STORY LINES

- No. 1 Baylor heads to Fort Worth for a road game at TCU on Saturday at 4 pm CT on ESPN+.
- Saturday is the 189th series meeting – BU leads 103-85, including a 42-43 mark in Fort Worth.
- Scott Drew is coaching his 600th game at Baylor on Saturday (384-215 overall, 350-146 since 2008).
- Baylor is 14-4 against TCU as Big 12 rivals. The Bears won the first 11 Big 12 series meetings.
- BU is 6-3 in games at TCU as Big 12 rivals, but TCU has won 3 of the last 4 meetings in Fort Worth.
- Baylor won 67-49 when the teams met in Fort Worth on Jan. 9 last season, but BU returns only 8 of its 67 points scored in that game. The rematch in Waco was canceled due to COVID protocols.
- In Tuesday's 10-point win vs. OU, Baylor had a 34-16 rebounding edge (19-0 in 2nd-chance points).
- With its 77-72 win at No. 8 Iowa State last Saturday, Baylor has now won 9-straight games against top-10 ranked teams, beating Nos. 5, 9, 6, 6, 10, 6, 1, 6 and 8, respectively. Baylor is the 6th team all-time to win 9-straight vs. top-10 teams, with Villanova (2016-18) the only other since 2000.
- Baylor is 15-3 in Big 12 road games over the last 3 seasons (rest of league is 61-103 in B12 road games).
- BU has the nation's longest winning streak (20), with 9 at neutral sites, 2 on the road and all by 5+ points.
- There have been four winning streaks of 20+ in the Big 12's 26-year history – 23 by Baylor in 2019-20, 22 by Kansas in 1997-98, 20 by Kansas in 2007-08 and the current 20-game Baylor streak.
- BU is 29-0 vs. unranked teams over the last 2 seasons (+25.1 avg margin) with all wins by 5+ points.
- Baylor's 30-4 Big 12 conference record over the last 3 seasons is the best of any Power-5 team.
- Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 6 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
- Saturday is Baylor's 21st all-time game as a No. 1-ranked team – BU is 18-2 while ranked No. 1.
- Baylor is 1 of 3 remaining undefeated teams (Baylor, Colorado State, USC). The Bears were the next-to-last undefeated team a season ago after starting 18-0 (Gonzaga started 31-0).
- Baylor's bench has out-scored the opponents' bench in 11 of 14 games and by an average of 30-21.
- BU is allowing only 6.1 second-chance points per game, while scoring 13.8 second-chance points.
- Baylor is averaging 11 more field goal attempts per game than its opponents (BU 65, OPP 54).
- BU is top-20 nationally in scoring offense (12th) and defense (18th). No other team is top-30 in both.
- Baylor ranks top-15 nationally in scoring margin (2nd, +24.1), assists (7th, 18.6), turnovers forced (11th, 18.4), rebounding margin (11th, +10.3), steals (13th, 10.3), offensive rebounds (13th, 14.0), field goal percentage (13th, .493) and turnover margin (14th, +5.6).
- Baylor's defense has recorded 7+ steals and 13+ turnovers forced in all 14 games this season.
- BU has 10+ offensive rebounds in 18-straight games, the nation's 2nd-longest streak (Bowling Green-19).
- BU's 46-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 is the nation's 3rd-longest behind Gonzaga and Villanova.
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 38-straight weeks top-10 ranked (top-5 ranked in 35 of those).
- Baylor has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 at some point in the last 7 years.
- BU has led by at least 4 points in all 74 games since the start of the 2019-20 season and built a double-digit lead in 65 of those games, including 41 of 44 games since the start of last season.

