### **STORY LINES**

- No. 10 Baylor heads back on the road for Wednesday's 7 p.m. CT game at Kansas State.
- Wednesday is the 48th all-time meeting. Baylor leads 24-23, including 23-18 in the Big 12 era.
- Baylor is 10-12 all-time in Manhattan and looks to win a 3rd-straight in Manhattan for the first time.
- BU has out-scored K-State 355-245 in 4 games over the last 2 seasons (average of 89-61).
- Baylor has won all 6 games vs. K-State over the last 3 seasons, its longest winning streak in series history.
- BU has held K-State below 70 points while scoring 73 + points in each of the last 6 meetings.
- BU hasn't trailed by more than 3 points in any of the 6 games against K-State over the last 3 seasons.
- The Bears have led for 96% of game time (229:49 of 240:00) and trailed for only 1% (3:05 of 240:00) in the last 6 meetings vs. K-State. BU led wire-to-wire in 4 of those 6 meetings.
- BU is tied for the nation's lead with 7 Quad 1 wins (tied with Auburn, Kansas, Marquette, Wisconsin).
- BU is 34-2 vs. unranked teams over the last 2 seasons (+21.6 avg margin) with all wins by 4+ points.
- Baylor is 4-1 in Big 12 road games this season, while the rest of the league is a combined 16-28.
- Baylor is 18-4 in Big 12 road games over the last 3 seasons (rest of league is 75-127 in B12 road games).
- BU has won 14 of its last 16 games away from home 9-0 neutral, 5-2 road.
- Baylor's 19-4 record is its lowest winning percentage through 23 games since 2018-19. BU was 22-1 in both 2020 & 2021. The Bears are a combined 63-6 through their first 23 games over the last 3 seasons.
- Baylor needs one more win to record the 13th 20-win season in the last 15 years. Prior to that, BU recorded only three 20-win seasons in the first 100 years of Baylor Basketball (1946, 1948, 1988).
- BU has been 7-2 or better midway through Big 12 play in 3-straight seasons (only once previously 2012).
- BU is playing its 301st game as a ranked team under Drew BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since January 2010, BU has been ranked in 286 of 423 games.
- Baylor's 35-7 Big 12 Conference record over the last 3 seasons is the best of any Power-5 team.
- Baylor's 47-6 record over the last 2 seasons is the nation's best among Power-5 teams, and the Bears' 73-10 record over the last 3 seasons is 2nd-best nationally, trailing only Gonzaga (81-5).
- BU is 16-0 this season when winning points off turnovers and 15-0 when winning points in the paint.
- Baylor is the nation's only team ranked top-40 in scoring offense (39th) and scoring defense (25th).
- Baylor ranks top-25 nationally in scoring margin (8th, +15.6), steals (10th, 9.6), assists (15th, 16.9), offensive rebounds (13th, 13.3), turnovers forced (18th, 17.1), turnover margin (21st, +4.0), rebounding margin (24th, +6.7), adj. offensive efficiency (9th, 117.5) and adj. defensive efficiency (17th, 90.9).
- Over the last 3 seasons, Baylor is 61-3 when leading at the half and 73-5 when taking a 2nd-half lead.
- BU has forced 10+ turnovers in 31-straight games, including 12+ TOs in 22 of 23 games this season.
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 43-straight weeks top-10 ranked (top-5 ranked in 38 of those).
- BU is on a school-record streak of 51-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). It's the nation's 3rd-longest active streak behind Gonzaga (109) and Villanova (54).

