#### TWO TO GO

 No. 9 Baylor welcomes Kansas State and Texas State for its last two regular-season matches of the year this week.

**Current Streak:**

• The Bears are currently 18-5 and will look to complete their fifth-straight 20-win season if they can collect wins over the Wildcats and Bobcats.

• BU is coming off a four-set home loss to former No. 2-ranked Texas, which snapped a 28-game home winning streak.

• Baylor has already faced K-State twice in the fall, winning both Big 12 matchups, as well as sweeping Texas State earlier in March in San Marcos.

#### AGAINST THE WILDCATS

 Baylor has won each of its last five meetings with K-State, including a two-match sweep at the Ferrell Center in November.

- Under sixth-year head coach Ryan McGuyre, the Bears are 9-3 against the Wildcats.
- Five of the last six contests between BU and K-State have resulted in Baylor sweeps.

#### **AGAINST THE BOBCATS**

6 p.m.

- BU holds a seven-match winning streak against Texas State, dating back to 2013.
- The Bears won this season's earlier meeting 3-0 in San Marcos.
- Under McGuyre, Baylor is 6-0 against the Bobcats.

#### THEY'RE COMING BACK

 On Monday, seniors Yossiana Pressley and Hannah Sedwick announced their intent to return to Baylor volleyball in the fall of 2021.

 All current NCAA Division I fall and winter student-athletes have been offered eligibility relief due to COVID-19.

• Pressley and Sedwick will return for their fifth years as Bears, having come to BU together as freshmen in 2017.

#### **SELECTION SUNDAY**

• The 2021 DI Women's Volleyball Selection Show is set for 3 p.m. CT on Sunday, April 4 and will be aired on ESPNU.

- A field of 48 teams will be announced for this season's championship, including 30 automatic qualifiers and 18 at-large bids.
- The field will be seeded in full 1-48, with the top-16 teams earning a first round bye.
- The remaining 32 teams will open play on Wednesday, April 14 in Omaha, Neb.

#### **Quick Hits**

#### **PRESSLEY A SENIOR CLASS AWARD FINALIST**

• Senior OH Yossiana Pressley was announced as one of 10 finalists amongst NCAA volleyball student-athletes considered for the 2021 Senior CLASS Award, which recognizes excellence both on and off the court.

• Pressley is the third Baylor finalist in program history, joining Katie Staiger (2016) and Shelly Stafford (2019), who both earned second team recognition.

• To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as a senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

• An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

• Nationwide fan voting begins immediately, and fans are encouraged to vote on the Senior CLASS Award wbesite through April 14. Fan votes will then be combined with media and Division I head coaches' votes to determine the winner.

• The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2020-21 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in April.

#### **IT'S HER CROWN**

 After undergoing offseason surgery, reigning national player of the year Yossiana Pressley has found her form in 2020-21 with 4.66 kills per set on a .256 attack percentage. She has recorded 22 double-digit kill performances, including a season-high outing with 32 against Texas on Nov. 6.

• Pressley was named the 2020 Preseason Big 12 Player of the Year and earned a spot on the preseason all-conference team.

• In her career, Pressley has recorded 95 double-digit kill performances, including 32 matches with at least 20 kills, and six outings with at least 30 putaways.

• Pressley owns the school record for kills in a single match with 39, coming in a five-set victory at lowa State in 2018. She became the first Bear since Stevie Nicholas in 2001 to record over 35 kills in a match.

• Pressley has won a Big 12 record 19 Big 12 weekly awards, most recently collecting her firstcareer defensive honor on March 24, 2021.

• Pressley is also the NCAA's career leader amongst active players with 1,869 kills, 4.58 kills per set and 4,595 total attacks.

#### HANNAH SET-WICK

• After an outstanding 45-assist performance in which she averaged 15 assists per set at Texas State on March 10, senior setter Hannah Sedwick was named the Sports Impacts/AVCA National Player of the Week on March 17.

• She was also honored as the Big 12's Offensive Player of the Week.

• The Des Moines, Iowa, native was electric in the Bears' only match of the week, spreading the ball around as four teammates tallied at least 10 kills, a program first under McGuyre in three-set matches.

• Sedwick became Baylor's fifth AVCA National Player of the Week recipient in program history and the first since Yossiana Pressley earned the title on Sept. 10, 2019.

• Sedwick picked up her fifth career Big 12 weekly award, third as offensive player of the week and first of the 2020-21 campaign.

#### **CARDIAC KIDS**

• Baylor has played eight five-set matches for the second time in the last three seasons.

- BU has won five of those eight contests.
- Three of BU's five losses have come in five sets.
- Under sixth-year head coach Ryan McGuyre, the Bears are 22-13 in five-setters.

## HOME COOKING

- Over the last two seasons, Baylor is 27-1 at the Ferrell Center.
- Under McGuyre, BU is 71-18 at home.

• BU's 28-game home winning streak was snapped last week as No. 2 Texas defeated the Bears in four sets. Both of Baylor's last two home losses have come to UT.

• Baylor is guaranteed to finish the 2020-21 season with its second-best home record in the McGuyre era.

#### **Quick Hits (continued)**

#### **DOMINATION UP FRONT**

 Baylor has held its opponents to below a .166 hitting percentage 15 times in the 2020-21 campaign.

The Bears have totaled at least 10 blocks as a team 10 times this year.

 Sophomore MB Kara McGhee (107, 2nd) and junior OPP Marieke van der Mark (66, 7th) have powered the Bears block, each ranking in the top-10 in the Big 12 Conference in total blocks.

