GAMEDAY QUICK FACTS

- **TELEVISION:** The game will be televised nationally by ESPN. Dave O'Brien (pxp), Dick Vitale (analyst) and Kris Budden (reporter) will call the action.
- **RADIO:** The Longhorn IMG Radio Network broadcasts every UT game on the statewide network. Craig Way (pxp) and Eddie Oran (analyst) will call the action. Check TexasSports.com for a listing of affiliates carrying the game. ESPN Radio will also provide a national broadcast, with Pat O'Keefe (pxp) and Bob Valvano (analyst) on the call.
- **SERIES:** Texas leads, 164-96. Last meeting: Texas 76-71 (Jan. 30, 2023; Austin).

NOTABLES

- **IT'S BEEN A WHILE:** With a win on Saturday in Waco, the Longhorns would complete a regular-season series sweep of Baylor for the first time since the 2013-14 season. Texas claimed a 76-71 victory in Austin earlier this year (Jan. 30).
- **DID YOU KNOW?:** UT's 22-6 mark is its best 28-game start since the 2010-11 season (24-4). The 11-4 conference record is Texas' best 15-game league start since the 2010-11 season (12-3). The Longhorns are 9-6 in Quad 1 games, and the nine Quad 1 wins are tied for the second-most nationally.
- **NATIONAL SIXTH MAN AWARD CANDIDATE:** Graduate G Sir'Jabari Rice has topped the 20-point mark in four of the last eight games entering Saturday's contest. Rice ranks second on the team in scoring (12.1 ppg) while hitting 37.7-percent (43-114) from three-point range and 86.3-percent (88-102) from the free throw line this season.

Interim Head Coach: Rodney Terry, 15-5 at Texas (1st year); 178-161 overall (11th year)

IMPRESSIVE START

- Texas is off to a 22-6 start (11-4 Big 12 Conference) and currently stands at No. 9 in the NCAA's NET ranking and No. 9 in KenPom.
- The 22-6 record marks UT's **best 28-game start** since the 2010-11 season (24-4).
- The 11-4 conference record marks UT's **best 15-game league start** since the 2010-11 season (12-3).
- The Longhorns are **9-6 in Quad 1** games this year. The **nine** Quad 1 wins are tied for the **second**-most nationally (Kansas is 13-5, Purdue is 9-4).
- Texas is **4-2 against AP Top 11 opponents** with wins over No. 2 Gonzaga (93-74), No. 7 Creighton (72-67), No. 11 Baylor (76-71) and at No. 7 K-State (69-66).
- UT is 5-0 against AP Top 25 opponents at Moody Center this year.
- **Thirteen** of the 22 victories have been by at least **10** points, and the Longhorns have posted a **+11.1** scoring margin this year (79.4-68.4).

THE TERRY EFFECT

- Since moving into the role of Interim Head Coach (beginning with a home OT win against Rice on Dec. 12), **Rodney Terry** has guided the Longhorns to a **15-5** record including **FOUR** wins against AP Top 25 opponents (vs. No. 17 TCU, vs. No. 11 Baylor, at No. 7 K-State and vs. No. 23 Iowa State).
- Texas is **7-0** under Terry in games decided by five points or less OR in overtime.

BAYLOR SERIES INFO

- Saturday's contest marks the 261st meeting between Texas and Baylor.
- **UT owns a 164-96 lead in the all-time series entering Saturday's game.**
- Texas is 34-24 against Bears since the formation of the Big 12 Conference (prior to start of 1996-97 season).
- Baylor was UT's first opponent in the program's inaugural 1906 season. The Horns won the first game of the series, 27-17, on March 10, 1906, in Austin. The Longhorns won all four games played against the Bears that season.
- Baylor is UT's most common opponent in program history. Texas and Baylor have competed in the same conference since 1915 (Southwest Conference and Big 12). The only season Texas and Baylor did not meet since 1906 was in 1908, when the Longhorns did not field a team.
- Texas is 68-54 against the Bears when the teams play in Waco.

IOWA STATE RECAP

- UT held the Cyclones to 54 points during the win. This marked a season-low point total in a Big 12 game for the Cyclones (previous: 55 at K-State).
- Texas improved to 19-2 against Iowa State in games played in Austin. The Longhorns have won eight straight and 14 of the last 15 meetings in Austin against the Cyclones.
- UT posted a 34-13 advantage in bench scoring, a 28-17 margin in points off turnovers and a 13-4 edge in fast-break points.
- The 12 three-pointers made (on 28 attempts) by Texas were one shy of a team season high (13 vs. Gonzaga on Nov. 16). The 12 threes made were the most by UT in a Big 12 game this season.