#### **QUICK HITS**

- Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 6 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power 5 schools to win 18 + games every year since 2008.
- BU ranks 4th nationally in KenPom's offensive rebound pct (37.7), its 8th-straight year ranked top-10.
- Baylor has built leads of 10 + points in 26 of 29 games since the start of the 2021 NCAA Tournament (25-4 record).
- BU has built double digit leads in 71 of 83 games over the last 3 seasons (47 of 53 last 2 seasons).
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 19th season at Baylor with a school-record 389 career victories, including a 17-8 mark in NCAA Tournaments, which is the 7th-best mark among active coaches.
- Drew has swept AP and coaches' Big 12 Coach of the Year honors each of the last two seasons.
- . For a second-straight season, Baylor was one of the nation's final two undefeated teams.
- BU went 305 days between losses, the longest in program history (March 12, 2021 Jan. 11, 2022).
- BU had a 36-game non-conference winning streak with 813 days between losses (Nov. 8, 2019 Jan. 29, 2022).
- BU went 1,038 days without consecutive losses before dropping back-to-back games Jan. 11 and Jan. 15.
- Baylor became the first program to start consecutive seasons 15-0 since Syracuse in 2010-11 and 2011-12.
- Baylor's streak of 9 consecutive postseasons is tied as the nation's 7th-longest active streak.
- Baylor is 91-6 when leading at halftime over the last 5 seasons (61-3 over last 3 seasons, 24-0 last season).
- Baylor has won 90% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (208-22).
- BU is 73-5 when leading at any point in the 2nd half of a game over the last 3 seasons.
- Baylor is 264-103 over the last 10+ seasons, averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 264 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (304).
- Baylor is 355-150 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships. Five of Baylor's players have used or are currently using a redshirt year. Two after transferring to BU (Flagler,
- Tchamwa Tchatchoua), one before transferring (Bonner) and two as freshmen Turner and Langston Love.
- Ten of Baylor's 11 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (16 of last 17 seasons).
- Baylor is 1 of 10 teams nationally to appear in every postseason since 2012 (7 NCAAs, 2 NITs).
- Baylor has the nation's 9th-longest active streak with at least one 3-point FG made in 985 straight games the last time Baylor failed to make a 3-pointer was more than 30 years ago, on Feb. 21, 1990 vs. Texas Tech (0-8).
- Baylor has won 8 tournament titles under Drew 2007 Paradise Jam, 2011 Las Vegas Classic, 2013 NIT, 2016 & 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational and 2021 NCAA Championship.

#### NOTABLE STREAKS

- Baylor has won 6-straight games against Kansas State, which is the Bears' longest winning streak in series history and ties the longest streak by either team (K-State won 6-straight in 2017-19).
- Baylor has taken a lead in 109-consecutive games (last wire-to-wire loss Dec. 1, 2018 at Wichita State).
- BU has won 58-straight when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (last loss March 2, 2019 at K-State).
- Baylor has won 35-straight games when shooting 50% or higher (last loss March 18, 2018 vs. Mississippi State).
- Baylor has won 35-straight games when scoring 80+ points (last loss Jan. 5, 2019 vs. TCU).
- Baylor has had at least 3 players make 3-pointers in 26-consecutive games (last on March 27, 2021 vs. Villanova).
- Baylor has made 3 or more 3-pointers in 112-consecutive games (last on Nov. 23, 2018 vs. Ole Miss).
- Baylor has won 9-consecutive neutral-site games (last loss Nov. 8, 2019 vs. Washington in Alaska).
- Baylor has won 21-consecutive non-conference home games (last loss Dec. 18, 2018 vs. SFA).

#### **SERIES HISTORY VS. K-STATE**

- Wednesday is the 48th all-time meeting. Baylor leads the series 24-23, including a 23-18 lead in the Big 12 era.
- BU out scored K-State 355-245 in sweeping all 4 games over the last 2 seasons (average of 89-61).
- Baylor won all 6 games vs. K-State over the last 3 seasons, its longest winning streak in series history. BU led wireto-wire in 4 of those 6 meetings and led for 96% of game time (229:49 or 240:00) while trailing for 1% (3:05).
- BU hasn't trailed by more than 3 points in any of those 6 games against K-State since the 2019-20 season.
- Since Big 12 double round-robin play began in 2012, BU has swept the season series four times (2014, 2016, 2020, 2021) and K-State has swept three times (2013, 2018, 2019). The teams split in 2012, 2015 and 2017.

#### LAST SEASON VS. K-STATE

- Baylor won all 3 meetings against K-State last season, winning 100-69 in Manhattan (Dec. 19), 107-59 in Waco (Jan. 27) and 74-68 in Kansas City (March 11). The average score of those games was 94-65.
- It was the first time since 1979 vs. TCU that Baylor scored 100 + points twice in a season against one opponent.
- Baylor returned only 27% of its points scored (76 of 281) against K-State last season Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua (22), Matthew Mayer (21), LJ Cryer (11), Flo Thamba (9), Zach Loveday (8) and Adam Flagler (5).