 Senior MB Preslie Anderson has joined in on the block party with 32 total blocks in her first seven matches with the Bears.

#### **HIT THE FLOOR**

 Head coach Ryan McGuyre has raved about his team's floor defense as of late, with strong production coming from junior L/DS Shanel Bramschreiber in the backcourt.

 Bramschreiber leads the Bears with 3.62 digs per set (7th in the Big 12) and has tallied at least 15 digs in 11 matches this year.

 Redshirt-junior S Callie Williams has recorded double-digit digs eight times this season and has proved to be a valuable asset on the defensive end, in addition to her setting.

 Campbell Bowden has also contributed, starting in 19 of her 21 matches played in 2020-21. She collected a career-high 12 digs at No. 2 Texas on March 3, 2021.

 Emily Van Slate has chipped in with nine double-digit dig performances, including a career-high 15 at Houston on March 18.

#### NEW IN 2020-21

• Due to precautions taken in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Ferrell Center will be restricted to 25 percent capacity in order to provide the safest environment for student-athletes, fans, coaches and staffs.

 The revised 2020 fall schedule included a new, 16-match format in which teams played on back-to-back days against league opponents.

 The season has resumed in the spring with 11 scheduled matches for the Bears before postseason play in April.

 The Big 12 has set the minimum number of players required to play a match this season at nine, which must include one setter. Teams falling below the benchmark, based on game week test results, could still elect to play as scheduled if so desired. Otherwise, upon approval by Big 12 Commissioner Bob Bowlsby, the match would be declared a no-contest if it cannot be moved to a later date.

#### POSTSEASON BUBBLE IN OMAHA

This season's NCAA Championship will be held exclusively in Omaha, Neb. from April 13-24.

 Selection Sunday for the NCAA Championship is currently set for April 4, 2021, with 48 teams being selected for the postseason.

 The NCAA will award 30 automatic bids and select 18 at-large teams to complete the postseason field.

Texas claimed the Big 12 bid by winning the regular season with a 14-0 mark in the fall.

#### **LEADERSHIP FROM THE TOP**

 Reigning AVCA National Coach of the Year Ryan McGuyre is in his sixth season at the helm for the Bears.

• The Bears are 130-48 (.730) under McGuyre.

McGuyre led the Bears to their first conference title in 2019, going 29-2 (15-1 Big 12).

 McGuyre has guided the Bears to the postseason in four-consecutive years, only falling short of the NCAA Tournament in his first season as Baylor's head coach (2015).

#### **FINISHING STRONG IN BIG 12 PLAY**

Baylor has finished in the top-four of the conference standings in each of the last five seasons.

 Though receiving three first-place votes, the Bears were picked to finish second in the Big 12 for the third consecutive season.

 BU has matched or surpassed its Big 12 preseason poll prediction in each of the last five seasons.

RYAN MCGUYRE 6th season at Baylor 19th season overall (w) 28th season overall (w/m)

In five seasons at the helm of Baylor volleyball, head coach Ryan McGuyre has put the program amongst the sport's biggest names and into the national spotlight. After narrowly missing the postseason in his first year, McGuyre

and the Bears marched their way to the program's first Big 12 title and the NCAA National Semifinals in 2019 while earning the school's first No. 1 AVCA national ranking and No. 1 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Entering his sixth season, McGuyre has compiled five consecutive winning seasons, four-straight 20-win seasons and a program-best four consecutive NCAA appearances since his arrival in 2015.

Named the 2019 AVCA and VolleyballMag.com National Coach of the Year, 2019 AVCA Southwest Region Coach of the Year, 2017 and 2019 Big 12 Coach of the Year, McGuyre has coached nine AVCA All-America selections, 11 All-Region honorees, 18 All-Big 12 awardees and 39 Academic All-Big 12 selections at Baylor.

McGuyre's teams continue to lock down home court advantage behind recordbreaking crowds at the Ferrell Center. Baylor has broken its own attendance record in three straight seasons. Last season's win against No. 1 Texas on Nov. 20 drew 7,357 fans, almost double the old attendance record set earlier against Tennessee in September.

Baylor went an unblemished 17-0 at home in 2019, securing wins over five ranked opponents and hosting through the NCAA Regional final to book a spot in Pittsburgh, Pa.

Along with matching the most home wins in program history with 13 in 2017, BU's season opener against LSU in 2018 drew a record crowd of 3,858. The team has had 10 top-10 crowds at the Ferrell Center under McGuyre.

McGuyre has coached at the collegiate level for both men and women since 1999 including head-coaching stints at California Baptist (CBU) and Biola University, both of which are faith-based institutions.

As associate head coach for two seasons, McGuyre and the Florida State Seminoles finished a 2014 NCAA Tournament run reaching the Sweet 16 before a loss to national runner-up, BYU. Prior to his arrival at Florida State, McGuyre was an assistant at Maryland for one season following a 10-year head coaching stint at CBU. There, he was the head coach for both the men's and women's programs, and he crafted a men's program that won six NAIA national championships and three women's national titles.

Among many accolades at CBU, McGuyre was named the 2005 NAIA Men's National Coach of the Year and in 2011 the NCCAA Division I National Coach of the Year. In 2010, he made history by being named both the AVCA Men's and Women's NAIA National Coach of the Year in the same calendar year.

A 1998 graduate of Biola, McGuyre is married to former University of Hawaii volleyball standout and USA National Team member Jennifer (Roberts) McGuyre. The couple has three children: sons, Tryston and Ryder, and a daughter, Kitana.




