STORYLINES

LEADING OFF

- . Baylor rounds out its four-game home stretch and enters the sixth week of the season by welcoming UTSA to Baylor Ballpark on Tuesday.
- BU went 1-3 last week, salvaging its Big 12-opening series against No. 21 TCU with a 7-3 win on Sunday.
- The Bears are 5-4 against ranked opponents in 2022, with wins over No. 23 Duke, No. 23 UCLA, No. 7 LSU and No. 21 TCU.
- Baylor is 46-16 in midweek contests under seventh-year head coach Steve Rodriguez, including a 3-1 mark in 2022.
- BU is 78-33 (.703) at Baylor Ballpark over the last five seasons, including a 6-7 record this season.
- The Bears have gone 9-7 against non-conference opponents this year.
- Baylor stays close to home in 2022, as 43 of its 52 regular-season contests will be played in the state of Texas.
- BU doesn't leave The Lone Star State until March 25-27, when it travels to take on Oklahoma in Norman.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Baylor leads the all-time series 35-8 over UTSA.
- BU is 3-1 against UTSA under Rodriguez and has won each of the last two meetings against the Roadrunners.
- The Bears are 2-1 against the Roadrunners in Waco under Rodriguez, and have won eight of the last 10 home contests against UTSA.
- Baylor is 1-0 against C-USA teams in 2022, having previously defeated Rice on March 2.

BEARS BATS HEATING UP

- Over the past week, Baylor's offense erupted for 45 hits across four games, hitting .288 as a team.
- The Bears have tallied seven multi-hit performances in 2022, with three of them coming in the last four games.
- BU set a season-high with 17 hits as a team on Saturday against No. 21 TCU in the 11-inning loss.
- The Bears followed that up with a 14-hit day on Sunday in the 7-3 victory over the Horned Frogs.
- The top of the order has led the charge, as Tre Richardson hit .476 last week (10-for-21), while Jack Pineda has collected multiple hits in five of his last six games.

T-THOM A TRUE FRIDAY NIGHT ACE

- Fifth-year senior LHP Tyler Thomas has turned himself into a bonafide Friday night ace, with five outstanding starts so far in 2022.
- Thomas logged a career day on March 4 against No. 23 UCLA, throwing 8.2 innings and allowing just four hits while notching a career-high 10 strikeouts in the 2-1 win over the Bruins.
- He followed up his career-best outing with another stellar start, going 8.0 scoreless against Columbia with seven strikeouts and just three hits allowed.
- Thomas is now 3-2 in 2022 with a 1.30 ERA, having surrendered just five earned runs across four different frames of his Big 12-leading 34.2 innings pitched.
- He has posted 32 K's and just five walks, ranking second in the conference with a 6.40 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- T-Thom recorded the second-highest game score in college baseball after his start vs. Columbia, an 83, according to D1Baseball.com. He also scored an 82 in his outing against UCLA, the fourth-best rating amongst March 4 pitchers.
- Thomas has helped lead the BU pitching staff to fourth in the Big 12 with a combined 4.01 team ERA.

TURNING TWO

- Baylor leads the Big 12 and ranks fourth nationally with 20 double plays turned in 2022 (1.05 per game).
- Tre Richardson has an assist in 19 of those 20 twin killings so far this season.
- The only DP that did not involved Richardson was a 1-6-3 turned Tuesday, March 15 at SHSU.
- The Bears rolled just 33 double plays in all of 2021 (0.65 per game).

WALK-OFF WINNERS

- Baylor capped off its series win over Columbia in dramatic fashion on Sunday, March 13, as Jared McKenzie delivered an RBI single in the bottom of the 10th inning to win it for the Bears.
- Tre Richardson led off the 10th with a four-pitch walk, then Kyle Nevin doubled off the right field wall. Chase Wehsener was intentionally walked to load the bases for McKenzie, who wasted no time in driving the second pitch he saw into the right-center gap to end it.
- Freshman RHP Mason Marriott provided 2.2 scoreless innings out of the bullpen, putting up zeros to give the Bears' offense a chance at a game-winning run.
- BU starter Will Rigney turned in a career-high 5.1 innings in the no decision, holding the Lions to just three hits and notching a trio of punchouts as well.

MCKENZIE'S ROUND TRIPPER

- Jared McKenzie circled the bases for an inside-the-park home run in Game 2 of Saturday, March 12's double-header against Columbia for his first home run of the season.
- The inside-the-parker was Baylor's first since March 19, 2011, when Chris Slater did so against Texas Tech.
- McKenzie blasted one to deep center field where the ball ricocheted off the wall and got past the Columbia outfielders. He never slowed down and beat the throw to the plate for a two-run shot.

NEUMANN FASTEST FRESHMAN TO HOMER

- Last Wednesday at Abilene Christian, Casen Neumann became the fastest Baylor freshman in the last 20 seasons to hit his first-career home run.
- In just his second-career at-bat, Neumann mashed one over the right field wall for a three-run blast, having entered as a pinch-hitter and putting the Bears ahead, 6-3.
- Neumann beat Landis Ware (3rd AB, 2008), Richard Cunningham (5th AB, 2016), Cam Caley (5th AB, 2021), Max Muncy (6th AB, 2010), Darryn Sheppard (7th AB, 2014) and Josh Ludy (7th AB, 2009) as the fastest BU freshman to hit his first-career HR.

