- Baylor Captains: Dillon Doyle, Jacob Gall, Cole Maxwell and Abram Smith.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas' 166 total yards were the fewest allowed by Baylor since September 2, 2016 against Northwestern State (78).
- It's the fewest total yards allowed by Baylor in a Big 12 game since October, 15 2016 against Kansas (217).
- It's the 2nd time in the 26-year Big 12 Era that Baylor has held 3-straight opponents under 300 yards of total offense. The only other time was 2019 vs. SFA, vs. UTSA and at Rice.
- Baylor improved to 8-1 in Big 12 openers since 2013 and 12-14 all-time in Big 12 openers.
- Baylor started 3-0 for the 8th time in 11 seasons.
- Baylor's first offensive play from scrimmage gained a first down for the the third-straight week.
- Baylor is now 6-of-7 on 4th downs this season.
- **Gerry Bohanon's** 69-yard touchdown pass to **RJ Sneed** in the 3rd quarter was Baylor's longest completion since a 78-yard connection from Jacob Zeno to Chris Platt in the 2019 Big 12 Championship Game.
- **Gavin Yates'** 2-yard touchdown run was the first time a Baylor player has scored from the fullback spot since Jerod Monk's 1-yard TD run vs. Kent State on October 3, 2009.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- **Trestan Ebner** moved past Tevin Reese for 10th all-time in career all-purpose yards at Baylor (3,286).
- With 74 rushing yards on Saturday, Ebner moved into 36th place on Baylor's career rushing yards list (1,210).
- **RJ Sneed's** 69-yard touchdown reception was the longest of his career.
- Sneed became the 21st player in Baylor history with 100-career receptions.
- With 128 receiving yards on Saturday, Sneed is now 26th in career receiving yards at Baylor (1,251).
- **Abram Smith** eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark for a third-straight game. He is the first Baylor running back with 3-straight 100-yard games since Shock Linwood in 2015.
- With 33 rushing yards on Saturday, quarterback **Gerry Bhoanon** moved in to the top-10 in career rushing yards by a quarterback (365).
- Nine-straight completions to start a game for Bohanon were the most for a Baylor quarterback since Zach Smith started 11-for-11 at Kansas State on September 30th, 2019.
- **Ben Sims'** 4th career receiving touchdown tied him with Steve Stutsman and Jordan Najvar for 5th-most in program history by a tight end.
- **Gavin Yates** scored his career-first touchdown on Saturday.
