• Four of the five freshman graduated early and participated in spring practice.

THE RETURNERS

• The Bears return nine of their letterwinners from the 2021 season.

• Harrison earned her first-career All-America nod with Honorable Mention honors in the 2020 season. First Team All-Big 12 in 2020 & 2021.

• K. McGhee is a 2020 First Team All-Big 12 selection and is consistently nationally-ranked for total blocks and blocks per set.

• Elise McGhee earned several freshman awards last season for her contributions on the court, tallying 26 kills and 14 total blocks in her 28 sets played.

- Lauren Briseño was the only freshman to play in all 28 matches for the Bears, all at DS, raking in 188 digs at 1.84 digs per set in her 102 sets played.
- Cassie Davis played in five matches in 2021 with three kills to her name as an outside hitter.

• Alicia Andrew & Riley Simpson both redshirted for the Bears, while Ava Grace Haggard and Faith Lynch each saw action in one set.

- Four rising sophomore returners for the Bears have changed their jersey numbers from 2021.

• The Bears had 14 letterwinners move on from the program after the completion of the 2021 season, including five starters and the starting libero.

- 11 of those 14 letterwinners were true seniors or fifth-year seniors.
- Five of the 11 seniors are using their last year of eligibility with other programs, two of them are in coaching roles, and two or more are pursuing professional volleyball careers.

CALENDAR COUNTING

- The Bears will play 29 regular-season matches in 2022.
- Overall, 16 will be Big 12 Conference matchups and 13 will be against non-conference opponents.

THE BIG DANCE

- Baylor competed in their sixth-straight NCAA Tournament in 2021, all under Ryan McGuyre.
- BU is 11-10 in NCAA Tournaments and 8-6 under McGuyre.
- 19 of BU's 25 regular-season matches were against teams that made the tournament. Baylor went 14-5 in those contests.
- Seven of the nine Big 12 teams made the tournament in 2021.



names and into the national spotlight. After



narrowly missing the postseason in his first year, McGuyre and the Bears marched their way to the program's first Big 12 title and the NCAA National Semifinals in 2019 while earning the school's first No. 1 AVCA national ranking and No. 1 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament.

McGuyre followed up the historic 2019 campaign by leading the Bears to their second consecutive NCAA Regional Semifinal berth in 2020, marking just the third time in program history that the program has reached the Sweet 16 (2009, 2019, 2020).

In his seventh season at BU, McGuyre compiled his seventh-consecutive winning season, sixth-straight 20-win season and a program-best six-consecutive NCAA appearances since his arrival in 2015. The Bears made the Regional Semifinals again in 2021 and finished the season ranked 10th by the AVCA with a 22-6 record. Powerhouse Yossiana Pressley recorded her 2,000th career kill to become the all-time leader at Baylor, while Hannah Sedwick also recorded her 4.000th career assist during the season. Pressley, Sedwick and All-American transfer Avery Skinner boosted BU to top-15 rankings throughout the year.

Named the 2019 AVCA and VolleyballMag.com National Coach of the Year, 2019 AVCA Southwest Region Coach of the Year, 2017 and 2019 Big 12 Coach of the Year, McGuyre has coached 11 AVCA All-America selections, 15 All-Region honorees, 22 All-Big 12 awardees and 48 Academic All-Big 12 selections throughout his time at Baylor.

McGuvre's teams continue to lock down home court advantage behind record-breaking crowds at the Ferrell Center. Baylor topped its own attendance record in three straight seasons from 2017-2019. BU's 2019 win against No. 1 Texas on Nov. 20 drew 7,357 fans, almost double the old attendance record set earlier that season against Tennessee in September

Baylor has gone an impressive 28-2 over the last two seasons at home, collecting nine ranked wins. In 2019, Waco hosted through the NCAA Regional final as the Bears booked their spot in Pittsburgh, Pa., for the NCAA Final Four.

Along with matching the most home wins in program history with 13 in 2017, BU's season opener against LSU in 2018 drew a record crowd of 3,858. The team has had 10 top-10 crowds at the Ferrell Center under McGuyre.

McGuvre has coached at the collegiate level for both men and women since 1999 including head-coaching stints at California Baptist (CBU) and Biola University, both of which are faith-based institutions

As associate head coach for two seasons, McGuyre and the Florida State Seminoles finished a 2014 NCAA Tournament run reaching the Sweet 16 before a loss to national runner-up, BYU. Prior to his arrival at Florida State, McGuyre was an assistant at Maryland for one season following a 10-year head coaching stint at CBU. There, he was the head coach for both the men's and women's programs, and he crafted a men's program that won six NAIA national championships and three women's national titles.

Among many accolades at CBU, McGuyre was named the 2005 NAIA Men's National Coach of the Year and in 2011 the NCCAA Division I National Coach of the Year. In 2010, he made history by being named both the AVCA Men's and Women's NAIA National Coach of the Year in the same calendar year.

A 1998 graduate of Biola, McGuyre is married to former University of Hawaii volleyball standout and USA National Team member Jennifer (Roberts) McGuyre. The couple has three children: sons, Tryston and Ryder, and a daughter, Kitana,