#### THIS SEASON VS. K-STATE

- Baylor built an 18-point halftime lead and cruised to a 74-49 win over Kansas State on Jan. 25 in Waco.
- Kendall Brown (10 points, 11 rebounds) and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua (13 points, 12 rebounds) both posted double-doubles, while Dale Bonner had a season-high 5 assists.
- Jeremy Sochan returned after missing 4.5 games with an injury. He had 5 points, 2 rebounds, 2 steals in 21 minutes.

#### NATION'S-BEST 19-5 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST THREE SEASONS

- Baylor is 19-5 against AP Top-25 ranked teams over the last 3 seasons.
- BU is 7-2 at home vs. ranked teams in the last 3 seasons wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 WVU (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021), #18 Texas Tech (March 2021) and #6 Villanova (Dec. 2021), and losses by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020) and #19 Texas Tech (Jan. 2022).
- The record includes 12-3 away from home, with neutral wins vs. #17 Villanova (Nov. 2019), vs. #5 Illinois (Nov. 2020), vs. #18 Villanova (March 2021), vs. #10 Arkansas (March 2021), vs. #6 Houston (April 2021) and #1 Gonzaga (April 2021) and road wins at #22 Texas Tech (Jan. 2020), at #4 Kansas (Jan. 2020), at #15 Texas Tech (Jan. 2021), at #6 Texas (Feb. 2021), at #6 West Virginia (March 2021) and at #8 Iowa State (January 2022).

#### **BAYLOR PARTNERS WITH CITY OF WACO ON \$700 MILLION RIVERFRONT PROJECT**

- Baylor and the City of Waco have partnered on a \$700 million riverfront development project, headlined by the \$185 million Foster Pavilion, the future home for Baylor's national champion basketball programs.
- Foster Pavilion (capacity 7,500) will be located along the Brazos River on the opposite side of I-35 from McLane Stadium.
- Groundbreaking is expected in June 2022, with the pavilion targeted for a January 2024 opening.
- Development Centers for both basketball programs are included in the 245k square foot Foster Pavilion project.

#### **RANKED NO. 1 FOR THIRD-STRAIGHT SEASON**

- Baylor reached No. 1 nationally on Dec. 13, marking a third-straight season with a No. 1 national ranking.
- BU was No. 1 for the first time on Jan. 9, 2017, spent five weeks ranked No. 1 in 2019-20, was No. 1 in the preseason and week 1 coaches' polls last year and has been No. 1 for five weeks in 2021-22.
- Baylor has now been ranked No. 1 in 14 weekly polls all time. The Bears are 19-4 when playing as a No. 1 team.
- Baylor joins Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas as the only programs ranked No. 1 in four seasons since 2016-17.

#### **PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS**

- Drew is in his 19th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (389).
- Baylor has had a nation-leading four players selected in the NBA Draft since 2010 who weren't ranked in the ESPN100 out of high school Quincy Acy, Ekpe Udoh, Pierre Jackson and Taurean Prince.
- Drew has graduated 55 players during his Baylor tenure, averaging 3 graduates per season.
- The Bears have advanced to postseason play in a school-record nine straight seasons (7 NCAA, 2 NIT).
- Baylor is 26-4 in regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, including 5 regular-season tournament titles.

#### ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew has swept Big 12 Coach of the Year honors from the league coaches and media each of the last two seasons. He was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 19th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (389).
- Drew is coaching his 609th game at Baylor (389-219). His .640 winning pct. is best in BU history among coaches with 40+ games, and he's the program's all-time wins leader with 188 more victories than any other coach.
- Baylor has a .703 winning percentage (355-150) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .719 winning percentage (264-103) over the last 10+ seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (51) is the youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- Baylor is playing its 301st game as a ranked team in Drew's 19 seasons. BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games
  over the program's first 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since January 2010. BU has been ranked in 286 of 423 games.
- In Drew's first 18 seasons at Baylor, 48 players have gone on to professional careers.

