STORY LINES

STARTING FIVE

- Graduate **Ja'Mee Asberry** has played 153 games in her career, as Iowa State's Ashley Joens broke the Big 12 record with her 154th career game in the regular-season finale and has 157 career games under her belt.
- Junior **Sarah Andrews** is 30 points away from reaching 1,000 for her career.
- Fifth-year **Caitlin Bickle** was shooting 50% from the floor, 40% from 3-point range and 80% at the free throw line during the regular season, which are the best averages among players in the five position in the Power 5. She is on a list of just nine players that were at least six-feet tall who have shot 50/40/80 in the Big 12 since 1999-00. Heading into the NCAA Tournament, she's one of just five players in the Big Dance, at least six-feet tall, shooting 50/30/80.
- Rookie **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** earned her eighth Big 12 Freshman of the Week award on March 6, becoming the first BU rookie to earn it eight-or-more times in program history. Additionally, she ranks second in the Big 12 all-time in Freshman of the Week honors behind Ayoka Lee, who earned it 12 times in 2020.
- The Bears are just one victory away from securing 20 wins this season. Baylor has won 20-plus games in 22-straight seasons, which is the second-longest active streak among Division I programs. UConn leads the way with 30-straight 20-plus win seasons.

TOURNEY TIME

- Baylor is making its 19th-consecutive trip to the NCAA Tournament, which is the fifth-longest active streak in the country behind Tennessee (41), Stanford (35), UConn (34) and Notre Dame (27), and 21st appearance overall.
- The Bears are 54-17 in the Big Dance and have made 15 trips to the Sweet 16.
- BU's meeting with Alabama will be the first in program history.
- On the other side of the bracket in Storrs, it would be the first-ever meeting with Vermont if the two programs meet each other in the second round. Opening-round host UConn holds the slim 5-4 advantage in the all-time series with the Bears, last edging Baylor, 69-67, in the 2021 Elite Eight.

BEARS IN THE BIG 12 TOURNAMENT

- With its 74-63 setback to Iowa State in the quarterfinal round of the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship on Friday, the Bears dropped to 48-15 all-time in the tournament and 4-2 against the Cyclones.
- Four Bears reached double figures led by **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs'** 16-point outpouring. **Caitlin Bickle** and **Jaden Owens** each added 15 points, while Sarah Andrews finished with 12.
- Andrews' six rebounds and nine assists led the way in each category, while **Jana Van Gytenbeek** dished out a career-high seven assists in 20 minutes off the bench.
- As a team, Baylor holds several Big 12 Championship records, including field goals made (44), assists (32) and most players in double figures (7), all set during the 2019 tournament.
- The Bears were the No. 6 seed, marking the lowest seeding for BU since Baylor was a No. 6 seed in the 2010 Big 12 Championship.

EARNED IT

- Four Bears - **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs, Sarah Andrews, Caitlin Bickle** and **Bella Fontleroy** - all earned postseason Big 12 Awards, the league announced on March 6.
- Voted the unanimous Big 12 Freshman of the Year, Littlepage-Buggs is the fourth Baylor Bear to earn the distinction and first to receive it since Nina Davis in 2014, also joining Odyssey Sims and Brittney Griner on the list. Additionally, she picked up an all-conference honorable mention and was a unanimous Big 12 All-Freshman Team selection.
- After landing a spot on the All-Big 12 Second Team last season, Andrews played her way onto the 11-person first team this year. With her selection, Baylor has had representation on the All-Big 12 First Team every year since 2004.
- For the first time in her five-year career, Bickle earned a spot on the All-Big 12 Second Team, as well as the Big 12 All-Defensive Team. The forward was one of the only players in the No. 5 position in the country shooting 50% from the floor, 40% from 3-point range and 80% from the free throw line during the regular season. She is now one of five participating in this year's NCAA Tournament shooting 50-30-80 and who is at least 6-feet tall.
- A two-time Big 12 Freshman of the Week, Fontleroy made an appearance in all 30 regular-season games for the Bears this season, starting the last 12 games heading into the Big Dance and 14 total as a true freshman. She was a unanimous pick to the league's all-rookie team.
- The selections of Fontleroy and Littlepage-Buggs to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team marks the first time a BU rookie has been named to the team since 2018 and the first time two Bears have earned a spot since 2016.

