season was the longest ever by a Big 12 team (previously 22 by 1996-97 KU).
- BU's 13-game conference winning streak was the longest in school history (previously 11 in 1946 SWC).
- Baylor has won 20+ games in 11 of the last 13 seasons after recording only three 20-win seasons in the previous 100 years of Baylor Basketball (1946, 1948, 1988).
- Baylor is 223-97 over the last 10 seasons, averaging 24 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 223 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (272).
- Baylor is 314-144 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- BU returned 8 players with at least 30 games of DI experience, including a pair of sophomore transfers who joined the rotation after sitting out last season – Adam Flagler and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua.
- Eight of Baylor's players either have used or are currently using a redshirt year. Four after transferring to BU Flagler, Mitchell, Tchamwa Tchatchoua and Teague, and four as freshmen Moffatt, Turner, Vital and Dainja.
- Nine of Baylor's 10 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (15 of last 16 seasons).
- Baylor is 1 of 14 teams nationally to appear in every postseason since 2012 (6 NCAAs, 2 NITs).
- Baylor has the nation's 10th-longest active streak with at least one 3-point FG made in 938 straight games the
 last time Baylor failed to make a 3-pointer was more than 30 years ago, on Feb. 21, 1990 vs. Texas Tech (0-8).

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 18th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (348).
- Drew is coaching his 562nd game at Baylor (348-213). His .620 winning pct. is best in BU history among coaches with 40+ games, and he's the program's all-time wins leader with 147 more victories than any other coach.
- Baylor has a .686 winning percentage (314-144) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .697 winning percentage (223-97) over the last 9+ seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (50) is the youngest of 12 coaches nationally to take his current program to four Sweet 16s since 2010.
- Baylor is playing its 248th game as a ranked team in Drew's 18 seasons. BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's first 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since 2008-09, BU has been ranked in 245 of 427 games.
- In Drew's first 17 seasons at Baylor, 44 players have gone on to professional careers.

ONE OF FOUR PROGRAMS RANKED NO. 1 THREE TIMES SINCE 2017

- Baylor joins Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas as the only programs ranked No. 1 in three seasons since 2017.
- BU was No. 1 for the first time on Jan. 9, 2017, spent five weeks ranked No. 1 in 2020 and was No. 1 in the preseason and week 1 coaches' polls this year. All told, BU has been No. 1 for eight weeks since 2017.
- The Bears have been ranked in 24 of 25 AP Top 25 spots during the Drew era (all since 2008). The only spot Baylor hasn't been ranked in the AP poll is No. 8.

SERIES HISTORY

- Tuesday is the third series meeting between Baylor and Central Arkansas.
- The first Battle of the Bears was the 2017-18 season opener on Nov. 10, a 107-66 Baylor win in Waco.
- The second meeting was the 2019-20 season opener on Nov. 5, 2019, a 105-61 Baylor win in Waco.
- Mark Vital is the only player on Baylor's roster to have faced UCA in both previous meetings.

LAST TIME VS. CENTRAL ARKANSAS

- Baylor won last year's season opener 105-61 on Nov. 5, 2019 against Central Arkansas.
- BU was led by **Jared Butler's** then-career-high 30 points (8-of-12 from 3-point range) and **MaCio Teague's** double-double with 18 points and 10 rebounds in his Baylor debut.
- The Bears made 18-of-33 from 3-point range, breaking the Ferrell Center record for 3-pointers made.

BEARS ARE 7-1 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST TWO SEASONS

- Baylor is 7-1 against top-25 ranked teams since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Bears last loss against a ranked team before that stretch was to No. 4-ranked Gonzaga in the 2019 NCAA Tournament second round.
- BU is 3-0 away from home against ranked teams over the last two seasons. BU defeated No. 17 Villanova in the 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, then recorded road wins at No. 22 Texas Tech and No. 4 Kansas in January 2020.