- Baylor is 13-1 against the Big East during the Drew era, 16-5 vs. the Pac-12 during the Drew era, and 17-11 against the SEC during the Drew era, including 12-6 since 2012-13 and 7-2 in the Big 12/SEC Challenge.
- The Bears are 5-0 against Big Ten teams since 2015, with wins against Michigan State (2016 B4A), Wisconsin (2017 HOF Classic), Illinois (2020 Jimmy V Classic), Wisconsin (2021 NCAAT) and Michigan State (2021 B4A).

- Baylor was the nation's final undefeated team before suffering its first loss on Jan. 12.

- The Bears' 15-0 start tied the 4th-longest winning streak to start a season by a returning national champion 34 by UNLV (1991-92), 18 by Georgetown (1984-85), 17 by Duke (1991-92) and 15 by Duke (2010-11).

#### **ENTIRE STAFF BACK FOR FIFTH-STRAIGHT SEASON**

- Scott Drew's entire coaching staff returned for the 2021-22 season, a fifth-straight season of continuity.
- Jerome Tang is in his fifth season as associate head coach and has been on Drew's staff all 19 seasons at Baylor.
- Assistant coaches Alvin Brooks III (sixth season) and John Jakus (fifth season) also return to the bench.
- Special assistant & director of player development Jared Nuness is back for his 12th season, while director of basketball operations Aditya Malhotra returns for his ninth season. Special assistant to the head coach Bill Peterson and director of video operations Ty Beard are both back for their fifth seasons.

#### BEARS WELCOME HIGHEST-RANKED RECRUITING CLASS IN PROGRAM HISTORY FOR 2021-22

- Baylor signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history in November 2020, inking a trio of top-40 recruits for the 2021-22 season. BU's 2021 recruiting class was ranked No. 4 nationally by ESPN.
- The Bears signed 5-star forward Kendall Brown, 4-star guard Langston Love and 4-star forward Jeremy Sochan.
- Brown was ranked No. 12 nationally, Love was No. 23 nationally and Sochan was No. 40 nationally.
- Brown and Sochan debuted in the season-opener, but Love is out for the year with a knee injury.

#### **ANOTHER STRONG CLASS HEADED TO WACO IN 2022**

- Baylor's three-player 2022 signing class is ranked No. 13 nationally by ESPN.com.
- The Bears signed the highest-ranked recruit in program history with No. 3-ranked Keyonte George (IMG Academy).
- George was recently named a McDonald's All-American, making him the 5th Burger Boy in BU history, joining Tweety Carter, Perry Jones III, Isaiah Austin and Kendall Brown.
- Baylor signed another guard with No. 53-ranked Dillon Hunter (Sunrise Christian) and added 4-star big man prospect Joshua Ojianwuna (NBA Global Academy – Australia).

#### ALL FOUR DEPARTED STARTERS NOW PLAYING PROFESSIONALLY

- All four departed starters from last season's National Championship team are now playing professionally.
- Davion Mitchell was drafted No. 9 overall by the Sacramento Kings.
- Jared Butler was drafted No. 40 by the New Orleans Pelicans (traded to Utah Jazz).
- MaCio Teague is playing on the Utah Jazz G-League team.
- Mark Vital is suiting up for the NFL's Kansas City Chiefs.

#### **POINT GUARDS THRIVE IN DREW'S SYSTEM**

- Ten of Baylor's 11 starting point guards during the Scott Drew era have earned All-Big 12 recognition.
- Baylor's starting point guard has earned All-Big 12 recognition in 16 of 17 seasons since 2004-05.
- Jared Butler (2019, 2020, 2021), Davion Mitchell (2020, 2021), Makai Mason (2019), Manu Lecomte (2017, 2018), Lester Medford (2016), Kenny Chery (2014, 2015), Pierre Jackson (2012, 2013), Tweety Carter (2010), Curtis Jerrells (2007, 2008, 2009) and Aaron Bruce (2005, 2006, 2007) have earned All-Big 12 recognition.

#### SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Three current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 13th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Grant McCasland is in his fifth season as head coach at North Texas. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Paul Mills is in his fifth season as head coach at Oral Roberts. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- All 3 former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.

