## **TOURNAMENT NOTES**

- Baylor improved to 52-15 (.776) all-time in the NCAA Tournament, all coming under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor is 15-3 all-time in second-round games with 12-straight advances to the Sweet 16.
- Baylor's 42-point win was the largest margin of victory in an NCAA Second-Round game.
- Baylor's 13 blocks is tied for the third-most in an NCAA Tournament game in program history.
- DiDi Richards now ranks third all-time among Baylor players in the NCAA Tournament with 45 career assists with nine assists and zero turnovers vs. Va Tech.
- Queen Egbo had seven blocks, the seventh-most by a BU player in an NCAA Tournament game.
- Mulkey has guided the Lady Bears to 19 NCAA Tournament appearances and 17-straight.
- Seventeen straight NCAA Tournament appearances ranks 12th all-time and is the fifth-longest active streak.
- Baylor is a No. 2 seed, and it marks the 10th-straight year that Baylor is at least a two seed or higher.
- Baylor earned trips to the Final Four in 2005, 2010, 2012 and 2019. Baylor won the NCAA titles in 2005, 2012 and 2019.
- · Baylor's string of 16-straight NCAA Tournament appearances ranks sixth-best among active streaks in the NCAA
- Baylor is 4-5 all-time in Elite 8 contests.
- Baylor is 9-5 all-time in Sweet 16 contests.
- The 42-point margin of victory is Baylor's largest in a second-round NCAA Tournament game.

## **TEAM NOTES**

- Baylor improved to 631-103 (.860) under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor improved to 1.0 vs. Virginia Tech all-time.
- Baylor's overall win streak reached 19 games.
- Baylor is 367-27 (.932) since the 2010-11 season.
- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in 159 of the last 169 games.

• In 720 of 734 games under Mulkey, the Lady Bears have held their opponent at or below 50 percent field goal shooting with only eight of those efforts coming in the last 15 seasons.

## **INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

- After scoring 21 points, Moon Ursin now has 60 career points in the NCAA Tournament. She entered this year's postseason with just 15.
- It's Ursin's seventh-career game with 20+ points and 33rd of her career in double figures.
- DiJonai Carrington's recorded a career-best 21-point performance in the NCAA Tournament.
- This is Carrington's eighth-career postseason outing in double figures.
- Queen Egbo's 12 points were a career-best in the NCAA Tournament.
- Combined with her 13 rebounds, Egbo produced her first-career NCAA Tournament double-double.
- It's Egbo's 19th double-double of her career.
- Egbo led the Lady Bears with three steals
