 Baylor is participating the Shriners Children's College Classic for the fourth time since the tournament rebranded in December 2015. This is BU's 13th appearance in the annual tournament hosted by the Astros Foundation. The Bears are 6-3 at Shriners under seventh-year head coach Steve Rodriguez, including sweeping the SEC (Missouri,

Arkansas, LSU) in its last appearance (2020) at the tournament.

 After a 9-0 win at Rice on Wednesday, the Bears remained in Houston for the weekend tournament, which features a six-team field including No. 1/1 Texas, No. 7/8 LSU, No. 17/16 Tennessee, NR/No. 23 UCLA and Oklahoma.

• BU closes out its five-game road stretch at Abilene Christian on Wednesday, March 9, before returning home for a three-game series against Columbia.

- Baylor is 49-47 in road games under seventh-year head coach Steve Rodriguez and 15-18 in neutral site contests under Rod.
- The Bears will stay close to home in 2022, as 46 of its 52 regular-season contests will be played in the state of Texas.
- Baylor doesn't leave the state of Texas until April 8-10, when it travels to take on West Virginia in Morgantown.

SERIES HISTORY BY THE NUMBERS

· Baylor is 4-7 all-time against UCLA, including a 1-3 mark under Rodriguez. The Bears and Bruins last squared off in the 2020 Los Angeles Regional, with then No. 1 UCLA eliminated BU, 11-6.

• Baylor is 1-0 all time against Tennessee, taking the only previous meeting, 3-2, on Feb. 12, 2005.

 Baylor is 3-9 all-time against LSU, including a 1-1 mark under Rodriguez. The Bears and Tigers last met at the 2020 Shriners Children's College Classic, as the Bears claimed a 6-4 win.

TESTED RIGHT FROM THE START

• 2022 is the first season since 1952 in which 11 of Baylor's first 13 opponents currently compete in Power 5 conferences.

- BU is coming off a series win over former No. 23 Duke and presently boasts a 2-1 record against ranked foes.
- The Bears will face three more ranked opponents this upcoming weekend at the Shriners Children's College Classic.
- Maryland, who was unranked during its opening weekend sweep of BU, now sits at No. 21 in both major polls.

 The Bears will play 22 games against 10 teams who competed in the 2021 NCAA Tournament, including five teams that reached a Super Regional and two that reached the College World Series.

TURNING TWO

- As of Thursday, March 3, Baylor ranks third nationally with 11 double plays turned and fourth with 1.38 DP's per game.
- Third-year sophomore 2B Tre Richardson has recorded an assist in all 11 twin killings so far.
- The Bears rolled just 33 double plays in all of 2021 (0.65 per game).

STRONG STARTERS

• Baylor's starting pitching had a fantastic weekend against Duke, with senior LHP Tyler Thomas and senior RHP Jake Jackson each picking up their first wins of the season.

- The duo, along with sophomore RHP Will Rigney, combined for a 0.53 ERA over the three games, going 17 innings and allowing just one earned run with 15 strikeouts to five walks.
- BU starters have allowed just the one earned run over their last 20.2 innings pitched.

EXTRA, EXTRA! READ ALL ABOUT IT

- Baylor has recorded at least one extra base hit in 32 of its last 35 games, dating back to last season.
- The Bears have tallied 106 extra base hits, including 65 doubles, 11 triples and 30 home runs.
- Baylor has notched at least two extra-base hits in 26 of its last 35 games.
- Through eight games in 2022, BU has tallied nine doubles, two triples and two home runs.

ADD ANOTHER TO THE K-COUNTER

• After racking up double-digit strikeouts in all three games against Maryland, the Baylor pitching staff reached

- double figures once again vs. Duke in Sunday's second game of the doubleheader with 12.
- The Bears have tallied 69 K's in eight games this season.
- The Bears only reached double figures in 16 of their 51 games in 2021.

DIGGIN' THE LONG BALL

• Baylor has hit 257 home runs in 297 games under seventh-year head coach Steve Rodriguez, including 48 in 2021.

- Before 2020, the Bears were coming off back-to-back-back seasons with at least 50 home runs (51 in 2017, 54
- in 2018, 57 in 2019) for the first time since 2008 (52), 2009 (73) and 2010 (57) and first time in the BBCOR era.
- In 2020, BU was on pace to hit over 50 home runs once again prior to the season getting canceled.
- The Bears finished with 15 homers in just 16 games in 2020.

THE BIG RIG

• After suffering season-ending injuries in each of his first two seasons, third-year sophomore RHP Will Rigney is finally healthy and contributing to the pitching staff in a big way.

• The righty, who made his first appearance since March 23, 2021, has tallied 10 strikeouts and walked none in six innings of work so far this season. He currently owns a 3.00 ERA, having allowed just two earned runs.

• His 4.0 IP against Duke were a career high, to go along with 6 K's.

GOING STREAKING

• Six Bears currently boast on-base streaks of at least five games, including Harrison Caley who has hit safely in each of his last five outings.

- Jared McKenzie has a team-best 14-game on-base streak that dates back to the end of the 2021 season.
- Jack Pineda is next with an 11-game on-base streak, dating back to the end of last year.
- Tre Richardson owns a seven-game on-base streak.
- Esteban Cardoza-Oquendo has reached safely in each of his last six games.
- · Chase Wehsener has reached safely in five-straight games.

CLOSING TIME

• Since the arrival of head coach Steve Rodriguez and pitching coach Jon Strauss in 2016, the Bears have had elite arms at the back of the bullpen.

