STORY LINES

• Baylor Softball is set to host McNeese State in a three-game series this weekend, with a single game Friday night and a doubleheader Saturday. This is the 34th-36th time these two teams are facing each other. Baylor leads the all-time record 26-7 and the record in Waco 15-2.

• Baylor (13-9) are coming off of a midweek game at Texas State where they won 3-0, while McNeese (11-12) are coming off of a five inning run-rule over Southern on Wednesday.

BEAR SHUTOUTS

• BU picked up its fifth shutout of the season in their midweek contest with Texas State defeating them 3-0.

• Dariana Orme and Aliyah Binford combined for eight strikeouts, four apiece, and issued no walks in the TXST win.

• The Bears only had four total shutouts all last season.

HOT OFFENSE

• Baylor is currently second in the Big 12 in batting average with a .315 team average.

• With two outs, the Bears are averaging .314, proving they can hit in timely situations.

• As a team, Baylor is out-hitting opponents 182-140 this season.

• McKenzie Wilson is still leading the conference in triples with five and is currently batting .420.

• Sydney Collazos and Kaci West are leading the Bears in homeruns with two, while three Bears have five doubles.

• Josie Bower is currently batting 1.000 with the bases loaded, while Taylor Strain leads the Big 12 in sacrifice bunts.

FINDING THE INFIELD

• Head coach Glenn Moore is starting to put together his infield, sticking with most of the same players from first to short for the past five games.

• Campbell Selman had a season-high four assists and two putouts against No. 1 Oklahoma this past week.

• At first base, Rhein Trochim had a career-high seven putouts against Cal in the Hawaii tournament.

RAINBOW WAHINE CLASSIC

• Emily Hott led the offensive charge in Hawaii, going 5-for-11 at the plate with a double, a triple and four RBI on a .727 slugging percentage.

• Defensively, Trochim led the charge with 17 total putouts, followed by Kendall Cross and Zadi LaValley with 11 each. The Bears turned two double plays in the tournament.

QUICK HITS

- Baylor will face five ESPN Preseason Top-25 teams this year, with four in the Preseason Top-10; Oklahoma, UCLA, Oklahoma State, Texas and Oregon (three times). Baylor was receiving votes in the ESPN Preseason poll.
- Baylor welcomes back 11 returners from last year, with six freshman and four transfers.
- BU was picked 4th in the Big-12 Preseason coaches' poll. Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, and Texas had the top three spots.
- Every Baylor Softball game this season will be broadcast on the radio on 101.3 FM. Dan Ingham, in his seventh season as the voice of Baylor Softball, will call every game.
- Every home game will be aired on Big 12 Now on ESPN+.

MOORE ERA HIGHLIGHTS

- **Glenn Moore** is coaching his 1,203rd through 1,206th (802-400) games at Baylor this weekend. His .667 winning percentage is best in BU history and he's the program's all-time wins leader.
- **Moore** recorded his 900th win overall with a 10-2 (5) victory over Grand Canyon in Waco (2/14/20).
- **Moore's** 800th career win came with a 9-3 win over McNeese State in Waco (2/22/18).
- **Moore** notched his 700th win at Baylor in the final game of the Tucson Super Regional, punching Baylor's ticket into the Women's College World Series (5/28/17).
- All but one of his 100-win milestones have come at Baylor, with his first 100th game coming during his tenure at LSU with a 6-5 win over Auburn (3/17/00).
- In **Moore's** 22 seasons as Baylor head coach, BU has cracked the Top 25 polls at some point in the season in every one.
- In 2021, **Moore** reached 800 wins at Baylor as he led the Lady Bears back to the postseason at the Gainesville Regional.
- **Moore** has coached 88 of Baylor's 93 All-Big 12 selections and 12 of Baylor's 13 All-Americans.
- Baylor has had 9 players drafted into the National Professional Fastpitch (NPF) draft.
- Baylor has placed at least six selections to the conference's academic honors for 13 straight seasons and five or more for 18 straight years.
- Moore has a career record of 941-442 over 25 seasons as a collegiate head coach, he stands as the active wins leader across all sports for Baylor athletics (802).