FOUR ALL-BIG 12 PLAYERS RETURN

- All five Baylor starters were named to 2020 All-Big 12 teams, making BU the first team in the league's 24-year history with five players on All-Big 12 teams, and four of those players are back for the 2020-21 season.
- Jared Butler became Baylor's first underclassman named first-team All-Conference since Terry Teagle in 1980, and he was named a consensus third-team All-American. He's the Bears' first AP Preseason All-American.
- MaCio Teague has been all-conference in all three of his previous seasons. He was a first-team All-Big South honoree while at UNC Asheville in 2017 and 2018 and earned second-team All-Big 12 honors in 2020.
- Mark Vital and Davion Mitchell were both third-team All-Big 12 and Big 12 All-Defensive Team choices.

SEVENTEEN STRAIGHT WEEKS AP TOP-5 RANKED

- BU is No. 2 in this week's AP Top 25, extending its school-record streak to 17 straight weeks top-5 ranked. The Bears were top-5 ranked in 12 total weeks in program history prior to the current streak.
- Baylor's 5-week streak at No. 1 last season was the longest since Kentucky in 2015.
- Baylor has been in the AP Top 25 a school-record 26-straight weeks, which is the nation's 5th-longest active streak behind only Kansas (225), Duke (88), Gonzaga (83) and Villanova (28).

A WIN WOULD ...

- Be Drew's 349th win at Baylor and improve Baylor's record to 315-144 since 2007-08.
- Make Baylor 7-0 for the first time since starting 15-0 in 2016-17.
- Improve Baylor to 35-10 all-time when playing as an AP Top 5 team.

BENCH TAKES CARE OF BUSINESS VS. UAPB

- Baylor's bench scored more points than the entire UAPB team in the Bears' 99-42 win on Dec. 21. The BU bench out-scored UAPB's bench 55-0, with a team-high 15 points from freshman LJ Cryer.
- BU committed only 5 turnovers, forced 23 turnovers and had 25 assists on 37 made field goals.

NO RUST FOR BU OFFENSE IN BIG 12 OPENER AT K-STATE

- Despite going 9 days without a game and having only two days of practice before its Big 12 opener at Kansas State, BU rolled to a 100-69 victory on Dec. 19, becoming the first team to score 100 in Manhattan since 1992.
- Two Baylor guards posted double-doubles, with MaCio Teague's 23 points and 10 rebounds and Jared Butler's
 14 points and career-high 13 assists. Davion Mitchell added a career-high 20 points.

BU FORCES 35 TURNOVERS IN DOMINANT WIN OVER SFA

- Baylor forced a Ferrell Center-record 35 turnovers and rolled to an 83-52 win over SFA in its Dec. 9 home opener.
- The Bears snapped SFA's 18-game winning streak (which was the nation's 2nd-longest active streak) and handed SFA its largest margin-of-defeat in more than two years – a 38-point loss at Miami on Nov. 13, 2018.

BEARS NOTCH TOP-5 WIN OVER ILLINOIS IN JIMMY V CLASSIC

- Baylor recorded its first ranked win of the season by beating No. 5 Illinois 82-69 in the Jimmy V Classic on Dec. 2.
- Four BU guards all scored in double-figures and combined for 56 points, led by Adam Flagler's 18 off the bench.
- There were 10 lead changes in the game, and score was tied 43-43 with 13:16 left. BU used a 6-0 run to take the lead for good, and put the game away with a 9-0 run over 75 seconds to take a 65-61 lead with 7 minutes left.
- After being out-rebounded 25-18 in the first half, Baylor out-rebounded the Illini 20-10 after the break.

TWO 30-POINT WINS IN VEGAS TO OPEN SEASON

- Baylor's season started three days later than expected, but the Bears came out strong scoring 112 points in a 30-point win over Louisiana-Lafayette and then taking down Washington 86-52 the following day.
- The Bears drained 15 treys and had 25 assists on their way to 112 points in the opener vs. Louisiana-Lafayette.
- BU out-rebounded Washington 50-19, with Mark Vital (15) recording as many rebounds as all Washington players combined (15 + 4 team rebounds). It was the second time Vital accomplished that feat (2018-19 at Arizona).

BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12

- BU is 115-80 in Big 12 play in 12 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 129-97 in Big 12 play in 14 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 42-40 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (55-27).
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 9 straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has recorded double-digit Big 12 wins in 5 of the last 6 years and 7 of the last 11 seasons.