STORY LINES

SCOUTING THE SERIES AND THE CRIMSON TIDE

- Saturday's first round matchup with Alabama will be the first meeting between the Crimson Tide and the Bears in program history.
- Alabama enters the weekend with a 20-10 ledger and is making its second NCAA Tournament appearance in three years.
- Alabama is 17-11 all-time in the NCAA Tournament and the Crimson Tide's deepest run came in 1994 with the team advancing to the Final Four.
- Brittany Davis leads the team at 17.3 points per game. The graduate student has reached double figures in all but two games and has 10 20-plus point performances on the year. Davis was placed on the All-SEC First Team, while Hannah Barber was named the SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year.

PUT TO THE TEST

- Baylor is one of 12 schools in the country to have played at least 11 games against AP Top 25 opponents this season, and the only school in the Big 12 to do so.
- The Bears are one of 13 schools in the country with at least five wins against AP Top 25 opponents, and Iowa State is the only other school in the Big 12 with at least as many wins in top-25 matchups.
- Four of Baylor's five AP Top-25 wins have come in true road games and were all against league opponents. The other was a neutral site victory over Villanova in November.

NOT SO LITTLE(PAGE) BUGGS

- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** has three double-doubles in her last six games and a team-leading 14 double-doubles this season.
- Littlepage-Buggs ranks second among all Division I rookies in the country in rebounds per game, sitting at 9.4 per contest. ECU's Amiya Joyner jumped in front of the Baylor freshman and is averaging 9.7 boards per game.
- Her 14 double-doubles on the year are the third most in the Big 12 behind Kansas' Taiyanna Jackson (18) and Iowa State's Ashley Joens (15).
- Littlepage-Buggs ranks third overall in the league in rebounding for the entire season and in Big 12 action behind Jackson and Joens.
- Her 10 double-doubles in league games are the most among Baylor freshmen dating back to the 2009-10 season, surpassing Brittney Griner's eight.

TRIPLE THREAT

- **Caitlin Bickle** (13 pts/12 reb), **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** (19 pts/12 reb) and **Bella Fontleroy** (19 pts/11 reb) became the first Baylor trio since Nina Davis, Kalani Brown and Kristy Wallace in 2017 to post double-doubles in the same game on Feb. 18 against Iowa State.
- Additionally, it marked the first time three Bears finished in double figures on the glass since Brown, NaLyssa Smith and Queen Egbo in 2019.

SUPER SENIOR

- In her fifth season at Baylor, **Caitlin Bickle** has continued to make a difference for the Bears, especially in Big 12 play.
- Bickle ranks in the top five in the league in rebounding, sitting at 7.1 rebounds per game, and eighth in free throw percentage (80.0%).
- On the year, Bickle has reached double-figure scoring 18 times and double-figure rebounding on nine occasions. She also has six double-doubles on the year, including five during conference play.
- In an OT loss to Oklahoma on Feb. 7, Bickle had a career outing with 30 points, becoming just the second Bear to reach 30 in a game this season. Additionally, she drained four shots from 3-point range and went a perfect 10-for-10 from the charity stripe.

TOUGH DEFENSE

- BU is holding its opponents to just 28.6% shooting from behind the 3-point arc, which is the second-lowest shooting percentage from range in the league behind West Virginia (27.5%).
- Baylor has held six opponents to less than 20 points in the opening half this season, including a season-low 13 points scored by HCU in the opening 20 minutes on Dec. 4.
- The Bears have held four opponents (Incarnate Word, HCU, Tennessee State, No. 17 Oklahoma) to five or less points in at least one quarter, and an additional nine teams to 10 or less in a frame, including No. 12 Texas on Feb. 28.