QUICK HITS

- BU is 19-3 against ranked teams since beating No. 17 Villanova to win the 2019 Myrtle Beach Invite.
- Head coach **Scott Drew** is in his 19th season at Baylor with a school-record 384 career victories, including a 17-8 mark in NCAA Tournaments, which is the 7th-best mark among active coaches.
- Baylor's 42-2 record over the last two seasons is the nation's best, and the Bears' 68-6 record over the last three seasons is 2nd-best nationally, trailing only Gonzaga (73-5).
- Baylor's streak of 18-straight wins by 8+ points was snapped in a 5-point win at Iowa State. BU was the first returning national champion to win its first 12 games by 8+ points since 1990-91 UNLV.
- Baylor has won 36 straight non-conference games (+23.2 average margin) dating back to Nov. 2019.
- BU ranks 5th nationally in KenPom's offensive rebound pct (39.8), its 8th-straight year ranked top-10.
- BU is playing its 293rd game as a ranked team under Drew – BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since January 2010, BU has been ranked in 277 of 414 games.
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-5 schools to win 18+ games every year since 2008.
- Baylor's streak of 9 consecutive postseasons is tied as the nation's 7th-longest active streak.
- Baylor has won 20+ games in 12 of the last 14 seasons after recording only three 20-win seasons in the previous 100 years of Baylor Basketball (1946, 1948, 1988).
- Baylor is 88-5 when leading at halftime over the last 5 seasons (58-2 over last 3 seasons, 24-0 last season).
- Baylor has won 91% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (205-21).
- BU is 68-4 when leading at any point in the 2nd half of a game over the last 3 seasons.
- Baylor is 259-99 over the last 10+ seasons, averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 259 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (297).
- Baylor is 350-146 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- Five of Baylor's players have used or are currently using a redshirt year. Two after transferring to BU (Flagler, Tchamwa Tchatchoua), one before transferring (Bonner) and two as freshmen – Turner and Langston Love.
- Ten of Baylor's 11 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (16 of last 17 seasons).
- Baylor is 1 of 10 teams nationally to appear in every postseason since 2012 (7 NCAAs, 2 NITs).
- Baylor has the nation's 9th-longest active streak with at least one 3-point FG made in 976 straight games – the last time Baylor failed to make a 3-pointer was more than 30 years ago, on Feb. 21, 1990 vs. Texas Tech (0-8).
- BU is 7-1 all-time in Big 12/SEC Challenges, the best record of any team in either league. Combined with a 3-1 mark in the Big 12/Pac-10 Series and 1-0 in the Big 12/Big East Battle, Baylor is 11-2 in conference challenges.
- Baylor has won 8 tournament titles under **Drew** – 2007 Paradise Jam, 2011 Las Vegas Classic, 2013 NIT, 2016 & 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational and 2021 NCAA Championship.

BEARS MAKING BIG 12 HISTORY

- In the last three seasons, Baylor has recorded the longest winning streak in the Big 12 Conference's 26-year history (**23 in 2019-20**), the 3rd-longest in Big 12 history (**20 active in 2021-22**) and tied the 5th-longest (**18 in 2020-21**).

AKINJO, FLAGLER PUSH BEARS PAST OKLAHOMA FOR 20TH-STRAIGHT WIN

- Baylor prevailed 84-74 in a hard-fought battle against Oklahoma on Jan. 4, led by a career-high 27 points from James Akinjo and a Baylor-career high 22 points from Adam Flagler.
- Oklahoma shot 75% (24-of-32) on 2-point field goals, the highest ever by a Big 12 team in a loss, but the Bears overcame that by out-rebounding the Sooners 34-16 and recording a 19-0 edge in second-chance points.

BEARS PREVAIL AT IOWA STATE IN HISTORIC MATCHUP OF UNDEFEATED TEAMS

- Baylor led wire-to-wire and fought off a late comeback in a 77-72 win at No. 8 Iowa State on New Year’s Day.
- James Akinjo had a team -high 16 points, and Jeremy Sochan and LJ Cryer combined for 25 points off the bench.
- The matchup was the first time two undefeated Big 12 teams met in conference play (min. 10 games), as both teams entered 12-0. It was the 4th time in the last 40 years any two 12-0 or better Division I teams matched up.