THIRTY WINS VS. RANKED TEAMS IN LAST FIVE SEASONS

- Baylor has gone 30-33 against ranked teams since the start of the 2014-15 season (6-1 last season).
- BU is 48-73 against AP-ranked teams since 2007-08 after going 17-122 in the program's first 101 seasons.
- Baylor has won multiple games vs. AP Top 25 teams in each of the last 13 seasons entering 2020-21. The Bears have defeated at least five ranked teams in five of the last seven seasons dating back to 2013-14.

BUTLER BACK AFTER ALL-AMERICA SOPHOMORE SEASON

- Jared Butler was named to the Sporting News All-America Third Team and All-Big 12 First Team, becoming Baylor's first underclassman to earn All-America or All-Conference first team honors since Terry Teagle in 1980.
- Butler leads the Big 12 in assists (6.5/game) and ranks top-10 in the conference in steals (2nd, 2.0), AST-TO ratio (2nd, 3.0), 3-pointers made (2.0/game), scoring (9th, 14.8) and field goal percentage (9th, .472).
- Butler led Baylor in scoring in 17 of 30 games last season after doing so in 6 of 34 games as a freshman.
- Butler had 8 games with 20+ points last season, including his 2nd career 30-point game 30 vs. UCA, 22 vs. Villanova, 20 vs. UMES, 22 at Kansas, 20 at K-State, 21 vs. WVU, 22 at Oklahoma and 21 at WVU.

VITAL TO BEARS' SUCCESS

- Mark Vital is back after being named one of 4 Naismith Defensive Player of the Year Award finalists in 2020.
- He was named to the All-Big 12 Third Team and was a unanimous All-Defensive Team selection.
- In Baylor's Nov. 29, 2020 game vs. Washington, Vital's 15 rebounds matched all Washington players combined (15). That was the second time Vital accompished the feat, after doing so for the first time at Arizona in 2018.
- Vital did not attempt a field goal in the Feb. 1, 2020 win over TCU, but he had a + 13 plus-minus in 22 minutes.
- Vital filled the stat sheet in the Jan. 29 win at Iowa State, posting 8 points, 9 rebounds and 7 assists in 31 minutes.

TEAGUE LOOKING FOR FOURTH ALL-CONFERENCE SEASON

- MaCio Teague has earned all-conference honors in all 3 collegiate seasons All-Big South First Team in 2017 and 2018 at UNC Asheville and All-Big 12 Second Team in 2020 at Baylor.
- Teague leads the team and ranks 6th in the Big 12 in scoring (15.3), 6th in field goal percentage (.485), 6th in free throw percentage (.842), 8th in 3-pointers made (2.0/game), 13th in minutes (30.5) and 18th in rebounding (5.2).
- Teague played in 90 consecutive games and made 86 consecutive starts before sitting out two games with a broken wrist. He has started all but 3 games (Nov. 20, 2016, Feb. 18, 2020, Feb. 22, 2020) in his career.
- Baylor is 26-1 when Teague scores 10+ points. He's averaging 9.5 ppg in BU's 4 losses with him (8, 8, 13, 9).

MITCHELL RETURNS AS STARTING POINT GUARD

- Davion Mitchell was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, selected to the All-Big 12 Third Team and Big 12 All-Defensive Team and was a unanimous choice on the Big 12 All-Newcomer Team.
- Mitchell leads the Big 12 in steals (2.3/game) and 3-point percentage (.536), ranks 2nd in assists (6.0), 4th in 3-pointers made (2.5/game), 8th in AST-TO ratio (2.25) and 17th in scoring (13.2).
- Mitchell has started all 36 games at BU after coming off the bench in all 34 games as an Auburn freshman (2017-18).
- Mitchell has made a 3-pointer in 27 of the last 32 games and is shooting 39% on 3FGs in that stretch (47-of-120). Prior to that stretch, he shot .264 (19-of-72) from downtown over his first 38 collegiate games.
- When Mitchell has played 20+ minutes, his collegiate teams are 43-4 (12-0 at Auburn, 31-4 at Baylor).
- When Mitchell scores 10+ points, his collegiate teams are 20-1 (2-0 at Auburn, 18-1 at Baylor).

