Acrobatics & Tumbling

- The top-ranked Bears will host a pair of competitions this week, welcoming Frostburg State on Wednesday and Quinnipiac on Saturday to the Ferrell Center.
- Kamryn Kitchens was named Athlete of the Week while Jordan Gruendler earned Specialist of the Week after their performances in the win over Oregon in Eugene on Mar. 8.

Baseball

- Baylor had its best week of the season, posting a 3-1 record with a series win over Kansas State and a midweek win over Rice.
- The Bears bounced back from a series-opening setback to secure the series win with back-to-back 8-4 results, including an eight-run sixth inning in the rubber match.
- Baylor was boosted in the Sunday win by three perfect innings from Big 12 Pitcher of the Week Will Rigney in relief, with the righty returning to form from injury in 2022 to fan six of the nine hitters he faced.

Men's Basketball

- Baylor advanced to the Round of 32 in the NCAA Tournament with a dominating second half in a win over UC Santa Barbara.
- The Bears then fell in the second round to Creighton 85-76 despite a 30-point game from guard LJ Cryer.

Women's Basketball

- Baylor moved onto the second round in the NCAA Tournament behind a furious comeback to beat 10th seeded Alabama in Storrs, Conn., on Saturday. Baylor rallied from down 22-4 after the first quarter to outscore Bama 74-52 in the final three periods.
- The Bears will face host and second-seeded UConn for a berth in the Sweet 16 on Monday night.

Men's Golf

- No. 23 men's golf coming off a tie for sixth at the Cabo Collegiate
- BU returned to the top-25 this season for the first time since 2021.
- Will resume their schedule at the Aggie Invitational Apr. 10-11 at Traditions GC in College Station.

Women's Golf

- No. 14 Baylor is the only team in the Big 12 and the State of Texas to have three individuals ranked in the top-50 of the individual Golf Stat rankings.
- Will play two more tournaments in the Phoenix area before beginning the Postseason.

Men's Tennis

- No. 42 Baylor faced a pair of top-20 foes over the weekend, falling vs. No. 16 Wake Forest and No. 19 Illinois before posting a 7-0 win over Prairie View A&M in the nightcap of a Sunday doubleheader.
- The Bears got singles wins from Tadeas Paroulek and Zsombor Velcz in the Illinois match.

Women's Tennis

- No. 53 Baylor earned the 500th victory in the career of Coach Joey Scrivano with a 4-2 winner at Kansas State on Sunday. The Bears split the Kansas trip, faling at No. 19 Kansas on Friday.
- The Bears won the doubles point and got singles wins from Alina Shcherbinina, Anita Sahdiieva and Liubov Kostenko in the KSU win.

Softball

- No. 22 Baylor went 4-1 on the week with a midweek doubleheader split on Wednesday before sweeping future Big 12 foe Houston at Getteman Stadium.
- The Bears were led last week by catcher Sydney Collazos, who hit .692 with nine hits and a dinger.

Equestrian

- The Bears, ranked ninth, will open Big 12 Equestrian Championship play in Stillwater on Friday vs. host and No. 5 Oklahoma State.
- Baylor, fighting to earn a NCEA Championship berth, will then face TCU or Fresno State in the second round.

Track & Field

- The Bears will return to action with the Clyde Hart Classic in Waco on Friday and Saturday.
- Baylor will then venture to the Texas Relays in Austin March 29 - April 1.