NINE CONSECUTIVE WINS OVER TOP-10 TEAMS

- Baylor is 9-0 against top-10 ranked teams over the last two seasons (4 at neutral sites, 3 on road, 2 at home).
- BU is the 6th team ever to win 9-straight vs. top-10 teams, and joined Villanova (2016-18) as the only since 2000.
- Baylor’s 9-straight top-10 wins have come against No. 5 Illinois (n), No. 9 Kansas (h), No. 6 Texas (r), No. 6 West Virginia (r), No. 10 Arkansas (n), No. 6 Houston (n), No. 1 Gonzaga (n), No. 6 Villanova (h) and No. 8 Iowa State (r).

NOTEABLE STREAKS

- Baylor has won 20-consecutive games, the 2nd-longest in school history and 3rd-longest in Big 12 history.
- Baylor has won 29-consecutive games against unranked teams (last loss March 7, 2020 at WVU).
- Baylor has won 11-consecutive games away from home – 9 neutral, 2 road (last loss March 12, 2021 vs. OSU).
- Baylor has won a school-record 22-consecutive home games (last loss Feb. 22, 2020 vs. Kansas).
- Baylor has won 37-consecutive games when leading at halftime (last loss Feb. 29, 2020 at TCU).
- BU has won 55-straight when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (last loss March 2, 2019 at K-State).
- Baylor has won 33-straight games when shooting 50% or higher (last loss March 18, 2018 vs. Mississippi State).
- BU has won 33-consecutive games when its bench outscores the opposing bench (last loss Feb. 29, 2020 at TCU).
- Baylor has won 34-straight games when scoring 80+ points (last loss Jan. 5, 2019 vs. TCU).
- BU has won 32-consecutive games when holding an opponent below 70 points (last loss Feb. 22, 2020 vs. KU).
- Baylor has won 23-consecutive games when **Adam Flagler** scores 10+ points (never lost).
- Baylor has won a school-record 36-consecutive non-conference games (last loss Nov. 8, 2019 vs. Washington).
- Baylor has won 21-consecutive non-conference home games (last loss Dec. 18, 2018 vs. SFA).
- Baylor has won 18-consecutive non-conference road/neutral games (last loss Nov. 8, 2019 vs. Washington).

SERIES HISTORY VS. TCU

- Saturday is the 189th all-time series meeting and the 19th as Big 12 Conference members.
- Baylor leads the series 103-85, including a 42-43 mark in Fort Worth and a 14-4 record in the Drew era.
- Since TCU joined the Big 12, Baylor is 14-4 in the series with an average scoring margin of +13.7 points per game.
- The Bears’ 7 Big 12 home wins over TCU have been by at least 11 points and by an average of 20.3 points.
- The Bears are 6-3 against TCU in Fort Worth as Big 12 rivals, with an scoring margin of +11.1 points per game.
- BU beat TCU in Fort Worth by 26 in 2013, 33 in 2014, 7 (OT) in 2015, 15 in 2016, 9 in 2017 and 18 in 2021.
- The Bears lost at TCU by 10 in 2018, by 4 in 2019 and by 3 in 2020.

ONE OF THREE REMAINING UNDEFEATED TEAMS

- Baylor is 1 of 3 remaining undefeated teams, joining USC and Colorado State.
- The Bears are the only team to win every game by 5+ points this season (13 of 14 wins by 8+ points).
- BU became the first returning national champion to win its first 12 games by 8+ points since 1990-91 UNLV.
- Baylor won its first 17 games by 8+ points last season and was one of the last two undefeated teams (Gonzaga).

RANKED NO. 1 FOR THIRD-STRAIGHT SEASON

- Baylor reached No. 1 nationally on Dec. 13, marking a third-straight season with a No. 1 national ranking.
- BU was No. 1 for the first time on Jan. 9, 2017, spent five weeks ranked No. 1 in 2019-20, was No. 1 in the preseason and week 1 coaches’ polls last year and has been No. 1 for four weeks in 2021-22.
- Baylor has now been ranked No. 1 in 13 weekly polls all-time. The Bears are 18-2 when playing as a No. 1 team.
- Baylor joins Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas as the only programs ranked No. 1 in four seasons since 2016-17.