- Texas allowed just eight assists while forcing 16 turnovers. UT has now forced at least 15 turnovers in 20 of its first 28 games.
- The Longhorns converted 54.8-percent (17-31) from the floor, including a 56.3-percent clip (9-16) from three-point range, in the first half while building a 47-29 halftime advantage.
- Texas had separate runs of 16-0 and 11-0 in the first half.
- **Christian Bishop** tied his career high in steals (3) and recorded a team-best plus-minus total of plus-29 in 22 minutes.
- **Marcus Carr** reached double figures in scoring (13 points) for the 25th time this year (28 games) and 110th time in his career (154 games). He added a game-high five assists against just one turnover in 35 minutes.
- **Brock Cunningham** tied his career high in assists (4) and tied his season high in steals (3). He recorded a plus-minus total of plus-25 in 23 minutes.
- **Tyrese Hunter** reached double figures in scoring (team-high 15 points) for the 14th time this season (28 games) and 34th time in his career (63 games).
- **Sir'Jabari Rice** reached double figures in scoring (team-high 15 points) for the 17th time this season (28 games) and 75th time in his career (139 games). He recorded a plus-minus total of plus-23 in 21 minutes.

IN THE POLLS

- The Longhorns are ranked No. **8** in the latest AP poll (Feb. 20) and No. **8** in the latest USA TODAY Sports coaches' poll (Feb. 20).
- Texas climbed to as high as No. 2 in both polls earlier this year (Nov. 28 and Dec. 5). This marked the highest ranking in The AP poll for the Longhorns since UT was ranked No. 1 in consecutive polls on Jan. 11 and Jan. 18, 2010.
- The Longhorns have now been ranked in the **top 10** of The AP poll for **14** consecutive weeks. This marks the longest such stretch since Texas was in the top 10 for all 19 polls during the 2002-03 Final Four season.

REACHING THE 20-WIN MARK

- With the victory against WVU (Feb. 11), **the Longhorns reached the 20-win mark in their 25th contest of the year.**
- By comparison last year, Texas reached the 20-win mark in its 28th game of the season on Feb. 23.
- Prior to last year, the Longhorns had not reached the 20-win mark in the **regular season** since the 2015-16 season.
- UT has now reached the 20-win plateau a total of 34 times in its 117 seasons of basketball.

A FIRST IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- UT's contest at No. 9/8 Kansas (Feb. 6) marked Texas' **fourth-straight** game against an **AP Top 11 opponent**, with three of the four contests coming on the road. This marked a first in UT program history.
- The four-game stretch included matchups at No. 4 Tennessee (lost 82-71), home against No. 11 Baylor (won 76-71), at No. 7 K-State (won 69-66) and at No. 9 Kansas (lost 88-80).

INTERIM HEAD COACH RODNEY TERRY

- **Rodney Terry** was named Acting Head Coach at The University of Texas a few hours prior to the Dec. 12 home game against Rice. He was named Interim Head Coach for the remainder of the season on Jan. 5.
- **He has posted a 15-5 mark as Interim Head Coach** this season and now sports an overall career record of **178-161 (.525)**.
- Terry, who has 27 years of collegiate coaching experience including nine as an assistant previously with the Longhorns from 2002-11, was in his second year as Associate Head Coach at Texas prior to being named Interim Head Coach.
- Terry was a former head coach at UTEP and Fresno State for a combined 10 seasons, where he compiled an overall record of 163-156 (.511).
- He spent three years (2018-21) as head coach at UTEP and posted a 37-48 (.435) mark, including a 29-27 record in his final two seasons. In his second year in El Paso (2019-20), the Miners went 17-15 to post their first winning season in four years and claim nine more wins than the previous season.
- Terry worked for seven years (2011-18) as the head coach at Fresno State, guiding the Bulldogs to a 126-108 (.538) mark. He posted 20-win seasons in four of his last five years and double-digit win totals in Mountain West Conference play in each of his last four years.
- During the 2015-16 season, Terry led the Bulldogs to a 25-10 record and the MWC Tournament title. Fresno State advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2001, and the 25 wins marked the third-most in school history.
- Terry spent nine seasons (2002-11) as an assistant coach under Rick Barnes at The University of Texas. During those nine years, the Longhorns posted an overall record of **232-80 (.744)** and made nine NCAA Tournament appearances, highlighted by four trips to the Sweet 16 (2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008), three Elite Eights (2003, 2006 and 2008) and one Final Four (2003).
- A total of 10 McDonald's All-Americans made their way to the UT campus during Terry's time. The two-person class of Cory Joseph and Tristan Thompson was the No. 8 recruiting class in the nation by ESPN. UT's three-person freshman class in 2009 was ranked No. 3 nationally by Rivals and No. 4 by ESPNU. The seven-man freshman class in 2006 was tabbed as