BALANCED EFFORT

- Nine of the 12 active players on BU's roster have posted double figures in at least one contest this year, and five of them have recorded double-digit points in 15 or more games.
- Junior **Sarah Andrews** leads the way with 24 games in double figures.
- Six Bears have recorded double-doubles this season, led by freshman **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs**, who has had 14.
- For the fifth time this season, and first time in Big 12 play, five Bears reached double figures led by **Jaden Owens** and **Littlepage-Buggs**, who each notched 16 in the win over Texas Tech on Jan. 28. Additionally, Baylor used double-figure scoring by five Bears in the win at TCU on Feb. 22.

STORY LINES

ANDREWS, LITTLEPAGE-BUGGS SWEEP BIG 12 HONORS

- Sarah Andrews and Darianna Littlepage-Buggs were named the Big 12 Player and Big 12 Freshman of the Week, respectively, on Feb 6, sweeping the weekly awards for the second time this season.
- Andrews has earned the Big 12 Player of the Week recognition twice this year, while Littlepage-Buggs is a eight-time freshman of the week honoree.

APPLYING PRESSURE

- The Bears have forced their opponents to turn the ball over 20-plus times in seven games this season, most recently forcing 20 turnovers by Kansas on Feb. 1.
- The Bears forced 28 turnovers by the Lady Mavs on Dec. 7 - the most in a game by an opponent since McNeese turned the ball over 38 times in 2020.
- In Big 12 play, opponents committed 17-or-more turnovers against Baylor in 10 of 18 games.
- A total of 548 points by BU this season have been scored off of opponent turnovers.

SHARING IS CARING

- In the Bears' win over Kansas State on Jan. 18, Baylor recorded an assist on 96.6% (28-of-29) of its made baskets, which was the highest percentage of assisted baskets in a Division I game this season.
- Caitlin Bickle led the way with a career-high eight assists, while Jaden Owens finished with seven and Jana Van Gytenbeek added four off the bench.

NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED

- The Bears and junior guard Sarah Andrews combined for five national honors the week of Jan. 9 after picking up a pair of top-25 wins on the road at Oklahoma (Jan. 3) and Kansas (Jan. 7).
- Baylor was named ESPN's National Team of the Week, U.S. Basketball Writers Association National Team of the Week and the NCAA.com Team of the Week.
- Andrews was selected as the ESPN National Player of the Week, as well as the Naismith Trophy Player of the Week.

IN THE REARVIEW

- The Bears went 9-3 during the non-conference portion of their schedule to start the 2022-23 campaign.
- The nine wins marked the 23rd-straight year that BU has recorded at least nine victories in the non-con to start a season. The last time the Bears won less than nine games was during the 1998-99 slate when they went 8-4 against opponents outside of the league.
- The four top-25 matchups in the first 12 games marked the most since the 2016-17 slate.
- BU grabbed a top-25 win over Villanova at the Florida Gulf Coast Showcase on Nov. 26. All three of the Bears' setbacks have been to teams in the AP Top 25.
- The Bears have used six different lineups this season due to ongoing unavailability of players throughout the year.
- The Bears went 7-1 at the Ferrell Center in non-conference games. The eight home games marked the second time in the last five seasons BU has hosted that many non-con opponents to start a season.

WINNING BIG

- The 66-point margin of win over Tennessee State on Dec. 15 was the largest by BU this season and largest in the Nicki Collen era. It was the second-largest victory by the program since recording a 93-point win against McNeese on Dec. 19, 2020, and a 55-point victory over UTA on Dec. 7 of this year.
- The 93 points put up by the Bears against the Tigers were the most scored this season, behind the 92-point output against Saint Louis (Nov. 25) and 91 outpouring against UTA (Dec. 7). Additionally, it was the sixth time BU reached 90 in a game in the Collen era.
- Baylor has won 10 games by 20-or-more points - including three in Big 12 action - and six of those wins have been by at least 25.

BUGGS MAKES BIG STATEMENT

- With a 30-point, 11-rebound outing against Tennessee State on Dec. 15, Darianna Littlepage-Buggs became the first Division I player in the country to outscore a Division I opponent by herself this season. Additionally, she became just the fourth in the Big 12 to do so since the 1999-00 campaign.
- With her performance, Littlepage-Buggs became the first Big 12 and Baylor freshman to outscore an opponent by herself since Brittney Griner did so in 2009-10.
- She was the first Bear to reach the 30-point plateau since NaLyssa Smith poured in 37 against Oklahoma on March 12, 2022.
- Littlepage-Buggs became just the third player in the Big 12 to notch 30 points in a game this year, behind Gabby Gregory (Kansas State) and Ashley Joens (Iowa State).