BAYLOR PARTNERS WITH CITY OF WACO ON \$700 MILLION RIVERFRONT PROJECT

- Baylor and the City of Waco have partnered on a \$700 million riverfront development project, headlined by the \$185 million Foster Pavilion, the future home for Baylor’s national champion basketball programs.
- Foster Pavilion (capacity 7,500) will be located along the Brazos River on the opposite side of I-35 from McLane Stadium.
- Groundbreaking is expected in June 2022, with the pavilion targeted for a January 2024 opening.
- Development Centers for both basketball programs are included in the 245k square foot Foster Pavilion project.

THIRTY-EIGHT STRAIGHT WEEKS AP TOP-10 RANKED

- Baylor is ranked No. 1 in the Jan. 2 AP Top 25, extending a school-record streak to 38-straight weeks top-10 ranked.
- BU has been top-5 ranked in 35 of the last 38 weeks (28-week streak was snapped with preseason No. 8 ranking).
- Baylor has been in the AP Top 25 a school-record 46-straight weeks, which is the nation’s 3rd-longest active streak behind only Gonzaga (104) and Villanova (49).

NATION'S-BEST 19-3 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST THREE SEASONS

- Baylor is 19-3 against AP Top-25 ranked teams over the last 3 seasons. BU became the first team since Indiana in 1974-76 to win 10 of 11 games against ranked opponents before the Feb. 27, 2021 loss at Kansas ended the run.
- The record includes 12-2 away from home, with neutral wins vs. #17 Villanova (Nov. 2019), vs. #5 Illinois (Nov. 2020), vs. #18 Villanova (March 2021), vs. #10 Arkansas (March 2021), vs. #6 Houston (April 2021) and #1 Gonzaga (April 2021) and road wins at #22 Texas Tech (Jan. 2020), at #4 Kansas (Jan. 2020), at #15 Texas Tech (Jan. 2021), at #6 Texas (Feb. 2021), at #6 West Virginia (March 2021) and at #8 Iowa State (January 2022).
- BU is 7-1 at home vs. ranked teams in the last 3 seasons – wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 West Virginia (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021), #18 Texas Tech (March 2021) and #6 Villanova (Dec. 2021), and the lone loss by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020).

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- **Scott Drew** became Baylor head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew has swept Big 12 Coach of the Year honors from the league coaches and media each of the last two seasons. He was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 19th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (384).
- Drew is coaching his 600th game at Baylor (384-215). His .641 winning pct. is best in BU history among coaches with 40+ games, and he's the program's all-time wins leader with 183 more victories than any other coach.
- Baylor has a .706 winning percentage (350-146) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .723 winning percentage (259-99) over the last 10+ seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (51) is the youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- Baylor is playing its 293rd game as a ranked team in Drew's 19 seasons. BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's first 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since January 2010, BU has been ranked in 277 of 414 games.
- In Drew's first 18 seasons at Baylor, 48 players have gone on to professional careers.

- Baylor has been ranked in every AP Top 25 spot at some point in the last 7 years (since March 2, 2015).

- Baylor is 88-5 when leading at halftime over the last five seasons since the start of 2017-18.
- Baylor has won 91% of its games (206-21) when leading at the half in the last 10+ seasons ... **13-0** in 2021-22, **24-0** in 2020-21, **21-2** in 2019-20, **15-3** in 2018-19, **15-0** in 2017-18, **18-3** in 2016-17, **18-2** in 2015-16, **21-7** in 2014-15, **18-2** in 2013-14, **17-1** in 2012-13 and **26-1** in 2011-12.
- BU has won 40% of games in which its been tied or trailing at the half since 2011-12, going 53-78 in those.

FORTY-TWO WINS VS. RANKED TEAMS IN LAST SEVEN SEASONS

- Baylor has gone 42-35 against ranked teams since the start of the 2014-15 season (19-3 last 3 seasons).
- BU is 60-75 against AP-ranked teams since 2007-08 after going 17-122 in the program's first 101 seasons.
- Baylor has won multiple games vs. AP Top 25 teams in each of the last 14 seasons.
- The Bears have defeated at least five ranked teams in six of the last eight seasons.