the No. 3 class in the country by Rivals and Scout. Texas' five-man freshman class in 2004 featured three McDonald's All-Americans and was tabbed the No. 1 class in the nation by Hoop Scoop.

- The Longhorns claimed two National Player of the Year winners (T.J. Ford in 2003 and Kevin Durant in 2007) and 13 players drafted by the NBA in the nine years under Terry, including nine first-round selections and five lottery picks.

STAFF FULL OF HEAD COACHING EXPERIENCE

- **FOUR** members of the Texas coaching staff have a combined **45** years of head coaching experience at the collegiate, international and professional levels of basketball.
- Interim Head Coach **Rodney Terry** has **10** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at UTEP for three years (2018-21) and head coach at Fresno State for seven seasons (2011-18).
- Assistant Coach **Bob Donewald Jr.** has **18** years of head coaching experience at the professional and international levels. He was head coach of the PBC Lokomotiv Kuban in Russia for one year (2018-19) and head coach for the Jilin Northeast Tigers in the Chinese Basketball Association for one season (2016-17). Donewald served as head coach of the Iowa Energy in the NBA D League for two years (2014-16). He was head coach of the Chinese National Team for three years (2010-12), leading the team at the 2010 World Championships, the 2010 and 2011 Asian Games and the 2012 London Olympics. Donewald was head coach for the Xinjiang Flying Tigers in the CBA for one year (2011) and the Shanghai Sharks for two years (2009-11). He served as head coach of Dnipro Dnepropetrovsk in Ukraine for one season (2008-09) and Objetivo Sao Carlos in Brazil for two years (2005-07). Donewald was head coach and general manager of the Leicester Riders in the British Basketball League (BBL) for two seasons (1996-98), head coach of the Derby Storm for one year (1998-99) and head coach of the Greater London Leopards for two seasons (1999-2001).
- Special Assistant to the Head Coach **Steve McClain** has **14** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) for five years (2010-15) and head coach at Wyoming for nine seasons (1998-2007).
- Assistant Coach **Chris Ogden** has **three** years of Division I head coaching experience. Ogden served as the head coach at the University of Texas at Arlington (UTA) for three seasons (2018-21).

SUCCESS AT THE STRIPE

- Through its first 28 games, Texas has converted at a **74.7-percent (402-538)** clip from the free throw line.
- In the 20 games under Interim Head Coach Rodney Terry, the Longhorns have hit **77.7-percent (310-399)** as a team from the free throw line.
- **In Big 12 play**, Texas **leads** the conference in team free throw shooting percentage at **78.5-percent (245-312)**.

BREAKING RECORDS AT THE LINE

- Texas hit its first **24** free throws in the win against WVU (Feb. 11) and converted its last six free throws to end the game at Kansas (Feb. 6). The **30-straight free throws made** set a program record for most consecutive free throws made (records date back to 1965-66). The previous mark was 26 set from Nov. 28, 1972 thru Dec. 2, 1972.
- UT hit 16-of-16 from the FT line in the first half against WVU (Feb. 11). That tied the school record for most FT in a single half without a miss (also hit 16-16 in the second half at Ole Miss on Dec. 2, 1972).
- It also set a school record for most free throws in a half without a miss in a Big 12 Conference game (previous was 14-of-14 in the first half at K-State on Jan. 28, 2012).

