STORY LINES

- No. 4 Baylor travels to Alabama for Saturday's 3 p.m. CT tip in the 9th-annual Big 12/SEC Challenge.
- Baylor is 7-1 in Big 12/SEC Challenges, the best record of any team in either league. Combined with 3-1 in the Big 12/Pac-10 Series and 2-0 in the Big 12/Big East Battle, BU is 12-2 in conference challenges.
- BU (7-1) and Alabama (3-1) are the only teams without multiple Big 12/SEC Challenge losses.
- BU and Alabama last met in the 2019 event, with BU earning a 73-68 victory in Waco.
- Baylor's 18-2 record is its worst through 20 games since 2018-19. BU was 19-1 in 2019-20 & 2020-21. The Bears are a combined 56-4 through their first 20 games over the last 3 seasons.
- Baylor has won 36-straight non-conference games (+23.2 average margin) dating back to Nov. 2019.
- BU has won 18-straight non-conference road/neutral games (last loss Nov. 8, 2019 vs. Washington).
- BU has won 14-consecutive games away from home 9 neutral, 5 road (last loss March 12 vs. OSU).
- BU is 33-1 vs. unranked teams over the last 2 seasons (+23.0 avg margin) with all wins by 5+ points.
- Baylor is 13-5 against Southeastern Conference teams over the last 10 seasons, including road wins at Kentucky, Florida, Ole Miss, South Carolina and Vanderbilt and neutral wins vs. Arkansas and Kentucky.
- BU is coming off a 74-49 victory over Kansas State on Tuesday, its 4th time holding an opponent below 50 points this season. BU has held opponents below 40 points in 52-consecutive halves.
- Jeremy Sochan returned on Tuesday after missing 4.5 games with an ankle injury, while James Akinjo sat for the second time in three games while battling a lower back injury.
- Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 6 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
- Baylor's 34-6 Big 12 conference record over the last 3 seasons is the best of any Power-5 team.
- Baylor's 46-4 record over the last 2 seasons is the nation's best among Power-5 teams, and the Bears' 72-8 record over the last 3 seasons is 2nd-best nationally, trailing only Gonzaga (78-5).
- Baylor's bench has out-scored the opponents' bench in 16 of 20 games and by an average of 28-19.
- Baylor is the nation's only team ranked top-35 in scoring offense (35th) and scoring defense (11th).
- Baylor ranks top-25 nationally in scoring margin (5th, +19.4), assists (10th, 17.6), steals (12th, 9.7), rebounding margin (17th, +7.8), turnovers forced (18th, 17.4), turnover margin (20th, +4.2), offensive rebound percentage (6th, 37.8) and effective FG% (20th, .552).
- Over the last 3 seasons, Baylor is 61-3 when leading at the half and 72-5 when taking a 2nd-half lead.
- BU has forced 10+ turnovers in 28-straight games, including 12+ TOs in 19 of 20 games this season.
- BU's 49-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 is the nation's 3rd-longest behind Gonzaga and Villanova.
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 41-straight weeks top-10 ranked (top-5 ranked in 38 of those).
- Baylor has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 at some point in the last 7 years.
- Baylor has built leads of 11 + points in 25 of 26 games since the start of the 2021 NCAA Tournament.
- BU has built double-digit leads in 70 of 80 games over the last 3 seasons (46 of 50 last 2 seasons).
- BU has defeated 3 currently top-25 ranked teams this season No. 10 Michigan State (75-58 in Battle 4 Atlantis title game), No. 14 Villanova (57-36 in Waco) and No. 23 Iowa State (77-72 in Ames).