TESTED RIGHT FROM THE START

- 2022 is the first season since 1952 in which 9 of Baylor's first 11 opponents currently compete in Power 5 conferences.
- All nine of those opponents have been, or currently are, ranked in one of the two major polls (D1Baseball, Baseball America).
- In the latest RPI standings, Baylor comes in at No. 63, with the 28th-best rated strength of schedule.
- The Bears will play 22 games against 10 teams who competed in the 2021 NCAA Tournament, including five teams that reached a Super Regional and two that reached the College World Series.

EXTRA, EXTRA! READ ALL ABOUT IT

- Baylor has recorded at least one extra-base hit in 42 of its last 46 games, dating back to last season.
- The Bears have tallied 130 extra base hits, including 80 doubles, 12 triples and 39 home runs over that stretch.
- Baylor has notched at least two extra-base hits in 32 of its last 46 games.
- Through 19 games in 2022, BU has tallied 24 doubles, three triples and 10 home runs.

ADD ANOTHER TO THE K-COUNTER

- Baylor has racked up double-digit strikeouts as a pitching staff in six of its 19 games in 2022.
- The Bears did so in all three games against Maryland (14, 10, 12), then notched 12 vs. Duke in game one of Feb. 27's doubleheader, and collected 10 against both UCLA (March 4) and LSU (March 6) at the Shriners Children's College Classic.
- The Bears have tallied 141 K's in 19 games this season.
- The Bears only reached double figures in 16 of their 51 games in 2021.

GAME 20 - UTSA

DIGGIN' THE LONG BALL

- Baylor has hit 265 home runs in 308 games under seventh-year head coach Steve Rodriguez, including 48 in 2021.
- Before 2020, the Bears were coming off back-to-back-back seasons with at least 50 home runs (51 in 2017, 54 in 2018, 57 in 2019) for the first time since 2008 (52), 2009 (73) and 2010 (57) and first time in the BBCOR era.
- In 2020, BU was on pace to hit over 50 home runs once again prior to the season getting canceled.
- The Bears finished with 15 homers in just 16 games in 2020.

BEARS SHRINE BRIGHT

- Senior LHP Tyler Thomas was named the 2022 Shriners Children's College Classic Most Outstanding Player after going 8.2 IP with a career-high 10 strikeouts in the win against No. 23 UCLA.
- Thomas also earned Big 12 Pitcher of the Week distinction for his dazzling performance.
- Sophomore OF Kyle Nevin (4-for-10, 1 HR, 6 RBIs, 1 SB) and junior INF Jack Pineda (4-for-12, 5 R, 1 HR, 2 RBIs, 3 SB) joined Thomas on the All-Tournament Team.

BIG 12 HARDWARE

- Thomas was named the Big 12's Pitcher of the Week after his dazzling performance against the Bruins.
- It marked Baylor's first Big 12 Pitcher of the Week honor since 2018, when Cody Bradford won the award three times.
- It is the eighth weekly pitching accolade for the Bears under seventh-year head coach Steve Rodriguez.
- . This was Baylor's first Big 12 weekly recognition since the opening week of the 2021 season, when Jared McKenzie was named the league's Newcomer of the Week, Baylor's only recognition of the 2021 campaign.

WHAT'S NEW?

- BU returns 27 players from its 2021 team to the 2022 active roster, and adds 12 newcomers.
- Of the newcomers, six are freshmen and six are transfers.
- Baylor returns 78.3% of its offense with seven position starters returning. Former All-American catcher Andy Thomas and longtime right fielder Davion Downey are the only two departures from the 2021 starting nine.
- Only 47.4% of BU's 2021 innings pitched return, as seniors Jacob Ashkinos, Luke Boyd, Logan Freeman, Hayden Kettler, Ryan Leckich and Jimmy Winston all depart.

PRESEASON POLLS, RANKINGS, AWARDS

- The Bears were picked to finish fifth in the Big 12 in a vote by the league's head coaches.
- Texas was the unanimous favorite, collecting all eight possible first-place votes for a total of 64 points.
- Oklahoma State was second with 52 points and one first-place vote. Texas Tech came in third with 49 points with TCU trailing by one point in fourth.
- Sitting behind Baylor (33) are Oklahoma (25), Kansas State (23), West Virginia (20) and Kansas (10).
- Sophomore outfielder Jared McKenzie was unanimously named a Preseason All-Big 12 selection, one of six players in the conference to garner a spot unanimously.
- McKenzie also garnered consensus Preseason All-America honors, with his two second-team recognitions (Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, D1Baseball) and two third-team accolades (NCBWA, Perfect Game/Rawlings).

GOLDEN SLUGGER

- Additionally, McKenzie was one of 55 players named to the 2022 Golden Spikes Award Watch List, honoring the nation's top amateur baseball player.
- McKenzie also earned a spot on the 2022 Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award Watch List, which recognizes the nation's top collegiate hitter based on his performance at the plate, academics and personal integrity.

RECENT DRAFT SUCCESS

- The Bears had two players selected in the 2021 MLB Draft, Andy Thomas and Luke Boyd.
- Thomas was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 5th Round, while Boyd went in the 17th to the San Diego Padres.
- Under Coach Rodriguez, the Bears have had 14 players selected, including three in the first round (Nick Loftin, 2020; Shea Langeliers and Davis Wendzel, 2019).
- For only the second time in program history, the Bears had first round picks in back-to-back drafts in 2019-20.
- Three first round picks in the last two drafts are the most by any school in the nation.
- Overall, the Bears have 150 draft picks in program history and head coach Steve Rodriguez has seen 57 of his student-athletes drafted.