FOR LUM

- **Mark Lumley**, who helped Baylor softball make 13 NCAA regionals and four trips to the Women's College World Series in 20 years as an assistant coach, passed away in December of 2020 after his fourth bout with cancer.
- **Lum**, a 1985 graduate of the University of Arizona, was inducted into the Flowing Wells High School Athletic Hall of Fame in 2014.
- During his two decades at Baylor, **Lum** coached multiple All-American hitters.
- Baylor Softball will be playing this season for him.

MEET THE (RETURNING) TEAM

- With 11 returners, you will see some familiar faces on the diamond this year as 2021 letterwinners **Aliyah Binford, Emily Hott, Zadi LaValley, Kendall Cross, Sydney Collazos, Campbell Selman, Maren Judisch, Josie Bower, Ana Watson and Katie Ellington** all came back. From the 2021 roster, **Taylor Strain** is also returned but redshirted the 2021 season.
- Of the returners, **Hott** returns with the highest batting average with .310 last season, while also recording a team high in runs with 35 with 39 hits and 18 RBI.
- **Binford** also made an impact last season as a two-way player for the Bears. She led the team in homeruns with five and RBI with 28. She also pitched 55.2 innings with 41 strikeouts.

MEET THE (TRANSFER) TEAM

- BU picked up four transfers this season that will add power and dominance to the field and lineup. Two transfers come from Fresno State, outfielder **McKenzie Wilson** and pitcher **Dariana Orme**. They also picked up pitcher **Rachel Hertenberger** from Houston and senior outfielder **Rhein Trochim** from Illinois.
- **Wilson**, is making this her comeback season after suffering a season-ending injury prior to her 2021 campaign. In her prior two seasons at Fresno State, she topped the conference in on base percentage and ranked No. 2 in the country in stolen bases per game (1.08).
- **Orme**, redshirted her freshman season at Fresno before logging a 4-1 record the next season. In her 2021 campaign, she finished with an 8-4 record and earned a 3.26 ERA through 68.2 inning of work.
- **Hertenberger**, played three seasons for Houston finishing her 2021 season with a 3.98 ERA through 114.1 inning pitched.
- **Trochim**, is a fifth-year senior, who is originally from Robinson, Texas and is returning home to close out her career.

MEET THE (FRESHMAN) TEAM

- Baylor added six freshmen to their roster this season, **Emry McDonough, Ashlyn Wachtendorf, Grace Powell, Kaci West and Caroline Rowatt**.
- Most of the girls are staying close to home, as five are native to the central Texas/Waco area.

PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN THE WCWS

- Baylor's four appearances in the Women's College World Series places the Lady Bears tied for third all-time among private schools.
- The Lady Bears are the only private school to make the WCWS since 2008, doing so three times over that period (2011, 2014, 2017).
- Since 2000, Baylor leads all private schools with four appearances, with the next closest school being DePaul with three.

GOOD TO BE HOME

- Baylor is in its 23rd full season of play at Getteman Stadium, with the Bears securing a winning record in all but one full competition season since its doors were opened in 1999.
- Their first home game Getteman Stadium will take place Feb. 18 as Baylor hosts Oregon for a three-game series.
- In 2019, brand-new turf was installed on the field by GeoSurfaces, and new LED lights replaced the previous stadium fixtures.
- In 2020, Baylor installed a new video board. Daktronics, who has done every video board on campus with the exception of the one inside the Ferrell Center, did the renovations as the old scoreboard as be replaced with LED panels. It measures 48 feet by 12 feet. The brick columns on either side of the board will remain in keeping with Baylor's beautiful campus, and lighted letters that read Getteman Stadium are up above.
- Named for Sue and the late Ted Getteman, the stadium is considered one of the most premier softball venues in the nation. At the time, their donation stood as the largest single donation ever to a Baylor women's athletics program.
- When President George W. Bush visited the Western White House in nearby Crawford, Texas, during the summer months of his presidency, members of his staff and Secret Service agents often used Getteman Stadium for pick-up games.