NON-CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS

- Baylor is 13-1 against the Big East during the Drew era, 16-5 vs. the Pac-12 during the Drew era, and 17-10 against the SEC during the Drew era, including 12-5 since 2012-13 and 7-1 in the Big 12/SEC Challenge.
- The Bears are 5-0 against Big Ten teams since 2015, with wins against Michigan State (2016 B4A), Wisconsin (2017 HOF Classic), Illinois (2020 Jimmy V Classic), Wisconsin (2021 NCAAT) and Michigan State (2021 B4A).

BIG 12'S MOST WINS IN CONFERENCE CHALLENGES

- Baylor is 11-2 in conference challenges – 7-1 in Big 12/SEC Challenge, 3-1 in Big 12/Pac-10, 1-0 in Big 12/Big East.
- BU's 7-1 Big 12/SEC Challenge record is the best by any team in either league and includes wins over half of the 14 SEC programs – Kentucky, Vanderbilt, Georgia, Ole Miss, Alabama, Florida and Auburn.
- Baylor is 7-1 in Big 12/SEC Challenges, Oklahoma and Oklahoma State are 6-2, Kansas and Texas Tech are 5-3, TCU is 4-4, Texas is 3-4, K-State and Iowa State are 3-5 and West Virginia is 2-6.
- Baylor's 11-2 record in conference challenges is best in the Big 12, followed by Oklahoma State (10-5), Kansas (9-6), Oklahoma (8-7), Iowa State (7-7), Texas Tech (6-8), Texas (6-8), K-State (5-9), TCU (5-6) and West Virginia (4-7).

AKINJO, FLAGLER SHINE IN WIN OVER NORTHWESTERN STATE

- Baylor rolled to a 104-68 win over Northwestern State on Dec. 28, led by James Akinjo's career-high 27 points along with 9 assists, and Adam Flagler's 21 points, career-high 11 assists and 0 turnovers.
- Jeremy Sochan made his career-first start and recorded his first double-double with 16 points and 11 boards.

BEARS SHARE WEALTH IN WIN OVER ALCORN STATE

- Baylor rolled to a 94-57 win over Alcorn State on Dec. 20 in its final game before the Christmas break.
- Nine different Bears combined for 29 assists, and seven different Bears hit 3-pointers in the win.
- Flo Thamba and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua both posted career-highs of 16 points on a combined 14-14 FGs.

COMEBACK FROM 10 DOWN IN FIRST ROAD TEST AT OREGON

- Baylor faced a 34-24 deficit 15 minutes into its first road game, but the Bears fought back to take a 42-41 lead with 17 minutes remaining and used a 12-0 run to a break a 51-all tie in a 78-70 win at Oregon on Dec. 18.
- Head coach Scott Drew recorded his 400th career victory (380 at Baylor) in his 20th season as a head coach.
- Kendall Brown scored a team-high 17 points (15 in 2nd half), including 9 as part of the decisive 12-0 run.
- James Akinjo had 17 points and a game-high 6 assists, and Adam Flagler had 16 points with 5 first-half treys.

DOMINANT WIN OVER NO. 6 VILLANOVA

- Baylor put together a dominant defensive performance in a 57-36 win over No. 6 Villanova on Dec. 12.
- The Bears held Villanova to its fewest points since 1979, lowest field goal percentage (.222) of the 21-year Jay Wright era and fewest points by any AP Top 10 team in the shot clock era.
- It was BU's 8th-straight win over top-10 ranked teams and improved BU to 13-1 vs. the Big East in the Drew era.
- James Akinjo had a game-high 16 points along with 7 rebounds and 5 assists, as BU improved to 3-0 vs. Villanova.