FIGHT IN FLORIDA

- Baylor played three games in three days, including a pair of matchups with top-25 opponents, at the Gulf Coast Showcase, Nov. 25-27, in Estero Florida.
- Senior Jaden Owens was named to the 2022 Gulf Coast Showcase All-Tournament Team after a career outing at the event. She notched a career-high 17 points in the win over Villanova before surpassing that with 22 points against Michigan. On the weekend, she averaged 16.7 points per game and shot 60.6% from the floor.
- The Bears advanced to the championship game, falling to an undefeated Michigan team, 84-75.
- The contest marked the first time since the 2016-17 campaign that the Bears played a trio of non-conference regular-season games in a four-game span against teams in the AP Top 25 (Maryland, Saint Louis (NR), Villanova, Michigan)

FEELING IT IN FERRELL

- In the Nicki Collen era, Baylor is 26-8 in home games and 13-6 in Big 12 contests at the Ferrell Center under the direction of Collen.
- Baylor has won 72 of the last 74 non-conference games at the Ferrell Center, including 15 NCAA Tournament contests.
- It's last non-conference loss during the regular season at home prior to the 73-68 setback to No. 19 Maryland (Nov. 20) came Jan. 13, 2014 vs. UConn (66-55).
- The Bears suffered a 61-47 setback to South Dakota in the second round of the 2022 NCAA Tournament.

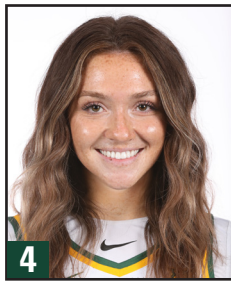
STARTING STRONG

- The Bears have won 13-straight season openers, courtesy of the 88-50 victory over Lamar at the Ferrell Center on Nov. 7. Baylor's last season-opening loss was during the 2009-10 season to then-No. 9/8 Tennessee on the road, falling 74-65. The Bears were ranked No. 7/4 to start the year.
- Baylor's match-up with Lamar marked the 13th-consecutive year the Bears started their season at home. Baylor has won 18-straight home openers, dating back to the 2005-06 campaign.

WELCOME HOME

- Eight new faces joined the Baylor program in the offseason. Darianna Littlepage-Buggs, who was tabbed the Preseason Big 12 Freshman of the Year, is joined by Kyla Abraham and Bella Fontleroy in the rookie class that was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.
- A transfer from Missouri who was named Preseason Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, Aijha Blackwell adds depth alongside Jana Van Gytenbeek (Stanford), Erika Porter (Illinois), Catarina Ferreira (Eastern Arizona College) and Dre'Una Edwards (Kentucky), who all joined the Bears in the offseason.

HEAD COACH NICKI COLLEN • 2ND SEASON



Nicki Collen was introduced as the fifth Head Coach in Baylor women's basketball history on May 5, 2021 and is in her second season at the helm in 2022-23.

In her first season with the Bears, Collen recorded the most wins by a rookie head coach in the country with 28. She helped lead the Bears to their 12th-straight Big 12 regular-season title and their 11th-straight top-two seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Collen implemented her system, which featured more perimeter shooting. Baylor went from the bottom of the list nationally to just outside the top 50 in 3-pointers made. In her first season, the Bears set new program records for 3-pointers made (233) and attempted (678).

From her introductory press conference, the Naismith Coach of the Year semifinalist said the Bears would be playing their best basketball late in the season, and she was right. Baylor became the first team to defeat a ranked opponent twice in a three-day span since 1999 when the Bears downed Texas two times to open the month of February. Two weeks later, exactly a month after sitting at the bottom of the conference standings with an 0-2 record, BU was back atop the league's leaderboard.