GET OLD AND STAY OLD

- The 2022-23 Texas roster includes **SIX** players who are either graduate students, super seniors OR seniors: Timmy Allen (super senior), Christian Bishop (super senior), Marcus Carr (graduate student), Brock Cunningham (graduate student), Dylan Disu (senior) and Sir'Jabari Rice (graduate student).
- **FOUR** players have already surpassed the **1,000-career point mark**: **Marcus Carr** (2,223 points), **Timmy Allen** (2,036 points), **Sir'Jabari Rice** (1,430 points) and **Christian Bishop** (1,144 points).
- The **SEVEN** players who brought previous collegiate experience to this year's roster have combined career totals of **860** games played (**593** starts).
- When including freshman Dillon Mitchell's 28 starts this season, the Longhorns' roster has accumulated a total of **621** career starts.

THE ONE AND ONLY

- Per the NCAA, Texas is the **ONLY** school in the nation (across ALL Divisions) to have **TWO** current roster players who have eclipsed the **2,000-point** mark in their careers: **Marcus Carr** (2,223) and **Timmy Allen** (2,036).
- Through games of Feb. 22, a total of 23 Division I players have topped the 2,000-career point milestone.

DOUBLE-DIGIT RALLY AT No. 7/6 K-STATE

- During the 69-66 win at No. 7/6 Kansas State (Feb. 4), the Longhorns trailed by as much as **14** points (36-22) with 30 seconds left in the first half and faced a 36-25 deficit at the half.
- The Longhorns posted a 44-30 scoring margin in the second half. UT converted 57.1-percent (16-28) from the floor while holding K-State to 41.7-percent (10-24) in the final 20 minutes.
- This marked the **FOURTH** double-digit comeback by the Longhorns this season. Texas overcame a 10-point hole (33-23) with 2:23 remaining in the first half against Rice in the 87-81 home overtime win (Dec. 12). The Longhorns faced an

18-point deficit (40-22) with 2:57 left in the first half in the 79-75 home win against No. 17/17 TCU (Jan. 11). Texas overcame a 12-point hole (34-22) with 1:12 remaining in the first half against Texas Tech in the 72-70 home victory (Jan. 14).

EPIC COMEBACK AGAINST No. 17/17 TCU

- In UT's 79-75 home win against No. 17/17 TCU (Jan. 11), the Longhorns trailed by as much as **18** points (40-22) with 2:57 left in the first half and faced a 12-point deficit (61-49) with 9:36 remaining in the contest.
- This marked the largest comeback for Texas since the Longhorns overcame a 22-point deficit (67-45) with 7:54 remaining in a 92-86 OT home win against Oklahoma on Feb. 27, 2013.
- After trailing 42-29 at the break, the Longhorns posted a 50-33 scoring margin in the second half. UT converted 59.4-percent (19-32) from the floor and 83.3-percent (10-12) from the free throw line in the final 20 minutes.

HISTORY-MAKING WIN vs. No. 2/2 GONZAGA

- Texas **tied** a program record for defeating the highest-ranked AP opponent in school history with its 93-74 win over No. 2 Gonzaga (Nov. 16).
- This marked the **fourth** time in school history that the Longhorns have topped the No. 2 team in The AP poll.
- Texas previously defeated No. 2 Louisville (74-70) on Nov. 30, 1986 in the seventh-place game at the Great Alaska Shootout (Anchorage, Alaska). The Longhorns beat No. 2 UCLA (63-61) on Dec. 2, 2007 at Pauley Pavilion. UT also topped No. 2 Oklahoma (73-68) on Feb. 21, 2009 in Austin.

DEFENSE WINS

- The Longhorns have allowed 320 assists while forcing 448 turnovers (16.0 tpg) this year. UT has forced at least **15** turnovers in **20** of its first 28 contests.
- **Texas has recorded a 522-306 advantage in points off turnovers this season.**
- Texas held Houston Christian to 31 points in the home win (Nov. 10). The 31 points is tied for the second-fewest points allowed by the Longhorns in program history.
- The Longhorns held HCU to 21.7-percent FG shooting (13-60) in the contest. This marked the **fourth**-lowest FG percentage allowed by Texas since the 1960-61 season and lowest since Texas State converted 21.6-percent (11-51) on Dec. 13, 2014.
- UT held Creighton (Dec. 1) to 67 points on 40.9-percent (27-66) FG shooting, including a 14.8-percent mark (4-27) from three-point range. Creighton entered the game averaging 83.9 points per contest while converting 51.2-percent FG, including a 38.2-percent mark from three-point range.
- Texas limited Iowa State (Feb. 21) to 54 points and allowed just eight assists while forcing 16 turnovers. The 54 points were a season low in a Big 12 game for the Cyclones.