QUICK HITS

- Baylor is 4-0 in Big 12 road games this season, while the rest of the league is a combined 12-22.
- For a second-straight season, Baylor was one of the nation's final two undefeated teams.
- BU went 305 days between losses, the longest in program history (March 12, 2021 Jan. 11, 2022).
- BU went 1,038 days without consecutive losses before dropping back-to-back games Jan. 11 and Jan. 15.
- Baylor became the first program to start consecutive seasons 15.0 since Syracuse in 2010-11 and 2011-12.
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 19th season at Baylor with a school-record 388 career victories, including a 17-8 mark in NCAA Tournaments, which is the 7th-best mark among active coaches.
- Baylor's streak of 18-straight wins by 8+ points was snapped in a 5-point win at Iowa State. BU was the first returning national champion to win its first 12 games by 8+ points since 1990-91 UNLV.
- BU ranks 6th nationally in KenPom's offensive rebound pct (37.8), its 8th-straight year ranked top-10.
- BU is playing its 299th game as a ranked team under Drew BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since January 2010, BU has been ranked in 283 of 420 games.
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-5 schools to win 18 + games every year since 2008.
- Baylor's streak of 9 consecutive postseasons is tied as the nation's 7th longest active streak.
- Baylor has won 20+ games in 12 of the last 14 seasons after recording only three 20-win seasons in the previous 100 years of Baylor Basketball (1946, 1948, 1988).
- Baylor is 91-6 when leading at halftime over the last 5 seasons (61-3 over last 3 seasons, 24-0 last season).
- Baylor has won 90% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (208-22).
- BU is 72-5 when leading at any point in the 2nd half of a game over the last 3 seasons.
- Baylor is 263-101 over the last 10 + seasons, averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 263 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (302).
- Baylor is 354-148 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- Five of Baylor's players have used or are currently using a redshirt year. Two after transferring to BU (Flagler. Tchamwa Tchatchoua), one before transferring (Bonner) and two as freshmen — Turner and Langston Love.
- Ten of Baylor's 11 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (16 of last 17 seasons).
- Baylor is 1 of 10 teams nationally to appear in every postseason since 2012 (7 NCAAs, 2 NITs).
- Baylor has the nation's 9th-longest active streak with at least one 3-point FG made in 982 straight games the last time Baylor failed to make a 3-pointer was more than 30 years ago, on Feb. 21, 1990 vs. Texas Tech (0-8).
- Baylor has won 8 tournament titles under Drew 2007 Paradise Jam, 2011 Las Vegas Classic, 2013 NIT, 2016 & 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational and 2021 NCAA Championship.

BIG 12'S MOST WINS IN CONFERENCE CHALLENGES

- Baylor is 12-2 in conference challenges 7-1 in Big 12/SEC Challenge, 3-1 in Big 12/Pac-10, 2-0 in Big 12/Big East.
- Baylor's 7-1 Big 12/SEC Challenge record includes wins vs. 7 different teams Kentucky (neutral), Vanderbilt (road), Georgia (home), Ole Miss (road), Alabama (home), Florida (road) and Auburn (home).
- Baylor's 2022 opponent Alabama (3-1) is the only other team without multiple Big 12/SEC Challenge losses.
- Baylor's 7-1 record is the best record by any team in the Big 12/SEC Challenge. OU and OSU are 6-2, while Kansas and Texas Tech are 5-3, TCU is 4-4, Texas is 3-4, Iowa State and K-State are 3-5 and WVU is 2-6.
- Baylor's 12-2 record in conference challenges is best in the Big 12, followed by OSU at 10-5, Kansas at 9-6, OU at 8-7, Iowa State at 7-7, Texas at 6-7, TCU at 5-6, Texas Tech at 6-8, K-State at 5-9 and WVU at 4-7.

