POSTSEASON STORYLINES

- For the 23rd-consecutive year, the Baylor men's tennis team is competing in the NCAA Tennis Championships.
- The Bears are making their third appearance in the NCAA National Championship and first since 2005.
- The No. 1-ranked and second-seeded Bears will face No. 2-ranked and top-seeded Florida on Saturday at 6:30 p.m. CT/7:30 p.m. ET for the national title.
- The Bears are 1-1 all-time in NCAA National Championship matches, having previously won the title in 2004.
- BU enters the Championship on an eight-match winning streak, which included the 2021 Big 12 Tournament Championship in Waco, Texas on April 25-26. The Bears have won 18 of their last 19 matches, dating back to March 11.
- Baylor compiled a 20-4 record against the NCAA Tournament field, including wins over No. 4 seed Texas, No. 7 TCU, No. 8 Texas A&M, No. 10 Wake Forest and No. 16 Illinois during the regular season.
- BU is currently 34-4 on the season, including 18 wins over ranked opponents.
- All four of Baylor's losses in 2021 came to NCAA Tournament teams.

TEAM NOTES

- The Bears are 12-2 all-time as the No. 2 seed in the NCAA Championship. BU was last the No. 2 seed in 2015 where they advanced to the NCAA semifinals in Waco.
- BU is 18-4 against ranked opponents this season.
- BU won its 23rd and 24th Big 12 titles with a share of the regular-season trophy and a tournament championship victory on its home courts in Waco.
- BU is 29-9 in the doubles point this season. The Bears are 28-1 when winning the opening tally and 6-3 when dropping the opening point.
- Baylor's 34 wins in a single season is a school record - 2005's 33 was the previous best.
- Baylor men's tennis placed six student-athletes on the Academic All-Big 12 Team.
- Michael Woodson was named the 10th head coach in program history on May 6, 2021, as he previously served as the team's interim head coach.

STREAKS & TRENDS

- For the 23rd-consecutive season, the Baylor men's tennis team secured a bid to the NCAA Tournament.
- The Bears have won eight matches in a row heading into the NCAA Semifinals and 18 of their last 19 contests.
- Spencer Furman leads the Bears with a 14-match singles winning streak.
- Finn Bass/Charlie Broom lead the Bears with a five-match doubles win streak.

WHEN HOSTING THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

- Baylor hosted the NCAA First and Second Rounds for the 15th time overall and 14th time in the last 19 seasons.
- When BU has hosted the NCAA First and Second Rounds, it has advanced to the Round of 16 each time (15 seasons).
- BU is 33-1 all-time in the NCAA Championship when playing on its home courts. Its lone loss came when BU was hosting the final site to eventual national champion Virginia in the 2015 NCAA National Semifinals.
- When hosting the NCAA First and Second Rounds, BU is 22-0 in 4-0 matches, 4-0 in 4-1 matches, 3-0 in 4-2 matches and 1-0 in 4-3 decisions.

HOME SWEET HOME

- The Bears went 20-2 at home this season and won six matches over ranked opponents in Waco.
- BU is 71-5 in its last 76 home matches dating back to the beginning of the 2017 season.
- In all of its 2021 home wins, Baylor outscored its opponents 120-19 in 20 matches.
- BU swept 14 teams at home this season.

SERIES HISTORY VS. FLORIDA

- Florida holds a 7-6 advantage over the Bears in the all-time series.
- The Gators have taken four of the last five meetings versus BU.
- Baylor and Florida have split the two previous postseason matchups (2005, 2019).
- In their most recent meeting, UF defeated Baylor 4-0 in the 2019 quarterfinals held in Orlando at the USTA National Campus.
- In 2005, the Bears took down the Gators 4-1 in the semifinals held in College Station, Texas.
- The Bears and Gators had seen each other at least once in each year from 2004-13, but have only met once since the 2013 campaign (2019).

GOAT STATUS

- On April 13, fifth-year senior Constantin Frantzen broke Baylor's all-time record for career doubles victories with his 105th, surpassing Benjamin Becker.
- Frantzen currently sits alone atop the leaderboard with 108 career doubles wins.
- Partnered with Sven Lah, Frantzen is ranked No. 9 in the country in doubles per the latest Oracle/ITA rankings.
- The Augsburg, Germany native is BU's active leader with 187 combined wins in his career.

GO HERTS!

- Finn Bass and Charlie Broom represent the same county in the United Kingdom.
- The duo have known each other since childhood, growing up in Hertfordshire, England.
- Now, after only playing one doubles tournament together previously in the summer of 2019, they are competing for the same university after Broom decided to use his extra year of eligibility by transferring to Baylor.
- Bass and Broom are 9-3 together in doubles on the season, entering the lineup just ahead of Big 12 conference play on March 28 at SMU.

THE MAN IN CHARGE

- Michael Woodson was promoted to head coach on May 6 after previously serving as the interim head coach following the departure of Brian Boland.
- In his fifth season with the program, Woodson has compiled a 34-4 record in his first year in charge, leading the Bears to a pair of Big 12 titles.
- Woodson previously served as BU's assistant coach from 2016-19 before being elevated to associate head coach.