GETTING OFFENSIVE

- The Longhorns are averaging **79.4** ppg and have converted **47.6**-percent (808-1698) from the floor this season. The last time Texas averaged **more** than 80 ppg was the 2009-10 season (**81.2** ppg).
- **Texas topped the century mark** for the first time since the 2017-18 season opener with its 100-72 home victory against Louisiana (Dec. 21). It marked the first 100-point effort for the Longhorns since UT claimed a 105-59 home win over Northwestern State on Nov. 10, 2017.
- The Longhorns topped 100 points for the **second** time in a **four**-game stretch during the 116-103 loss to K-State (Jan. 3).
- Texas converted 50.9-percent (29-57) from the floor, including a season-best **61.5-percent** (8-13) from three-point range, in the 89-75 home win against Oklahoma State (Jan. 24). The Cowboys entered the contest ranked fourth nationally in field goal percentage defense (37.3).
- **The Longhorns have posted a 357-195 advantage in fast-break points this year.**

SHARING THE ROCK

- Texas has averaged **16.3** assists per game and sports an impressive 1.4 **TEAM** assist-to-turnover ratio (456 assists, 332 turnovers) this season.
- The Longhorns registered a season-high 30 assists (on 37 made field goals) against nine turnovers versus UAPB (Dec. 10).
- UT posted 22 assists (on 28 made field goals) against eight turnovers versus Stanford (Dec. 18).

He has recorded career totals of **1,144** points, **709** rebounds and **129** blocked shots. Bishop has converted **61.7-percent** (460-746) from the field over his **career**. He has reached double figures in scoring **55** times and double digits in rebounds 10 times in his career. Bishop has tallied seven double-doubles in his collegiate career.

- In the first 27 contests (one start), he is second on the team in blocks (16), fourth in rebounding (3.5 rpg) and steals (25) and sixth in scoring (6.5 ppg) in 17.3 mpg.
- Bishop tied his career high in steals (3) and added six boards while recording a team-best plus-minus total of plus-29 in 22 minutes against No. 23/21 Iowa State (Feb. 21).

- He recorded 14 points (6-11 FG, 2-3 FT), six rebounds (five offensive), two steals and two blocks in a season-high 26 minutes at No. 7/6 Kansas State (Feb. 4). In 14 minutes of action in the second half, he had 14 points (6-8 FG, 2-3 FT), six boards, two blocks and one steal.
- Bishop posted 11 points (5-9 FG), a team-high seven rebounds (four offensive), one assist and one steal in a season-best 24 minutes at West Virginia (Jan. 21).
- He tallied a team-high 12 points (4-7 FG, 4-4 FT), five boards and two blocks in 19 minutes at No. 12/12 Iowa State (Jan. 17).
- Bishop tied his career high with three steals and added seven points and six boards in 20 minutes against Texas Tech (Jan. 14).
- He recorded 10 points (5-6 FG), a game-high eight rebounds, two blocks and two steals in 20 minutes vs. Louisiana (Dec. 21).
- Bishop set season highs in points (16), FG made (7-10), rebounds (9) and assists (4) in 20 minutes against UAPB (Dec. 10). With his made jumper at the 8:17 mark of the first half, he reached the **1,000**-career point mark.
- He recorded four blocked shots to go along with six points (3-5 FG) and four rebounds against UTRGV (Nov. 26).
- Bishop posted nine points (4-6 FG), two steals and one assist in 20 minutes against No. 2/2 Gonzaga (Nov. 16).

GLUE GUY IN YEAR FIVE

Graduate F **Brock Cunningham** is in his fifth season in the UT program (and still has another year of eligibility remaining in 2023-24). He graduated in May 2022 with a bachelor's degree in Advertising and is pursuing a master's degree in Advertising. Cunningham has played in **103** career games (four starts) and reached double figures in scoring **five** times and double digits in rebounds **four** times. A three-time Academic All-Big 12 selection, he elected to redshirt the 2018-19 season.

