TEAM NOTES

- Baylor is 3-2, 1-1 in the Big 12 Conference and Oklahoma State is 4-0, 1-0 in the Big 12.
- Oklahoma State leads the all-time series with Baylor, 23-19 and Baylor owns a 9-8 margin in games played in Waco.
- Baylor captains: Dillon Doyle, Bryson Jackson, Blake Shapen, Ben Sims,
- A crowd of 47,979 were in attendance, marking the seventh-largest crowd in McLane Stadium history.
- Baylor is 17-11 under third-year head coach Dave Aranda.
- The Bears are 2-1 in 2022 at home and 11-3 under Aranda.
- Baylor had a nine-game home winning streak snapped.
- The Bears own a 126-62-2 all-time record as a ranked team.
 - Baylor is 26-35-1 as a ranked team against a ranked team.
 - Baylor is 21-98-2 vs. top-10 opponents and are 59-192-6 against ranked teams all-time.
 - The Bears are 5-6 vs. ranked foes under Aranda.
 - Baylor is 5-5 against ranked foes at McLane Stadium.
 - This marks the fourth straight time BU has faced a ranked Oklahoma State squad, going 1-3 in those meetings.
- Baylor is 11-7 in day games under Aranda.
- Baylor is 3-1 in 2022 when scoring first and 12-4 under Aranda.
- The Bears are 8-1 when scoring on their first possession under Aranda.
- Baylor had its streak of four consecutive games holding an opponent under 100 rushing yards snapped.
 - This was the longest streak of consecutive games allowing 100 rush yards or less since setting the program standard with five consecutive games in 1953.
- The Bears intercepted a pass in the third quarter and own a +21 turnover margin under Aranda.
 - Baylor has 49 takeaways (34 interceptions, 15 fumble recoveries) and only 28 giveaways (17 interceptions, 11 fumbles lost).
- For the first time in an 18-game span, an opponent scored more than 30 points against Baylor, dating back to the season finale in 2020.
 - It was the longest stretch holding an opponent to 30 or fewer points since a 19-game stretch from 1984-86.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Sophomore QB **Blake Shapen** threw for a career-high 345 yards on 28 of 40 passing with two TDs.
 - It eclipsed his previous career high of 254 yards, coming in 2021 vs. Texas Tech.
 - Shapen is the first 300+ yard passer for the Bears since Gerry Bohanon threw for 336 vs. West Virginia in 2021.
 - Shapen has nine TD passes on the year and the 14 in his career.
 - Shapen's 70 yard TD strike in the third quarter was a career long.
- Sophomore WR **Monaray Baldwin** caught a career-high seven balls for 174 yards and two TDs.
 - Baldwin caught his two career long grabs, a 49 yarder and a 70 yarder, both TDs.
 - It marked his second and third TD catches of the year and his career.
 - Baldwin was the first Baylor player with a 100-yard receiving game since Trestan Ebner vs. Texas Tech in 2021.
- Freshman RB **Richard Reese** rushed 17 times for 85 yards and a score.
 - Reese rushed for his team-high seventh TD of the year, which entered the game leading all NCAA freshmen.
- Senior LB **Dillon Doyle** had a season-high and team-leading 10 tackles.
- Senior S **Christian Morgan** finished with four tackles, an interception, a tackle for a loss and a forced fumble.
 - Morgan intercepted his sixth career pass and his second of 2022.
 - Morgan has six career tackles for a loss.
 - Morgan has forced two fumbles in his career and this was his first since 2018.
- Senior **John Mayers** nailed a 34-yard field goal and hit two PATs.
 - Mayers has made 28 of 36 career field-goal attempts, good for a .778 percentage, which ranks first in program history.
 - Mayers had made 28 career field goals, passing Ryan Havens (2003-06) for ninth all-time.
 - Mayers has 177 career points, ranking ninth in program history.
 - Mayers has made 94 career PATs, ranking seventh in school history.