GAME 7 — CENTRAL ARKANSAS

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Drew is in his 18th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (348).
- Baylor has had a nation-leading four players selected in the NBA Draft since 2010 who weren't ranked in the ESPN100 out of high school — Quincy Acy, Ekpe Udoh, Pierre Jackson and Taurean Prince.
- Drew has graduated 52 players during his Baylor tenure, averaging 3 graduates per season.
- The Bears have advanced to postseason play in a school-record eight straight seasons (6 NCAA, 2 NIT).
- Baylor is 23-4 in regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, including 4 regular-season tournament titles.
- Drew has won 20+ games in 11 of the last 13 years the Bears had 3 seasons of 20+ wins prior to his arrival.

PROTECTING HALFTIME LEADS

- Baylor is 60-5 in its last 65 games when leading at the half, including 21-2 last year, 15-3 in 2019 and 15-0 in 2018.
- Baylor has won 89% of its games (175-21) when leading at the half since 2011-12 (21-2 in 2019-20, 15-3 in 2018-19, 15-0 in 2017-18, 18-3 in 2016-17, 18-2 in 2015-16, 21-7 in 2014-15, 18-2 in 2013-14, 17-1 in 2012-13 and 26-1 in 2011-12).
- BU has won 39% of games in which its been tied or trailing at the half since 2011-12, going 48-76 in those.

SECOND-MOST WINS AMONG BIG 12 TEAMS SINCE 2011-12

- Baylor's 223-97 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (272-64) among Big 12 teams (thru 12/28/20).
- West Virginia (197-122) and Iowa State (197-116) are tied for 3rd, Kansas State (186-127) is 4th, Oklahoma (185-119) is 5th, Texas (177-136) is 7th, Oklahoma St. (168-137) is 8th, Texas Tech (166-139) is 9th and TCU (159-152) is 10th.
- Baylor has averaged 24.1 wins per season over the last nine full seasons since 2011-12.

BIG 12'S SECOND-BEST ROAD MARK SINCE 2012

- Baylor is 42-40 in Big 12 road games since 2012, 2nd-best in the league behind only Kansas (thru 12/28/20).

- BU is 40-5 in December games since 2013, with the only losses at No. 24 Texas A&M (2015), vs. No. 8 Wichita State (2017), at No. 22 Texas Tech (2017), at Wichita State (2018) and vs. SFA (2018).

EIGHT CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of eight consecutive postseason berths, surpassing the total number of postseason berths in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
- Baylor is 1 of 14 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Cincinnati, Duke, Gonzaga, Iona, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan State, New Mexico State, North Carolina, Oregon, Saint Mary's, Virginia and Wichita State.
- BU earned NCAA Tournament bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2019 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has made postseason appearances in 11 of 12 seasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).
- Baylor is 21-10 in postseason national tournaments during the Drew era after going 3-9 prior to Drew's arrival.

FIVE MARCH MADNESS APPEARANCES IN LAST SIX TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor has appeared in five of the last six NCAA Tournaments dating back to 2014.

HISTORY OF DEVELOPMENT WITH REDSHIRTS

- Baylor has a track record of success when redshirting players. Ekpe Udoh, Johnathan Motley, Cory Jefferson,
 Brady Heslip, Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. and Manu Lecomte have all gone on to professional careers after redshirting.
- Mark Vital, Freddie Gillespie, MaCio Teague and Davion Mitchell have earned All-Big 12 honors after redshirting.
- Adam Flagler and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua redshirted last season while sitting out to satisfy NCAA transfer rules, while freshman Jordan Turner elected to redshirt last year. Dain Dainja is redshirting in 2020-21.

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING BECOMING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- Baylor has ranked top-10 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in every season since 2013-14, including five times ranked in the nation's top-4. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor's 7-year streak is the nation's best, and West Virginia (6 years) is the only other team with a 3+ year streak.
- The Bears ranked 8th nationally in offensive rebounding percentage (35.7) in 2019-20.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 2 nationally in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that top-10 streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

- Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Network from Learfield IMG College on ESPN Central Texas and flagship station 1660AM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.
- Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and former Baylor basketball standout Pat Nunley.
- Morris is in his 37th year doing BU broadcasts (26th full-time), and Nunley is in his 40th season as analyst.

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Three current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.

- Grant McCasland is in his fourth season as head coach at North Texas. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Paul Mills is in his fourth season as head coach at Oral Roberts. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.