- Thru the first 28 games, Cunningham is tied for second on the team in steals (26) and sixth in rebounding (3.3 rpg) while averaging 5.1 ppg in 18.2 mpg.
- He sports a **35-to-14** assist-to-turnover ratio and has converted 51.0-percent (49-96) from the floor, including a 45.1-percent mark (23-51) from three-point range, and 22-of-25 (.880) free throws this year.
- Forty-four (44) of his 92 rebounds have come off the offensive glass.
- Cunningham tied his career high in assists (4) and tied his season high in steals (3) while recording a plus-minus total of plus-25 in 23 minutes against No. 23/21 Iowa State (Feb. 21).
- He registered 10 points (4-7 FG, 2-3 threes), four rebounds (all offensive), four assists against one turnover and one steal in a career-high 33 minutes against Oklahoma (Feb. 18).
- Cunningham posted 11 points (3-4 FG, 1-1 threes, 4-5 FT) in 16 minutes at No. 4/4 Tennessee (Jan. 28).
- He recorded a career-high 15 points while tying his career highs in field goals made (5-6) and three-point field goals made (3-3) and added five rebounds, one assist, one block and one steal in 24 minutes against Oklahoma State (Jan. 24).
- Cunningham tied his season high with three steals in 15 minutes against No. 17/17 TCU (Jan. 11).
- He registered eight points (2-2 threes, 2-2 FT) and four rebounds (three offensive) in 14 minutes at Oklahoma State (Jan. 7). Both of his three-pointers came in the final 10 minutes, including his dagger at the 2:05 mark that gave the Longhorns a 53-46 cushion.

- Cunningham recorded a season-best 10 rebounds (five offensive), six points (2-4 FG, 2-2 FT) and two steals in 27 minutes against Rice (Dec. 12).
- He tallied 13 points (career-high 5-6 FG, career-best 3-3 threes) and three rebounds (all offensive) in 15 minutes against UAPB (Dec. 10).
- Cunningham registered eight points (3-4 FG, 2-3 threes), five boards (three offensive), one assist, one block and one steal in 21 minutes against No. 17/17 Illinois (Dec. 6).
- He converted a pair of free throws (1-and-1 situation) with 4.0 seconds left to seal the win against No. 7/7 Creighton (Dec. 1).
- Cunningham had seven points (3-4 FG, 1-2 threes), one block and one steal in 12 minutes against No. 2/2 Gonzaga (Nov. 16).

MITCHELL'S IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Freshman F **Dillon Mitchell** was ranked as the No. 4 prospect nationally by ESPN and Rivals and No. 5 by 247 Sports Composite in the Class of 2022. He was the MVP for Team Air in the Jordan Brand Classic in Chicago (April 15) and a member of the USA Nike Hoop Summit Team in the 23rd Nike Hoop Summit (April 8). Mitchell averaged 12.3 ppg, 10 rpg and 1.5 bpg as a senior while leading Montverde Academy (Fla.) to the GEICO Nationals title.

- Mitchell has started each of the first 28 games and ranks second on the team in rebounding (4.4 rpg) and seventh in scoring (5.3 ppg) in 19.5 mpg.
- He has converted **62.3**-percent (66-106) from the field.
- Forty-six (46) of his 124 rebounds have come off the offensive glass.
- He tied his season high with two blocked shots in 12 minutes against Oklahoma (Feb. 18).
- Mitchell grabbed a game-high nine rebounds and tallied four points (2-2 FG), two steals and one block in 22 minutes at No. 9/8 Kansas (Feb. 6).
- He registered a game-high seven rebounds to go along with five points (2-2 FG), one block and one steal in 18 minutes against No. 11/11 Baylor (Jan. 30).
- Mitchell tied his career highs in rebounds (12) and steals (three) in 30 minutes at Oklahoma State (Jan. 7).
- He had a career-high 16 points (career-best 8-9 FG) and five boards in 27 minutes vs. Texas A&M-Commerce (Dec. 27).
- Mitchell tallied 12 points (3-6 FG, 6-6 FT), nine rebounds and three steals in a career-high 32 minutes against Rice (Dec. 12).
- He had 13 points (6-7 FG), three boards and three assists in 20 minutes against UAPB (Dec. 10).
- Mitchell posted 10 points (5-8 FG) and three boards in 20 minutes against No. 7/7 Creighton (Dec. 1).
- He recorded 10 points (4-9 FG, 2-2 FT), four boards and two steals in 17 minutes against UTRGV (Nov. 26).
- Mitchell had 10 points (5-5 FG) and a career-high 12 rebounds (eight offensive) in 17 minutes against HCU (Nov. 10).