BEST RECORD IN BIG 12/SEC CHALLENGE

- Baylor's 7-1 record in the Big 12/SEC Challenge is the best of any team in either league.
- Baylor defeated No. 3 Kentucky, 67-62, at Cowboys Stadium in the inaugural challenge on Dec. 6, 2013.
- Baylor improved to 2-0 in the challenge with a 66-63 win at Vanderbilt on Dec. 3, 2014.
- The Bears knocked off Georgia, 83-73, in their first home game in the challenge on Jan. 30, 2016.
- Baylor rallied from 15 points down to win at Ole Miss, 78-75, on Jan. 28, 2017.
- The Bears' lone loss came on the road at No. 20 Florida, 81-60, on Jan. 27, 2018.
- Baylor got back in the win column with a 73-68 victory over Alabama in Waco on Jan. 26, 2019.
- BU avenged its lone loss in the Big 12/SEC Challenge with a 72-61 win at Florida on Jan. 25, 2020.
- Baylor rolled to an 84-72 victory over Auburn in Waco on Jan. 30, 2021, defeating a 7th different SEC team.

NOTEABLE STREAKS

- Baylor has won a school-record 36-consecutive non-conference games (last loss Nov. 8, 2019 vs. Washington).
- Baylor has won 18-consecutive non-conference road/neutral games (last loss Nov. 8, 2019 vs. Washington).
- Baylor has won 14-consecutive games away from home 9 neutral, 5 road (last loss March 12, 2021 vs. OSU).
- Baylor has won 6-consecutive road games (last loss Feb. 27, 2021 at Kansas).
- BU has won 58-straight when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (last loss March 2, 2019 at K-State).
- Baylor has won 35-straight games when shooting 50% or higher (last loss March 18, 2018 vs. Mississippi State).
- \bullet Baylor has won 34-straight games when scoring 80+ points (last loss Jan. 5, 2019 vs. TCU).
- Baylor has had at least 3 players make 3-pointers in 23-consecutive games (last on March 27, 2021 vs. Villanova).
- Baylor has made 3+ 3-pointers in 109-consecutive games (last on Nov. 23, 2018 vs. Ole Miss).
- Baylor has won 9-consecutive games against AP Top-10 ranked opponents (last loss Feb. 22, 2020 vs. Kansas).
- Baylor has won 21-consecutive non-conference home games (last loss Dec. 18, 2018 vs. SFA).

SERIES HISTORY VS. ALABAMA

- Saturday is the 9th series meeting between Baylor and Alabama and the second in Tuscaloosa
- Alabama leads the series 6.2, including a 5-1 record at neutral sites and a 1-0 mark in Tuscaloosa.
- BU and Alabama have met just twice in the last 55 years a 79-76 Alabama win in the 2009 Old Spice Classic in Lake Buena Vista, Fla. and a 73-68 Baylor win in the 2019 Big 12/SEC Challenge in Waco.

LAST TIME VS. ALABAMA

- Mario Kegler had 17 points and 7 rebounds to lead Baylor to a 73-68 win over Alabama on Jan. 26, 2019.
- There were 12 ties and 12 lead changes in the game, and BU trailed 59-56 with 5 minutes left.
- Matthew Mayer and Flo Thamba are Baylor's only remaining players from that game. Mayer had 9 points, 5 rebounds and 3 assists in 22 minutes off the bench, while Thamba added 5 rebounds and 2 blocks in 17 minutes.
- BU controlled the glass 35-31, becoming the 2nd team to out-rebound Alabama through 19 games that season.

STRONG RECORD AGAINST SEC TEAMS

- Baylor is 13-5 against Southeastern Conference teams over the last 10 seasons since 2012-13.
- BU has wins at Kentucky, at Vanderbilt, at South Carolina, at Ole Miss and at Florida, neutral-site wins vs. Kentucky and Arkansas and home wins against Vanderbilt, South Carolina, Georgia, Texas A&M, Alabama and Auburn.
- BU's only losses against SEC opponents in the last 10 seasons were at No. 24 Texas A&M in December 2015, vs. South Carolina in the 2017 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, at No. 20 Florida in the 2018 Big 12/SEC Challenge, vs. Mississippi State in the 2018 NIT Second Round and vs. Ole Miss in the 2018 Emerald Coast Classic.