NUMBER ONE IN THE NATION

- On April 28, BU was ranked the No. 1 team in the nation per the Oracle/ITA rankings.
- It's the first time since 2005 that the Bears have been ranked as the top team in the country.
- This marks the 17th time and just the third different season in program history that BU has been tabbed No. 1, having first achieved the ranking in the final poll of the 2004 season and holding the spot until the final installment of the 2005 campaign.
- Men's tennis became the fourth Baylor program to achieve a No. 1 ranking in the 2020-21 season, joining acrobatics & tumbling (national champion), men's basketball (national champion) and women's golf (national championship participants).

CHIP ON THEIR SHOULDER

- Despite the No. 1 ranking, Baylor earned the No. 2 overall seed to the NCAA Championship.
- Baylor was ranked the No. 15 team in the nation in the Oracle/ITA preseason poll.
- The Bears were picked to finish second in the Big 12 preseason poll, behind TCU.
- No Bears were ranked inside the top-40 of the Oracle/ITA preseason singles rankings.

ALL-BIG 12 AWARDS

- Baylor had seven players earn 10 Big 12 postseason honors on Tuesday, May 11, headlined by unanimous Newcomer of the Year Charlie Broom.
- Broom is the seventh Bear all-time to earn the award and first since 2015 (Max Tchoutakian).
- Adrian Boitan and Matias Soto were unanimously selected to the All-Big 12 Singles First Team.
- Broom and Nick Stachowiak landed on the All-Big 12 Singles Second Team.
- Constantin Frantzen and Sven Lah were chosen to the All-Big 12 Doubles First Team.
- Soto and Stachowiak garnered a spot on the All-Big 12 Doubles Second Team.
- Boitan (No. 1 singles), Broom (No. 5 singles) and Spencer Furman (No. 6 singles) were each crowned the Big 12 individual champion at their respective position.

COACHING STAFF



MICHAEL WOODSON
HEAD COACH • 5TH SEASON AT BAYLOR
VALPARAISO, 2012 • 1ST SEASON AS HEAD COACH

Michael Woodson was promoted to head coach of the Baylor men's tennis team on May 6, 2021, after being named interim head coach for the 2020-21 season. He enters his fifth season with the Bears after previously serving as associate head coach. He was the assistant coach for three seasons before being promoted in Dec. 2019.

Woodson also served a stint as the program's interim head coach from May 13 to May 24, 2018, prior to Brian Boland's hire as the Director of Tennis.

Despite the 2020 season being cut short, Woodson and the Bears recorded a 13-3 record and a perfect 10-0 mark in Waco.

In 2019, Woodson helped Baylor reach its 13th NCAA quarterfinal appearance and earn the program's ninth Big 12 postseason title. Individually, he mentored ITA Doubles All-Americans and All-Big 12 honorees Jimmy Bendeck and Sven Lah and saw them post the second-most wins in BU history with a 28-7 record. He also saw Adrian Boitan go 16-4 on the singles court and earn Big 12 Freshman of the Year, ITA Regional Rookie of the Year and Big 12 Championship MOP honors. Woodson also guided Matias Soto to his first career All-Big 12 singles honors with an 18-5 spring record.

During the 2017-18 season, Woodson helped guide Baylor to its 21st consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and a 21-10 overall record without a senior on the roster. Woodson mentored three All-Big 12 honorees in Sven Lah, Roy Smith and Will Little. Lah and Smith finished their freshman seasons with an impressive 17-2 doubles record and earned first team and all-tournament recognition. Little compiled a 17-9 overall singles record and his second straight All-Big 12 honor while earning his first all-tournament award.

In his first season in Waco, Woodson contributed immediately as BU advanced to its 17th Sweet 16 appearance in the last 19 years. He helped coach senior Max Tchoutakian to a 15-3 singles record and guided Johannes Schretter and Jimmy Bendeck to an 11-3 doubles record. During the summer, he served as the USTA National Collegiate Team coach.

Prior to coming to Waco, Woodson had been a member of the Valparaiso men's tennis coaching staff since the 2012-13 season, after concluding a three-year career on the court for the Crusaders. In May 2015, Woodson was promoted to associate head coach and went on to help Valpo set a school record for wins (22-6), claim conference regular season and tournament titles and earn the program's first-ever NCAA Championship appearance.

In his four years as a Crusader assistant, Woodson's teams racked up a 73-34 record. He had five players earn first team All-Horizon League accolades and three more card second-team honors. Nineteen times Valparaiso players won conference Player of the Week honors under Woodson. Individually, Woodson helped Jeffrey Schorsch become the winningest singles player in school history and win back-to-back Horizon League Player of the Year honors. He also guided Charlie Ernhardt to break the all-time doubles win record at Valpo. Meanwhile, Woodson's student-athletes also secured a pair of league Freshman of the Year awards during his Valpo tenure.

During his playing career with the Crusaders, Woodson was a three-year starter who split time between No. 5 and 6 singles, while appearing at No. 2 and 3 doubles for the Brown and Gold. For his senior season, Woodson was named a team captain for the Crusaders. Woodson was recognized with the Bill Steinbrecher Sportsmanship Award and the athletic department's Laurel Award, which honors the graduating senior student-athlete with the highest cumulative grade point average.

Woodson graduated from Valparaiso in May of 2012 as a triple major in biology, chemistry and exercise science. He also earned a master's degree in sport administration from Valpo in December of 2013.

He married his wife, Vanessa, in July 2017. The couple has two children, Jordyn and Kiley.