ANOTHER BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS TITLE

- Baylor won its second Battle 4 Atlantis title (2016, 2021) with wins over Arizona State, VCU and Michigan State. The Bears joined Villanova (2013, 2017) as the only 2-time Battle 4 Atlantis Champions.
- Baylor is now 39-12 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including 26-4 since 2013-14.
- James Akinjo was named 2021 B4A MVP, while Kendall Brown joined him on the All-Tournament Team.
- Baylor defeated VCU, Michigan State and Louisville, respectively, to win the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis.

BEARS NOTCH MARQUEE WIN OVER MICHIGAN STATE IN B4A TITLE GAME

- Baylor won the Battle 4 Atlantis title with a 75-58 win over Michigan State on Nov. 26. The 17-point margin of victory was the largest for a non-conference team against Michigan State since Nov. 15, 2016 (Kentucky, 69-48).
- BU faced its largest deficit at 36-31 with 2:20 left in the first half, then went on a 24-6 run and led by double-digits for the final 14 minutes. BU forced 19 turnovers and had 15 more field goal attempts than the Spartans.
- **James Akinjo** (game-highs 15 pts, 5 assists) was named MVP, and **Kendall Brown** was named All-Tournament.

HARD-FOUGHT B4A SEMIFINAL WIN OVER VCU

- Baylor overcame 13 first-half turnovers in a hard-fought 69-61 win over VCU in the Battle 4 Atlantis semifinals.
- The Bears led 29-27 at the break, then started the second half on a 9-0 run. VCU cut the deficit to 3 points with 11 minutes left, but BU responded with a 6-0 run and led by at least 4 points the rest of the game.
- BU was out-shot (42%-40%), but forced 19 turnovers and out-rebounded VCU 42-33. **Matthew Mayer** led BU with 15 points, while **Kendall Brown** added 14, and **Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua** tied his career-high 13 points.

BEARS PULL AWAY EARLY IN BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS WIN OVER ARIZONA STATE

- Baylor broke a 23-23 tie with a 19-4 run and led by double-digits for the final 22 minutes in a 75-63 win over Arizona State on Nov. 24 in the Battle 4 Atlantis first round. BU won despite shooting a season-low 42% from the field.
- **Flo Thamba** posted career-highs with 11 points in 23 minutes, while **LJ Cryer** (15 points) led the Bears in scoring for a 4th-straight game. **Matthew Mayer** (14), **Adam Flagler** (13) and **Kendall Brown** (10) also scored 10+ points.

SECOND-HALF SURGE LEADS TO BLOWOUT OF STANFORD

- Baylor led 34-28 at the break, then rushed out to a 24-3 run to start the second half and pulled away for a dominating 86-48 win over Stanford on Nov. 20. BU snapped Stanford's streak of 89-straight games with 50+ points.
- **LJ Cryer** (21 points) made his career-first start and had his 3rd-consecutive 20-point game, while **James Akinjo** (11 points, 11 assists) had his second-straight double-double after recording his career-first three days prior.

DREW'S 17-8 NCAA TOURNAMENT RECORD

- Head coach Scott Drew has a 17-8 record over nine NCAA Tournament appearances, including five Sweet 16s, three Elite Eights, one Final Four and one National Championship.
- Drew's 17-8 record (.680) is 7th-best among active coaches, trailing only Mike Krzyzewski (.764; 97-30), John Calipari (.56-19; .747), Rick Pitino (.33-22; .730), Chris Beard (.713; 10-4), Tom Izzo (.703; 52-22) and Bill Self (.700; 49-21).
- Drew has guided Baylor to nine of the last 12 NCAA Tournaments. Prior to Drew's arrival, Baylor had been to only four NCAA Tournaments, including just once in the 53 seasons preceding his arrival in 2003-04.
- In 2008, Drew guided Baylor to its first NCAA Championship appearance in 20 seasons (since 1988) and just its second appearance in 58 seasons since going to the eight-team tournament in 1950.

BEARS RETURN SEVEN LETTERWINNERS FROM NATIONAL TITLE TEAM

- Baylor lost four starters from last season's National Championship team, but the Bears returned seven lettermen.
- BU's seven returning lettermen entered this year with a combined 344 games (77 starts) of collegiate experience.
- Matthew Mayer (93 career games), Flo Thamba (82 career games, 30 starts), Adam Flagler (64 career games, 36 starts), Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua (60 career games, 11 starts), LJ Cryer (20 career games), Zach Loveday (13 career games) and Jordan Turner (12 career games) all returned from last year's National Championship team.