18-STRAIGHT NON-CONFERENCE WINS AWAY FROM HOME

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 18-consecutive wins against non-Big 12 teams in road/neutral games.
- The Bears' last non-conference loss away from home was against Washington in the Armed Forces Classic on Nov. 8, 2019. That loss started the Bears' Big 12-record 23-game winning streak.
- Baylor's 18-straight non-conference wins away from home: vs. Ohio, at Coastal Carolina, vs. #17 Villanova, vs. UT-Martin, at Florida, vs. Louisiana, vs. Washington, vs. #5 Illinois, vs. Hartford, vs. Wisconsin, vs. #18 Villanova, vs. #10 Arkansas, vs. #6 Houston, vs. #1 Gonzaga, vs. Arizona State, vs. VCU, vs. Michigan State, at Oregon.

RANKED NO. 1 FOR THIRD-STRAIGHT SEASON

- Baylor reached No. 1 nationally on Dec. 13, marking a third-straight season with a No. 1 national ranking.
- BU was No. 1 for the first time on Jan. 9, 2017, spent five weeks ranked No. 1 in 2019-20, was No. 1 in the preseason and week 1 coaches' polls last year and has been No. 1 for five weeks in 2021-22.
- Baylor has now been ranked No. 1 in 14 weekly polls all-time. The Bears are 19-4 when playing as a No. 1 team.
- Baylor joins Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas as the only programs ranked No. 1 in four seasons since 2016-17.

BAYLOR PARTNERS WITH CITY OF WACO ON \$700 MILLION RIVERFRONT PROJECT

- Baylor and the City of Waco have partnered on a \$700 million riverfront development project, headlined by the \$185 million Foster Pavilion, the future home for Baylor's national champion basketball programs.
- Foster Pavilion (capacity 7,500) will be located along the Brazos River on the opposite side of I-35 from McLane Stadium.
- Groundbreaking is expected in June 2022, with the pavilion targeted for a January 2024 opening.
- Development Centers for both basketball programs are included in the 245k square foot Foster Pavilion project.

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew has swept Big 12 Coach of the Year honors from the league coaches and media each of the last two seasons. He was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 19th season at Baylor and is the school's all time wins leader (388).
- Drew is coaching his 606th game at Baylor (388-217). His .641 winning pct. is best in BU history among coaches with 40 + games, and he's the program's all-time wins leader with 187 more victories than any other coach.
- Baylor has a .705 winning percentage (354-148) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .723 winning percentage (263-101) over the last 10+ seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (51) is the youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- Baylor is playing its 299th game as a ranked team in Drew's 19 seasons. BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's first 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since January 2010, BU has been ranked in 283 of 420 games.
- In Drew's first 18 seasons at Baylor, 48 players have gone on to professional careers.

- Baylor's three-player 2022 signing class is ranked No. 13 nationally by ESPN.com.
- The Bears signed the highest-ranked recruit in program history with No. 3-ranked Keyonte George (IMG Academy).
- George was recently named a McDonald's All-American, making him the 5th Burger Boy in BU history, joining Tweety Carter, Perry Jones III, Isaiah Austin and Kendall Brown.
- Baylor signed another guard with No. 53-ranked Dillon Hunter (Sunrise Christian) and added 4-star big man prospect Joshua Ojianwuna (NBA Global Academy Australia).

• Jared Butler (2019, 2020, 2021), Davion Mitchell (2020, 2021), Makai Mason (2019), Manu Lecomte (2017, 2018), Lester Medford (2016), Kenny Chery (2014, 2015), Pierre Jackson (2012, 2013), Tweety Carter (2010), Curtis Jerrells (2007, 2008, 2009) and Aaron Bruce (2005, 2006, 2007) have earned All-Big 12 recognition.

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Three current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 13th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Grant McCasland is in his fifth season as head coach at North Texas. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Paul Mills is in his fifth season as head coach at Oral Roberts. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- All 3 former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.