Collen implemented the 1-0 mentality that paid off with a 25-point win at No. 8 Iowa State in front of a nearly sold-out crowd of 13,000 raucous fans which clinched the conference crown. Baylor became the first team since Texas Tech in 2000 to start a Big 12 season 0-2 and go on to win the league.

After her first season ended in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Collen saw three of her players be selected in the 2022 WNBA Draft, tying a program record. Two of them - NaLyssa Smith (No. 2) and Queen Egbo (No. 10) marked the first duo to be taken in the top 10 in program history.

Collen's first recruiting class was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

Collen came to Baylor from the WNBA's Atlanta franchise, where she spent the last three seasons at the helm for the Dream. Her rookie season in Atlanta resulted in a 23-11 season in 2018, where she earned WNBA Coach of the Year honors and helped the franchise to the WNBA Playoff Semifinals.

Prior to her arrival in Atlanta, she spent two seasons under former head coach Curt Miller of the Connecticut Sun, helping the franchise improve from fifth in the East Division to second from 2016 to 2017, respectively.

"I am thrilled to be the head coach at Baylor University. I believe it is the top job in the country for women's basketball," said Collen. "I am excited to begin working with this extremely talented team and I am grateful for the unwavering support of President Livingstone and Mack Rhoades. The success of this program speaks for itself, and I will begin working today to ensure Baylor women's basketball continues to be a program that excels at the highest levels."

Collen's collegiate coaching career spanned for nine seasons prior to her WNBA arrival. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Colorado State from 2000-2002, one season at Ball State from 2002-2003, one at Louisville from 2003-2004, three at Arkansas from 2011-2014 and two at Florida Gulf Coast from 2014-2016.

Her teams' combined record in nine seasons as an NCAA Division I assistant was 214-74, good for a .743 win percentage. As an assistant, Collen guided four different squads to the NCAA Tournament, reaching the second round in three of those seasons.

She spent six of her nine seasons as an assistant under her husband, Tom Collen's head-coaching tenures at Colorado State, Louisville and Arkansas. She also coached under Tracy Roller at Ball State and Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Collen helped the FGCU program to a 64-9 record and the school's first NCAA Tournament win in her two-year tenure.

In her nine seasons at the collegiate level, Collen coached three All-Americans and saw three players selected in the WNBA Draft.

Collen's collegiate playing career began at Purdue in 1993-94, when the Boilermakers made an NCAA Final Four run with a 29-5 overall record and a 16-2 mark in the Big Ten. Her sophomore season, Purdue made another deep run with an Elite Eight appearance to go with a 24-8 overall record. She transferred to Marquette, where she tallied 421 assists in her final two seasons, averaging 7.0 per game in her last 60 collegiate games. She helped the Golden Eagles to two-straight NCAA Tournament appearances in 1997 and 1998.

Nicki and her husband Tom have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan.

THE BAYLOR BEARS REGIME

2019 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2018-19 Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame, 82-81, April 7 in Tampa, Florida. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox**, each earning multiple all-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament championship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the Associated Press and the WBCA.

2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2011-12 Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. **Brittney Griner** and **Mulkey** swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE & 11-PLUS YEAR DOMINANCE

- The Bears have made 19-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 21 overall. Those appearances have resulted in three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Elite Eights and 14 Sweet Sixteens.
- The Bears are 24-time Big 12 Champions-- most in Big 12 history --capturing 12 of the last 13 regular season titles, 13 overall & 11 tournament titles.
- Baylor is 415-47 (.898) over the past 12 seasons while posting a 212-20 mark in Big 12 play and 29-3 in Big 12 Tournament play.
- 335 of Baylor's 396 wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 19 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.

BIG 12 DYNASTY

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 24 Big 12 Conference titles -- 13 regular season and 11 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game 15 times in program history.
- The Bears have won eight of the last 10 Big 12 Championship titles, last besting No. 17/20 West Virginia, 76-50, in the 2021 final.

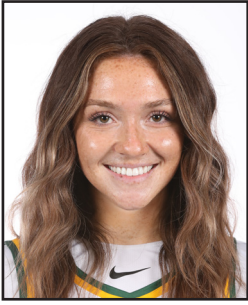