#### NINE CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of nine consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 12 of the last 13 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
- Baylor is 1 of 10 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Iona, Kansas, Michigan State, North Carolina, Oregon, Saint Mary's, Virginia and Wichita State.
- BU earned NCAA Tournament bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019 and 2021 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- · Baylor has appeared in 12 of the last 13 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

#### **OFFENSE STRUGGLES IN LOSS AT KANSAS**

- Baylor fell behind early and could never close the gap in an eventual 83-59 loss at No. 10 Kansas on Feb. 5.
- The Bears scored their fewest adjusted points-per-possession (0.776) since the 2017 Sweet 16.
- BU also had its lowest field goal percentage (29.6) since Jan. 14, 2013.
- Adam Flagler had a team-high 16 points and 4 steals, while Kendall Brown added 12 points and a team-high 8 boards.

#### DOWN TO TWO GUARDS, BEARS COME FROM BEHIND TO SWEEP WEST VIRGINIA

- Baylor was down to 2 scholarship guards with all remaining scholarship players 6'8 or taller, and the Bears trailed
- 57-48 with 10 minutes left, but BU fought back with a 16-6 run and held off West Virginia 81-77 on Jan. 31 in Waco.
- BU committed only 1 turnover in the final 15 minutes, and Matthew Mayer scored all 9 of his points in the final 3:30.
- Dale Bonner made his first D1 start and played a career-high 36 minutes, while James Akinjo poured in 25 points in a season-high 38 minutes. Jeremy Sochan (13) and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua (14) added 27 bench points.

#### **BEARS FALL AT ALABAMA IN BIG 12/SEC CHALLENGE**

- Baylor suffered only its second loss in nine Big 12/SEC Challenge games when it fell 87-78 at Alabama on Jan. 29.
- The Bears led 32-31 with less than two minutes remaining in the first half, but Alabama closed the half on a 7-2
- run and BU wouldn't get closer than 2 points the rest of the way. Alabama shot 79% (22-28) on 2-point field goals.
- BU made a run to cut a 15-point deficit to 4 with 4 minutes left, but Alabama answered with a 6-0 run.
- Leading scorer LJ Cryer missed the game (injury), but Jeremy Sochan had a career-high 17 points in 32 minutes.

#### **BU ROLLS PAST K-STATE IN SOCHAN'S RETURN**

- Baylor built an 18-point halftime lead and cruised to a 74-49 win over Kansas State on Jan. 25 in Waco.
- Kendall Brown (10 points, 11 rebounds) and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua (13 points, 12 rebounds) both posted double-doubles, while Dale Bonner had a season-high 5 assists.
- Jeremy Sochan returned after missing 4.5 games with an injury. He had 5 points, 2 rebounds, 2 steals in 21 minutes.

#### BEARS CLOSE STRONG TO WIN AT OKLAHOMA

- Baylor used a late 18-4 run to the put the game away in a 65-51 win at Oklahoma on Jan. 22.
- The 51 points BU allowed tied the fewest scored by OU in any game since BU won 77-47 in Norman on Jan. 28, 2019.
- Baylor went on a 16-0 run the final 4 minutes of the first half and first 2 minutes of the second half.
- BU forced 25 turnovers and recorded 16 steals, led by Matthew Mayer and James Akinjo with 4 steals each.

#### SHORT-HANDED BEARS BREAK THROUGH AT WEST VIRGINIA

- Baylor was without starting point guard James Akinjo (31.1 mpg) and reserve forward Jeremy Sochan (21.9 mpg), but the short-handed Bears fought off a tough West Virginia team for a 77-68 win in Morgantown on Jan. 18.
- LJ Cryer (25) and Matthew Mayer (20) both scored career-highs, while Adam Flagler added 14 points and a gamehigh 7 assists). That trio combined for 20 points in the final 8 minutes as BU erased WVU's 54-53 lead.
- Dale Bonner contributed 4 assists in a season-high 26 minutes and had a game-high + 18 plus-minus.

#### LATE RALLY FALLS SHORT VS. OKLAHOMA STATE

- Baylor trailed by 17 points with 11 minutes left, then cut the deficit to 55-54 with 1:21 left before falling short in a 61-54 loss to Oklahoma State on Jan. 15. The Bears had two chances to tie or take the lead in the final minute.
- LJ Cryer led the Bears with 18 points. BU was without James Akinjo for the final 9 minutes, as he battled through a bruised tailbone, and Jeremy Sochan missed his second-straight game with a sprained ankle.
- With the loss, Baylor suffered consecutive losses for the first time since March 14, 2019.