NINE CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

Baylor is on a school-record streak of nine consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 12 of the last 13 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
Baylor is 1 of 10 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Iona, Kansas, Michigan State, North Carolina, Oregon, Saint Mary's, Virginia and Wichita State.

BU earned NCAA Tournament bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019 and 2021 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
Baylor has appeared in 12 of the last 13 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

BU ROLLS PAST K-STATE IN SOCHAN'S RETURN

• Baylor built an 18-point halftime lead and cruised to a 74-49 win over Kansas State on Jan. 25 in Waco.

• Kendall Brown (10 points, 11 rebounds) and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua (13 points, 12 rebounds) both posted double-doubles, while Dale Bonner had a season-high 5 assists.

• Jeremy Sochan returned after missing 4.5 games with an injury. He had 5 points, 2 rebounds, 2 steals in 21 minutes.

BEARS CLOSE STRONG TO WIN AT OKLAHOMA

- Baylor used a late 18-4 run to the put the game away in a 65-51 win at Oklahoma on Jan. 22.
- The 51 points BU allowed tied the fewest scored by OU in any game since BU won 77-47 in Norman on Jan. 28, 2019.
- Baylor went on a 16-0 run the final 4 minutes of the first half and first 2 minutes of the second half.
- BU forced 25 turnovers and recorded 16 steals, led by Matthew Mayer and James Akinjo with 4 steals each.

SHORT-HANDED BEARS BREAK THROUGH AT WEST VIRGINIA

- Baylor was without starting point guard James Akinjo (31.1 mpg) and reserve forward Jeremy Sochan (21.9 mpg), but the short-handed Bears fought off a tough West Virginia team for a 77-68 win in Morgantown on Jan. 18.
- LJ Cryer (25) and Matthew Mayer (20) both scored career-highs, while Adam Flagler added 14 points and a gamehigh 7 assists). That trio combined for 20 points in the final 8 minutes as BU erased WVU's 54-53 lead.
- Dale Bonner contributed 4 assists in a season-high 26 minutes and had a game-high + 18 plus-minus.

LATE RALLY FALLS SHORT VS. OKLAHOMA STATE

- Baylor trailed by 17 points with 11 minutes left, then cut the deficit to 55-54 with 1:21 left before falling short in
- a 61-54 loss to Oklahoma State on Jan. 15. The Bears had two chances to tie or take the lead in the final minute.
- LJ Cryer led the Bears with 18 points. BU was without James Akinjo for the final 9 minutes, as he battled through a bruised tailbone, and Jeremy Sochan missed his second-straight game with a sprained ankle.
- With the loss, Baylor suffered consecutive losses for the first time since March 14, 2019.

BEARS SUFFER FIRST LOSS TO NO. 19 TEXAS TECH

- Baylor built an early 15-point lead and led for more than 31 minutes of game time, but No. 19 Texas Tech used a late 8-0 run to take the lead for good and hand Baylor its first loss of the season, 65-62, on Jan. 11.
- Adam Flagler and James Akinjo had 17 points apiece, but aside from Flagler's 5-of-8, the rest of the team shot 3-of-16 from 3-point range. The Bears also forced a season-low 12 turnovers and had a season-low 5 steals.
- The loss snapped Baylor's 21-game winning streak (3rd-longest by any team in Big 12 history).

FLAGLER SPARKS COMEBACK FROM 9 DOWN TO WIN AT TCU

- Baylor trailed TCU by 9 points early in the second half, but the Bears used a 17-0 run to take the lead for good in
- a 76-64 win in Fort Worth on Jan. 8. Adam Flagler had 18 second half points (6-of-9 from 3-point range).
- James Akinjo added 20 points, 8 assists and 3 steals to lead the Bears to the comeback victory.
 LJ Cryer contributed 15 points off the bench, giving the guard trio 57 of the team's 76 points.