• First it was Troy Montemayor, who is tied for the program record with 37 career saves and earned All-America honors in 2018.

• Then in 2019, Kyle Hill took over the role, earning first team All-America honors, while not giving up a run in 29.1 innings. He earned seven saves and a 6-0 record.

• In 2020 it was senior righty Luke Boyd taking over the role, converting six of seven save attempts in 2020 and following it up with another eight saves in 2021.

• Under the direction of Strauss, the Bears have converted 66 save opportunities, including one so far in 2022 by Matt Voelker.

WHAT'S NEW?

- BU returns 27 players from its 2021 team to the 2022 active roster, and adds 12 newcomers.
- Of the newcomers, six are freshmen and six are transfers.

•Baylor returns 78.3% of its offense with seven position starters returning. Former All-American catcher Andy Thomas and longtime right fielder Davion Downey are the only two departures from the 2021 starting nine.

• Only 47.4% of BU's 2021 innings pitched return, as seniors Jacob Ashkinos, Luke Boyd, Logan Freeman, Hayden Kettler, Ryan Leckich and Jimmy Winston all depart.

• Nine Bears made their Baylor debuts in the season-opening series against Maryland, including Kobe Andrade, Harrison Caley, Cortlan Castle, Henry Cone, Brett Garcia, Cody Grebeck, Jake Jackson, Mason Marriott and Matt Voelker.

• Each of the debutants have appeared in at least two games for the Bears now in 2022, including Cone who made his first-career start on Wednesday at Rice.

• Voelker, a transfer from Loyola Marymount, and Garcia, a transfer from Cypress College, are tied for second on the team with three relief appearances each.

2022 BAYLOR BASEBALL GAME NOTES PRESEASON POLLS, RANKINGS, AWARDS

- The Bears were picked to finish fifth in the Big 12 in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- Texas was the unanimous favorite, collecting all eight possible first place votes for a total of 64 points.
- Oklahoma State was second with 52 points and one first-place vote. Texas Tech came in third with 49 points with TCU trailing by one point in fourth.
- Sitting behind Baylor (33) are Oklahoma (25), Kansas State (23), West Virginia (20) and Kansas (10).

 Sophomore outfielder Jared McKenzie was unanimously named a Preseason All-Big 12 selection, one of six players in the conference to garner a spot unanimously.

 McKenzie also garnered consensus Preseason All-America honors, with his two second-team recognitions (Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, D1Baseball) and two third-team accolades (NCBWA, Perfect Game/Rawlings).

GOLDEN SLUGGER

 Additionally, McKenzie was one of 55 players named to the 2022 Golden Spikes Award Watch List, honoring the nation's top amateur baseball player.

 McKenzie also earned a spot on the 2022 Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award Watch List, which recognizes the nation's top collegiate hitter based on his performance at the plate, academics and personal integrity.

D1 BASEBALL POSITION RANKINGS

- Baylor has five players ranked in D1Baseball's preseason position rankings.
- Jared McKenzie is No. 6 amongst all outfielders.
- Tre Richardson is No. 8 at second base.
- Jack Pineda is No. 18 at shortstop.
- Tyler Thomas is No. 67 and Jake Jackson is No. 84 amongst all starting pitchers.

RECENT DRAFT SUCCESS

- The Bears had two players selected in the 2021 MLB Draft, Andy Thomas and Luke Boyd.
- Thomas was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 5th Round, while Boyd went in the 17th to the San Diego Padres.
- Under Coach Rodriguez, the Bears have had 14 players selected, including three in the first round (Nick Loftin, 2020; Shea Langeliers and Davis Wendzel, 2019).
- For only the second time in program history, the Bears had first round picks in back-to-back drafts in 2019-20.
- Three first round picks in the last two drafts are the most by any school in the nation.
- Overall, the Bears have 150 draft picks in program history and head coach Steve Rodriguez has seen 57 of his student-athletes drafted.

BEHIND THE DISH

 Baylor carries five catchers on its 2022 roster: Nicolas Balsano, Harrison Caley, Cortlan Castle, Cade Currington and Ian Groves, who will each compete for the job and figure to split time behind the plate.

VACUUM AT FIRST

- Fifth-year junior 1B Chase Wehsener carries a .994 fielding percentage into the 2022 season.
- The staple at first base has made just five errors in his career as a Bear, including a perfect redshirt freshman campaign in 2019, three in 2020, two in 2021 and none so far in 2022.

DOUBLE PLAY DUO

• After making a mid-season exchange of positions in 2021, third-year sophomore Tre Richardson and fourth-year iunior Jack Pineda have settled into their respective spots and 2B and SS, respectively.

• The duo are expected to hit at the top of the lineup for the Bears.

HOT CORNER

- Fifth-year senior Esteban Cardoza-Oquendo is the projected starter at third base.
- Baylor also retains options in Antonio Valdez, Alex Gonzales and Cody Grebeck.

BIG LEAGUE OUTFIELDERS

- Third-year sophomore Jared McKenzie will anchor the Baylor outfield in center as one of the more highly-touted prospects in all of college baseball.
- · Fellow third-year sophomore Kyle Nevin makes the switch from left field over to right field, where he can show off his range and plus-arm.
- Kobe Andrade, Alex Gonzales and Antonio Valdez figure to be in the mix in left field.
- Speedy sophomores Jacob Schoenvogel and Nolan Rodriguez provide depth across all three spots.