BEARS WELCOME HIGHEST-RANKED RECRUITING CLASS IN PROGRAM HISTORY FOR 2021-22

- Baylor signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history in November 2020, inking a trio of top-40 recruits for the 2021-22 season. BU's 2021 recruiting class was ranked No. 4 nationally by ESPN.
- The Bears signed 5-star forward Kendall Brown, 4-star guard Langston Love and 4-star forward Jeremy Sochan.
- Brown was ranked No. 12 nationally, Love was No. 23 nationally and Sochan was No. 40 nationally.
- Brown and Sochan debuted in the season-opener, but Love is out for the year with a knee injury.

ANOTHER STRONG CLASS HEADED TO WACO IN 2022

- Baylor's three-player 2022 signing class is ranked No. 13 nationally by ESPN.com.
- The Bears signed the highest-ranked recruit in program history with No. 3-ranked Keyonte George (IMG Academy).
- Baylor signed another guard with No. 53-ranked Dillon Hunter (Sunrise Christian) and added 4-star big man prospect Joshua Ojjanwuna (NBA Global Academy – Australia).

BIG 12'S SECOND-BEST ROAD MARK SINCE 2012

- Baylor is 49-41 in Big 12 road games since 2012, 2nd-best in the league behind only Kansas (thru 1/7/22).
- BU is 40-32 in Big 12 road games since 2014, which is also second-best in the league behind only Kansas.

ENTIRE STAFF BACK FOR FIFTH-STRAIGHT SEASON

- Scott Drew's entire coaching staff returned for the 2021-22 season, a fifth-straight season of continuity.
- Jerome Tang is in his fifth season as associate head coach and has been on Drew's staff all 19 seasons at Baylor.
- Assistant coaches Alvin Brooks III (sixth season) and John Jakus (fifth season) also return to the bench.
- Special assistant & director of player development Jared Nuness is back for his 12th season, while director of basketball operations Aditya Malhotra returns for his ninth season. Special assistant to the head coach Bill Peterson and director of video operations Ty Beard are both back for their fifth seasons.

ALL FOUR DEPARTED STARTERS NOW PLAYING PROFESSIONALLY

- All four departed starters from last season's National Championship team are now playing professionally.
- Davion Mitchell was drafted No. 9 overall by the Sacramento Kings.
- Jared Butler was drafted No. 40 by the New Orleans Pelicans (traded to Utah Jazz).
- MaCio Teague is playing on the Utah Jazz G-League team.
- Mark Vital is suiting up for the NFL's Kansas City Chiefs.

SECOND-MOST WINS AMONG BIG 12 TEAMS IN LAST DECADE

- Baylor's 259-99 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (297-73) among Big 12 teams (thru 1/7/22).
- West Virginia (222-131) is 3rd, Iowa State (210-136) is 4th, Oklahoma (207-131) is 5th, Texas (201-145) is 6th, Kansas State (199-147) is 7th, Oklahoma St. (191-149) is 8th, Texas Tech (187-152) is 9th and TCU (174-165) is 10th.
- Baylor has averaged 24.5 wins per season over the last 10 full seasons since 2011-12.

APPEARANCES IN SIX OF LAST SEVEN NCAA TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in the last seven tournaments.
- BU is 1 of 16 teams to appear in six NCAA Tournaments since 2014, joining Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Michigan State, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Oregon, Purdue, VCU, Villanova, Virginia, Wichita State and Wisconsin.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Drew is in his 19th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (384).
- Baylor has had a nation-leading four players selected in the NBA Draft since 2010 who weren't ranked in the ESPN100 out of high school — Quincy Acy, Ekpe Udoh, Pierre Jackson and Taurean Prince.
- Drew has graduated 55 players during his Baylor tenure, averaging 3 graduates per season.
- The Bears have advanced to postseason play in a school-record nine straight seasons (7 NCAA, 2 NIT).
- Baylor is 26-4 in regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, including 5 regular-season tournament titles.
- Drew has won 20+ games in 12 of the last 14 years — the Bears had 3 seasons of 20+ wins prior to his arrival.