AKINJO AND FLAGLER PUSH BEARS PAST OKLAHOMA FOR 20TH-STRAIGHT WIN

- Baylor prevailed 84-74 in a hard-fought battle against Oklahoma on Jan. 4, led by a career-high 27 points from James Akinjo and a Baylor-career high 22 points from Adam Flagler.
- Oklahoma shot 75% (24-of-32) on 2-point field goals, the highest ever by a Big 12 team in a loss, but the Bears overcame that by out-rebounding the Sooners 34-16 and recording a 19-0 edge in second-chance points.

BEARS PREVAIL AT IOWA STATE IN HISTORIC MATCHUP OF UNDEFEATED TEAMS

- Baylor led wire-to-wire and fought off a late comeback in a 77-72 win at No. 8 lowa State on New Year's Day.
- James Akinjo had a team high 16 points, and Jeremy Sochan and LJ Cryer combined for 25 points off the bench.
- The matchup was the first time two undefeated Big 12 teams met in conference play (min. 10 games), as both teams entered 12-0. It was the 4th time in the last 40 years any two 12-0 or better Division I teams matched up.

AKINJO, FLAGLER SHINE IN WIN OVER NORTHWESTERN STATE

- Baylor rolled to a 104-68 win over Northwestern State on Dec. 28, led by James Akinjo's career-high 27 points along with 9 assists, and Adam Flagler's 21 points, career-high 11 assists and 0 turnovers.
- Jeremy Sochan made his career-first start and recorded his first double-double with 16 points and 11 boards.

BEARS SHARE WEATLH IN WIN OVER ALCORN STATE

- Baylor rolled to a 94-57 win over Alcorn State on Dec. 20 in its final game before the Christmas break.
- Nine different Bears combined for 29 assists, and seven different Bears hit 3-pointers in the win.
- Flo Thamba and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua both posted career-highs of 16 points on a combined 14-14 FGs.

COMEBACK FROM 10 DOWN IN FIRST ROAD TEST AT OREGON

• Baylor faced a 34-24 deficit 15 minutes into its first road game, but the Bears fought back to take a 42-41 lead with 17 minutes remaining and used a 12-0 run to a break a 51-all tie in a 78-70 win at Oregon on Dec. 18.

- Head coach Scott Drew recorded his 400th career victory (380 at Baylor) in his 20th season as a head coach.
- Kendall Brown scored a team-high 17 points (15 in 2nd half), including 9 as part of the decisive 12-0 run.
- James Akinjo had 17 points and a game-high 6 assists, and Adam Flagler had 16 points with 5 first-half treys.

DOMINANT WIN OVER NO. 6 VILLANOVA

- Baylor put together a dominant defensive performance in a 57-36 win over No. 6 Villanova on Dec. 12.
- The Bears held Villanova to its fewest points since 1979, lowest field goal percentage (.222) of the 21-year Jay Wright era and fewest points by any AP Top 10 team in the shot clock era.
- It was BU's 8th-straight win over top-10 ranked teams and improved BU to 13-1 vs. the Big East in the Drew era.
- James Akinjo had a game-high 16 points along with 7 rebounds and 5 assists, as BU improved to 3-0 vs. Villanova.

ANOTHER BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS TITLE

- Baylor won its second Battle 4 Atlantis title (2016, 2021) with wins over Arizona State, VCU and Michigan State. The Bears joined Villanova (2013, 2017) as the only 2-time Battle 4 Atlantis Champions.
- Baylor is now 39-12 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including 26-4 since 2013-14.
- James Akinjo was named 2021 B4A MVP, while Kendall Brown joined him on the All-Tournament Team.
- Baylor defeated VCU, Michigan State and Louisville, respectively, to win the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis.