#### **BEARS SUFFER FIRST LOSS TO NO. 19 TEXAS TECH**

- Baylor built an early 15-point lead and led for more than 31 minutes of game time, but No. 19 Texas Tech used a late 8-0 run to take the lead for good and hand Baylor its first loss of the season, 65-62, on Jan. 11.
- Adam Flagler and James Akinjo had 17 points apiece, but aside from Flagler's 5-of-8, the rest of the team shot 3-of-16 from 3-point range. The Bears also forced a season-low 12 turnovers and had a season-low 5 steals.
- The loss snapped Baylor's 21-game winning streak (3rd-longest by any team in Big 12 history).

#### FLAGLER SPARKS COMEBACK FROM 9 DOWN TO WIN AT TCU

- Baylor trailed TCU by 9 points early in the second half, but the Bears used a 17-0 run to take the lead for good in a 76-64 win in Fort Worth on Jan. 8. Adam Flagler had 18 second-half points (6-of-9 from 3-point range).
- James Akinjo added 20 points, 8 assists and 3 steals to lead the Bears to the comeback victory.
- LJ Cryer contributed 15 points off the bench, giving the guard trio 57 of the team's 76 points.

#### AKINJO AND FLAGLER PUSH BEARS PAST OKLAHOMA FOR 20TH-STRAIGHT WIN

- Baylor prevailed 84-74 in a hard-fought battle against Oklahoma on Jan. 4, led by a career-high 27 points from James Akinjo and a Baylor-career high 22 points from Adam Flagler.
- Oklahoma shot 75% (24-of-32) on 2-point field goals, the highest ever by a Big 12 team in a loss, but the Bears overcame that by out-rebounding the Sooners 34-16 and recording a 19-0 edge in second-chance points.

#### BEARS PREVAIL AT IOWA STATE IN HISTORIC MATCHUP OF UNDEFEATED TEAMS

- Baylor led wire-to-wire and fought off a late comeback in a 77-72 win at No. 8 lowa State on New Year's Day.
- James Akinjo had a team -high 16 points, and Jeremy Sochan and LJ Cryer combined for 25 points off the bench.
- The matchup was the first time two undefeated Big 12 teams met in conference play (min. 10 games), as both teams entered 12-0. It was the 4th time in the last 40 years any two 12-0 or better Division I teams matched up.

#### AKINJO, FLAGLER SHINE IN WIN OVER NORTHWESTERN STATE

- Baylor rolled to a 104-68 win over Northwestern State on Dec. 28, led by James Akinjo's career-high 27 points along with 9 assists, and Adam Flagler's 21 points, career-high 11 assists and 0 turnovers.
- Jeremy Sochan made his career first start and recorded his first double double with 16 points and 11 boards.

#### **BEARS SHARE WEATLH IN WIN OVER ALCORN STATE**

- Baylor rolled to a 94-57 win over Alcorn State on Dec. 20 in its final game before the Christmas break.
- Nine different Bears combined for 29 assists, and seven different Bears hit 3-pointers in the win.
- . Flo Thamba and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua both posted career-highs of 16 points on a combined 14-14 FGs.

#### COMEBACK FROM 10 DOWN IN FIRST ROAD TEST AT OREGON

 Baylor faced a 34-24 deficit 15 minutes into its first road game, but the Bears fought back to take a 42-41 lead with 17 minutes remaining and used a 12-0 run to a break a 51-all tie in a 78-70 win at Oregon on Dec. 18.

- Head coach Scott Drew recorded his 400th career victory (380 at Baylor) in his 20th season as a head coach.
- Kendall Brown scored a team-high 17 points (15 in 2nd half), including 9 as part of the decisive 12-0 run.
- James Akinjo had 17 points and a game-high 6 assists, and Adam Flagler had 16 points with 5 first-half treys.

