

TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Baylor's 33 points in the 4th quarter set a Big 12 record for the most points in a single quarter in Big 12 Championship history.
- Baylor was 14-for-14 at the free throw line, a Big 12 record for most in a Championship game without a miss.
- Baylor's 41 defensive rebounds set the single-game record for the Big 12 Championship.
- Baylor's 7 points allowed in the 1st quarter was tied for the 6th-fewest allowed in a Big 12 Championship game.
- The 37-point margin of victory tied for the 3rd-largest in Big 12 Championship history.
- Baylor's 55 points in the second half were tied for 2nd most in Big 12 Championship history.
- Baylor's 92 points were tied for 10th most in Big 12 Championship history.
- Baylor's 37 field goals made were tied for 5th most in Big 12 Championship history.
- Baylor's defense held TCU to .264 shooting, tied for the 9th lowest output in Big 12 Championship history.
- Baylor's 52 rebounds were tied for 8th most in Big 12 Championship history.
- Baylor's 10 blocks were tied for the 5th most in Big 12 Championship history and tied BU's second-best effort.
- Baylor improved to 44-13 (.772) in the Big 12 Championship All-Time.
- Baylor improved to 43-9 (.827) in the Big 12 Championship under Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor is now 25-1 (.962) in the Big 12 Championship since 2011.
- Baylor improved to 18-4 all-time in the Big 12 Championship quarterfinals.
- Baylor improved to 2-0 all-time vs. TCU in the Big 12 Championship.
- Queen Egbo's 12 defensive rebounds were tied for the 10th most in Big 12 Championship history.
- Egbo's six blocks were a career-high and tied for 9th most in Big 12 Championship history.

TEAM NOTES

- Baylor improved to 627-103 (.859) under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor moved to 43-5 all-time vs. TCU [20-0 in the Mulkey era].
- Baylor's win over TCU is the 32nd-straight for the Lady Bears in the series.
- Baylor's overall win streak reached 15 games.
- Baylor is 363-27 (.931) since the 2010-11 season.
- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in 155 of the last 165 games.
- Baylor's 14-14 performance at the free-throw line was the third most field goals made in school history without a miss.
- All 11 Lady Bears scored at least 2 points.
- Baylor is 244-1 all-time when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
- In 716 of 730 games under Mulkey, the Lady Bears have held their opponent at or below 50 percent field goal shooting with only eight of those efforts coming in the last 15 seasons.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- NaLyssa Smith reached double figures in scoring for the 23rd-straight game with 26 points.
- The performance marked Smith's 10th game with 20+ points this season and 17th of her career.
- Smith's 26-point outing was her 62nd-career game with 10+ and 24th of the 2020-21 season.
- DiJonai Carrington dropped 17 points, the 16th time this season and 60th time in her career that she has reached double figures.
- Jordyn Oliver tallied 11 points, the third double-digit effort of her career.
- Oliver also tallied her 100th-career assist as part of her three-dish performance.
- Queen Egbo recorded double-digit rebounds for the fourth-straight game with 12 against the Horned Frogs.
- It's the ninth time this season and 21st time in her career that Egbo has snagged at least 10 boards.
- Egbo also eclipsed 100 career blocks with her six swats in the contest.
- Moon Ursin grabbed 10 rebounds, her fifth double-digit outing with at least 10 this season and sixth of her career.