BEARS NOTCH MARQUEE WIN OVER MICHIGAN STATE IN B4A TITLE GAME

- Baylor won the Battle 4 Atlantis title with a 75-58 win over Michigan State on Nov. 26. The 17-point margin of victory was the largest for a non-conference team against Michigan State since Nov. 15, 2016 (Kentucky, 69-48).
- BU faced its largest deficit at 36-31 with 2:20 left in the first half, then went on a 24-6 run and led by double-digits for the final 14 minutes. BU forced 19 turnovers and had 15 more field goal attempts than the Spartans.
- James Akinjo (game highs 15 pts, 5 assists) was named MVP, and Kendall Brown was named All Tournament.

HARD-FOUGHT B4A SEMIFINAL WIN OVER VCU

- Baylor overcame 13 first-half turnovers in a hard-fought 69-61 win over VCU in the Battle 4 Atlantis semifinals.
- The Bears led 29-27 at the break, then started the second half on a 9-0 run. VCU cut the deficit to 3 points with 11 minutes left, but BU responded with a 6-0 run and led by at least 4 points the rest of the game.
- BU was out-shot (42%-40%), but forced 19 turnovers and out-rebounded VCU 42-33. Matthew Mayer led BU with 15 points, while Kendall Brown added 14, and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua tied his career-high 13 points.

BEARS PULL AWAY EARLY IN BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS WIN OVER ARIZONA STATE

- Baylor broke a 23-23 tie with a 19-4 run and led by double-digits for the final 22 minutes in a 75-63 win over Arizona State on Nov. 24 in the Battle 4 Atlantis first round. BU won despite shooting a season-low 42% from the field.
- Flo Thamba posted career-highs with 11 points in 23 minutes, while LJ Cryer (15 points) led the Bears in scoring for a 4th-straight game. Matthew Mayer (14), Adam Flagler (13) and Kendall Brown (10) also scored 10 + points.

- Baylor lost four starters from last season's National Championship team, but the Bears returned seven lettermen.
 - BU's seven returning lettermen entered this year with a combined 344 games (77 starts) of collegiate experience.
 - Matthew Mayer (93 career games), Flo Thamba (82 career games, 30 starts), Adam Flagler (64 career games, 36 starts), Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua (60 career games, 11 starts), LJ Cryer (20 career games), Zach Loveday (13 career games) and Jordan Turner (12 career games) all returned from last year's National Championship team.

APPEARANCES IN SIX OF LAST SEVEN NCAA TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in the last seven tournaments.
- BU is 1 of 16 teams to appear in six NCAA Tournaments since 2014, joining Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan,
- Michigan State, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Oregon, Purdue, VCU, Villanova, Virginia, Wichita State and Wisconsin.

HISTORY OF DEVELOPMENT WITH REDSHIRTS

- Baylor has a track record of success when redshirting players. Davion Mitchell, MaCio Teague, Freddie Gillespie, Mark Vital, Ekpe Udoh, Johnathan Motley, Cory Jefferson, Brady Heslip, Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. and Manu Lecomte have all gone on to professional careers after redshirting.
- Adam Flagler and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua redshirted in 2019-20 while sitting out to satisfy NCAA transfer rules, while Jordan Turner elected to redshirt in 2019-20.

BAYLOR BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO

- Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Network from Learfield on ESPN Central Texas and flagship station 1660AM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.
- Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and former Baylor basketball standout Pat Nunley.
- Morris is in his 38th year doing BU broadcasts (27th full-time), and Nunley is in his 41st season as analyst.
- All of Baylor's games can be heard live on the Internet at www.BaylorBears.com and via the TuneIn App.

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- Baylor has ranked top-10 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in all eight seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation's top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor's 8-year streak is the nation's best, and West Virginia (7 years) is the only other team with a 4+ year streak.
- Baylor currently ranks 7th nationally in offensive rebounding percentage, grabbing 38% of its missed field goals.
- BU finished No. 5 in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that top-10 streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

GRADUATING 91 PERCENT OF SENIORS

- Since Scott Drew took over the Baylor Basketball program in 2003, 38 of 41 scholarship players who have
 played their final years of collegiate eligibility under Drew have graduated from Baylor.