MORRIS EMBRACING THE PROCESS

Freshman G **Arterio Morris** was ranked as the No. 15 prospect nationally by Rivals, No. 17 by 247 Sports Composite and No. 17 by ESPN in the Class of 2022. He was tabbed the No. 2 player in the state of Texas by Mike Kunstadt of Texas Hoops. Morris averaged 19.4 ppg and 7 rpg as a senior in the regular season while leading Kimball HS to a 30-9 mark and the Class 5A state semifinals.

- Through the first 28 contests, Morris ranks in a tie for eighth on the team in scoring (5.1 ppg) while averaging 12.3 mpg.

- He registered 8 points (3-5 FG, 2-4 threes) in 12 minutes against No. 23/21 Iowa State (Feb. 21).
- Morris posted 12 points (4-8 FG, 2-4 threes, 2-2 FT), three rebounds, one assist and one steal in 21 minutes against West Virginia (Feb. 11).
- He tallied 12 points (4-9 FG, 3-4 FT), three boards and one steal in 17 minutes against Texas A&M-Commerce (Dec. 27).
- **Morris recorded a career-high 25 points** (career-best 9-11 FG, career-high 5-7 threes, 2-2 FT) in 18 minutes against Louisiana (Dec. 21).
- He posted eight points, a season-high six boards and a season-best four steals in 21 minutes against UAPB (Dec. 10).
- Morris recorded 11 points (3-5 FG, 2-4 threes, 3-3 FT) and one block in 17 minutes vs. NAU (Nov. 21).
- He registered 10 points (5-11 FG), five rebounds and a season-high three assists in a season-best 22 minutes against Houston Christian (Nov. 10).

KEEP AN EYE ON THIS ONE

Freshman F **Alex Anamekwe** was ranked as the No. 15 prospect in the state of Texas by 247 Sports Composite in the Class of 2022. A four-year starter at McKinney HS, he led McKinney to a 35-6 record and the Class 6A state championship game as a senior.

- Anamekwe has seen action in 10 of the first 28 games and is averaging 2.0 ppg and 0.8 rpg in 6.9 mpg. He has converted 8-of-13 (.615) field goals, including 2-of-3 threes.
- He had five points (2-2 FG, 1-1 threes) and two rebounds in nine minutes against UAPB (Dec. 10).
- Anamekwe posted five points (2-2 FG, 1-1 threes) in 10 minutes against NAU (Nov. 21).

PAIR OF MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICANS

Freshmen **Dillon Mitchell** and **Arterio Morris** were two of the 24 players selected to compete in the 45th annual McDonald's All-American Game last March in Chicago.

- Mitchell and Morris became the 21st and 22nd players in UT history to play in the McDonald's All-American Game.
- This marked just the fifth time in program history that the Longhorns have had at least two signees named to the roster in the same year (2004, 2006, 2010, 2016 and 2022).

HORNS IN THE NBA

A total of 10 former University of Texas players appeared on NBA rosters when the league opened the 2022-23 regular season.

- Texas ranked in a tie for **SIXTH** nationally in most players on 2022-23 NBA opening-night rosters.
- In addition to the 10 former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Matt Hill is an assistant coach with the Atlanta Hawks and Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Brooklyn Nets.

IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Saturday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,082 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,210 of 1,218 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

HORNS INK PAIR OF TOP-15 NATIONAL RECRUITS

Ron Holland and **A.J. Johnson** both signed National Letters of Intent during the fall signing period to play basketball next season at The University of Texas. Holland and Johnson will join the Longhorns for the 2023-24 season.

- **Ron Holland** (6-8, 200), a forward from Duncanville, Texas who has played at Duncanville HS under coach David Peavy for the previous three seasons, is ranked as the top prospect in the state of Texas and a top-10 national recruit. Holland is ranked as the No. 10 prospect nationally by ESPN and 247 Sports Composite.
- Holland is one of 24 players selected to compete in the 46th annual **McDonald's All-American Game** on March 28 in Houston. Holland will become the **23rd** player in UT program history to play in the McDonald's All-American Game.
- During his junior season in 2021-22, Holland averaged 15.9 ppg, 7.9 rpg, 2.9 apg and 2.0 spg in 23.9 mpg while leading Duncanville to a 35-1 overall record and the Class 6A state championship. He was tabbed as MaxPreps' National Junior of the Year last season.
- **A.J. Johnson** (6-5, 165), a guard from Fresno, Calif., who currently plays at Southern California Academy for coach Julius Von Hanzlik, is ranked as the No. 7 prospect nationally by On3, No. 9 by Rivals, No. 14 by 247 Sports and No. 15 in the 247 Sports Composite.
- Johnson played his junior year in 2021-22 at Taft HS (Woodland Hills, Calif.). He averaged 16.7 ppg, 4.7 apg, 2.6 rpg and 2.5 spg as a junior while leading Taft to a 17-7 mark.