#### **DOMINANT WIN OVER NO. 6 VILLANOVA**

- Baylor put together a dominant defensive performance in a 57-36 win over No. 6 Villanova on Dec. 12.
- The Bears held Villanova to its fewest points since 1979, lowest field goal percentage (.222) of the 21-year Jay Wright era and fewest points by any AP Top 10 team in the shot clock era.
- It was BU's 8th-straight win over top 10 ranked teams and improved BU to 13-1 vs. the Big East in the Drew era.
- James Akinjo had a game-high 16 points along with 7 rebounds and 5 assists, as BU improved to 3-0 vs. Villanova.

#### **ANOTHER BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS TITLE**

- Baylor won its second Battle 4 Atlantis title (2016, 2021) with wins over Arizona State, VCU and Michigan State. The Bears joined Villanova (2013, 2017) as the only 2-time Battle 4 Atlantis Champions.
- Baylor is now 39-12 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including 26-4 since 2013-14.
- James Akinjo was named 2021 B4A MVP, while Kendall Brown joined him on the All-Tournament Team.
- Baylor defeated VCU, Michigan State and Louisville, respectively, to win the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis.

#### BEARS NOTCH MARQUEE WIN OVER MICHIGAN STATE IN B4A TITLE GAME

- Baylor won the Battle 4 Atlantis title with a 75-58 win over Michigan State on Nov. 26. The 17-point margin of victory was the largest for a non-conference team against Michigan State since Nov. 15, 2016 (Kentucky, 69-48).
- BU faced its largest deficit at 36-31 with 2:20 left in the first half, then went on a 24-6 run and led by double-digits for the final 14 minutes. BU forced 19 turnovers and had 15 more field goal attempts than the Spartans.
- James Akinio (game-highs 15 pts. 5 assists) was named MVP, and Kendall Brown was named All-Tournament.

#### HARD-FOUGHT B4A SEMIFINAL WIN OVER VCU

- Baylor overcame 13 first-half turnovers in a hard-fought 69-61 win over VCU in the Battle 4 Atlantis semifinals.
- The Bears led 29-27 at the break, then started the second half on a 9-0 run. VCU cut the deficit to 3 points with 11 minutes left, but BU responded with a 6-0 run and led by at least 4 points the rest of the game.
- BU was out-shot (42%-40%), but forced 19 turnovers and out-rebounded VCU 42-33. Matthew Mayer led BU with 15 points, while Kendall Brown added 14, and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua tied his career-high 13 points.

#### BEARS PULL AWAY EARLY IN BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS WIN OVER ARIZONA STATE

- Baylor broke a 23-23 tie with a 19-4 run and led by double-digits for the final 22 minutes in a 75-63 win over Arizona State on Nov. 24 in the Battle 4 Atlantis first round. BU won despite shooting a season-low 42% from the field.
- Flo Thamba posted career-highs with 11 points in 23 minutes, while LJ Cryer (15 points) led the Bears in scoring for a 4th-straight game. Matthew Mayer (14), Adam Flagler (13) and Kendall Brown (10) also scored 10+ points.

#### **BEARS RETURN SEVEN LETTERWINNERS FROM NATIONAL TITLE TEAM**

- Baylor lost four starters from last season's National Championship team, but the Bears returned seven lettermen.
- BU's seven returning lettermen entered this year with a combined 344 games (77 starts) of collegiate experience.
- Matthew Mayer (93 career games), Flo Thamba (82 career games, 30 starts), Adam Flagler (64 career games, 36 starts), Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua (60 career games, 11 starts), LJ Cryer (20 career games), Zach Loveday (13 career games) and Jordan Turner (12 career games) all returned from last year's National Championship team.

#### **BIG 12'S MOST WINS IN CONFERENCE CHALLENGES**

- Baylor is 12-3 in conference challenges 7-2 in Big 12/SEC Challenge, 3-1 in Big 12/Pac-10, 2-0 in Big 12/Big East.
- Baylor's 7-2 Big 12/SEC Challenge record includes wins vs. 7 different teams Kentucky (neutral), Vanderbilt (road), Georgia (home), Ole Miss (road), Alabama (home), Florida (road) and Auburn (home).
- Baylor's 7-2 record is the best record by any team in the Big 12/SEC Challenge. OU, OSU and Texas Tech are 6-3, while Kansas is 5-3, TCU is 5-4, Texas is 4-4, Iowa State is 4-5, K-State is 3-6 and WVU is 2-7.
- Baylor's 12-3 record in conference challenges is best in the Big 12, followed by OSU at 10-6, Kansas at 9-7, Iowa State at 8-7, OU at 8-8, Texas at 7-7, TCU at 6-6, Texas Tech at 7-8, K-State at 5-10 and WVU at 4-8.