NINE CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of nine consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 12 of the last 13 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program’s 97 seasons prior to the **Scott Drew** era.
- Baylor is 1 of 10 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Iona, Kansas, Michigan State, North Carolina, Oregon, Saint Mary’s, Virginia and Wichita State.
- BU earned NCAA Tournament bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019 and 2021 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has appeared in 12 of the last 13 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor’s only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

48 PRO PLAYERS IN DREW ERA

- In Scott Drew’s 18 years at Baylor, 48 of his players have gone on to professional careers.
- Five Bears are currently on NBA rosters – Jared Butler (Jazz), Davion Mitchell (Kings), Royce O’Neale (Jazz), Taurean Prince (Timberwolves) and Ishmail Wainright (Suns).
- In addition to the five current NBA players, eight more of Drew’s former players have played in the NBA (most recent team) – Quincy Acy (Raptors), Freddie Gillespie (Raptors), Pierre Jackson (Mavs), Cory Jefferson (Suns), Perry Jones III (Thunder), Quincy Miller (Kings), Johnathan Motley (Clippers) and Ekpe Udoh (Jazz).

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Three current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew’s BU staff.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 13th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Grant McCasland is in his fifth season as head coach at North Texas. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Paul Mills is in his fifth season as head coach at Oral Roberts. He was a member of Drew’s original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- All 3 former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments – Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.

POINT GUARDS THRIVE IN DREW’S SYSTEM

- Ten of Baylor’s 11 starting point guards during the **Scott Drew** era have earned All-Big 12 recognition.
- Baylor’s starting point guard has earned All-Big 12 recognition in 16 of 17 seasons since 2004-05.
- Jared Butler (2019, 2020, 2021), Davion Mitchell (2020, 2021), Makai Mason (2019), Manu Lecomte (2017, 2018), Lester Medford (2016), Kenny Chery (2014, 2015), Pierre Jackson (2012, 2013), Tweety Carter (2010), Curtis Jerrells (2007, 2008, 2009) and Aaron Bruce (2005, 2006, 2007) have earned All-Big 12 recognition.

HISTORY OF DEVELOPMENT WITH REDSHIRTS

- Baylor has a track record of success when redshirting players. **Davion Mitchell, MaCio Teague, Freddie Gillespie, Mark Vital, Ekpe Udoh, Johnathan Motley, Cory Jefferson, Brady Heslip, Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. and Manu Lecomte** have all gone on to professional careers after redshirting.
- **Adam Flagler** and **Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua** redshirted in 2019-20 while sitting out to satisfy NCAA transfer rules, while **Jordan Turner** elected to redshirt in 2019-20.

BAYLOR BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO

- Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Network from Learfield on ESPN Central Texas and flagship station 1660AM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.
- Games are broadcast by the “Voice of the Bears” John Morris, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and former Baylor basketball standout Pat Nunley.
- Morris is in his 38th year doing BU broadcasts (27th full-time), and Nunley is in his 41st season as analyst.
- All of Baylor’s games can be heard live on the Internet at www.BaylorBears.com and via the TuneIn App.

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- Baylor has ranked top-10 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in all eight seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation’s top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew’s first 10 years.
- Baylor’s 8-year streak is the nation’s best, and West Virginia (7 years) is the only other team with a 4+ year streak.
- Baylor currently ranks 5th nationally in offensive rebounding percentage, grabbing 40% of its missed field goals.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 5 nationally in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that top-10 streak, BU’s best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

GRADUATING 91 PERCENT OF SENIORS

- Since **Scott Drew** took over the Baylor Basketball program in 2003, 38 of 41 scholarship players who have played their final years of collegiate eligibility under Drew have graduated from Baylor.