BLESS THE MOOD

- The Longhorns moved into Moody Center, the new home of Texas Basketball, at the start of the 2022-23 season.
- Texas is **15-1** in games played at Moody Center this year.
- **UT has had a sellout crowd in EACH of its first 16 contests in Moody Center** and is averaging **10,943** fans per game in Moody (capacity: 10,763).
- The \$375 million world-class arena is located on campus and will play host to Texas Men's and Women's Basketball games, graduations, concerts and other events.
- The arena opened for concerts in April 2022.
- Moody Center is the first of its kind in the industry with an unrivaled partnership between Oak View Group (OVG), Live Nation/C3 Presents, The University of Texas and the MOC (Minister of Culture) Matthew McConaughey.
- Moody Center is named in honor of a \$130 million grant to The University of Texas at Austin from the Moody Foundation, the single-largest gift from a foundation in the university's history. The Moody Foundation has supported museums, libraries, universities and hospitals throughout the state of Texas for over 75 years.

THE CORRAL

- Prior to the 2022-23 season, Texas Basketball and Matthew McConaughey joined forces to launch the new official student section, **The Corral**.
- UT students get the best seats for games at Moody Center, 270-degrees around the court in the lower bowl.

His mom, Elise Allen, passed away after a seven-year battle with breast cancer on Dec. 3, 2016 at the age of 49 (during Timmy's junior year of high school). Timmy has two older brothers, Nick and Teddy. Teddy played college basketball at West Virginia, Western Nebraska Community College, Nebraska and New Mexico State. His godfather, Ray Arvizu, has served as a father figure to Timmy for the last decade. Timmy is on pace to earn his bachelor's degree at Texas in May 2023.
- **Alex Anamekwe** enjoys writing and has the desire to become an author. Both of his parents (father, Nnamdi; and mother, Kelechi) are from Nigeria. Kelechi ran track in Nigeria during her youth.
- **Christian Bishop** was born in Sacile, Italy. His father, Jerry Bishop, played basketball at Abilene Christian. His older brother, Grant, played basketball at Missouri Baptist. He wears jersey No. 32 to honor Jerry and Grant, who both wore the number. Christian is on pace to earn his bachelor's degree at Texas in May 2023.
- **Cole Bott** chose to come to Texas because of the opportunity to play for a great basketball coach while pursuing his MBA with an interest in the stock market.
- **Rowan Brumbaugh** lived in New York City, Northampton, Mass., Brooklyn and Washington, D.C. during his childhood. His father, Sam Brumbaugh, played rugby at Trinity University in Hartford, Conn. His uncle, Peter Brumbaugh, played football at Tulane and UCLA. His grandfather, Fred Brumbaugh, was a boxer at Princeton.
- **Marcus Carr's** brother, Duane Notice, played on South Carolina's 2017 NCAA Final Four team and has gone on to play professionally internationally and with Raptors 905 (Toronto affiliate in the NBA G-League). Marcus graduated in August 2021 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in Human Resource Development and is pursuing a second degree in Communication & Leadership.
- **Brock Cunningham's** dad, Ed Cunningham, was a football offensive lineman at The University of Texas (1985-89) who earned All-America honors in 1989. Brock graduated in May 2022 with a bachelor's degree in Advertising. He still has two years of eligibility remaining and is pursuing a master's degree in Advertising.
- **Dylan Disu's** mother, Michelle Anderson, played basketball and volleyball at William Penn University (Oskaloosa, Iowa). His father, Rodney Anderson, football at Texas A&I University (now Texas A&M-Kingsville). Dylan is on pace to earn his bachelor's degree at Texas in May 2023.
- **Tyrese Hunter** lost both his father and mother during his childhood. His father, Brian, passed from sudden cardiac arrest when Tyrese was six years old. He earned his bachelor's degree in Individualized Studies from New Mexico State University in May 2022 and is pursuing postgraduate coursework at Texas.