### APPEARANCES IN SIX OF LAST SEVEN NCAA TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in the last seven tournaments.
- BU is 1 of 16 teams to appear in six NCAA Tournaments since 2014, joining Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Michigan State, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Oregon, Purdue, VCU, Villanova, Virginia, Wichita State and Wisconsin.

- Baylor has a track record of success when redshirting players. Davion Mitchell, MaCio Teague, Freddie Gillespie, Mark Vital, Ekpe Udoh, Johnathan Motley, Cory Jefferson, Brady Heslip, Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. and Manu Lecomte have all gone on to professional careers after redshirting.
- Adam Flagler and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua redshirted in 2019-20 while sitting out to satisfy NCAA transfer rules, while Jordan Turner elected to redshirt in 2019-20.

#### **BAYLOR BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO**

- Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Network from Learfield on ESPN Central Texas and flagship station 1660AM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.
- Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and former Baylor basketball standout Pat Nunley.
- Morris is in his 38th year doing BU broadcasts (27th full-time), and Nunley is in his 41st season as analyst.
- All of Baylor's games can be heard live on the Internet at www.BaylorBears.com and via the Tuneln App.

#### **OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE**

- Baylor has ranked top-10 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in all eight seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation's top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor's 8-year streak is the nation's best, and West Virginia (7 years) is the only other team with a 4+ year streak.
- Baylor currently ranks 5th nationally in offensive rebounding percentage, grabbing 37% of its missed field goals.
- BU finished No. 5 in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that top-10 streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

#### **GRADUATING 91 PERCENT OF SENIORS**

- Since Scott Drew took over the Baylor Basketball program in 2003, 38 of 41 scholarship players who have played their final years of collegiate eligibility under Drew have graduated from Baylor.

- Baylor is 39-12 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 5 tournaments.
- BU is 26-4 in its eight regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1, 3-0 and 3-0.
- BU advanced to championship games in the 2007 Paradise Jam (won), 2008 76 Classic (lost), 2011 Las Vegas Classic (won), 2013 Maui Invitational (lost), 2014 Las Vegas Invitational (lost), 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis (won), 2017 Hall of Fame Classic (won), 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational (won) and 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis (won).
- Baylor has won six regular-season tournament titles under Drew 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2011 Las Vegas Classic and 2007 Paradise Jam.

#### DREW IS THIRD BIG 12 COACH TO REACH 150 CONFERENCE WINS

- Scott Drew joined Rick Barnes and Bill Self as the only coaches to reach 150 Big 12 wins on March 4, 2021 vs. OSU.
- Drew needed 136 games over 2,940 days for his first 50 Big 12 wins (50-86), 88 games over 1,821 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-38) and only 77 games over 1,493 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-27).

#### **48 PRO PLAYERS IN DREW ERA**

- In Scott Drew's 18 years at Baylor, 48 of his players have gone on to professional careers.
- Five Bears are currently on NBA rosters Jared Butler (Jazz), Davion Mitchell (Kings), Royce O'Neale (Jazz), Taurean Prince (Timberwolves) and Ishmail Wainright (Suns).
- In addition to the five current NBA players, eight more of Drew's former players have played in the NBA (most recent team) – Quincy Acy (Raptors), Freddie Gillespie (Raptors), Pierre Jackson (Mavs), Cory Jefferson (Suns), Perry Jones III (Thunder), Quincy Miller (Kings), Johnathan Motley (Clippers) and Ekpe Udoh (Jazz).

#### **BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12**

- BU is 134-84 in Big 12 play in 13 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 148-101 in Big 12 play in 15 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 52-42 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (62-34).
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 10 straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has double-digit Big 12 wins in 6 of the last 7 years and 8 of the last 12 seasons. BU didn't reach double-digit Big 12 wins in any of its first 13 years in the league before reaching 10+ for the first time since 2010.




